PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - OCT. 12

CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - TYRELL MAXWELL, GARDNER-WEBB, QB, SOPH (CORDOVA, S.C.)

Maxwell dashed for a career-high 173 yards and three touchdowns on 21 carries, and passed for 105 yards and another score, in leading Gardner-Webb to a 34-20 win over No. 15/15 Liberty. Maxwell's rushing yards broke GWU's single-game total by a quarterback and is the second-highest output by a quarterback in Big South history. He scored on runs of 45, one and five yards, and accounted for 16 of Gardner-Webb's 17 first downs against the Flames (10 rushing, six passing).

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - CHAD GETER, GARDNER-WEBB, LB, R-Jr (IRMO, S.C.)

Getter tallied a team-high 10 tackles (seven solo, three assisted) with two tackles-for-loss and one sack in Gardner-Webb's victory over Liberty. Midway through the third quarter, Getter made an open field tackle on 3rd-and-11 that forced a long field goal attempt that missed. In the fourth quarter, his four-yard TFL on second down eventually kept the Flames off the scoreboard. He then had a critical seven-yard sack in the fourth quarter on Liberty's final drive, and with LU out of timeouts, eliminated any chances at a rally.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - RYAN GRANGER, COASTAL CAROLINA, K, R-Jr (NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C.)

Granger accounted for 16 of Coastal Carolina's 24 points in a seven-point victory over Presbyterian College. With PC ahead, 3-0, the Chanticleers faked a field goal and Granger took an option pitch and ran just inside the pylon for a four-yard touchdown. Following that score, he hit field goals of 38 and 47 yards (season-long) to give the Chants a 12-3 halftime lead. Granger's 22-yard field goal gave CCU a 17-10 advantage and his lone PAT followed Coastal's final touchdown of the day.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - SOLOMON BROWN, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, LB, R-Fr (CENTRAL, S.C.)

Brown recorded a team-high seven total tackles (five solo, two assisted) in CSU's 37-7 win over Monmouth. He also added two tackles-for-loss of seven yards plus one quarterback hurry. He helped the Bucs hold MU to 1-of-13 on third down attempts and 115 offensive yards.

FOR OPENERS

Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina and Gardner-Webb all won their Big South openers this past Saturday. Charleston Southern is 1-0 in the league for the second time under third-year head coach **JAMEY CHADWELL**, and the fifth time overall. Coastal Carolina has opened Big South play 1-0 for the third consecutive year and 10th time overall. Gardner-Webb is 1-0 for the first time since 2010 and seventh time. CSU is seeking its first 2-0 start since 2013, Coastal is looking to start 2-0 for the third consecutive year, while Gardner-Webb attempts its first 2-0 Big South start since 2009.

HENDERSON TIES FCS RECORD FOR CONSECUTIVE GAMES WITH TOUCHDOWN

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** has tied the FCS record for consecutive games with a touchdown with a Big South-record streak of 20. He has matched Monmouth's **DAVID SINISI**'s effort from 2006-07, when Sinisi scored 31 touchdowns (28 rush, 3 receive) during his 20-game streak. Henderson has the identical output over his 20-game span -- 31 TDs (28 rush, 3 receive), and ironically, could break the record in two weeks when CCU travels to play at Monmouth. Henderson broke the Big South record of 18 consecutive games, which was established by Liberty's **ZACH TERRELL** from 2006-08.

THREE-PLAY

For the second time in Big South history, three teams are nationally-ranked during the same week, as this week's FCS Coaches poll has Coastal Carolina (No. 1), Liberty (No. 22) and Charleston Southern (No. 23) among its Top 25. The first time occurred the week of Sept. 22, 2014 when the same three schools appeared in the Coaches poll. Meanwhile, the Big South has had a football squad nationally-ranked for 57 consecutive weeks now, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 season (Oct. 24). In addition, the league has had two teams nationally-ranked at the same time for seven consecutive weeks this year and a total of 30 times overall in league history -- including 25 times since the start of the 2013 campaign.

BIG SOUTH BIG SIX

Coastal Carolina is one of two 6-0 teams in FCS (James Madison), and the Chanticleers are the first program in Big South history with three 6-0 starts to a season (2013, 2014, 2015). CCU's 6-0 open marks just the sixth time in league history a team has won its first six games of a season. Charleston Southern (2006, 2013) and Liberty (2008) are the remaining league members to open a season 6-0.

MAD MAX

Gardner-Webb QB **TYRELL MAXWELL** rushed for 173 yards against Liberty this past Saturday, the second-most rushing yards by a quarterback in a single-game in league history. He also tied the Big South single-game record for rushing TDs by a quarterback with three, and posted his second 100-yard, 100-pass game this season vs. the Flames -- already tied for most in a career.

OWLS TAKE FLIGHT

Kennesaw State set the Big South single-game record for total offense with 699 yards this past Saturday against Point. The Owls bettered the old mark of 695 set by Charleston Southern against West Virginia Wesleyan on Oct. 15, 2005. Kennesaw State amassed 391 rushing yards and 308 passing yards against the Skyhawks, becoming just the second team in Big South history with 300 rushing and 300 passing yards in the same game. The first was Coastal Carolina in 2006 against Gardner-Webb (332 rush, 306 pass).

PIRATES COVE

Charleston Southern held Monmouth to 115 yards of offense this past Saturday, the fourth-fewest allowed in a conference game. The Bucs have held four of their five opponents below 300 offensive yards -- including the last three contests, and now rank second nationally in total defense at 255.0 yards allowed. Meanwhile, CSU was the last Big South team to hold four consecutive opponents under 300 yards, accomplished just last season.

GOLDEN GATE BRIDGES

Presbyterian College RB **DARRELL BRIDGES** is averaging 25.3 rushing carries per game, and is on pace for 279 rushing attempts -- which would be the second-most in a single-season in league history. Meanwhile, Bridges is second in the Big South with 713 rushing yards -- the most by a PC rusher since 2011 (**LANCE BYRD** - 910), and the fourth-most in PC's Division I history. He is looking to become the first Blue Hose back with 1,000 rushing yards since PC became a Big South member in 2008.

HENDERSON ADDED TO STATS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** was added to the STATS National Offensive Player of the Year Watch List on Oct. 7, joining teammate **ALEX ROSS** and Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** has official candidates for the national honor. Henderson's addition gives the Big South three student-athletes on the offensive award Watch List for the first time.

COASTAL CAROLINA REMAINS NO. 1 IN FCS COACHES POLL

The Big South has the No. 1-ranked football team in the nation, as Coastal Carolina holds the top spot in the FCS Coaches poll for the sixth consecutive week. It is the second-straight year the Big South has the No. 1 ranked FCS program, as the Chanticleers became the first athletic program in conference history to receive the No. 1 ranking in a national poll in 2014 and held the top spot from Nov. 10-22.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL RETURNS TO ESPN3 IN 2015

The Big South Conference will again televise eight football games exclusively on ESPN3 this season. The "Game of the Week" package included a non-conference broadcast for the third time (Montana at Liberty on Sept. 19) and continues this Saturday when new Big South member Kennesaw State hosts Gardner-Webb at 1:00pm. **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **RENALDO WYNN** (analyst) have the call from Kennesaw. The package features a "Wildcard" selection for the first time, which will be the weekend of Nov. 14. That selection will be made 21 days in advance.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL RETURNS TO AMERICAN SPORTS NETWORK

The Big South Conference will appear on the American Sports Network (ASN) three times this season. The first broadcast was Gardner-Webb's 34-20 win over No. 15/15 Liberty this past Saturday, and resumes Oct. 31 when Coastal Carolina visits Charleston Southern. **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will handle the call from North Charleston. The final ASN broadcast will be Nov. 7 (Gardner-Webb at Coastal Carolina).

DON OF A NEW DAY

Presbyterian College LB **DONELLE WILLIAMS** is now fourth in Big South history with 354 career tackles and needs 11 hits to surpass Coastal Carolina's **JAMAR LEATH** (364) for third. Williams, who became the 12th player in Big South history with 300 career tackles when he eclipsed the milestone at Charlotte in Week 2, is 45 away from becoming the third player with 400. He is fourth all-time with 194 solo hits and six away from becoming the second player with 200 solo stops.

CODE BLUE

Monmouth redshirt-freshman QB **CODY WILLIAMS** is fourth in the Big South with 206.5 yards of offense and third with 173.5 passing yards a game. Williams is looking to become the first freshman QB in league history to average 200 yards of offense, while his passing yards per game trails the Big South freshman record of 188.3, set by VMI's **JONATHAN WILSON** in 2003. Meanwhile, Williams recorded a 71-yard rush at Fordham in Week 4, tied for the fourth-longest rush by a quarterback in Big South history. It was the longest by a signal-caller since 2011, when Presbyterian College QB **RYAN SINGER** scampered 74 yards for a TD at Liberty on Oct. 29.

GROUND PACKAGE

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** rushed for 532 yards through the Chanticleers' first four games, setting the school record for most rushing yards through Coastal's first four contests of a season. He and **AUNDRES PERKINS** held the previous mark of 498 yards. Henderson's current total of 758 is just behind former All-American teammate and current Baltimore Raven **LORENZO TALIAFERRO**'s school record pace, as Taliaferro had 835 yards after six games in 2013 en route to a school-record 1,729. Below is a chart featuring Henderson, Taliaferro and Big South single-season rushing record holder **MIGUEL MAYSONET** after six and seven games.

CHIM CHIMINY

Liberty DE **CHIMA UZOWIHE** is the Big South's all-time leader for quarterback sacks with a record total 23.5. He surpassed the previous mark of 20.5 (set by Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** from 2004-07) against Montana in Week 3. Uzowihe leads the Big South with 6.5 sacks this season, just three away from matching the single-season record of 9.5 set by former teammate **TOBY ONYECHI** last season. Meanwhile, Uzowihe is tied for seventh all-time in Big South history with 34.0 career TFL and is 1.5 away from the top five.

PASSING GRADES

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** is now the Big South's career record-holder for most 300-yard passing games, as he posted his eighth effort this past Saturday with 307 yards at Gardner-Webb. His output pushed his career total to 9,045 -- becoming the second player in Big South history with 9,000 passing yards. Woodrum is 724 passing yards away from breaking the Big South career record of 9,768, which was established by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** from 2003-06. Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** is fourth in league history with 8,151 career passing yards, 1,617 yards from catching Drafts.

LUNSFORD SHARES FCS CAREER RECORD FOR MOST FIELD GOALS FROM 50+ YARDS

Liberty All-American kicker **JOHN LUNSFORD** -- already the Big South record holder for most field goals from 50 yards-or-longer at 11 -- tied the FCS career mark with his 56-yarder at Georgia State in Week 5. Lunsford, Western Carolina's **KIRK ROACH** (1984-87) and Idaho State's **PETE GARCES** (1998-99) are the only FCS players with 11 career field goals from 50-yards and beyond. Lunsford is 11-of-18 for his career from 50-plus yards (=61.1 percent). Meanwhile, his 18 career FG from 40 yards-or-longer are a Big South record as well, and he became the fifth Big South placekicker with 40 career field goals when he reached the milestone in Week 4 during the Southern Illinois game. He is currently third all-time in league annals with 44 career field goals.

COASTAL IS FIRST TO WIN 100 GAMES AS BIG SOUTH MEMBERS

Coastal Carolina won its 100th game in Week 5 against Alabama A&M, becoming the first program to win 100 games during the Big South's 14-year existence. The Chants' record total stands at 101. Liberty is second at 88 wins since 2002, followed by Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb at 74 each.

HENDERSON HOPPING THROUGH BIG SOUTH RECORD BOOK

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** became the fifth Big South player with 30 career rushing touchdowns when he reached the milestone against Western Illinois in Week 3. He needs 109 rushing yards to become the fifth player in Big South history with 3,000 in a career. Once Henderson hits the yardage plateau, he would be just the third player with 3,000 rushing yards and 30 rushing TDs. The other two are Big South all-time leading rusher **MIGUEL MAYSONET** (4,725 yards, 48 TD) and **RASHAD JENNINGS** (3,633 yards, 42 TD). Meanwhile, Henderson is three TDs away from becoming the fifth player with 40 career scores.

TWO TREYS FOR TREY

Kennesaw State QB **TREY WHITE** is now just the second quarterback in Big South history to record a 3-TD rush game and 3-TD pass game in the same season, joining Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN**, who achieved the feat in 2005. White rushed for three touchdowns against Edward Waters in Week 2 to become the first Big South quarterback with three rushing TDs in a game since VMI's **TIM MAY-PRAY** in 2008. This past Saturday against Point, White threw three TD passes for the first time. He is the Big South's top rushing quarterback with 440 yards, which ranks fourth among the league leaders.

ROADIES

Liberty concludes its four-game road swing (1-2 record) this week, and is just the third Big South team in league history to play four consecutive road games in one season. Former member Elon was the first to do so in the Big South's first football season in 2002, with Gardner-Webb following in 2009.

TURF BUILDERS

Kennesaw State leads the Big South with 341.6 rushing yards per game, currently the second-highest per game average in league history. The record is 357.5 rushing yards per contest set by VMI in 2008. The Owls are on pace for 3,757 rushing yards this season, which would be the third-highest single-season total in Big South history. The Owls have rushed for more than 300 yards in a game four times this season; the conference record for most 300-yard rushing games is eight (VMI - 2008).

ROADIES THE SEQUEL

Coastal Carolina returns to the road Oct. 24 for the first time since Week 2. The Chanticleers will carry a Big South-record nine-game road win streak into their game at Monmouth in two weeks.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 117, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (51). In addition, Liberty is the Big South's record holder for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 61. Meanwhile, Liberty has scored a point in all 63 of its Big South games, the longest such streak in league annals. Of those 63 games, the last 51 have been in double digits. Charleston Southern's current streak of 37 conference games with a point is third-longest, just ahead of PC's active streak of 35 games.

EXCEPTIONAL ESTES

Gardner-Webb redshirt-junior TE **MIKE ESTES** is quickly moving up the Big South record book among tight ends. His 66 career receptions are second all-time, while his 848 career receiving yards are third-most in league history -- just 63 away from unseating **DAVID DURAN** for the top spot. Duran had 910 receiving yards for Coastal Carolina from 2009-12. Estes' former teammate **SETH CRANFILL** is second in yardage with 899.

THIS IS SARGENT PETERSON

Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** is looking to become the Big South's all-time leading receiver by season's end. He is currently seventh with 180 career receptions -- 43 away from the record of 223 set by Gardner-Webb's **JAMES PERRY III** from 2008-11. Peterson is 20 catches shy of becoming just the third Big South player with 200. Meanwhile, he needs 69 receiving yards to jump from fourth all-time with 2,652 yards and break the Big South record of 2,720, which is held by Coastal Carolina's **JEROME SIMPSON**.

BALANCED ATTACK

Coastal Carolina is the only Big South member to average more than 200 rushing yards and 200 passing yards in the same season, as the Chanticleers have achieved the feat twice (2013 and 2014). Coastal is on pace for its third consecutive 200/200 campaign, as CCU is averaging 222.8 rushing yards and 227.7 passing yards through five games this season.

MOVING THE CHAINS

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** is the first running back in Big South history with three career touchdown passes, and the second overall non-quarterback with three TD strikes, joining former Liberty WR **ADRIAN HALL** (2002-03). Chaney had two last year during his sophomore campaign, and recorded his third career TD pass on a 64-yard TD connection with WR **UGO EZEMMA** at Wagner in Week 3.

BROWN'S RECORD HOUSE CALLS

Coastal Carolina KR **DEVIN BROWN** is the Big South's all-time leader for career kickoff return touchdowns with five, as he had two in the first three games of the season and three in a four-game span dating back to 2014. The NCAA FCS record for career kickoff return touchdowns is six. He became the career leader in Week 1 with a 100-yard return at Furman -- just the third 100-yard kickoff return in league history. Meanwhile, Brown's career kickoff return average of 27.6 is just behind the Big South record of 27.8, which is held by Stony Brook's **BROCK JACKOLSKI** (2010-11).

HIGH RATE OF RETURN

Coastal Carolina is 68-5 (=93.2 percent) when rushing for 200 yards in game, including 29-1 under head coach **JOE MOGLIA**. The Chanticleers have reached the 200-yard rushing plateau 62.5 percent of the time during Moglia's 48 games as head coach.

MAN WITH A PURPOSE

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** has 3,484 career all-purpose yards and is 111 away from joining the league's all-time Top 10. Meanwhile, he is averaging 170.5 all-purpose yards per game, pacing behind the Big South single-season record of 187.8 yards per game set by Stony Brook's **BROCK JACKOLSKI** in 2011. Henderson became the first running back in Big South history to have 100 receiving yards in a game with his 129 at Furman in Week 1. He also narrowly missed becoming the first Big South player with 100 yards rushing and receiving in the same game, as he fell five rushing yards shy against the Paladins.

BIRDS OF PREY

Kennesaw State has already returned three fumbles for touchdowns this season, tying the Big South single-season record. The Owls join Charleston Southern (2007), Stony Brook (2011), Liberty (2014) and Coastal Carolina (2014) as the only teams with three fumble return TDs in a season. KSU became the first Big South program to record a defensive TD in each of its first three games of a season. The Owls also were the first team in league annals to return two fumbles in a game during Week 2 against Edwards Waters.

50-50 RAFFLE

Coastal Carolina's **ALEX ROSS** and Liberty's **JOSH WOODRUM** are among the five all-time players in Big South history to throw 50 career touchdown passes. Ross is second all-time with 61 career scoring strikes after becoming the Chanticleers' all-time leader during Week 2. Woodrum became the fifth member of the 50-TD pass club in Week 1 and sits in third with 54. Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** is the all-time leader with 73.

CAKE ROSS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** recorded his 13th career game with 300 yards of offense in Week 1 at Furman as he amassed 362 yards against the Paladins. He is second in league annals for most games with 300 yards of offense, just two away from **MIKE BROWN**'s record of 15. Meanwhile, Ross is third in Big South history for most rushing yards by a quarterback with 1,448. He needs 191 to unseat former Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** (1,638) for second. Ross' 17 career rushing touchdowns are tied for third-most in the conference record book among QBs, behind **TIM MAYPRAY**'s 18. Brown and Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS** share the record of 19.

LIBERTY COLLECTS BIG SOUTH'S FIFTH-EVER FBS WIN

The Big South Conference notched its fifth-ever win over an FBS opponent with Liberty's 41-33 win at Georgia State in Week 5 -- marking the league's second consecutive season with an FBS victory and third in four years. It was also Liberty's second straight win over a Sun Belt foe. The Big South's five wins have all come since 2010, and the Flames now own three of those victories.

HOME EQUITY

Coastal Carolina became the fifth team in Big South history to play four consecutive home games in a single-season, as the Chanticleers concluded a four-game homestand from Sept. 19-Oct. 10. Coastal joins the 2005 Liberty Flames, 2006 and 2014 Charleston Southern Buccaneers, and 2011 Stony Brook Seawolves in the group. The Chants finished 4-0 to match the success of Charleston Southern in 2006 and 2014 (4-0 both times).

OFFENSIVE JUGGERNAUTS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** (9,599) needs 973 yards to become the Big South's all-time leader in total offense. The current career mark is 10,571, set by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** from 2003-06. Ross, who is second only to Drafts in yardage, is 401 yards away from joining Drafts in the 10,000-yard club. Meanwhile, Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** is lurking as well, as he is third in league history with 9,464 career offensive yards, just 536 away from 10,000 and 1,105 from catching Drafts.

MARK YOUR CALENDARS FOR THIS ONE

The highly-anticipated Coastal Carolina at Liberty season finale on Nov. 21 has been moved to Thursday night, Nov. 19, at 7:00pm and will be televised live on ESPNEWS. It will be the first time a conference game will air on one of ESPN's linear networks, as well as the first league contest to be played on Thursday night. The teams will meet the final weekend for the second consecutive year, and the series is tied, 6-6, and the winner of the match-up has won or shared the Big South football Championship 10 times. The Chanticleers won three-straight over Liberty from 2004-06 en route to three consecutive titles (two outright, one shared). The Flames were victorious from 2007-09 while winning three-straight Big South crowns (two outright, one shared). Liberty won last season's meeting and both teams shared the title in 2014, as well as 2010, 2012 and 2013.

BOSS ROSS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** threw four touchdown passes in Week 5 against Alabama A&M, his Big South-record 10th career game with at least three TD strikes. He had shared the record of nine with Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** and Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS**.

CAN'T FUMBLE THIS NOTE

Presbyterian College DL **UGONNA AKOH** returned a fumble 73 yards for a touchdown in Week 5 at Western Carolina, the eighth-longest fumble return in Big South history. It was the league's fifth fumble return TD this season -- the second-most in conference annals. That record is eight, set just last season. Three different teams -- Kennesaw State (3), Presbyterian and Charleston Southern -- have fumble return touchdowns in 2015.

FREEZE FRAME

For the first time in league history, the Big South is utilizing full replay review for nearly every home football game this season via a partnership with DVSport. The conference previously used replay just for televised games on ESPN3 in 2013 and 2014.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL FIRST: 7-0 WEEK

The Big South Conference went 7-0 during Week 3 action, the first 7-0 week in league history and just the second time that every conference member won its respective non-league matchup in the same week -- which first occurred in Week 3 in 2014. Five of the wins were against FCS foes, one more than the total in Week 3 in both 2013 and 2014.

ANOTHER BIG SOUTH FIRST -- TWO TOP 10 TEAMS

For the first time in Big South history, the league had two teams ranked in the Top 10 of the national polls during the week of Sept. 21. Coastal Carolina was No. 1 in the FCS Coaches poll and No. 2 in the STATS ranking, while Liberty was No. 10 in both the Coaches and STATS polls.

RANK AND FILE

Nationally-ranked Liberty defeated nationally-ranked Montana in Week 3, pushing the Big South to 10-10 all-time in games featuring a ranked league member against a ranked non-conference foe -- including 5-4 in regular-season matchups. Since 2008, the Flames have played 10 ranked non-league opponents as a nationally-ranked program, going 5-5 in that span.

* The Bucs held Monmouth to 115 total yards and took a shutout into the final minutes (MU scored with 2:26 remaining). CSU held Monmouth to 1-for-13 (8%) on third down.

* The 115 yards allowed were the second-fewest CSU has allowed to an FCS opponent (112 vs. Monmouth in '14). In two games vs. the Hawks, Charleston Southern has allowed just seven points.

* CSU outscored The Citadel and Monmouth, 64-3, over an almost six quarter stretch.

* RB **MIKE HOLLOWAY** is the first Buccaneer with three consecutive multi-rushing TD games since Big South football began in 2002. Holloway now has eight TDs in three games, one shy of the school record (9).

* RB **DARIUS HAMMOND** has scored a TD in five consecutive games, the longest streak by a CSU player since the start of Big South football in 2002.

* Hammond returned five punts for 103 yards against MU (20.6 avg), and is now fourth all-time in Big South history with 348 career punt return yards.
