PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - OCT. 19

CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - TREY WHITE, KENNESAW STATE, QB, R-Jr (ATLANTA, GA.)

White rushed for 170 yards and passed for 114 as he engineered the Owls to a 12-7 win over Gardner-Webb in the program's first-ever conference game. He was responsible for 16 of KSU's 20 first downs (10 rushing, six passing) and had 284 of the Owls' 353 total yards of offense. White's performance allowed Kennesaw State to keep the ball for 38:40, and his 39-yard completion to Justin Sumpter late in the fourth quarter led to KSU's final field goal.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - SOLOMON BROWN, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, LB, R-Fr (CENTRAL, S.C.)

Brown posted eight tackles (six solo), three for loss of 13 yards and two sacks as Charleston Southern shutout Presbyterian in the second half en route to a 10-7 road victory. He had a sack in each half to end a Blue Hose drive, and was part of a Buc defense that limited PC to 43 total yards, four punts and two interceptions during the final 30 minutes.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - MATT WHITE, MONMOUTH, K/P, SOPH (GIBSONIA, PA.)

White was the hero in Monmouth's 20-17 overtime win over No. 22/22 Liberty. He kicked the game-tying field goal -- a 35-yarder -- as time expired in regulation, then converted a 37-yard field goal in overtime for the win. White also punted seven times for an average of 36.6 yards, and three of his punts landed inside Liberty's 20-yard line.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - JUSTIN THOMPSON, KENNESAW STATE, K, Fr (EVANS, GA.)

Thompson accounted for all of Kennesaw State's points in the Owls' 12-7 win over Gardner-Webb. He tied the Big South single-game record with four field goals, hitting from 30, 33, 26 and 31 yards.

START ME UP

Charleston Southern is 2-0 in the Big South for the second time under head coach **JAMEY CHADWELL** and third time overall. The Bucs are looking to start 3-0 in league play for the just the second time, as CSU opened 3-0 in Chadwell's first season of 2013. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina is looking to start 2-0 for the third consecutive year and sixth time in program history. Kennesaw State is the first Big South newcomer to open 1-0 in conference action.

STINGINESS

After six conference games, the average margin of victory in Big South competition is just 10.3 points -- the second-lowest margin in league annals. The record is 9.4 set during 2006 as part of a 10-game conference season that featured five teams. Four of the six 2015 Big South contests have been decided by single-digits; the record for such outcomes is 11 in 2009.

ATOP THE PERCH

With the exception of the first season of Big South football in 2002, Kennesaw State is the first newcomer to the league to win its first-ever conference game, as the Owls defeated Gardner-Webb, 12-7, this past Saturday. When including 2002, KSU is just the second team on the list, as GWU won its debut Big South game. Kennesaw State's five wins are the second-most by a program in its first season in the league. Coastal Carolina (2003), VMI (2003) and Monmouth (2014) won six games during their respective inaugural seasons in the Big South. When adding 2002 to the equation, Gardner-Webb had nine wins during the league's first year of football.

SEVEN UP

The 6-0 Coastal Carolina Chanticleers remain one of seven undefeated teams in FCS. The first program in Big South history with three 6-0 starts to a season (2013, 2014, 2015), CCU is looking to become the first with three 7-0 starts. The Chants are tied with Charleston Southern (2006, 2013) as the only Big South teams to open a season at 7-0. Coastal previously started 7-0 in 2013 and 2014.

HENDERSON LOOKING FOR FCS RECORD FOR CONSECUTIVE GAMES WITH TOUCHDOWN

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** shares the FCS record for consecutive games with a touchdown with a Big South-record streak of 20. He matched Monmouth's **DAVID SINISI**'s effort from 2006-07, when Sinisi scored 31 touchdowns (28 rush, 3 receive) during his 20-game streak. Henderson has the identical output over his 20-game span -- 31 TDs (28 rush, 3 receive), and ironically, could break the record this weekend when CCU plays at Monmouth. Henderson broke the Big South record of 18 consecutive games, which was established by Liberty's **ZACH TERRELL** from 2006-08.

PIRATES COVE

Charleston Southern is the first team in Big South history to hold back-to-back conference opponents to less than 200 yards of offense, and the fourth overall to accomplish this feat. CSU held Monmouth to 112 yards in Week 6 and allowed just 142 to PC this past Saturday. The Bucs have held five of their six opponents below 300 offensive yards -- including the last four contests. The record for consecutive games holding an opponent below 300 offensive yards is five (Liberty in 2013). Charleston Southern now ranks first nationally in total defense at 236.2 yards allowed. No Big South team has ever led the country in this category.

WHITE-WASHING

Kennesaw State QB **TREY WHITE** set a Big South single-game record for most quarterback rushing attempts with 34 this past Saturday against Gardner-Webb, while his 170 rushing yards against the Runnin' Bulldogs were third-most in a game by a signal-caller. White is the Big South's top rushing quarterback this season with 610 yards (third overall), and his yardage is already the sixth-highest single-season total by a QB in league history.

COASTAL CAROLINA IS NO. 1 IN FCS COACHES POLL FOR SEVENTH WEEK

The Big South has the No. 1-ranked football team in the nation, as Coastal Carolina holds the top spot in the FCS Coaches poll for the seventh consecutive week. It is the second-straight year the Big South has the No. 1 ranked FCS program, as the Chanticleers became the first athletic program in conference history to receive the No. 1 ranking in a national poll in 2014 and held the top spot from Nov. 10-22.

SPEAKING OF NATIONAL RANKINGS

The Big South has had a football squad nationally-ranked for 58 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 season (Oct. 24). In addition, the league has had two teams nationally-ranked at the same time for eight consecutive weeks this year, as Charleston Southern is No. 20 in the FCS Coaches poll. The conference has had two teams nationally-ranked in the same week 31 times overall in league history -- including 26 times since the start of the 2013 campaign.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL RETURNS TO ESPN3 IN 2015

The Big South Conference will again televise eight football games exclusively on ESPN3 this season. The "Game of the Week" package included a non-conference broadcast for the third time (Montana at Liberty on Sept. 19) and continues this Saturday when Monmouth hosts Coastal Carolina at 1:00pm. **MIKE HOGWOOD** (play-by-play) and **RENALDO WYNN** (analyst) have the call from West Long Branch. The package features a "Wildcard" selection for the first time, which will be the weekend of Nov. 14. That selection will be made 21 days in advance.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL RETURNS TO AMERICAN SPORTS NETWORK

The Big South Conference will appear on the American Sports Network (ASN) three times this season. The first broadcast was Gardner-Webb's 34-20 win over No. 15/15 Liberty in Week 6, and resumes Oct. 31 when Coastal Carolina visits Charleston Southern. **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will handle the call from North Charleston. The final ASN broadcast will be Nov. 7 (Gardner-Webb at Coastal Carolina).

TREASURE MAP

Charleston Southern has tied the Big South single-season record for most consecutive games holding a league foe to less than 10 points at two, as the Bucs held Monmouth and PC to seven points each. CSU's effort is the fifth overall occurrence in league action, and has an opportunity to match the overall record of three, which is held by Coastal Carolina (2008 and 2014).

GOLDEN GATE BRIDGES

Presbyterian College RB **DARRELL BRIDGES** is averaging 25.4 rushing carries per game, and is on pace for 280 rushing attempts -- which would be the second-most in a single-season in league history. Meanwhile, Bridges leads the Big South with 817 rushing yards -- the most by a PC rusher since 2011 (**LANCE BYRD** - 910), and the second-most in PC's Division I history. He is looking to become the first Blue Hose back with 1,000 rushing yards since PC became a Big South member in 2008.

THOMPSON TWIN

Kennesaw State K **JUSTIN THOMPSON** tied the Big South single-game record with four field goals this past Saturday against Gardner-Webb. It was the second time this season Thompson made four field goals in a game, becoming just the third kicker in league history with multiple 4-field goal efforts. Liberty's **MATT BEVINS** did it a record four times in his career, while VMI's **MATT SHARPE** achieved it twice in 2003.

HENDERSON ADDED TO STATS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** was added to the STATS National Offensive Player of the Year Watch List on Oct. 7, joining teammate **ALEX ROSS** and Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** has official candidates for the national honor. Henderson's addition gives the Big South three student-athletes on the offensive award Watch List for the first time.

DON OF A NEW DAY

Presbyterian College LB **DONELLE WILLIAMS** remains fourth in Big South history with 361 career tackles and needs four hits to surpass Coastal Carolina's **JAMAR LEATH** (364) for third. Williams, who became the 12th player in Big South history with 300 career tackles when he eclipsed the milestone at Charlotte in Week 2, is 39 away from becoming the third player with 400. He is third all-time with 198 solo hits and two away from becoming the second player with 200 solo stops.

CODE BLUE

Monmouth redshirt-freshman QB **CODY WILLIAMS** is fourth in the Big South with 207.1 yards of offense and third with 176.4 passing yards a game. Williams is looking to become the first freshman QB in league history to average 200 yards of offense, while his passing yards per game trails the Big South freshman record of 188.3, set by VMI's **JONATHAN WILSON** in 2003. Meanwhile, Williams recorded a 71-yard rush at Fordham in Week 4, tied for the fourth-longest rush by a quarterback in Big South history. It was the longest by a signal-caller since 2011, when Presbyterian College QB **RYAN SINGER** scampered 74 yards for a TD at Liberty on Oct. 29.

CHIM CHIMINY

Liberty DE **CHIMA UZOWIHE** is the Big South's all-time leader for quarterback sacks with a record total 24.5. He surpassed the previous mark of 20.5 (set by Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** from 2004-07) against Montana in Week 3. Uzowihe leads the Big South with 7.5 sacks this season, just two away from matching the single-season record of 9.5 set by former teammate **TOBY ONYECHI** last season. Meanwhile, Uzowihe is sixth all-time in Big South history with 35.0 career TFL and is 0.5 away from the top five.

GROUND PACKAGE

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** rushed for 532 yards through the Chanticleers' first four games, setting the school record for most rushing yards through Coastal's first four contests of a season. He and **AUNDRES PERKINS** held the previous mark of 498 yards. Henderson's current total of 758 is just behind former All-American teammate and current Baltimore Raven **LORENZO TALIAFERRO**'s school record pace, as Taliaferro had 835 yards after six games in 2013 en route to a school-record 1,729. Below is a chart featuring Henderson, Taliaferro and Big South single-season rushing record holder **MIGUEL MAYSONET** after six and seven games.

THIS IS SARGENT PETERSON

Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** became the Big South's all-time leading for receiving yards this past Saturday during the Monmouth game, as he eclipsed Coastal Carolina's **JEROME SIMPSON** previous record of 2,720 yards. Peterson's record total sits at 2,772 after extending his Big South-career record for most 100-yard receiving games to 14 against the Hawks. Peterson is third in the conference record book with 193 career receptions -- 31 away from breaking the record of 223 set by Gardner-Webb's **JAMES PERRY III** from 2008-11. Peterson is seven catches shy of becoming just the third Big South player with 200.

PASSING GRADES

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** is the Big South's career record-holder for most 300-yard passing games with nine, as he has posted back-to-back games above the threshold the last two weeks. His career total stands at 9,381 -- second all-time in Big South history and 388 away from breaking the league career record of 9,768, which was established by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** from 2003-06. Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** is fourth in league history with 8,151 career passing yards, 1,617 yards from catching Drafts.

COASTAL IS FIRST TO WIN 100 GAMES AS BIG SOUTH MEMBERS

Coastal Carolina won its 100th game in Week 5 against Alabama A&M, becoming the first program to win 100 games during the Big South's 14-year existence. The Chants' record total stands at 101. Liberty is second at 88 wins since 2002, followed by Charleston Southern (75) and Gardner-Webb (74).

HENDERSON HOPPING THROUGH BIG SOUTH RECORD BOOK

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** needs 109 rushing yards to become the fifth player in Big South history with 3,000 in a career, and once he reaches the plateau, he would be just the third player with 3,000 career rushing yards and 30 career rushing TDs. The other two are Big South all-time leading rusher **MIGUEL MAYSONET** (4,725 yards, 48 TD) and **RASHAD JENNINGS** (3,633 yards, 42 TD). Henderson is three TDs away from becoming the fifth player with 40 career scores.

LUNSFORD SHARES FCS CAREER RECORD FOR MOST FIELD GOALS FROM 50+ YARDS

Liberty All-American kicker **JOHN LUNSFORD** -- already the Big South record holder for most field goals from 50 yards-or-longer at 11 -- tied the FCS career mark with his 56-yarder at Georgia State in Week 5. Lunsford, Western Carolina's **KIRK ROACH** (1984-87) and Idaho State's **PETE GARCES** (1998-99) are the only FCS players with 11 career field goals from 50-yards and beyond. Lunsford is 11-of-18 for his career from 50-plus yards (=61.1 percent). Meanwhile, his 18 career FG from 40 yards-or-longer are a Big South record as well, and he became the fifth Big South placekicker with 40 career field goals when he reached the milestone in Week 4 during the Southern Illinois game. He is currently tied for second all-time in league annals with 45 career field goals.

TWO TREYS FOR TREY

Kennesaw State QB **TREY WHITE** is just the second quarterback in Big South history to record a 3-TD rush game and 3-TD pass game in the same season, joining Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN**, who achieved the feat in 2005. White rushed for three touchdowns against Edward Waters in Week 2 to become the first Big South quarterback with three rushing TDs in a game since VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2008. In Week 6 against Point, White threw three TD passes for the first time.

HOME EQUITY

Coastal Carolina became the fifth team in Big South history to play four consecutive home games in a single-season, as the Chanticleers concluded a four-game homestand from Sept. 19-Oct. 10. Coastal joins the 2005 Liberty Flames, 2006 and 2014 Charleston Southern Buccaneers, and 2011 Stony Brook Seawolves in the group. The Chants finished 4-0 to match the success of Charleston Southern in 2006 and 2014 (4-0 both times).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

Coastal Carolina returns to the road this Saturday for the first time since Week 2. The Chanticleers will carry a Big South-record nine-game road win streak into their game at Monmouth.

TURF BUILDERS

Kennesaw State leads the Big South with 324.5 rushing yards per game, currently the second-highest per game average in league history. The record is 357.5 rushing yards per contest set by VMI in 2008. The Owls are on pace for 3,570 rushing yards this season, which would be the fourth-highest single-season total in Big South history. The Owls have rushed for more than 300 yards in a game four times this season; the conference record for most 300-yard rushing games is eight (VMI - 2008).

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 118, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (51). In addition, Liberty is the Big South's record holder for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 62. Meanwhile, Liberty has scored a point in all 64 of its Big South games, the longest such streak in league annals. Of those 64 games, the last 52 have been in double digits. Charleston Southern's current streak of 38 conference games with a point is third-longest, just ahead of PC's active streak of 36 games.

EXCEPTIONAL ESTES

Gardner-Webb redshirt-junior TE **MIKE ESTES** is moving up the Big South record book among tight ends. His 67 career receptions are second all-time, while his 850 career receiving yards are third-most in league history -- just 61 away from unseating **DAVID DURAN** for the top spot. Duran had 910 receiving yards for Coastal Carolina from 2009-12. Estes' former teammate **SETH CRANFILL** is second in yardage with 899.

BALANCED ATTACK

Coastal Carolina is the only Big South member to average more than 200 rushing yards and 200 passing yards in the same season, as the Chanticleers have achieved the feat twice (2013 and 2014). Coastal is on pace for its third consecutive 200/200 campaign, as CCU is averaging 222.8 rushing yards and 227.7 passing yards through six games this season.

MOVING THE CHAINS

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** is the first running back in Big South history with three career touchdown passes, and the second overall non-quarterback with three TD strikes, joining former Liberty WR **ADRIAN HALL** (2002-03). Chaney had two last year during his sophomore campaign, and recorded his third career TD pass on a 64-yard TD connection with WR **UGO EZEMMA** at Wagner in Week 3.

BROWN'S RECORD HOUSE CALLS

Coastal Carolina KR **DEVIN BROWN** is the Big South's all-time leader for career kickoff return touchdowns with five, as he had two in the first three games of the season and three in a four-game span dating back to 2014. The NCAA FCS record for career kickoff return touchdowns is six. He became the Big South career leader in Week 1 with a 100-yard return at Furman -- just the third 100-yard kickoff return in league history. Meanwhile, Brown's career kickoff return average of 27.6 is just behind the Big South record of 27.8, which is held by Stony Brook's **BROCK JACKOLSKI** (2010-11).

MAN WITH A PURPOSE

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** has 3,484 career all-purpose yards and is 111 away from joining the league's all-time Top 10. Meanwhile, he is averaging 170.5 all-purpose yards per game, pacing behind the Big South single-season record of 187.8 yards per game set by Stony Brook's **BROCK JACKOLSKI** in 2011. Henderson became the first running back in Big South history to have 100 receiving yards in a game with his 129 at Furman in Week 1. He also narrowly missed becoming the first Big South player with 100 yards rushing and receiving in the same game, as he fell five rushing yards shy against the Paladins.

BIRDS OF PREY

Kennesaw State has already returned three fumbles for touchdowns this season, tying the Big South single-season record. The Owls join Charleston Southern (2007), Stony Brook (2011), Liberty (2014) and Coastal Carolina (2014) as the only teams with three fumble return TDs in a season. KSU became the first Big South program to record a defensive TD in each of its first three games of a season. The Owls also were the first team in league annals to return two fumbles in a game during Week 2 against Edwards Waters.

LIBERTY COLLECTS BIG SOUTH'S FIFTH-EVER FBS WIN

The Big South Conference notched its fifth-ever win over an FBS opponent with Liberty's 41-33 win at Georgia State in Week 5 -- marking the league's second consecutive season with an FBS victory and third in four years. It was also Liberty's second straight win over a Sun Belt foe. The Big South's five wins have all come since 2010, and the Flames now own three of those victories.

OWLS TAKE FLIGHT

Kennesaw State set the Big South single-game record for total offense with 699 yards in Week 6 against Point. The Owls bettered the old mark of 695 set by Charleston Southern against West Virginia Wesleyan on Oct. 15, 2005. Kennesaw State amassed 391 rushing yards and 308 passing yards against the Skyhawks, becoming just the second team in Big South history with 300 rushing and 300 passing yards in the same game. The first was Coastal Carolina in 2006 against Gardner-Webb (332 rush, 306 pass).

MAD MAX

Gardner-Webb QB **TYRELL MAXWELL** rushed for 173 yards against Liberty in Week 6, the second-most rushing yards by a quarterback in a single-game in league history. He also tied the Big South single-game record for rushing TDs by a quarterback with three, and posted his second 100-yard, 100-pass game this season vs. the Flames -- already tied for most in a career.

COUNTING BENJAMINS

For the first time since 2013 and just the third time overall, the Big South has three individual 100-yard rushing/100-yard passing performances on its ledger. Gardner-Webb's **TYRELL MAXWELL** has two such efforts this year, while Kennesaw State's **TREY WHITE** posted his first this past Saturday against GWU.

OFFENSIVE JUGGERNAUTS

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** is now second all-time in league history with 9,797 yards of total offense, and needs 203 to become the second player with 10,000 in a career. Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** is third all-time at 9,599. Woodrum is 775 yards away from breaking the league's career record of 10,571, set by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** from 2003-06. Ross is 973 yards away from surpassing the record, and 401 from 10,000 in his career.

APPOINTMENT TELEVISION

The highly-anticipated Coastal Carolina at Liberty season finale on Nov. 21 has been moved to Thursday night, Nov. 19, at 7:00pm and will be televised live on ESPNEWS. It will be the first time a conference game will air on one of ESPN's linear networks, as well as the first league contest to be played on Thursday night. The teams will meet the final week for the second consecutive year, and the series is tied, 6-6, and the winner of the match-up has won or shared the Big South football Championship 10 times. The Chanticleers won three-straight over Liberty from 2004-06 en route to three consecutive titles (two outright, one shared). The Flames were victorious from 2007-09 while winning three-straight Big South crowns (two outright, one shared). Liberty won last season's meeting and both teams shared the title in 2014, as well as 2010, 2012 and 2013.

BOSS ROSS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** threw four touchdown passes in Week 5 against Alabama A&M, his Big South-record 10th career game with at least three TD strikes. He had shared the record of nine with Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** and Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS**.

CAN'T FUMBLE THIS NOTE

Presbyterian College DL **UGONNA AKOH** returned a fumble 73 yards for a touchdown in Week 5 at Western Carolina, the eighth-longest fumble return in Big South history. It was the league's fifth fumble return TD this season -- the second-most in conference annals. That record is eight, set just last season. Three different teams -- Kennesaw State (3), Presbyterian and Charleston Southern -- have fumble return touchdowns in 2015.

FREEZE FRAME

For the first time in league history, the Big South is utilizing full replay review for nearly every home football game this season via a partnership with DVSPORT. The conference previously used replay just for televised games on ESPN3 in 2013 and 2014.

HIGH RATE OF RETURN

Coastal Carolina is 68-5 (=93.2 percent) when rushing for 200 yards in game, including 29-1 under head coach **JOE MOGLIA**. The Chanticleers have reached the 200-yard rushing plateau 62.5 percent of the time during Moglia's 48 games as head coach.

* QB **KYLE COPELAND** came on to lead a decisive 8-play, 75-yard touchdown drive in the fourth quarter at PC this past Saturday. Copeland carried three times for 58 yards on the drive to spark the Bucs.

* The Bucs held the Blue Hose to 43 total yards, four punts, and two interceptions in the second half, and didn't allow a single yard on the final three drives in the 10-7 win.

* The Bucs have allowed just 257 total yards over their last two games (128.5 average).

* RB **DARIUS HAMMOND**'s 4-yard TD run with 8:48 to play was the deciding score. He has scored a TD in six consecutive games, the longest streak by a CSU player since the start of Big South football in 2002.

* The Bucs have started 6-0, 5-1, and 5-1 in the first six games of **JAMEY CHADWELL**'s three seasons. Both losses were to FBS opponents (Vanderbilt in '14, Troy in '15).
