PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - NOV. 2

CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - AUSTIN BROWN, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, QB, Sr (FLOWERY BRANCH, GA.)

Brown totaled 282 offensive yards and two touchdowns in leading Charleston Southern past No. 1/2 Coastal Carolina, 33-25, on Saturday. He was 13-of-21 passing for 252 yards and two scores and rushed 10 times for another 30 yards. Brown, who averaged 9.10 yards per play against the Chanticleers, gained 19.38 yards per completion and finished the day with a 194.13 passing efficiency. His two touchdown passes were part of 24 unanswered points by the Bucs in the first half to seize control of the game.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - CHAD GETER, GARDNER-WEBB, LB, R-Jr (IRMO, S.C.)

Getter tallied nine tackles, three tackles-for-loss, two sacks and a forced fumble at Presbyterian to lead Gardner-Webb to its first Big South road win in two years. He posted six solo tackles and made solo stops twice on third down that prevented PC from extending drives. Getter's sack and forced fumble at the Gardner-Webb 23-yard line eventually led to zero points three plays later. His 4-yard tackle-for-loss late in the fourth quarter set up a 3rd-and-long that led to a punt.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - TYLER TEKAC, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, K, Fr (GOOSE CREEK, S.C.)

Tekac finished with nine points against Coastal Carolina -- including CSU's final six points -- as he made two field goals and three extra points in the Bucs' eight-point win over the Chanticleers. He connected on a career-long 40-yard field goal in the third quarter to push CSU's lead to 30-15. Tekac added a 25-yarder in the fourth quarter to make the score 33-18 and help the Buccaneers distance themselves with 11 minutes remaining.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - TAYLOR HENKLE, KENNESAW STATE, S, R-Fr (MARIETTA, GA.)

Henkle recorded nine tackles -- all solo -- with two pass break-ups and an interception in the Owls' 23-13 win over Monmouth. His interception occurred at the KSU 47-yard and sealed the victory after Monmouth recovered an onside kick with 1:03 remaining.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BECOMES THIRD BIG SOUTH MEMBER TO DEFEAT NATION'S NUMBER 1

Charleston Southern's 33-25 win over previous No. 1/2 Coastal Carolina marked the third time in Big South history that a league member defeated the No. 1 ranked team in FCS. Coastal was the first in 2005 when the Chanticleers defeated No. 1 James Madison, 31-27, on Sept. 10. Liberty was second when the Flames defeated No. 1 CCU last season, 15-14, on Nov. 22. A Big South member has knocked off a nationally-ranked league counterpart at least once in the past 10 seasons (three times this year).

BUC-ING THE TREND -- CSU CAN CLINCH SHARE OF TITLE, AQ BID ON SATURDAY

Charleston Southern is 4-0 in Big South games for the first time, and can clinch at least a share of the regular-season championship as well as the Big South's automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs with a win Saturday at Kennesaw State. The Bucs' 4-0 conference start is the 14th overall in league history. Of the previous 13 times, 12 of those squads went on to win/share the Big South Championship. The only team not win the league title after starting 4-0 was Liberty in 2011 (second-place).

ESPN3 GOES WILD FOR BIG SOUTH -- NOV. 14 SELECTION IS LIBERTY AT CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

ESPN3 has selected the Liberty at Charleston Southern game as its Nov. 14 Wildcard broadcast selection. The game will air live at 2:00pm from CSU Stadium.

STINGINESS

After 12 conference games, the average margin of victory in Big South competition is just 10.9 points -- the third-lowest margin in league annals. The record is 9.4 set during 2006 as part of a 10-game conference season that featured five teams. Seven of the 12 Big South contests this season have been decided by single-digits; the record for such outcomes is 11 in 2009.

ATOP THE PERCH

With the exception of the first season of Big South football in 2002, Kennesaw State's six wins are tied for the most by a program in its first season in the Big South. The Owls have clinched a winning season in their first year of existence, and join Coastal Carolina (2003), VMI (2003) and Monmouth (2014), who all won six games during their respective inaugural seasons in the Big South. When adding 2002 to the equation, Gardner-Webb had nine wins during the league's first year of football. KSU became the first newcomer to the league to win its first-ever conference game, as the Owls defeated Gardner-Webb, 12-7, in Week 7. When including 2002, KSU is just the second team on the list, as GWU won its debut Big South game.

HENDERSON OWNS FCS RECORD FOR CONSECUTIVE GAMES WITH TOUCHDOWN

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** owns the FCS record for consecutive games with a touchdown at 22. He surpassed Monmouth's **DAVID SINISI**'s 20-game effort from 2006-07 in Week 8 at Monmouth, and has 33 TDs (30 rush, 3 receive) during his streak. Henderson broke the Big South record of 18 consecutive games, which was established by Liberty's **ZACH TERRELL** from 2006-08. The NCAA Division I FBS record is 27 consecutive games (Virginia Tech's **LEE SUGGS** from Sept. 2, 2000 through Dec. 31, 2002).

LUNSFORD OWNS FCS CAREER RECORD FOR MOST FIELD GOALS FROM 50+ YARDS

Liberty All-American kicker **JOHN LUNSFORD** is the all-time career leader in the Big South and FCS with 12 career field goals from 50 yards-or-longer following his record-breaking 57-yarder against Kennesaw State in Week 8. Lunsford was tied with Western Carolina's **KIRK ROACH** (1984-87) and Idaho State's **PETE GARCES** (1998-99) with 11 career field goals from 50-yards and beyond. Lunsford is 12-of-19 for his career from 50-plus yards (=63.2 percent). Meanwhile, his 19 career FG from 40 yards-or-longer are a Big South record as well, and he became the fifth Big South placekicker with 40 career field goals when he reached the milestone in Week 4 during the Southern Illinois game. He is currently second all-time in league annals with 46 career field goals.

PIRATES COVE

Charleston Southern remains first nationally in total defense with 244.1 yards allowed per game. No Big South team has ever led the country in this category. The Bucs became the first team in Big South history to hold three consecutive opponents to less than 200 yards of offense -- 112 to Monmouth in Week 6, 142 to PC in Week 7 and 110 to Gardner-Webb in Week 8. The Bucs have held six of their eight opponents below 300 offensive yards -- including a Big South record-tying five consecutive contests.

DON OF A NEW DAY

Presbyterian College LB **DONELLE WILLIAMS** became the second player in Big South history with 200 career solo tackles when he surpassed the milestone this past Saturday. He also moved into third in Big South history with 372 career tackles, and is 28 away from becoming the third player in league annals with 400.

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** needs 158 passing yards to break the Big South career record of 9,768, which has established by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** from 2003-06. Woodrum, who is already the Big South's career record-holder for most 300-yard passing games with nine, is 56 completions away from matching Drafts' Big South-record total of 833. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** is third in league history with 8,707 career passing yards.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL RETURNS TO ESPN3 IN 2015

The Big South Conference will again televise eight football games exclusively on ESPN3 this season. The "Game of the Week" package included a non-conference broadcast for the third time (Montana at Liberty on Sept. 19) and continues this Saturday when Liberty hosts Presbyterian at 3:30pm. **MIKE HOGEWOOD** (play-by-play) and **JAY SONHALTER** (analyst) have the call from Lynchburg. The package featured "Wildcard" selections for the first time, which were the final two weeks of the season.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL RETURNS TO AMERICAN SPORTS NETWORK

The Big South Conference will appear on the American Sports Network (ASN) three times this season. The first broadcast was Gardner-Webb's 34-20 win over No. 15/15 Liberty in Week 6, followed by Charleston Southern's 33-25 win over No. 1/2 Coastal Carolina this past Saturday. The slate concludes this Saturday when Gardner-Webb visits Coastal Carolina. **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **JIM DONNAN** (analyst) will handle the call from Conway.

WHITE-WASHING

Kennesaw State QB **TREY WHITE** is the first quarterback in Big South history to rush for three touchdowns in a game twice in the same season (Week 2 vs. Edwards Waters and Week 8 at Liberty). White's nine rushing scores this season are tied for second-most in a season by a Big South QB and three away from tying the league single-season mark of 12 (VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2008). White's 806 rushing yards this season are also third-highest by a Big South quarterback. Maypray holds that record as well (1,266 in 2008). White set a Big South single-game record for most quarterback rushing attempts with 34 in Week 7 against Gardner-Webb, while his 170 rushing yards against the Runnin' Bulldogs were third-most in a game by a signal-caller.

CUP OF JOE

Coastal Carolina head coach **JOE MOGLIA** is one victory away from becoming the fifth coach in league history with 40 wins. Should he be victorious on Saturday, he would be the fastest Big South coach to 40 victories, as he would achieve the milestone in just his 51st game as head coach. The current record is 55 games, set by former Liberty coach **DANNY ROCCO**.

GOLDEN GATE BRIDGES

Presbyterian College RB **DARRELL BRIDGES** is second in the Big South with 855 rushing yards -- the most by a PC rusher since 2011 (**LANCE BYRD** - 910), and the second-most in PC's Division I history. He is looking to become the first Blue Hose back with 1,000 rushing yards since PC became a Big South member in 2008. Meanwhile, Bridges is on pace for 254 rushing attempts, which would be sixth-most in a single-season in league history.

THOMPSON TWIN

Kennesaw State K **JUSTIN THOMPSON** tied the Big South single-game record with four field goals in Week 7 against Gardner-Webb. It was the second time this season Thompson made four field goals in a game, becoming just the third kicker in league history with multiple 4-field goal efforts. Liberty's **MATT BEVINS** did it a record four times in his career, while VMI's **MATT SHARPE** achieved it twice in 2003.

THE LONE GRANGER

Coastal Carolina kicker **RYAN GRANGER** leads the Big South with 14 field goals, just one away from tying the school record of 15 set by **ALEX CATRON** in 2014. Granger is 14-of-18 on field goals attempts (=77.8 percent) and is looking to become the third kicker to make 80 percent of his field goal attempts in a season (based on a minimum 15 made).

TREASURE MAP

Charleston Southern set the Big South single-season record for most consecutive games holding a league foe to less than 10 points at three, as the Bucs held Monmouth and PC to seven points each and shutout Gardner-Webb in Week 8. CSU's effort matched the overall record of three, which was first set by Coastal Carolina in non-conference games in 2008 and 2014.

OFFENSIVE JUGGERNAUTS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** is the third player in Big South history with 10,000 career yards of total offense, as he eclipsed the mark this past Saturday at Charleston Southern. Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** became the second with 10,000 during Week 8. Ross and Woodrum have alternated positions on the league's all-time list as they continue to chase career record-holder **COLLIN DRAFTS**, who has held the mark for nine years. With three games remaining in the regular-season for both players, below is a chart detailing Ross and Woodrum's likelihood of breaking the record:

EXCEPTIONAL ESTES

Gardner-Webb redshirt-junior TE **MIKE ESTES** became the Big South's record-holder for most career receiving yards by a tight end this past Saturday at Presbyterian. His career total of 929 surpassed the old mark of 910, held by Coastal Carolina's **DAVID DURAN**. Meanwhile, Estes is second all-time among Big South tight ends with 70 career receptions, and is 20 away from matching the record of 90 set by former teammate **SETH CRANFILL** from 2010-14.

THIS IS SARGENT PETERSON

Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** is the Big South's all-time leader with 2,936 career receiving yards. He surpassed the previous record of 2,720 (Coastal Carolina's **JEROME SIMPSON**) in Week 7. Peterson's 15 career 100-yard receiving games are also a conference record, and he is approaching the league mark for career receptions. Peterson is third all-time with 197 catches -- 27 away from breaking the record of 223 set by Gardner-Webb's **JAMES PERRY III** from 2008-11. Peterson is three receptions shy of becoming just the third Big South player with 200.

CODE BLUE

Monmouth redshirt-freshman QB **CODY WILLIAMS** is fourth in the Big South with 210.1 yards of offense and third with 175.1 passing yards a game. Williams is looking to become the first freshman QB in league history to average 200 yards of offense, while his passing yards per game trails the Big South freshman record of 188.3, set by VMI's **JONATHAN WILSON** in 2003. Meanwhile, Williams recorded a 71-yard rush at Fordham in Week 4, tied for the fourth-longest rush by a quarterback in Big South history. It was the longest by a signal-caller since 2011, when Presbyterian College QB **RYAN SINGER** scampered 74 yards for a TD at Liberty on Oct. 29.

CHIM CHIMINY

Liberty DE **CHIMA UZOWIHE** is the Big South's all-time leader for quarterback sacks with a record total 25.0. He surpassed the previous mark of 20.5 (set by Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** from 2004-07) against Montana in Week 3. Uzowihe leads the Big South with 8.0 sacks this season, just 1.5 away from matching the single-season record of 9.5 set by former teammate **TOBY ONYECHI** last season. Meanwhile, Uzowihe is third all-time in Big South history with 38.5 career TFL and is 1.5 away from becoming the third player with 40 in a career.

COASTAL IS FIRST TO WIN 100 GAMES AS BIG SOUTH MEMBERS...

Coastal Carolina won its 100th game in Week 5 against Alabama A&M, becoming the first program to win 100 games during the Big South's 14-year existence. The Chants' record total stands at 102. Liberty is second at 89 wins since 2002, followed by Charleston Southern (77) and Gardner-Webb (75).

...WHILE LIBERTY IS APPROACHING 50 BIG SOUTH VICTORIES

Liberty has won a league-high 47 Big South games during its time in the conference since the league started football in 2002. Coastal Carolina is second with 42 Big South wins, followed by Gardner-Webb (31) and Charleston Southern (28). The Flames need to win their three remaining Big South games to reach 50 by season's end.

HENDERSON HOPPING THROUGH BIG SOUTH RECORD BOOK

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** became the fifth player in Big South history with 3,000 career rushing yards when he eclipsed the mark this past Saturday at Charleston Southern. He is now just the third player with 3,000 career rushing yards (3,072) and 30 rushing touchdowns (36). The other two are Big South all-time leading rusher **MIGUEL MAYSONET** (4,725 yards, 48 TD) and **RASHAD JENNINGS** (3,633 yards, 42 TD). Henderson, who is one TD away from becoming the fifth player with 40 career scores, is fifth all-time in rushing yards and is on pace to end the regular-season with 3,424 -- which would put him third all-time in Big South annals.

RANK AND FILE

The Big South has had a football squad nationally-ranked for 60 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 season (Oct. 24). In addition, the league has had two teams nationally-ranked at the same time for 10 consecutive weeks this year, as Coastal Carolina is No. 8 in both the FCS Coaches poll and STATS ranking, while Charleston Southern is No. 13 (FCS Coaches) and No. 15 (STATS) this week. The conference has had two teams nationally-ranked in the same week 33 times overall in league history -- including 28 times since the start of the 2013 campaign.

CAKE ROSS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** recorded his 14th career game with 300 yards of offense this past Saturday at Charleston Southern as he amassed 324 yards against the Buccaneers. He is second in league annals for most games with 300 yards of offense, just one away from **MIKE BROWN**'s record of 15. Meanwhile, Ross has tied the conference career record for most rushing touchdowns by a QB with 19, matching Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS** (2002-05) and Brown (2008-11). Ross is third in Big South history for most rushing yards by a quarterback with 1,499. He needs 140 to unseat former Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** (1,638) for second.

TWO TREYS FOR TREY

Kennesaw State QB **TREY WHITE** is just the second quarterback in Big South history to record a 3-TD rush game and 3-TD pass game in the same season, joining Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN**, who achieved the feat in 2005. White rushed for three touchdowns against Edward Waters in Week 2 to become the first Big South quarterback with three rushing TDs in a game since VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2008. In Week 6 against Point, White threw three TD passes for the first time.

LAVON IS ON

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** posted 228 all-purpose yards in Week 8 against Coastal Carolina, his third 200-yard all-purpose game during his Big South tenure -- good for seventh all-time in league history for most 200-yard all-purpose efforts. Chaney's 196 rushing yards against the Chanticleers were the second-most ever by a Big South player.

TURF BUILDERS

Kennesaw State leads the Big South with 322.5 rushing yards per game, currently the second-highest per game average in league history. The record is 357.5 rushing yards per contest set by VMI in 2008. The Owls are on pace for 3,548 rushing yards this season, which would be the fourth-highest single-season total in Big South history. The Owls have rushed for more than 300 yards in a game five times this season; the conference record for most 300-yard rushing games is eight (VMI - 2008).

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 119, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (53). In addition, Liberty is the Big South's record holder for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 63. Meanwhile, Liberty has scored a point in all 65 of its Big South games, the longest such streak in league annals. Of those 65 games, the last 53 have been in double digits. Charleston Southern's current streak of 40 conference games with a point is third-longest, just ahead of PC's active streak of 37 games.

BALANCED ATTACK

Coastal Carolina is the only Big South member to average more than 200 rushing yards and 200 passing yards in the same season, as the Chanticleers have achieved the feat twice (2013 and 2014). Coastal is seeking its third consecutive 200/200 campaign, as CCU is averaging 199.5 rushing yards and 240.2 passing yards through eight games this season.

MOVING THE CHAINS

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** is the first running back in Big South history with three career touchdown passes, and the second overall non-quarterback with three TD strikes, joining former Liberty WR **ADRIAN HALL** (2002-03). Chaney had two last year during his sophomore campaign, and recorded his third career TD pass on a 64-yard TD connection with WR **UGO EZEMMA** at Wagner in Week 3.

BROWN'S RECORD HOUSE CALLS

Coastal Carolina KR **DEVIN BROWN** is the Big South's all-time leader for career kickoff return touchdowns with five, as he had two in the first three games of the season and three in a four-game span dating back to 2014. The NCAA FCS record for career kickoff return touchdowns is six. He became the Big South career leader in Week 1 with a 100-yard return at Furman -- just the third 100-yard kickoff return in league history.

ROAD BLOCK

Charleston Southern ended Coastal Carolina's 10-game regular-season road win streak this past Saturday, which included three Big South road victories. It was the Chanticleers' first regular-season road loss and conference road defeat since Nov. 9, 2013 -- also at the hands of the Buccaneers.

MAN WITH A PURPOSE

Coastal Carolina RB **DeANGELO HENDERSON** has 3,700 career all-purpose yards, good for eighth all-time in league history. He is 300 yards away from becoming the seventh player with 4,000 in a career. He leads the league with 1,239 all-purpose yards and 154.9 per game, and is looking to become the third consecutive Chanticleer to lead the Big South in all-purpose yards. Henderson was tops last season with 1,823, and could become just the third player to lead the conference in the category in consecutive seasons. Meanwhile, Henderson became the first running back in Big South history to have 100 receiving yards in a game with his 129 at Furman in Week 1.

LIBERTY COLLECTS BIG SOUTH'S FIFTH-EVER FBS WIN

The Big South Conference notched its fifth-ever win over an FBS opponent with Liberty's 41-33 win at Georgia State in Week 5 -- marking the league's second consecutive season with an FBS victory and third in four years. It was also Liberty's second straight win over a Sun Belt foe. The Big South's five wins have all come since 2010, and the Flames now own three of those victories.

OWLS TAKE FLIGHT

Kennesaw State set the Big South single-game record for total offense with 699 yards in Week 6 against Point. The Owls bettered the old mark of 695 set by Charleston Southern against West Virginia Wesleyan on Oct. 15, 2005. Kennesaw State amassed 391 rushing yards and 308 passing yards against the Skyhawks, becoming just the second team in Big South history with 300 rushing and 300 passing yards in the same game. The first was Coastal Carolina in 2006 against Gardner-Webb (332 rush, 306 pass).

COUNTING BENJAMINS

For the first time in league history, the Big South has four individual 100-yard rushing/100-yard passing performances in a single season. Gardner-Webb's **TYRELL MAXWELL** and Kennesaw State's **TREY WHITE** each have two such efforts this year -- tied for the most in a career.

50-50 RAFFLE

Coastal Carolina's **ALEX ROSS** and Liberty's **JOSH WOODRUM** are among the five all-time players in Big South history to throw 50 career touchdown passes. Ross is second all-time with 61 career scoring strikes after becoming the Chanticleers' all-time leader during Week 2. Woodrum became the fifth member of the 50-TD pass club in Week 1 and sits in third with 59. Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** is the all-time leader with 73. From a TD responsibility standpoint (rushing and passing), Ross has 80 and Woodrum has tallied 74. Drafts had 90 (73 passing, 17 rushing) during his career from 2003-06.

APPOINTMENT TELEVISION

The highly-anticipated Coastal Carolina at Liberty season finale on Nov. 21 has been moved to Thursday night, Nov. 19, at 7:00pm and will be televised live on ESPNEWS. It will be the first time a conference game will air on one of ESPN's linear networks, as well as the first league contest to be played on Thursday night. The teams will meet the final week for the second consecutive year, and the series is tied, 6-6, and the winner of the match-up has won or shared the Big South football Championship 10 times. The Chanticleers won three-straight over Liberty from 2004-06 en route to three consecutive titles (two outright, one shared). The Flames were victorious from 2007-09 while winning three-straight Big South crowns (two outright, one shared). Liberty won last season's meeting and both teams shared the title in 2014, as well as 2010, 2012 and 2013.

BIRDS OF PREY

Kennesaw State has already returned three fumbles for touchdowns this season, tying the Big South single-season record. The Owls join Charleston Southern (2007), Stony Brook (2011), Liberty (2014) and Coastal Carolina (2014) as the only teams with three fumble return TDs in a season. KSU became the first Big South program to record a defensive TD in each of its first three games of a season. The Owls also were the first team in league annals to return two fumbles in a game during Week 2 against Edwards Waters.

HIGH RATE OF RETURN

Coastal Carolina is 68-5 (=93.2 percent) when rushing for 200 yards in game, including 29-1 under head coach **JOE MOGLIA**. The Chanticleers have reached the 200-yard rushing plateau 60.0 percent of the time during Moglia's 50 games as head coach.
