## PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - SEPT. 21

### CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - JOSH WOODRUM, LIBERTY, QB, R-Sr (ROANOKE, VA.)

Woodrum was 16-of-30 passing for 260 yards and two touchdowns in leading Liberty to a 31-21, wire-to-wire victory over No. 7/8-ranked Montana. His two TD strikes gave the Flames an early 14-0 lead, and he averaged 16.25 yards per completion, posted a 148.13 passing efficiency, had seven completions go for at least 10 yards, did not commit a turnover, and directed the Flames' offense to a 36:13-to-23:47 edge in time of possession.

### DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - DIMITRIUS SMITH, MONMOUTH, DL, Sr (MILLSTONE, N.J.)

Smith dominated Wagner up front with five tackles (four solo), three tackles-for-loss, one sack and two fumble recoveries in Monmouth's 31-16 victory. Smith was part of the Hawks' defensive effort that kept Wagner out of the end zone until the final minute of the game. Two of his three TFLs created third-and-long situations, and his second fumble recovery led to a Monmouth touchdown on the ensuing drive.

### SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - DEVIN BROWN, COASTAL CAROLINA, KR, R-JR (CHARLESTON, S.C.)

Brown had five kickoff returns for 195 yards (39.0 average) and a touchdown in Coastal Carolina's win over Western Illinois. After WIU went ahead 14-10 in the third quarter, Brown returned the ensuing kickoff 93 yards for a touchdown to put the Chants back in the lead. Later in the game, his 46-yard kickoff return setup Coastal's final score and the eventual 34-27 margin.

### THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - CODY WILLIAMS, MONMOUTH, QB, R-Fr (SPRINGFIELD, MASS.)

Williams went 23-of-34 passing for 243 yards and one touchdown to lead Monmouth to its first victory of the season. His second quarter touchdown strike put the Hawks ahead, 14-3, and he finished the day with 259 yards of total offense and a 137.39 passing efficiency with no turnovers. Williams had four pass plays longer than 20 yards and completed five consecutive passes twice during the evening.

## BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL FIRST: 7-0 WEEK

The Big South Conference went 7-0 during Week 3 action, the first 7-0 week in league history and just the second time that every conference member won its respective non-league matchup in the same week -- which first occurred in Week 3 in 2014. Five of the wins were against FCS foes, one more than the total in Week 3 in both 2013 and 2014. The Big South is now 9-2 against FCS opponents in 2015, and 47-16 in regular-season games since 2013.

## ANOTHER BIG SOUTH -- TWO TOP 10 TEAMS

For the first time in Big South history, the league has two teams ranked in the Top 10 of the national polls. Coastal Carolina is No. 1 in the FCS Coaches poll and No. 2 in the STATS ranking, while Liberty is No. 10 in both the Coaches and STATS polls. The league has had two teams ranked at the same time for four consecutive weeks this season and 27 times overall in league history -- including 22 times since the start of the 2013 season. Overall, the Big South has had a football squad nationally-ranked for 54 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 campaign (Oct. 24).

## 3-0 THREE-PEAT

For the third consecutive year, two Big South teams are 3-0 -- matching the Big South record for most teams opening 3-0 in the same year. Coastal Carolina is 3-0 for the third time in school history, while Kennesaw State's 3-0 start makes the Owls the first team in Big South history to begin a season 3-0 in their first year in the conference.

## RANK AND FILE

Nationally-ranked Liberty defeated nationally-ranked Montana this past Saturday, pushing the Big South to 10-10 all-time in games featuring a ranked league member against a ranked non-conference foe -- including 5-4 in regular-season matchups. Since 2008, the Flames have played 10 ranked non-league opponents as a nationally-ranked program, going 5-5 in that span.

## COASTAL CAROLINA REMAINS NO. 1 IN FCS COACHES POLL

The Big South has the No. 1-ranked football team in the nation, as Coastal Carolina holds the top spot in the FCS Coaches poll for the third consecutive week. It is the second-straight year the Big South has the No. 1 ranked FCS program, as the Chanticleers became the first athletic program in conference history to receive the No. 1 ranking in a national poll in 2014. CCU was No. 1 in the FCS Coaches poll for two weeks from Nov. 10-22.

## CHIM CHIMINY

Liberty DE **CHIMA UZOWIHE** is the Big South's all-time leader for quarterback sacks with a record total 22.5. He surpassed the previous mark of 20.5 (set by Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** from 2004-07) this past Saturday against Montana. Uzowihe leads the Big South with 5.5 sacks this season, just four away from matching the single-season record of 9.5 set by former teammate **TOBY ONYECHI** last season. Meanwhile, Uzowihe is tied with Charleston Southern's **JADA ROSS** for eighth all-time in Big South history with 32.5 career TFL.

## STREAKERS

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** has scored a touchdown in 17 consecutive games, dating back to last season. Henderson's streak is the second-longest in Big South history, and trails the mark of 18 consecutive games set by Liberty's **ZACH TERRELL** from 2006-08. The FCS record is 20 games, set by Monmouth's **DAVID SINISI** from 2006-07.

## BIRDS OF PREY

Kennesaw State has already returned three fumbles for touchdowns this season, tying the Big South single-season record. The Owls join Charleston Southern (2007), Stony Brook (2011), Liberty (2014) and Coastal Carolina (2014) as the only teams with three fumble return TDs in a season. Meanwhile, KSU is the first Big South program to record a defensive TD in each of its first three games of a season. The Owls became the first team in league annals to return two fumbles in a game during Week 2 against Edwards Waters.

## LARENZO'S OIL

Charleston Southern DB **LARENZO MATHIS** recorded an 87-yard interception return touchdown this past Thursday against East Tennessee State, the fifth-longest INT return in Big South history. It was the longest return in the league since Liberty's **KaJUAN LEE**'s 100-yard pick-6 against CSU in 2011.

## ROADIES

Liberty will play its next four games on the road, becoming just the third Big South team in league history to play four consecutive road games in one season. Former member Elon was the first to do so in the Big South's first football season in 2002, with Gardner-Webb following in 2009.

## GROUND PACKAGE

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** has rushed for 396 yards through the Chanticleers' first three games, the Big South's highest rushing total after the first three games of a season since 2003 when VMI's **SEAN MIZZER** had 413 rushing yards in the Keydets' first three games of the year. Henderson's total is the most after three games in school history -- bettering his own record of 391 set last season. Henderson's current total also exceeds the yardage Big South single-season rushing leader **MIGUEL MAYSONET** had after the first three games in 2012 (382). Maysonet finished with 1,964 yards that season.

## KICK START

Kennesaw State freshman kicker **JUSTIN THOMPSON** tied the Big South single-game record with four field goals against Shorter this past Saturday. He hit from distances of 42, 26, 40 and 28 yards to become the first kicker with four field goals in a game since Gardner-Webb's **JORDAN DAY** in 2013 and the ninth different kicker to achieve the feat. Meanwhile, Thompson attempted a Big South single-game record seven field goals in the Shorter game, breaking the previous record of five.

## DON OF A NEW DAY

Presbyterian College LB **DONELLE WILLIAMS** became the 12th player in Big South history with 300 career tackles when he eclipsed the milestone at Charlotte in Week 2. He is now eighth all-time in league annals with 316 career stops, and needs eight hits to move past Gardner-Webb's **MARTY PATTERSON** (323) for seventh. Williams, who needs 33 tackles to crack the top 5, is fourth all-time with 178 solo hits and 22 away from becoming the second player with 200.

## MOVING THE CHAINS

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** is the first running back in Big South history with three career touch-down passes, and the second overall non-quarterback with three TD strikes, joining former Liberty WR **ADRIAN HALL** (2002-03). Chaney had two last year during his sophomore campaign, and recorded his third career TD pass on a 64-yard TD connection with WR **UGO EZEMMA** this past Saturday at Wagner.

## BROWN'S RECORD HOUSE CALLS

Coastal Carolina KR **DEVIN BROWN** is the Big South's all-time leader for career kickoff return touch-downs with five, as he has two in the first three games of the season. The NCAA FCS record for career kickoff return touchdowns is six. He became the career leader in Week 1 with a 100-yard return at Furman -- just the third 100-yard kickoff return in league history. Meanwhile, Brown's career kickoff return average of 28.1 is just ahead of the Big South record of 27.8, which is held by Stony Brook's **BROCK JACKOLSKI** (2010-11).

## THIS IS SARGENT PETERSON

Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** is looking to become the Big South's all-time leading receiver by season's end. He is currently tied for eighth with 162 career receptions -- 61 away from the record of 223 set by Gardner-Webb's **JAMES PERRY III** from 2008-11. Peterson is 38 catches shy of becoming just the third Big South player with 200. Meanwhile, he needs 265 receiving yards to break the Big South record of 2,720, which is held by Coastal Carolina's **JEROME SIMPSON**.

## EXCEPTIONAL ESTES

Gardner-Webb TE **MIKE ESTES** is quickly moving up the Big South record book among tight ends. His 62 career receptions rank third all-time, just four away from moving into second-place. Estes' 814 career receiving yards are third-most in league history -- just 97 away from unseating **DAVID DURAN** for the top spot. Duran had 910 receiving yards for Coastal Carolina from 2009-12. Estes' former teammate **SETH CRANFILL** is second in yardage with 899.

## OFFENSIVE JUGGERNAUTS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** (8,989) needs 1,583 yards to become the Big South's all-time leader in total offense. The current career mark is 10,571, set by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** from 2003-06. Ross, who is second only to Drafts in yardage, is 1,011 yards away from joining Drafts in the 10,000-yard club. Meanwhile, Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** is lurking as well, as he is third in league history with 8,599 career offensive yards, just 1,401 away from 10,000 and 1,972 from catching Drafts.

## PASSING GRADES

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** is now second all-time in Big South history with 8,222 career passing yards, as he surpassed Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** this past Saturday. Woodrum is 1,547 passing yards away from breaking the Big South career record of 9,768, which was established by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** from 2003-06. Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** is lurking as well, as he is fourth in league history with 7,585 career passing yards, just 2,183 yards from catching Drafts.

## POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 114, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (48). Meanwhile, Liberty is the Big South's record holder for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 58.

## TREY FOR TREY

Kennesaw State QB **TREY WHITE** rushed for three touchdowns against Edward Waters in Week 2, becoming the first Big South quarterback with three rushing TDs in a game since VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2008. White is the fourth signal-caller to accomplish the rushing trifecta, joining Maypray, Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** (2005) and Elon's **JAMES MURDAUGH** (2002).

## 50-50 RAFFLE

Coastal Carolina's **ALEX ROSS** and Liberty's **JOSH WOODRUM** are among the five all-time players in Big South history to throw 50 career touchdown passes. Ross is second all-time with 56 career scoring strikes after becoming the Chanticleers' all-time leader during Week 2. Woodrum became the fifth member of the 50-TD pass club in Week 1 and sits in third with 54. Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** is the all-time leader with 73.

## HENDERSON HOPPING THROUGH BIG SOUTH RECORD BOOK

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** became the fifth Big South player with 30 career rushing touchdowns when he reached the milestone this past Saturday against Western Illinois. He needs 471 rushing yards to become the fifth player in Big South history with 3,000 in a career. Once Henderson hits the yardage plateau, he would be just the third player with 3,000 rushing yards and 30 rushing TDs. The other two are Big South all-time leading rusher **MIGUEL MAYSONET** (4,725 yards, 48 TD) and **RASHAD JENNINGS** (3,633 yards, 42 TD).

## JOHNNY B-GOOD

Liberty kicker **JOHN LUNSFORD** extended his Big South record of most field goals from 50 yards-or-longer to nine with his 52-yarder against Delaware State in Week 1, and is 9-of-15 for his career from 50-plus yards ( =60.0 percent). Lunsford became the league's all-time record holder for most field goals from 40 yards-or-longer in Week 2 with his 16th career FG from that distance -- a 49-yarder at West Virginia. He surpassed the old mark of 15, which was set by former Flames kicker **MATT BEVINS** from 2008-11. Meanwhile, Lunsford needs two field goals to become the fifth Big South placekicker with 40 in a career.

## MAN WITH A PURPOSE

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** is averaging 203.0 all-purpose yards per game, pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of 187.8 yards per game set by Stony Brook's **BROCK JACKOLSKI** in 2011. Henderson became the first running back in Big South history to have 100 receiving yards in a game with his 129 at Furman in Week 1. He also narrowly missed becoming the first Big South player with 100 yards rushing and receiving in the same game, as he fell five rushing yards shy against the Paladins.

## HIGH RATE OF RETURN

Coastal Carolina is 66-5 (=93.0 percent) when rushing for 200 yards in game, including 27-1 under head coach **JOE MOGLIA**. The Chanticleers have reached the 200-yard rushing plateau 62.2 percent of the time during Moglia's 45 games as head coach.

## CAKE ROSS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** recorded his 13th career game with 300 yards of offense in Week 1 at Furman as he amassed 362 yards against the Paladins. He is second in league annals for most games with 300 yards of offense, just two away from **MIKE BROWN**'s record of 15. Meanwhile, Ross is third in Big South history for most rushing yards by a quarterback with 1,404. He needs 235 to unseat former Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** (1,638) for second. Ross' 17 career rushing touchdowns are tied for third-most in the conference record book among QBs, behind **TIM MAYPRAY**'s 18. Brown and Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS** share the record of 19.

## HOME EQUITY

Coastal Carolina is the fifth team in Big South history to play four consecutive home games in a single-season, as the Chanticleers continue a four-game homestand this Saturday. Coastal joins the 2005 Liberty Flames, 2006 and 2014 Charleston Southern Buccaneers, and 2011 Stony Brook Seawolves in the group. The Chants are 1-0 thus far and looking to match the success of the three most-recent occurrences, as CSU went 4-0 both times and SBU went 3-1.
