PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - OCT. 26

CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - LAVON CHANEY, MONMOUTH, RB, JR (EDGEWATER, MD.)

Chaney compiled 228 all-purpose yards and all three Monmouth touchdowns in the Hawks' near upset of top-ranked Coastal Carolina. He scored on runs of three and 21 yards while catching a 17-yard touchdown in the second quarter. Chaney finished with career highs of 24 carries and 196 rushing yards for an impressive 8.2 yards per carry, and had runs of 15, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 39 and 41 yards during the contest. He also caught three passes for 32 yards.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - JABARAI BOTHWELL, COASTAL CAROLINA, DT, JR (OCALA, FLA.)

Bothwell tallied nine tackles, including a season-high six solo stops, plus a game-high three tackles-for-loss for seven yards at Monmouth. He recorded five of his tackles in the second half, including two behind the line, and was part of a Chanticleer defense that stopped three fourth down attempts in the final 30 minutes.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - RYAN GRANGER, COASTAL CAROLINA, K, R-JR (NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C.)

Granger's 30-yard game-winning field goal as time expired was part of an 11-point day during Coastal's 23-20 win at Monmouth. He made 3-of-3 field goals, hitting from 30, 32 and 30 yards, as well as 2-of-2 on PATs. Granger gave CCU its first lead of the day at 3-0 in the first quarter, and his 32-yarder in the third quarter extended Coastal's lead to 20-13.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - SOLOMON BROWN, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, LB, R-Fr (CENTRAL, S.C.)

Brown finished with seven tackles, one-half tackle-for-loss, one quarterback hurry, and a 28-yard interception return for a touchdown in Charleston Southern's 34-0 win at Gardner-Webb. He was part of a defense that had nine tackles-for-loss and held GWU to 110 offensive yards -- a school record against an FCS opponent.

MATCH-UP OF RANKED BIG SOUTH TEAMS ON SATURDAY

No. 1/2 Coastal Carolina visits No. 19/24 Charleston Southern on Saturday, which will be televised on ASN. It will mark the second time in league history that two Big South teams ranked in the two major FCS polls (STATS and FCS Coaches) will go head-to-head. The previous time was in 2013, when No. 16/18 Charleston Southern defeated No. 3/5 Coastal Carolina, 31-26, at home. In 2006, Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern were both ranked in the Weekly Football Gazette when the teams met on Nov. 18. The Chanticleers were No. 7 in that ranking while the Bucs were No. 21. Coastal was also No. 12 in the Coaches poll and No. 13 in the media poll at the time, while Charleston Southern received votes in both rankings in the days leading up to that contest nine seasons ago.

HENDERSON SCORES FCS RECORD FOR CONSECUTIVE GAMES WITH TOUCHDOWN

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** now owns the FCS record for consecutive games with a touchdown at 21. He surpassed Monmouth's **DAVID SINISI**'s 20-game effort from 2006-07, when Sinisi scored 31 touchdowns (28 rush, 3 receive) during his streak. Henderson has -- 32 TDs (29 rush, 3 receive) during his streak, and ironically, broke the record this past Saturday at Monmouth. Henderson broke the Big South record of 18 consecutive games, which was established by Liberty's **ZACH TERRELL** from 2006-08. The NCAA Division I FBS record is 27 consecutive games (Virginia Tech's **LEE SUGGS** from Sept. 2, 2000 through Dec. 31, 2002).

LUNSFORD SCORES FCS CAREER RECORD FOR MOST FIELD GOALS FROM 50+ YARDS

Liberty All-American kicker **JOHN LUNSFORD** -- already the Big South record holder for most field goals from 50 yards-or-longer at 12 -- is now the all-time career leader in FCS following his 57-yarder against Kennesaw State this past Saturday. Lunsford was tied with Western Carolina's **KIRK ROACH** (1984-87) and Idaho State's **PETE GARCES** (1998-99) with 11 career field goals from 50-yards and beyond. Lunsford is 12-of-19 for his career from 50-plus yards (=63.2 percent). Meanwhile, his 19 career FG from 40 yards-or-longer are a Big South record as well, and he became the fifth Big South placekicker with 40 career field goals when he reached the milestone in Week 4 during the Southern Illinois game. He is currently second all-time in league annals with 46 career field goals.

START ME UP

Charleston Southern is 3-0 in the Big South for the second time under head coach **JAMEY CHADWELL** and second time overall in program history. The Bucs opened 3-0 in Chadwell's first season of 2013. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina is looking to start 3-0 for the third consecutive year and sixth time in program history.

PIRATES COVE

Charleston Southern is the first team in Big South history to hold three consecutive opponents to less than 200 yards of offense. CSU held Monmouth to 112 yards in Week 6, allowed just 142 to PC in Week 7 and limited Gardner-Webb to 110 this past Saturday. The Bucs have held six of their seven opponents below 300 offensive yards -- including the last five contests to tie the Big South record. Liberty first set the record for consecutive games holding an opponent below 300 offensive yards in 2013. Charleston Southern ranks first nationally in total defense at 218.1 yards allowed. No Big South team has ever led the country in this category.

STINGINESS

After nine conference games, the average margin of victory in Big South competition is just 12.1 points -- the third-lowest margin in league annals. The record is 9.4 set during 2006 as part of a 10-game conference season that featured five teams. Five of the nine 2015 Big South contests have been decided by single-digits; the record for such outcomes is 11 in 2009.

FIVE GUYS

The 7-0 Coastal Carolina Chanticleers remain one of five undefeated teams in FCS. The first program in Big South history with three 7-0 starts to a season (2013, 2014, 2015), CCU is looking to become the first with three 8-0 starts. The Chants started 9-0 in 2013 and 11-0 in 2014. Charleston Southern also won its first eight games of the season as part of a 9-0 start in 2006.

WHITE-WASHING

Kennesaw State QB **TREY WHITE** is the first quarterback in Big South history to rush for three touchdowns in game twice in the same season (Week 2 vs. Edwards Waters and this past Saturday at Liberty). White's eight rushing scores this season are third-most in a season by a Big South QB and four away from tying the league single-season mark of 12 (VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2008). White's 704 rushing yards this season are also third-highest by a Big South quarterback. Maypray holds that record as well (1,266 in 2008). White set a Big South single-game record for most quarterback rushing attempts with 34 in Week 7 against Gardner-Webb, while his 170 rushing yards against the Runnin' Bulldogs were third-most in a game by a signal-caller.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL RETURNS TO ESPN3 IN 2015

The Big South Conference will again televise eight football games exclusively on ESPN3 this season. The "Game of the Week" package included a non-conference broadcast for the third time (Montana at Liberty on Sept. 19) and continues this Saturday when Kennesaw State hosts Monmouth at 1:00pm. **MIKE HOGWOOD** (play-by-play) and **RENALDO WYNN** (analyst) have the call from Kennesaw. The package features a "Wildcard" selection for the first time, which will be the weekend of Nov. 14. That selection will be made following this week's games.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL RETURNS TO AMERICAN SPORTS NETWORK

The Big South Conference will appear on the American Sports Network (ASN) three times this season. The first broadcast was Gardner-Webb's 34-20 win over No. 15/15 Liberty in Week 6, and resumes this Saturday when Coastal Carolina visits Charleston Southern. **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will handle the call from North Charleston. The final ASN broadcast will be Nov. 7 (Gardner-Webb at Coastal Carolina).

COASTAL CAROLINA IS NO. 1 IN FCS COACHES POLL FOR EIGHTH WEEK

The Big South has the No. 1-ranked football team in the nation, as Coastal Carolina holds the top spot in the FCS Coaches poll for the eighth consecutive week. It is the second-straight year the Big South has the No. 1 ranked FCS program, as the Chanticleers became the first athletic program in conference history to receive the No. 1 ranking in a national poll in 2014 and held the top spot from Nov. 10-22.

SPEAKING OF NATIONAL RANKINGS

The Big South has had a football squad nationally-ranked for 59 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 season (Oct. 24). In addition, the league has had two teams nationally-ranked at the same time for nine consecutive weeks this year, as Charleston Southern is No. 19 in the FCS Coaches poll and No. 24 in the STATS ranking. The conference has had two teams nationally-ranked in the same week 32 times overall in league history -- including 27 times since the start of the 2013 campaign.

TREASURE MAP

Charleston Southern has set the Big South single-season record for most consecutive games holding a league foe to less than 10 points at three, as the Bucs held Monmouth and PC to seven points each and shutout Gardner-Webb this past Saturday. CSU's effort matches the overall record of three, which is first set by Coastal Carolina in non-conference games in 2008 and 2014.

CUP OF JOE

Coastal Carolina head coach **JOE MOGLIA** is one victory away from becoming the fifth coach in league history with 40 wins. Should he be victorious on Saturday, he would be the fastest Big South coach to 40 victories, as he would achieve the milestone in just his 50th game as head coach. The current record is 55 games, set by former Liberty coach **DANNY ROCCO**.

GOLDEN GATE BRIDGES

Presbyterian College RB **DARRELL BRIDGES** is averaging 25.4 rushing carries per game, and is on pace for 280 rushing attempts -- which would be the second-most in a single-season in league history. Meanwhile, Bridges is second in the Big South with 817 rushing yards -- the most by a PC rusher since 2011 (**LANCE BYRD** - 910), and the second-most in PC's Division I history. He is looking to become the first Blue Hose back with 1,000 rushing yards since PC became a Big South member in 2008.

THOMPSON TWIN

Kennesaw State K **JUSTIN THOMPSON** tied the Big South single-game record with four field goals in Week 7 against Gardner-Webb. It was the second time this season Thompson made four field goals in a game, becoming just the third kicker in league history with multiple 4-field goal efforts. Liberty's **MATT BEVINS** did it a record four times in his career, while VMI's **MATT SHARPE** achieved it twice in 2003.

DON OF A NEW DAY

Presbyterian College LB **DONELLE WILLIAMS** remains fourth in Big South history with 361 career tackles and needs four hits to surpass Coastal Carolina's **JAMAR LEATH** (364) for third. Williams, who became the 12th player in Big South history with 300 career tackles when he eclipsed the milestone at Charlotte in Week 2, is 39 away from becoming the third player with 400. He is third all-time with 198 solo hits and two away from becoming the second player with 200 solo stops.

THE LONE GRANGER

Coastal Carolina kicker **RYAN GRANGER** leads the Big South with 13 field goals, just two away from tying the school record of 15 set by **ALEX CATRON** in 2014. Granger is 13-of-15 on field goals attempts (=86.7 percent) and is contending for the Big South single-season record for percentage.

CODE BLUE

Monmouth redshirt-freshman QB **CODY WILLIAMS** is fourth in the Big South with 215.4 yards of offense and third with 180.2 passing yards a game. Williams is looking to become the first freshman QB in league history to average 200 yards of offense, while his passing yards per game trails the Big South freshman record of 188.3, set by VMI's **JONATHAN WILSON** in 2003. Meanwhile, Williams recorded a 71-yard rush at Fordham in Week 4, tied for the fourth-longest rush by a quarterback in Big South history. It was the longest by a signal-caller since 2011, when Presbyterian College QB **RYAN SINGER** scampered 74 yards for a TD at Liberty on Oct. 29.

CHIM CHIMINY

Liberty DE **CHIMA UZOWIHE** is the Big South's all-time leader for quarterback sacks with a record total 25.0. He surpassed the previous mark of 20.5 (set by Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** from 2004-07) against Montana in Week 3. Uzowihe leads the Big South with 8.0 sacks this season, just 1.5 away from matching the single-season record of 9.5 set by former teammate **TOBY ONYECHI** last season. Meanwhile, Uzowihe is third all-time in Big South history with 38.5 career TFL and is 1.5 away from becoming the third player with 40 in a career.

ATOP THE PERCH

With the exception of the first season of Big South football in 2002, Kennesaw State became the first newcomer to the league to win its first-ever conference game, as the Owls defeated Gardner-Webb, 12-7, in Week 7. When including 2002, KSU is just the second team on the list, as GWU won its debut Big South game. Kennesaw State's five wins are the second-most by a program in its first season in the league. Coastal Carolina (2003), VMI (2003) and Monmouth (2014) won six games during their respective inaugural seasons in the Big South. When adding 2002 to the equation, Gardner-Webb had nine wins during the league's first year of football.

THIS IS SARGENT PETERSON

Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** is the Big South's all-time leader with 2,936 career receiving yards. He surpassed the previous record of 2,720 (Coastal Carolina's **JEROME SIMPSON**) in Week 7. Peterson's 15 career 100-yard receiving games are also a conference record, and he is approaching the league mark for career receptions. Peterson is third all-time with 197 catches -- 27 away from breaking the record of 223 set by Gardner-Webb's **JAMES PERRY III** from 2008-11. Peterson is three receptions shy of becoming just the third Big South player with 200.

PASSING GRADES

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** needs 158 passing yards to break the Big South career record of 9,768, which has established by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** from 2003-06. Woodrum, who is already the Big South's career record-holder for most 300-yard passing games with nine, is 56 completions away from matching Drafts' Big South-record total of 833. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** is third in league history with 8,433 career passing yards.

COASTAL IS FIRST TO WIN 100 GAMES AS BIG SOUTH MEMBERS

Coastal Carolina won its 100th game in Week 5 against Alabama A&M, becoming the first program to win 100 games during the Big South's 14-year existence. The Chants' record total stands at 102. Liberty is second at 89 wins since 2002, followed by Charleston Southern (76) and Gardner-Webb (74).

HENDERSON HOPPING THROUGH BIG SOUTH RECORD BOOK

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** needs 18 rushing yards to become the fifth player in Big South history with 3,000 in a career, and once he reaches the plateau, he would be just the third player with 3,000 career rushing yards and 30 career rushing TDs. The other two are Big South all-time leading rusher **MIGUEL MAYSONET** (4,725 yards, 48 TD) and **RASHAD JENNINGS** (3,633 yards, 42 TD). Henderson is two TDs away from becoming the fifth player with 40 career scores.

TWO TREYS FOR TREY

Kennesaw State QB **TREY WHITE** is just the second quarterback in Big South history to record a 3-TD rush game and 3-TD pass game in the same season, joining Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN**, who achieved the feat in 2005. White rushed for three touchdowns against Edward Waters in Week 2 to become the first Big South quarterback with three rushing TDs in a game since VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2008. In Week 6 against Point, White threw three TD passes for the first time.

LAVON IS ON

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** posted 228 all-purpose yards this past Saturday against Coastal Carolina, his third 200-yard all-purpose game during his Big South tenure -- good for seventh all-time in league history for most 200-yard all-purpose efforts. Chaney's 196 rushing yards against the Chanticleers were the second-most ever by a Big South player.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

Coastal Carolina puts its Big South-record 10-game road win streak on the line Saturday at Charleston Southern. The Chanticleers have won their last three Big South road contests, as their last league loss away from home was Nov. 9, 2013 -- at CSU.

OFFENSIVE JUGGERNAUTS

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** is the second player in Big South history with 10,000 career yards of total offense, as he eclipsed the mark this past Saturday against Kennesaw State. He is second all-time with 10,031 yards and 541 away from breaking the league's career record of 10,571, set by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** from 2003-06. Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** is third all-time at 9,882 and 118 from the 10,000-yard plateau.

TURF BUILDERS

Kennesaw State leads the Big South with 319.9 rushing yards per game, currently the second-highest per game average in league history. The record is 357.5 rushing yards per contest set by VMI in 2008. The Owls are on pace for 3,519 rushing yards this season, which would be the fourth-highest single-season total in Big South history. The Owls have rushed for more than 300 yards in a game four times this season; the conference record for most 300-yard rushing games is eight (VMI - 2008).

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 119, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (52). In addition, Liberty is the Big South's record holder for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 63. Meanwhile, Liberty has scored a point in all 65 of its Big South games, the longest such streak in league annals. Of those 65 games, the last 53 have been in double digits. Charleston Southern's current streak of 39 conference games with a point is third-longest, just ahead of PC's active streak of 36 games.

EXCEPTIONAL ESTES

Gardner-Webb redshirt-junior TE **MIKE ESTES** is moving up the Big South record book among tight ends. His 68 career receptions are second all-time, while his 858 career receiving yards are third-most in league history -- just 53 away from unseating **DAVID DURAN** for the top spot. Duran had 910 receiving yards for Coastal Carolina from 2009-12. Estes' former teammate **SETH CRANFILL** is second in yardage with 899.

BALANCED ATTACK

Coastal Carolina is the only Big South member to average more than 200 rushing yards and 200 passing yards in the same season, as the Chanticleers have achieved the feat twice (2013 and 2014). Coastal is on pace for its third consecutive 200/200 campaign, as CCU is averaging 206.3 rushing yards and 235.4 passing yards through six games this season.

MOVING THE CHAINS

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** is the first running back in Big South history with three career touchdown passes, and the second overall non-quarterback with three TD strikes, joining former Liberty WR **ADRIAN HALL** (2002-03). Chaney had two last year during his sophomore campaign, and recorded his third career TD pass on a 64-yard TD connection with WR **UGO EZEMMA** at Wagner in Week 3.

BROWN'S RECORD HOUSE CALLS

Coastal Carolina KR **DEVIN BROWN** is the Big South's all-time leader for career kickoff return touchdowns with five, as he had two in the first three games of the season and three in a four-game span dating back to 2014. The NCAA FCS record for career kickoff return touchdowns is six. He became the Big South career leader in Week 1 with a 100-yard return at Furman -- just the third 100-yard kickoff return in league history. Meanwhile, Brown's career kickoff return average of 27.6 is just behind the Big South record of 27.8, which is held by Stony Brook's **BROCK JACKOLSKI** (2010-11).

MAN WITH A PURPOSE

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** has 3,577 career all-purpose yards and is 18 away from joining the league's all-time Top 10. Meanwhile, he is averaging a league-high 1,116 all-purpose yards and 159.4 all-purpose yards per game, and is looking to become the third consecutive Chanticleer to lead the Big South in all-purpose yards. Henderson was tops last season with 1,823, and could become just the third player to lead the conference in the category in consecutive seasons. Meanwhile, Henderson became the first running back in Big South history to have 100 receiving yards in a game with his 129 at Furman in Week 1. He also narrowly missed becoming the first Big South player with 100 yards rushing and receiving in the same game, as he fell five rushing yards shy against the Paladins.

LIBERTY COLLECTS BIG SOUTH'S FIFTH-EVER FBS WIN

The Big South Conference notched its fifth-ever win over an FBS opponent with Liberty's 41-33 win at Georgia State in Week 5 -- marking the league's second consecutive season with an FBS victory and third in four years. It was also Liberty's second straight win over a Sun Belt foe. The Big South's five wins have all come since 2010, and the Flames now own three of those victories.

OWLS TAKE FLIGHT

Kennesaw State set the Big South single-game record for total offense with 699 yards in Week 6 against Point. The Owls bettered the old mark of 695 set by Charleston Southern against West Virginia Wesleyan on Oct. 15, 2005. Kennesaw State amassed 391 rushing yards and 308 passing yards against the Skyhawks, becoming just the second team in Big South history with 300 rushing and 300 passing yards in the same game. The first was Coastal Carolina in 2006 against Gardner-Webb (332 rush, 306 pass).

MAD MAX

Gardner-Webb QB **TYRELL MAXWELL** rushed for 173 yards against Liberty in Week 6, the second-most rushing yards by a quarterback in a single-game in league history. He also tied the Big South single-game record for rushing TDs by a quarterback with three, and posted his second 100-yard, 100-pass game this season vs. the Flames -- already tied for most in a career.

COUNTING BENJAMINS

For the first time since 2013 and just the third time overall, the Big South has three individual 100-yard rushing/100-yard passing performances on its ledger. Gardner-Webb's **TYRELL MAXWELL** has two such efforts this year, while Kennesaw State's **TREY WHITE** posted his first in Week 7 against GWU.

APPOINTMENT TELEVISION

The highly-anticipated Coastal Carolina at Liberty season finale on Nov. 21 has been moved to Thursday night, Nov. 19, at 7:00pm and will be televised live on ESPNEWS. It will be the first time a conference game will air on one of ESPN's linear networks, as well as the first league contest to be played on Thursday night. The teams will meet the final week for the second consecutive year, and the series is tied, 6-6, and the winner of the match-up has won or shared the Big South football Championship 10 times. The Chanticleers won three-straight over Liberty from 2004-06 en route to three consecutive titles (two outright, one shared). The Flames were victorious from 2007-09 while winning three-straight Big South crowns (two outright, one shared). Liberty won last season's meeting and both teams shared the title in 2014, as well as 2010, 2012 and 2013.

BOSS ROSS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** threw four touchdown passes in Week 5 against Alabama A&M, his Big South-record 10th career game with at least three TD strikes. He had shared the record of nine with Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** and Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS**.

BIRDS OF PREY

Kennesaw State has already returned three fumbles for touchdowns this season, tying the Big South single-season record. The Owls join Charleston Southern (2007), Stony Brook (2011), Liberty (2014) and Coastal Carolina (2014) as the only teams with three fumble return TDs in a season. KSU became the first Big South program to record a defensive TD in each of its first three games of a season. The Owls also were the first team in league annals to return two fumbles in a game during Week 2 against Edwards Waters.

CAN'T FUMBLE THIS NOTE

Presbyterian College DL **UGONNA AKOH** returned a fumble 73 yards for a touchdown in Week 5 at Western Carolina, the eighth-longest fumble return in Big South history. It was the league's fifth fumble return TD this season -- the second-most in conference annals. That record is eight, set just last season. Three different teams -- Kennesaw State (3), Presbyterian and Charleston Southern -- have fumble return touchdowns in 2015.

HIGH RATE OF RETURN

Coastal Carolina is 68-5 (=93.2 percent) when rushing for 200 yards in game, including 29-1 under head coach **JOE MOGLIA**. The Chanticleers have reached the 200-yard rushing plateau 61.2 percent of the time during Moglia's 49 games as head coach.

FREEZE FRAME

For the first time in league history, the Big South is utilizing full replay review for nearly every home football game this season via a partnership with DVSPORT. The conference previously used replay just for televised games on ESPN3 in 2013 and 2014.

* Charleston Southern meets Coastal Carolina for the 13th time on Saturday. The Buccaneers last defeated Coastal in 2013, a 31-26 home victory on Nov. 9

* Charleston Southern held Gardner-Webb to 110 total yards in a 34-0 shutout of the Bulldogs on Saturday. It was CSU's fewest allowed to an FCS opponent.

* CSU held Gardner-Webb to just six offensive snaps in Buc territory and did not take a snap inside the Bucs' 45-yard line.

* The Bucs had allowed only one offensive TD in each of their previous four games before Saturday's shutout.

* The Bucs have allowed just 367 total yards in their three Big South games (122.3 average) and 2.37 yards per play.

* QB **AUSTIN BROWN** had a career-high three TD passes at Gardner-Webb. He was 9-for-14 for 146 yards and two TDs in the first half, and all three of his TD passes were over 24 yards.

* RB **DARIUS HAMMOND**'s six-game TD streak came to an end this past Saturday at Gardner-Webb. It was the longest streak by a CSU player since Big South football began in 2002.

* The Buccaneers rushed for 189 yards at GWU, the first time this season the team did not eclipse 200 rushing yards in a game.

* Over the past two-plus seasons (2013-present), Coastal Carolina has won 31 games. The only FCS team to win more over the span is North Dakota State with 35 wins.

* QB **ALEX ROSS** is 31-5 as CCU's starting quarterback, and has thrown a TD pass in 31 of his 36 career starts.

* For the first time this season, a CCU opponent attempted a punt return on what was CCU's 22nd punt of the season. Monmouth had one return for one yard this past Saturday.

* The one punt return this season is the fewest in FCS with the next closest being Bryant and Lamar, each with just three.

* DT **JABARAI BOTHWELL** has 20 tackles in his last two games (11 vs. PC, nine at Monmouth). He had just 15 tackles in his first five games of the season.

* RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** is one of just two Big South players to lead his team in rushing in every contest this season.

* LB **TANNER BURCH** is just two tackles shy of becoming the 13th Big South player with 300 career stops. He will be the fifth Runnin' Bulldog on the list once he reaches the milestone.

* DL **O.J. MAU** is two TFL shy of becoming the 14th Big South player with 30 in a career.

* Gardner-Webb remains the Big South leader in red zone defense, allowing a 57.1 success rate (12-of-21). The Runnin' Bulldogs have allowed four touchdowns (2 rush, 2 pass) and eight field goals.

* WR **DARRIN PETERSON** caught four passes for 164 yards and 3 TDs against Kennesaw State this past Saturday, becoming the first player in program history to record three touchdown receptions in a game three times.

* Peterson also tied **CHRIS SUMMERS** (2008-11) for Liberty's all-time record with 26 career touchdown receptions.

* LB **JIMMY O'GRADY** led the Flames with 15 tackles against KSU. He has recorded 23 of his 50 tackles on the season in the last two games (eight tackles vs. Monmouth; 15 tackles vs. Kennesaw State).

* LB **DONELLE WILLIAMS** has 198 career solo tackles, one shy of the PC record set by **JUSTIN BETHEL**.

* PC recovered its ninth fumble of the season during the CSU contest in Week 7. The Blue Hose currently lead the Big South in fumble recoveries, with four returned for 190 yards and one score.
