PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - SEPT. 7

CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - DE'ANGELO HENDERSON, COASTAL CAROLINA, RB, R-Jr (SUMMERVILLE, S.C.)

Amassed 224 all-purpose yards and scored a touchdown in Coastal's 38-35 win at Furman. Henderson caught seven passes for 129 yards -- the first running back in league history with 100 receiving yards in a game, and finished with 95 yards rushing and a touchdown in nearly becoming the first player in Big South history with 100 yards rushing and receiving in the same game. Henderson averaged 10.18 yards per touch against the Paladins, had catches of 17 and 23 yards on CCU's opening scoring drive, and scored from two yards out to give Coastal a 21-7 advantage.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - CHIMA UZOWIHE, LIBERTY, DE, Sr (HOUSTON, TEXAS)

Tallied four total tackles, 2.5 sacks and a forced fumble in Liberty's victory over Delaware State. He recorded a quarterback hurry that forced the Hornets to punt on their first possession, and later forced a fumble on a first down sack in the second quarter. He added a half-sack on the next series, and recorded a sack for a loss of seven yards early in the third quarter on a 2nd-and-1 situation.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - DEVIN BROWN, COASTAL CAROLINA, KR, R-Jr (CHARLESTON, S.C.)

Returned three kickoffs for 138 yards (46.0 average) against Furman, including a 100-yard return for a touchdown. After Furman tied the game at 7-7 in the first quarter, Brown returned the ensuing kickoff down the left sideline for the score -- his Big South record fourth career kickoff return TD. He also became just the third player in league annals with a 100-yard kickoff return.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - SOLOMON BROWN, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, LB, R-Fr (CENTRAL, S.C.)

Recorded seven tackles, three tackles-for-loss, two sacks and a forced fumble in Charleston Southern's season-opening win. His game-high three stops behind the line resulted in minus-17 yards, while both of his sacks came on third down -- including a sack-fumble that was recovered by CSU.

COASTAL CAROLINA RETURNS TO NO. 1 IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

For the second time in league history, the Big South has the No. 1-ranked football team in the nation, as Coastal Carolina claimed the top spot in this week's FCS Coaches poll. The Chanticleers are No. 3 in the STATS FCS ranking. Last season, the Chanticleers became the first athletic program in conference history to receive the No. 1 ranking in a national poll when CCU was No. 1 in the FCS Coaches poll for two weeks from Nov. 10-22.

SPEAKING OF NATIONAL RANKINGS

The Big South has had a football squad nationally-ranked for 52 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 campaign (Oct. 24). The league has had two teams ranked at the same time for two consecutive weeks this season, as Liberty is No. 13 in the FCS Coaches poll and No. 15 in the STATS ranking. The conference has two teams nationally-ranked in the same week for the 25th time overall in league history, including 20 times since the start of the 2013 season.

FOR OPENERS

The Big South tied its mark for most season-opening wins this past weekend, as four teams are 1-0. It is the fourth time that four teams opened with wins, joining the 2005, 2006 and 2010 seasons. Big South football teams are now a combined 40-43 in season openers since 2002, with 21 of those 43 losses (=48.8 percent) against FBS competition.

MORE ON THE 1-0 TEAMS

Coastal Carolina is 1-0 for the fifth consecutive year and eighth time in the history of the program. The Chants are looking for their fifth consecutive 2-0 start this week. Charleston Southern is 1-0 for the third straight year and is seeking its third 2-0 start in as many seasons. Liberty is 1-0 for the first time since 2010, which was also the last time the Flames opened 2-0. Start-up program Kennesaw State was victorious in the program's debut contest last Thursday.

SMASHING DEBUT

As mentioned above, Kennesaw State won its first-ever contest, as the Owls defeated East Tennessee State, 56-16. KSU is the sixth different program to win its first game as members of the Big South, joining Gardner-Webb and Elon in 2002, Coastal Carolina in 2003, Stony Brook in 2008 and Monmouth in 2014. Meanwhile, Kennesaw State's 56 points at East Tennessee State was the most points scored by a Big South member in a season opener against an FCS opponent, and the fourth-most points scored overall in an opening game of a season since the league's formation in 2002.

HOME SWEET HOME

Three teams played their home openers last week (Charleston Southern, Liberty and Monmouth) and Gardner-Webb and Kennesaw State will play their home openers this Saturday. Coastal Carolina and Presbyterian open their respective home slates Sept. 19. Below is a look at the last home-opening win and current home opening streaks for GWU, CCU and PC.

NESTING

Kennesaw State rushed for 416 yards and six touchdowns in its debut game against East Tennessee State -- just the 10th time in league history that a football member gained at least 415 yards on the ground with six rushing TDs. The last to do it was Presbyterian on Sept. 6, 2014 against Bluefield (523/7). KSU's performance was just the fifth such effort against an FCS opponent.

GET SMART

Gardner-Webb QB **TYRELL MAXWELL** became the first quarterback in Big South history to rush for 100 yards and pass for 100 yards in the same game against an FBS opponent with his 102 rushing yards and 132 passing yards at South Alabama in the season opener. He is the 10th overall QB in league history with 100 rush/100 pass yards in the same game, and the third Gardner-Webb quarterback to achieve the feat in Big South annals.

GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE

Presbyterian College RB **DARRELL BRIDGES** rushed for a 125 yards at Miami (Ohio) this past weekend, the fifth-highest single-game rushing total by a Big South player against an FBS opponent. It was Bridges' second consecutive 100-yard rushing game, as he gained a career-high 135 yards at Gardner-Webb in PC's 2014 season finale.

THIS IS SARGENT PETERSON

Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** is on pace to become the Big South's all-time leading receiver by season's end. He is currently 10th with 155 career receptions -- 68 away from the record of 223 set by Gardner-Webb's **JAMES PERRY III** from 2008-11. Peterson is 45 catches shy of becoming just the third Big South player with 200. Meanwhile, he needs 374 receiving yards to break the Big South record of 2,720, which is held by Coastal Carolina's **JEROME SIMPSON**.

DON OF A NEW DAY

Presbyterian College LB **DONELLE WILLIAMS** is one tackle away from becoming the 12th player in Big South history with 300 career tackles. Williams, who averages 8.08 tackles per game, needs 10 tackles to move into the league's all-time top 10 and 50 stops to crack the top 5. He is fifth all-time with 168 solo hits and 32 away from becoming the second player with 200.

CHIM CHIMINY

Liberty DE **CHIMA UZOWIHE** recorded 2.5 quarterback sacks in the season opener against Delaware State to push his career total to 19.5 -- second-most all-time in Big South history and just one away from tying the career record of 20.5 set by Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** from 2004-07.

EXCEPTIONAL ESTES

Gardner-Webb TE **MIKE ESTES** is quickly moving up the Big South record book among tight ends. His 56 career receptions rank fourth all-time, just three away from moving into third-place. Estes' 775 career receiving yards are third-most in league history -- just 136 away from unseating **DAVID DURAN** for the top spot. Duran had 910 receiving yards for Coastal Carolina from 2009-12.

CAKE ROSS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** recorded his 13th career game with 300 yards of offense this past Saturday as he amassed 362 yards at Furman. Ross is second in league annals for most games with 300 yards of offense, just two away from **MIKE BROWN**'s record of 15. Ross is second all-time with 8,626 yards of offense, just 374 yards away from 9,000. Meanwhile, Ross is third in Big South history for most rushing yards by a quarterback with 1,389. He needs 250 to unseat former Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** (1,638) for second.

OFFENSIVE JUGGERNAUTS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** needs 1,946 yards this year to become the Big South's all-time leader in total offense. The current career mark is 10,571, set by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** from 2003-06. Ross, who is second only to Drafts in yardage, is 1,374 yards away from joining Drafts in the 10,000-yard club. Meanwhile, Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** is lurking as well, as he is fourth in league history with 8,091 career offensive yards, just 1,909 away from 10,000 and 2,481 from catching Drafts.

PASSING GRADES

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** is 2,087 passing yards away from breaking the Big South career record of 9,768, which was established by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** from 2003-06. Woodrum is currently third all-time with 7,682, and needs 494 yards to surpass Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** for second. Beatty had 8,175 yards from 2011-14. Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** is lurking as well, as he is fourth in league history with 7,237 career passing yards, just 2,531 yards from catching Drafts.

50-50 RAFFLE

Coastal Carolina's **ALEX ROSS** and Liberty's **JOSH WOODRUM** are among the five all-time players in Big South history to throw 50 career touchdown passes. Ross is tied with former Coastal QB **TYLER THIGPEN** for second all-time with 53 career scoring strikes, while Woodrum became the fifth member of the 50-TD pass club this past weekend after throwing two TDs against Delaware State to push his total to 51 and fourth-place on the list. Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** is the all-time leader with 73.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 112, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (46). Meanwhile, Liberty is the Big South's record holder for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 56.

HIGH RATE OF RETURN

Coastal Carolina is 65-5 (=92.9 percent) when rushing for 200 yards in game, including 26-1 under head coach **JOE MOGLIA**. The Chanticleers have reached the 200-yard rushing plateau 62.8 percent of the time during Moglia's 43 games as head coach.

HENDERSON HOPPING THROUGH BIG SOUTH RECORD BOOK

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** became the first running back in Big South history to have 100 receiving yards in a game with his 129 at Furman in the season opener. He also narrowly missed becoming the first Big South player with 100 yards rushing and receiving in the same game, as he fell five rushing yards shy against the Paladins. Meanwhile, Henderson needs 772 rushing yards to become the fifth player in Big South history with 3,000 in a career. He is also three rushing TDs away from 30, which would make him the fifth on that list as well. Once Henderson hits 3,000 career rushing yards and 30 career rushing touchdowns, he would be just the third player to achieve this feat. The other two are Big South all-time leading rusher **MIGUEL MAYSONET** (4,725 yards, 48 TD) and **RASHAD JENNINGS** (3,633 yards, 42 TD).

BROWN'S RECORD HOUSE CALL

Coastal Carolina KR **DEVIN BROWN** is the Big South's all-time leader for kickoff return touchdowns with four, as he broke away from a five-way tie at three to secure the top spot. Brown's record-breaker was a 100-yard return in the season opener at Furman -- just the third 100-yard kickoff return in league history. The NCAA FCS record for career kick returns for a touchdown is six. Meanwhile, Brown's career kickoff return average of 27.2 is just shy of the Big South record of 27.8, which is held by Stony Brook's **BROCK JACKOLSKI** (2010-11).

JOHNNY B-GOOD

Liberty kicker **JOHN LUNSFORD** extended his Big South record of most field goals from 50 yards-or-longer to nine with his 52-yarder against Delaware State in the season opener, and is now 9-of-14 for his career from 50-plus yards (=64.3 percent). It was also Lunsford's 15th career FG from at least 40 yards, which is tied with former Flames kicker **MATT BEVINS** for most in conference history. Lunsford needs four field goals to become the fifth Big South placekicker with 40 in a career.

STREAKERS

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** has scored a touchdown in 15 consecutive games, dating back to last season. Henderson's streak is the second-longest in Big South history, and trails the mark of 18 consecutive games set by Liberty's **ZACH TERRELL** from 2006-08.

GOOD WORK YOUNG MEN

For the second time in Big South history, two football players have been nominated for the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team®, as Gardner-Webb's **CHAD GETER** and Liberty's **CHIMA UZOWIHE** are among the 197 candidates from every subdivision and classification. The Big South has had one honoree named to the team -- Charleston Southern's **JORDAN LANCASTER** in 2010.

ROSS, PETERSON NAMED CANDIDATES FOR NATIONAL OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR AWARD

For the second consecutive year and third time in Big South history, two players open the season as official candidates for the FCS National Offensive Player of the Year Award, as Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS**, who finished seventh in the voting last year, and Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** are among the initial 22 candidates for the top individual award in FCS. Last season, Ross and Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK** opened the campaign among the initial candidates. In 2011, Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** and Flames' WR **CHRIS SUMMERS** were the Big South's first preseason duo.

MAU, UZOWIHE NAMED CANDIDATES FOR NATIONAL DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR AWARD

For the second consecutive year, the Big South has multiple players among the initial 22 candidates for the FCS National Defensive Player of the Year Award, as Gardner-Webb DL **O.J. MAU** and Liberty DL **CHIMA UZOWIHE** are on this year's watch list. The Big South had a record three candidates in 2014.

MARK YOUR CALENDARS FOR THIS ONE

The highly-anticipated Coastal Carolina at Liberty season finale on Nov. 21 has been moved to Thursday night, Nov. 19, at 7:00pm and will be televised live on ESPNEWS. It will be the first time a conference game will air on one of ESPN's linear networks, as well as the first league contest to be played on Thursday night. The teams will meet the final weekend for the second consecutive year, and the series is tied, 6-6, and the winner of the match-up has won or shared the Big South football Championship 10 times. The Chanticleers won three-straight over Liberty from 2004-06 en route to three consecutive titles (two outright, one shared). The Flames were victorious from 2007-09 while winning three-straight Big South crowns (two outright, one shared). Liberty won last season's meeting and both teams shared the title in 2014, as well as 2010, 2012 and 2013.
