PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - SEPT. 14

CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - DE'ANGELO HENDERSON, COASTAL CAROLINA, RB, R-Jr (SUMMERVILLE, S.C.)

Henderson rushed for 136 yards and one touchdown, and caught five passes for 44 yards to help the Chanticleers to a 41-14 win at South Carolina State. He had 116 yards on 21 carries in the first half, including a 3-yard touchdown run that gave CCU a 15-0 lead. Henderson rushed for 30 of Coastal's 49 yards during the eight-play drive. He posted five plays of 10 yards or more (three rushes, two receptions) and was responsible for 11 first downs (nine rush, two receiving).

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - DERRICK FARROW, KENNESAW STATE, DB, Jr (COCHRAN, GA.)

Farrow forced three fumbles and had a team-high five tackles -- all solo -- in Kennesaw State's home-opening victory over Edward Waters. His second quarter forced fumble resulted in an 18-yard recovery and touchdown for the Owls. Later in the third quarter, Farrow forced fumbles on back-to-back plays. The first was recovered by EWC but resulted in a one-yard loss. On the next play, Farrow ran down the ball carrier after a 73-yard run and caused a fumble at the KSU seven-yard line that was recovered by the Owls.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - EVAN RABON, COASTAL CAROLINA, P, Fr (FLORENCE, S.C.)

Rabon averaged 41.7 yards on three punts at South Carolina State, and landed all three inside the 20-yard line as the Bulldogs could not manage any returns. He had a 46-yard punt that was fair caught at the SCSU 15-yard line, his second kick was 48 yards and downed at the 15, and his last punt was downed inside the one-yard line.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - DEONTA FAIR, MONMOUTH, DB, Fr (MIAMI, FLA.)

Fair recorded five tackles (four solo) at Central Michigan with an interception -- Monmouth's first forced turnover of the season. He picked off the pass at the MU 11-yard line and returned it 33 yards to give the Hawks possession near midfield. Fair also helped limit CMU to just 66 yards of offense in the second half.

LOOK WHO'S 2-0!!

Coastal Carolina and Kennesaw State are 2-0, the fourth-straight season and the seventh time overall in league history that two Big South teams have opened the season undefeated after two games. The Chanticleers are 2-0 for the fifth consecutive season and are looking to start 3-0 for the third-straight year. The Owls are just the second Big South "newcomer" to open its first season in the conference at 2-0, joining the 2014 Monmouth Hawks. KSU has a chance to be the first member to start 3-0 in its first year in the league on Saturday.

RANK AND FILE

No. 14/15 Liberty hosts No. 7/8 Montana Saturday in an exclusive broadcast on ESPN3. It marks the 20th time that a ranked Big South member will play a ranked non-conference foe, and the ninth time during the regular-season. The league is 9-10 in such games, including 4-4 in regular-season matchups. Since 2008, the Flames have played nine ranked non-league opponents as a nationally-ranked program, going 4-5 in that span. Meanwhile, the No. 7/8-ranked Grizzlies are the highest ranked opponent to visit Williams Stadium since No. 3 James Madison in 2010.

COASTAL CAROLINA REMAINS NO. 1 IN FCS COACHES POLL

The Big South has the No. 1-ranked football team in the nation, as Coastal Carolina holds the top spot in the FCS Coaches poll for the second consecutive week. The Chanticleers are No. 2 in the STATS FCS ranking. It is the second-straight year the Big South has the No. 1 ranked FCS program, as the Chanticleers became the first athletic program in conference history to receive the No. 1 ranking in a national poll in 2014. CCU was No. 1 in the FCS Coaches poll for two weeks from Nov. 10-22.

SPEAKING OF NATIONAL RANKINGS

The Big South has had a football squad nationally-ranked for 53 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 campaign (Oct. 24). The league has had two teams ranked at the same time for three consecutive weeks this season, as Liberty is No. 14 in the FCS Coaches poll and No. 15 in the STATS ranking. The conference has two teams nationally-ranked in the same week for the 26th time overall in league history, including 21 times since the start of the 2013 season.

HOME SWEET HOME

Coastal Carolina and Presbyterian open their respective home slates this week, and below is a look at the last home-opening win and current home opening streaks for each.

HAMMING IT UP

Charleston Southern RB **DARIUS HAMMOND** rushed for 161 yards at Troy this past weekend, the second-highest single-game rushing total by a Big South player against an FBS opponent. The record is 220 yards by all-time leading rusher **MIGUEL MAYSONET** against Army in 2012. It was Hammond's second consecutive 100-yard rushing game, and he leads the Big South with 275 rushing yards after two games.

CHIM CHIMINY

Liberty DE **CHIMA UZOWIHE** leads the Big South with 3.5 quarterback sacks to push his career total to 20.5 -- tied with Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** (2004-07) as the all-time leader in Big South history. Uzowihe also entered the league's all-time Top 10 for career TFL, as he is tied for 10th at 30.5.

BIRDS OF PREY

Kennesaw State is the first Big South member since Gardner-Webb in 2005, and second overall, to open the season with consecutive 50-point games. No team has scored 50 points in each of its first three games during the Big South's football history. Meanwhile, the Owls became the first team in league annals to return two fumbles in a game when **IZZY SAM** (11 yards) and **McKENZIE BILLINGS-LEA** (18) each achieved the feat this past weekend against Edward Waters.

HOME EQUITY

Coastal Carolina will be the fifth team in Big South history to play four consecutive home games in a single-season, as the Chanticleers begin a four-game homestand on Saturday. Coastal joins the 2005 Liberty Flames, 2006 and 2014 Charleston Southern Buccaneers, and 2011 Stony Brook Seawolves in the group. The Chants are looking to match the success of the three most-recent occurrences, as CSU went 4-0 both times and SBU went 3-1.

TREY FOR TREY

Kennesaw State QB **TREY WHITE** rushed for three touchdowns this past Saturday against Edward Waters, becoming the first Big South quarterback with three rushing TDs in a game since VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2008. White is the fourth signal-caller to accomplish the rushing trifecta, joining Maypray, Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** (2005) and Elon's **JAMES MURDAUGH** (2002).

DON OF A NEW DAY

Presbyterian College LB **DONELLE WILLIAMS** became the 12th player in Big South history with 300 career tackles when he eclipsed the milestone this past Saturday at Charlotte. Williams sits at 305 and needs four to move into the league's all-time top 10 and 44 stops to crack the top 5. He is fifth all-time with 173 solo hits and 27 away from becoming the second player with 200.

THIS IS SARGENT PETERSON

Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** is on pace to become the Big South's all-time leading receiver by season's end. He is currently 10th with 159 career receptions -- 64 away from the record of 223 set by Gardner-Webb's **JAMES PERRY III** from 2008-11. Peterson is 41 catches shy of becoming just the third Big South player with 200. Meanwhile, he needs 310 receiving yards to break the Big South record of 2,720, which is held by Coastal Carolina's **JEROME SIMPSON**.

EXCEPTIONAL ESTES

Gardner-Webb TE **MIKE ESTES** is quickly moving up the Big South record book among tight ends. His 61 career receptions rank third all-time, just five away from moving into second-place. Estes' 808 career receiving yards are third-most in league history -- just 103 away from unseating **DAVID DURAN** for the top spot. Duran had 910 receiving yards for Coastal Carolina from 2009-12. Estes' former teammate **SETH CRANFILL** is second in yardage with 899.

OFFENSIVE JUGGERNAUTS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** (8,830) needs 1,742 yards to become the Big South's all-time leader in total offense. The current career mark is 10,571, set by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** from 2003-06. Ross, who is second only to Drafts in yardage, is 1,170 yards away from joining Drafts in the 10,000-yard club. Meanwhile, Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** is lurking as well, as he is third in league history with 8,379 career offensive yards, just 1,621 away from 10,000 and 2,192 from catching Drafts.

PASSING GRADES

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** is 1,807 passing yards away from breaking the Big South career record of 9,768, which was established by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** from 2003-06. Woodrum is currently third all-time with 7,962, and needs 214 yards to surpass Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** for second. Beatty had 8,175 yards from 2011-14. Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** is lurking as well, as he is fourth in league history with 7,432 career passing yards, just 2,336 yards from catching Drafts.

50-50 RAFFLE

Coastal Carolina's **ALEX ROSS** and Liberty's **JOSH WOODRUM** are among the five all-time players in Big South history to throw 50 career touchdown passes. Ross is second all-time with 55 career scoring strikes after becoming the Chanticleers' all-time leader this past Saturday. Woodrum became the fifth member of the 50-TD pass club in Week 1 and sits in fourth with 52. Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** is the all-time leader with 73.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 113, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (47). Meanwhile, Liberty is the Big South's record holder for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 57.

HIGH RATE OF RETURN

Coastal Carolina is 66-5 (=93.0 percent) when rushing for 200 yards in game, including 27-1 under head coach **JOE MOGLIA**. The Chanticleers have reached the 200-yard rushing plateau 63.6 percent of the time during Moglia's 44 games as head coach.

CAKE ROSS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** recorded his 13th career game with 300 yards of offense in Week 1 at Furman as he amassed 362 yards against the Paladins. He is second in league annals for most games with 300 yards of offense, just two away from **MIKE BROWN**'s record of 15. Meanwhile, Ross is third in Big South history for most rushing yards by a quarterback with 1,398. He needs 241 to unseat former Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** (1,638) for second. Ross' 17 career rushing touchdowns are tied for third-most in the conference record book among QBs, behind **TIM MAYPRAY**'s 18. Brown and Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS** share the record of 19.

HENDERSON HOPPING THROUGH BIG SOUTH RECORD BOOK

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** became the first running back in Big South history to have 100 receiving yards in a game with his 129 at Furman in Week 1. He also narrowly missed becoming the first Big South player with 100 yards rushing and receiving in the same game, as he fell five rushing yards shy against the Paladins. Meanwhile, Henderson needs 636 rushing yards to become the fifth player in Big South history with 3,000 in a career. He is also two rushing TDs away from 30, which would make him the fifth on that list as well. Once Henderson hits 3,000 career rushing yards and 30 career rushing touchdowns, he would be just the third player to achieve this feat. The other two are Big South all-time leading rusher **MIGUEL MAYSONET** (4,725 yards, 48 TD) and **RASHAD JENNINGS** (3,633 yards, 42 TD).

BROWN'S RECORD HOUSE CALL

Coastal Carolina KR **DEVIN BROWN** is the Big South's all-time leader for kickoff return touchdowns with four, as he broke away from a five-way tie at three to secure the top spot. Brown's record-breaker was a 100-yard return in Week 1 at Furman -- just the third 100-yard kickoff return in league history. The NCAA FCS record for career kick returns for a touchdown is six. Meanwhile, Brown's career kickoff return average of 27.2 is just shy of the Big South record of 27.8, which is held by Stony Brook's **BROCK JACKOLSKI** (2010-11).

JOHNNY B-GOOD

Liberty kicker **JOHN LUNSFORD** extended his Big South record of most field goals from 50 yards-or-longer to nine with his 52-yarder against Delaware State in Week 1, and is 9-of-14 for his career from 50-plus yards (=64.3 percent). This past weekend, Lunsford became the league's all-time record holder for most field goals from 40 yards-or-longer with his 16th career FG from that distance -- a 49-yarder at West Virginia. He surpassed the old mark of 15, which was set by former Flames kicker **MATT BEVINS** from 2008-11. Meanwhile, Lunsford needs three field goals to become the fifth Big South placekicker with 40 in a career.

STREAKERS

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** has scored a touchdown in 16 consecutive games, dating back to last season. Henderson's streak is the second-longest in Big South history, and trails the mark of 18 consecutive games set by Liberty's **ZACH TERRELL** from 2006-08.

FOR OPENERS

The Big South tied its mark for most season-opening wins, as four teams started 1-0. It is the fourth time that four teams opened the season with wins, joining the 2005, 2006 and 2010 seasons. Big South football teams are now a combined 40-43 in season openers since 2002, with 21 of those 43 losses (=48.8 percent) against FBS competition.

SMASHING DEBUT

Kennesaw State won its first-ever contest, as the Owls defeated East Tennessee State, 56-16. The 56 points was the most points scored by a Big South member in a season opener against an FCS opponent, and the fourth-most points scored overall in an opening game of a season since the league's formation in 2002.

GET SMART

Gardner-Webb QB **TYRELL MAXWELL** became the first quarterback in Big South history to rush for 100 yards and pass for 100 yards in the same game against an FBS opponent with his 102 rushing yards and 132 passing yards at South Alabama in Week 1. He is the 10th overall QB in league history with 100 rush/100 pass yards in the same game, and the third Gardner-Webb quarterback to achieve the feat in Big South annals.

NESTING

Kennesaw State rushed for 416 yards and six touchdowns in its debut game against East Tennessee State -- just the 10th time in league history that a football member gained at least 415 yards on the ground with six rushing TDs. The last to do it was Presbyterian on Sept. 6, 2014 against Bluefield (523/7). KSU's performance was just the fifth such effort against an FCS opponent.

GOOD WORK YOUNG MEN

For the second time in Big South history, two football players have been nominated for the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team®, as Gardner-Webb's **CHAD GETER** and Liberty's **CHIMA UZOWIHE** are among the 197 candidates from every subdivision and classification. The Big South has had one honoree named to the team -- Charleston Southern's **JORDAN LANCASTER** in 2010.
