## BIG SOUTH KICKS OFF 14TH SEASON THIS WEEK

The Big South Conference begins Year 14 of its football history this week with all seven teams in action. Big South football teams are a combined 36-40 in season openers since 2002, including a League-best four wins in 2005, 2006 and 2010. Nineteen of the 40 losses (=47.5 percent) have been against FBS members. Coastal Carolina has the current longest season-opening win streak in the Conference at four games, while Gardner-Webb has won eight season openers since the Conference began football.

## WELCOME MAT

The Big South Conference welcomes start-up program **KENNESAW STATE UNIVERSITY** as an associate member in 2015, returning the league to seven football members.

## TEAM-BY-TEAM OPENERS

Charleston Southern is opening the campaign at home for the second consecutive year but just the third time in the last 12 seasons ... Coastal Carolina is opening on the road for the third consecutive year ... Gardner-Webb is opening on the road for the second-straight season ... Liberty will play its season opener at Williams Stadium for the first time since 2008 ... Monmouth is opening the season at home for the second year in a row but just the seventh time in the program's 23-year history ... Presbyterian College is opening its season on the road for the third-straight year at an FBS foe ... Kennesaw State is making its program debut. Below is a team-by-team look at season openers:

## COASTAL CAROLINA PICKED TO WIN IT ALL IN 2015

For the third consecutive season, defending Conference co-champion Coastal Carolina University has been tabbed the favorite in the Big South Conference's annual preseason football poll for the 2015 campaign, as voted by the league's head coaches and media panel. The Chanticleers have won or shared seven Big South titles since the program's first season in 2003.

## BIG SOUTH CONTINUES PRESEASON TREND OF RANKED TEAMS

For the first time in league history, the Big South has two teams ranked in the preseason Top 25 polls, as Coastal Carolina is No. 5/5 (FCS Coaches / STATS), while Liberty is No. 14/15. The Chants' season-opening rank is the highest in league history, and marks the sixth consecutive year that a Big South member has opened the season as a nationally-ranked program.

## SPEAKING OF NATIONAL RANKINGS

The Big South has had a football squad nationally-ranked for 51 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 campaign (Oct. 24). The league had two teams ranked at the same time six times in 2014, including the final polls. In fact, all six Big South football members in 2014 were either ranked or received votes in one or both national polls at some point -- a league first. Coastal Carolina spent two weeks (Nov. 10-22) as the nation's No. 1 ranked team in the FCS Coaches poll -- the first time in the conference's history that any athletic program received a No. 1 national poll ranking.

## BIG SOUTH SETS RECORD FOR MOST FCS WINS FOR SECOND-STRAIGHT YEAR

One year after posting an all-time league best 18-10 mark against FCS opponents in 2013 -- including 16 regular-season victories, the Big South eclipsed that standard with a record-setting 24-7 performance in 2014 with 22 regular-season wins. In addition, the Big South won 11 of its 24 FCS games on the road last season -- also setting a league record. The previous best was eight in 2013. Big South members were 3-2 against the Colonial and 7-2 against the SoCon in 2014.

## SEVENTH HEAVEN

The Big South had a record-tying seven players named preseason All-American by STATS LLC, matching the record set in 2014. Liberty led all of FCS with three first-team selections -- OG **JONATHAN BURGESS**, WR **DARRIN PETERSON** and PK **JOHN LUNSFORD**.

## GOOD WORK YOUNG MEN

For the second time in Big South history, two football players have been nominated for the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team®, as Gardner-Webb's **CHAD GETER** and Liberty's **CHIMA UZOWIHE** are among the 197 candidates from every subdivision and classification. The Big South has had one honoree named to the team -- Charleston Southern's **JORDAN LANCASTER** in 2010.

## ROSS, PETERSON NAMED CANDIDATES FOR NATIONAL OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR AWARD

For the second consecutive year and third time in Big South history, two players open the season as official candidates for the FCS National Offensive Player of the Year Award, as Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS**, who finished seventh in the voting last year, and Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** are among the initial 22 candidates for the top individual award in FCS. Last season, Ross and Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK** opened the campaign among the initial candidates. In 2011, Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** and Flames' WR **CHRIS SUMMERS** were the Big South's first preseason duo.

## MAU, UZOWIHE NAMED CANDIDATES FOR NATIONAL DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR AWARD

For the second consecutive year, the Big South has multiple players among the initial 22 candidates for the FCS National Defensive Player of the Year Award, as Gardner-Webb DL **O.J. MAU** and Liberty DL **CHIMA UZOWIHE** are on this year's watch list. The Big South had a record three candidates in 2014.

## COASTAL'S ROSS TABBED PRESEASON OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Coastal Carolina redshirt-senior quarterback **ALEX ROSS** has been voted the Big South's 2015 Preseason Offensive Player of the Year. Ross is the reigning Big South's Offensive Player of the Year and is among the initial 22 candidates for the FCS National Offensive Player of the Year award, which is given to the top player in FCS. He set conference and school single-season records in 2014 for passing yards (3,389), completions (271) and total offense (4,080) while rushing for 691 yards -- second-most in a season by a Big South quarterback -- and had seven games with at least 300 yards of total offense. Ross led the Big South in six offensive categories last season while ranking among the FCS leaders in passing yards (8th, 3,389); total offense (11th, 291.4 ypg); completion percentage (14th, 64.2); points responsible for (18th, 176); yards per passing attempt (20th, 8.03); passing efficiency (20th, 144.0 rating) and passing touchdowns (30th, 20).

## GWU'S MAU PICKED AS PRESEASON DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Gardner-Webb senior defensive lineman **O.J. MAU**, named a 2015 National Defensive Player of the Year candidate and preseason All-American by STATS, is the first defensive lineman since 2007 to be voted Big South Preseason Defensive Player of the Year. He earned postseason All-America honors from Phil Steele (2013) and College Sporting News (2014) over the past two seasons, and was a finalist for the 2014 Buck Buchanan Award as a junior. Mau was the lynchpin for a defense that ranked No. 5 nationally as a sophomore in 2013, and last season posted a career-high 60 total tackles, 10.0 tackles for loss and 3.0 sacks from his spot in the middle of the trenches. He forced a career-best two fumbles and had a 27-yard fumble return in the season finale. Mau also blocked a field goal for the first time in his career in 2014. Not surprisingly, 82 percent of Mau's tackles came on run plays in 2014. He had double figures stops in wins over both Wofford and Charlotte and collected a season-best 3.0 tackles for loss in the season opener vs. Furman. He has totaled 20.5 career tackles for loss and burst onto the scene as a first-year starter in 2013.

## MARK YOUR CALENDARS FOR THIS ONE

The highly-anticipated Coastal Carolina at Liberty season finale on Nov. 21 has been moved to Thursday night, Nov. 19, at 7:00pm and will be televised live on ESPNNEWS. It will be the first time a conference game will air on one of ESPN's linear networks, as well as the first league contest to be played on Thursday night. The teams will meet the final weekend for the second consecutive year, and the series is tied, 6-6, and the winner of the match-up has won or shared the Big South football Championship 10 times. The Chanticleers won three-straight over Liberty from 2004-06 en route to three consecutive titles (two outright, one shared). The Flames were victorious from 2007-09 while winning three-straight Big South crowns (two outright, one shared). Liberty won last season's meeting and both teams shared the title in 2014, as well as 2010, 2012 and 2013.

## PASSING GRADES

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** is 2,275 passing yards away from breaking the Big South career record of 9,768, which was established by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** from 2003-06. Woodrum is currently third all-time with 7,494, and needs 682 yards to surpass Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** for second. Beatty had 8,175 yards from 2011-14. Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** is lurking as well, as he is fifth in league history with 6,909 career passing yards, just 2,859 yards from catching Drafts.

## OFFENSIVE JUGGERNAUTS

After becoming the first player in Big South history with 4,000 yards of offense in a season with 4,080 in 2014, Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** needs 2,308 yards this year to become the Big South's all-time leader. The current career mark is 10,571, set by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** from 2003-06. Ross, who is second only to Drafts in yardage, is 1,736 yards away from joining Drafts in the 10,000-yard club. Meanwhile, Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** is lurking as well, as he is fifth in league history with 7,899 career offensive yards, just 2,101 away from 10,000 and 2,672 from catching Drafts.
