## PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - NOV. 9

### CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - ALEX ROSS, COASTAL CAROLINA, QB, R-Sr (ALPHARETTA, GA.)

Ross passed for 209 yards and two touchdowns, along with 229 yards of offense and a 225.98 passing efficiency in the Chanticleers' 46-0 win over Gardner-Webb. He was 14-of-16 passing (=87.5 percent) and completed his last 10 passes of the day for 141 yards and two scores. Ross averaged 14.93 yards per completion and nearly 10 yards per play against the Runnin' Bulldogs.

### DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - ANTHONY ELLIS, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, DE, Soph (Apopka, Fla.)

Ellis registered five solo tackles -- including four behind the line of scrimmage for loss of 20 yards, as well as one sack, one forced fumble, a blocked PAT and a 61-yard fumble return for a touchdown in Charleston Southern's 28-14 win at Kennesaw State. His fumble return TD was part of 21 unanswered points by the Bucs in the first half as CSU seized control of the game. Ellis helped the Bucs hold the Owls to a season-low 113 rushing yards -- 209 yards below their season average.

### SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - DARIUS HAMMOND, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, KR, Jr (JOHNSON, S.C.)

Hammond returned five kicks (three punts, two kickoffs) for 146 yards (=29.2 return average) to provide Charleston Southern with great field possession against Kennesaw State. He averaged 39.5 yards on his kickoff returns and 22.3 yards on his punt returns. Hammond's 53-yard punt return in the first quarter set-up the Bucs' first score of the game. He also had a 56-yard kickoff return.

### THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - TAYLOR HENKLE, KENNESAW STATE, S, R-Fr (MARIETTA, GA.)

Henkle recorded 10 tackles -- a solo -- with two interceptions against Charleston Southern. He tied for the team lead in tackles and recorded an interception for the second straight game. Henkle's second interception of the day ended a CSU drive in the red zone, and the Owls capitalized on the ensuing drive with a touchdown.

## BU-CING THE TREND -- CSU CLINCHES SHARE OF TITLE, SECURES BIG SOUTH'S PLAYOFF BID

Charleston Southern clinched at least a share of the Big South title and has secured the Big South's automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs following Saturday's 28-14 win at Kennesaw State -- the program's first-ever playoff berth. The Bucs can finish no worse than 5-1 in league games, and could only tie Coastal Carolina at 5-1 should the Chants win out. In that scenario, CSU is the auto bid recipient based on its head-to-head victory over CCU in Week 9. It is the earliest that the conference's automatic playoff representative has been determined since being awarded an AQ starting in 2010.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN LOOKING TO BECOME SECOND TEAM WITH 6-0 BIG SOUTH RECORD

Charleston Southern is 5-0 in Big South games for the first time, and can become just the second team in league history to finish a perfect 6-0 in conference action. The only team to complete a 6-0 league season was Stony Brook in 2011. Charleston Southern's 5-0 start is the seventh in Big South history, and members that have opened 5-0 in Big South games have now won/shared the conference title six times. The only team not win the league title after starting 5-0 was Liberty in 2011 (second-place).

## ESPN3 CONCLUDES REGULAR-SEASON COVERAGE THIS WEEKEND WITH WILDCARD BROADCAST

The Big South's exclusive "Game of the Week" on ESPN3 concludes this Saturday with the Liberty at Charleston Southern game live at 2:00pm. The contest was ESPN3's Wildcard broadcast selection, and will have **MIKE HOGWOOD** (play-by-play) and **RENALDO WYNN** (analyst) on the call from North Charleston. The league's eight-game package this season included a non-conference broadcast for the third time (Montana at Liberty on Sept. 19), as well as "Wildcard" selections for the first time, which were the final two weeks of the season.

## PASSING GRADES

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** became the Big South's all-time leader in passing yards this past Saturday against Presbyterian. His 9,824 career yards broke the previous mark of 9,768 that was held by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** (2003-06). Woodrum is 176 passing yards away from becoming the first Big South player with 10,000. Already the Big South's career record-holder for most 300-yard passing games with nine, Woodrum is 40 completions away from matching Drafts' Big South-record total of 833.

## STINGINESS

After 15 conference games, the average margin of victory in Big South competition is 13.3 points -- the third-lowest margin in league annals. The record is 9.4 set during 2006 as part of a 10-game conference season that featured five teams. Eight of the 15 Big South contests this season have been decided by single-digits; the record for such outcomes is 11 in 2009.

## HENDERSON OWNS FCS RECORD FOR CONSECUTIVE GAMES WITH TOUCHDOWN

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** owns the FCS record for consecutive games with a touchdown at 23. He surpassed the previous mark of 20 that was held by Monmouth's **DAVID SINISI** from 2006-07 in Week 8 at Monmouth. Henderson has 35 TDs (32 rush, 3 receive) during his streak, and is four games away from tying the overall NCAA Division I record of 27 consecutive games (Virginia Tech's **LEE SUGGS** from Sept. 2, 2000 through Dec. 31, 2002). Henderson broke the Big South record of 18 consecutive games, which was established by Liberty's **ZACH TERRELL** from 2006-08.

## LUNSFORD OWNS FCS CAREER RECORD FOR MOST FIELD GOALS FROM 50+ YARDS

Liberty All-American kicker **JOHN LUNSFORD** is the all-time career leader in the Big South and FCS with 12 career field goals from 50 yards-or-longer following his record-breaking 57-yarder against Kennesaw State in Week 8. Lunsford was tied with Western Carolina's **KIRK ROACH** (1984-87) and Idaho State's **PETE GARCES** (1998-99) with 11 career field goals from 50-yards and beyond. Lunsford is 12-of-19 for his career from 50-plus yards (=63.2 percent). Meanwhile, his 19 career FG from 40 yards-or-longer are a Big South record as well, and he became the fifth Big South placekicker with 40 career field goals when he reached the milestone in Week 4 during the Southern Illinois game. He is currently second all-time in league annals with 46 career field goals.

## PIRATES COVE

Charleston Southern remains first nationally in total defense with 250.6 yards allowed per game. No Big South team has ever led the country in this category. The Bucs became the first team in Big South history to hold three consecutive opponents to less than 200 yards of offense -- 112 to Monmouth in Week 6, 142 to PC in Week 7 and 110 to Gardner-Webb in Week 8. The Bucs have held six of their nine opponents below 300 offensive yards -- including a Big South record-tying five consecutive contests.

## HIGH RATE OF RETURN

Coastal Carolina is 69-5 (=93.2 percent) when rushing for 200 yards in game, including 30-1 under head coach **JOE MOGLIA**. The Chanticleers have reached the 200-yard rushing plateau 60.8 percent of the time during Moglia's 51 games as head coach.

## CUP OF JOE

Coastal Carolina head coach **JOE MOGLIA** is the fastest Big South coach to win 40 games, as he reached the total with Saturday's 46-0 win over Gardner-Webb in his 51st game as Coastal's head coach. The previous fastest was 55 games by former Liberty head coach **DANNY ROCCO**. Moglia is the fifth coach in Big South history with 40 wins.

## OFFENSIVE JUGGERNAUTS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** is 137 yards away from breaking the Big South career record for total offense. The third player in Big South history with 10,000 career yards of offense, Ross is second to Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS**, who amassed a record 10,571 from 2003-06. Meanwhile, Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** -- officially the second player with 10,000 career yards during Week 8, is 332 away from surpassing Drafts. Ross and Woodrum have alternated positions on the league's all-time list as they continue to chase Drafts' all-time mark. With two games remaining in the regular-season for both players, below is a chart detailing Ross and Woodrum's likelihood of breaking the record:

## GOLDEN GATE BRIDGES

Presbyterian College RB **DARRELL BRIDGES** is second in the Big South with 919 rushing yards -- the most by a PC rusher in the school's Division I history. He is looking to become the first Blue Hose back with 1,000 rushing yards since PC became a Big South member in 2008. Bridges has scored eight of PC's 13 touchdowns this season, which are the most by a Blue Hose player since **LANCE BYRD** had eight in 2011.

## ATOP THE PERCH

With the exception of the first season of Big South football in 2002, Kennesaw State's six wins are tied for the most by a program in its first season in the Big South. The Owls have clinched a winning season in their first year of existence, and join Coastal Carolina (2003), VMI (2003) and Monmouth (2014), who all won six games during their respective inaugural seasons in the Big South. When adding 2002 to the equation, Gardner-Webb had nine wins during the league's first year of football. KSU became the first newcomer to the league to win its first-ever conference game, as the Owls defeated Gardner-Webb, 12-7, in Week 7. When including 2002, KSU is just the second team on the list, as GWU won its debut Big South game.

## DON OF A NEW DAY

Presbyterian College LB **DONELLE WILLIAMS** became the second player in Big South history with 200 career solo tackles when he surpassed the milestone in Week 9, and has 206 solo stops in his career. He is third in Big South history with 380 career tackles, and is 20 away from becoming the third player in league annals with 400.

## WHITE-WASHING

Kennesaw State QB **TREY WHITE** is the first quarterback in Big South history to rush for three touchdowns in a game twice in the same season (Week 2 vs. Edwards Waters and Week 8 at Liberty). White's nine rushing scores this season are tied for second-most in a season by a Big South QB and three away from tying the league single-season mark of 12 (VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2008). White's 809 rushing yards this season are also third-highest by a Big South quarterback. Maypray holds that record as well (1,266 in 2008). White set a Big South single-game record for most quarterback rushing attempts with 34 in Week 7 against Gardner-Webb, while his 170 rushing yards against the Runnin' Bulldogs were third-most in a game by a signal-caller.

## CHIM CHIMINY

Liberty DE **CHIMA UZOWIHE** is the Big South's all-time leader for quarterback sacks with a record total 25.0. He surpassed the previous mark of 20.5 (set by Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** from 2004-07) against Montana in Week 3. Uzowihe leads the Big South with 8.0 sacks this season, just 1.5 away from matching the single-season record of 9.5 set by former teammate **TOBY ONYECHI** last year. Meanwhile, Uzowihe is third all-time in Big South history with 39.0 career TFL and is 1.0 away from becoming the third player with 40 in a career.

## THE LONE GRANGER

Coastal Carolina kicker **RYAN GRANGER** leads the Big South with 14 field goals, just one away from tying the school record of 15 set by **ALEX CATRON** in 2014. Granger is 14-of-18 on field goals attempts (=77.8 percent) and is looking to become the third Big South kicker to make 80 percent of his field goal attempts in a season (based on a minimum 15 made).

## RANK AND FILE

The Big South has had a football squad nationally-ranked for 61 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 season (Oct. 24). In addition, the league has had two teams nationally-ranked at the same time for 11 consecutive weeks this year, as Coastal Carolina is No. 4 in both the FCS Coaches poll and STATS ranking, while Charleston Southern is No. 8 (FCS Coaches) and No. 11 (STATS) this week -- the second time this season two Big South teams were ranked in the Top 10 at the same time. The conference has had two teams nationally-ranked in the same week 34 times overall in league history -- including 29 times since the start of the 2013 campaign.

## EXCEPTIONAL ESTES

Gardner-Webb redshirt-junior TE **MIKE ESTES** is the Big South's all-time leader for receiving yards by a tight end with 983, and is 17 yards away from becoming the first with 1,000. He surpassed the old mark of 910, held by Coastal Carolina's **DAVID DURAN**, in Week 9. Meanwhile, Estes is second all-time among Big South tight ends with 72 career receptions, and is 18 away from matching the record of 90 set by former teammate **SETH CRANFILL** from 2010-14.

## THIS IS SARGENT PETERSON

Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** is the Big South's all-time leader with 3,022 career receiving yards. He surpassed the previous record of 2,720 (Coastal Carolina's **JEROME SIMPSON**) in Week 7. Peterson's 15 career 100-yard receiving games are also a conference record, and he is approaching the league mark for career receptions. Peterson is second all-time with 205 catches -- 19 away from breaking the record of 223 set by Gardner-Webb's **JAMES PERRY III** from 2008-11.

## CODE BLUE

Monmouth redshirt-freshman QB **CODY WILLIAMS** is third in the Big South with 210.1 yards of offense and 175.1 passing yards a game. Williams is looking to become the first freshman QB in league history to average 200 yards of offense, while his passing yards per game trails the Big South freshman record of 188.3, set by VMI's **JONATHAN WILSON** in 2003. Meanwhile, Williams recorded a 71-yard rush at Fordham in Week 4, tied for the fourth-longest rush by a quarterback in Big South history. It was the longest by a signal-caller since 2011, when Presbyterian College QB **RYAN SINGER** scampered 74 yards for a TD at Liberty on Oct. 29.

## COASTAL IS FIRST TO WIN 100 GAMES AS BIG SOUTH MEMBERS...

Coastal Carolina won its 100th game in Week 5 against Alabama A&M, becoming the first program to win 100 games during the Big South's 14-year existence. The Chants' record total stands at 103. Liberty is second at 90 wins since 2002, followed by Charleston Southern (78) and Gardner-Webb (75).

## ...WHILE LIBERTY IS APPROACHING 50 BIG SOUTH VICTORIES

Liberty has won a league-high 48 Big South games during its time in the conference since the league started football in 2002. Coastal Carolina is second with 43 Big South wins, followed by Gardner-Webb (31) and Charleston Southern (29). The Flames need to win their two remaining Big South games to reach 50 by season's end.

## HENDERSON HOPPING THROUGH BIG SOUTH RECORD BOOK

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** became the fifth player in Big South history with 3,000 career rushing yards when he eclipsed the mark in Week 9 at Charleston Southern. He is now just the third player with 3,000 career rushing yards (3,186) and 30 rushing touchdowns (38). The other two are Big South all-time leading rusher **MIGUEL MAYSONET** (4,725 yards, 48 TD) and **RASHAD JENNINGS** (3,633 yards, 42 TD). Henderson, who became the fifth player with 40 career scores this past Saturday, is fifth all-time in rushing yards and is on pace to end the regular-season with 3,420 -- which would put him third all-time in Big South annals.

## TREASURE MAP

Charleston Southern set the Big South single-season record for most consecutive games holding a league foe to less than 10 points at three, as the Bucs held Monmouth and PC to seven points each and shutout Gardner-Webb in Week 8. CSU's effort matched the overall record of three, which was first set by Coastal Carolina in non-conference games in 2008 and 2014.

## HOME SWEET HOME

Coastal Carolina (5-0), Charleston Southern (4-0) and Liberty (4-0) are all undefeated at home this season. The Chants last finished unbeaten at home in 2013 (7-0), while the Flames' last occurrence was in 2010 (5-0). The Bucs' last had a perfect home record in 2008 (5-0). The trio has a chance to finish their respective 2015 home slates with unblemished marks, which would also mark the first time three Big South members finished a season undefeated at home. The current record is two (2009). The conference has had at least one member with an undefeated home record 11 times in its 13 previous seasons (2002-03-04-05-06-07-08-09-10-12-13).

## IT'S ACADEMIC

The Big South had three players receive CoSIDA Academic All-District honors late last week. Monmouth's **JOE JOHNSON** and Presbyterian College's **UGONNA AKOH** are repeat honorees, and were joined by Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS**. All three players advance to the Academic All-America ballot.

## 50-50 RAFFLE

Coastal Carolina's **ALEX ROSS** and Liberty's **JOSH WOODRUM** are among the five all-time players in Big South history to throw 50 career touchdown passes. Ross is second all-time with 63 career scoring strikes after becoming the Chanticleers' all-time leader during Week 2. Woodrum became the fifth member of the 50-TD pass club in Week 1 and sits in third with 59. Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** is the all-time leader with 73. Meanwhile, Ross is second all-time with 82 touchdowns responsible for (TDs scored and passed for), eight away from Drafts' Big South-record of 90. Woodrum has tallied 74 -- fourth all-time and four away from moving into third.

## TWO TREYS FOR TREY

Kennesaw State QB **TREY WHITE** is just the second quarterback in Big South history to record a 3-TD rush game and 3-TD pass game in the same season, joining Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN**, who achieved the feat in 2005. White rushed for three touchdowns against Edward Waters in Week 2 to become the first Big South quarterback with three rushing TDs in a game since VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2008. In Week 6 against Point, White threw three TD passes for the first time.

## LAVON IS ON

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** posted 228 all-purpose yards in Week 8 against Coastal Carolina, his third 200-yard all-purpose game during his Big South tenure -- good for seventh all-time in league history for most 200-yard all-purpose efforts. Chaney's 196 rushing yards against the Chanticleers were the second-most ever by a Big South player.

## RECEIVING BACKS

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** and Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** rank among the league's all-time leaders for receptions and receiving yards by a running back. Henderson is second all-time in Big South history with 71, while Chaney is tied for fourth with 68. The record is 75 by Gardner-Webb's **DAVID MONTGOMERY** from 2006-09. Henderson became the Big South's career leader for receiving yards by a RB during Week 5, when he surpassed VMI's **SEAN MIZZER**'s (2003-06) then-record of 574. Henderson's record yardage total is 628. Chaney is seventh in league annals with 509.

## POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 120, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (54). In addition, Liberty is the Big South's record holder for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 64. Meanwhile, Liberty has scored a point in all 66 of its Big South games, the longest such streak in league annals. Of those 66 games, the last 54 have been in double digits. Charleston Southern's current streak of 41 conference games with a point is third-longest, just ahead of PC's active streak of 38 games.

## BALANCED ATTACK

Coastal Carolina is the only Big South member to average more than 200 rushing yards and 200 passing yards in the same season, as the Chanticleers have achieved the feat twice (2013 and 2014). Coastal is seeking its third consecutive 200/200 campaign, as CCU is averaging 202.4 rushing yards and 242.3 passing yards through nine games this season.

## CAKE ROSS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** recorded his 14th career game with 300 yards of offense in Week 9 at Charleston Southern as he amassed 324 yards against the Buccaneers. He is second in league annals for most games with 300 yards of offense, just one away from **MIKE BROWN**'s record of 15. Meanwhile, Ross is tied for the conference career record for most rushing touchdowns by a QB with 19, matching Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS** (2002-05) and Brown (2008-11). Ross is third in Big South history for most rushing yards by a quarterback with 1,519. He needs 120 to unseat former Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** (1,638) for second.

## TURF BUILDERS

Kennesaw State leads the Big South with 299.2 rushing yards per game, currently the second-highest per game average in league history. The Owls are seeking to become just the second Big South team to average 300 rushing yards a game, and trail the single-season record of 357.5 rushing yards per contest set by VMI in 2008. The Owls are on pace for 3,291 rushing yards this season, which would be the fifth-highest single-season total in Big South history. The Owls have rushed for more than 300 yards in a game five times this season; the conference record for most 300-yard rushing games is eight (VMI - 2008).

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BECOMES THIRD BIG SOUTH MEMBER TO DEFEAT NATION'S NUMBER 1

Charleston Southern's 33-25 win over then-No. 1/2 Coastal Carolina marked the third time in Big South history that a league member defeated the No. 1 ranked team in FCS. Coastal was the first in 2005 when the Chanticleers defeated No. 1 James Madison, 31-27, on Sept. 10. Liberty was second when the Flames defeated No. 1 CCU last season, 15-14, on Nov. 22. A Big South member has knocked off a nationally-ranked league counterpart at least once in the past 10 seasons (three times this year).

## BROWN'S RECORD HOUSE CALLS

Coastal Carolina KR **DEVIN BROWN** is the Big South's all-time leader for career kickoff return touchdowns with five, as he had two in the first three games of the season and three in a four-game span dating back to 2014. The NCAA FCS record for career kickoff return touchdowns is six. He became the Big South career leader in Week 1 with a 100-yard return at Furman -- just the third 100-yard kickoff return in league history.

## ROAD BLOCK

Charleston Southern ended Coastal Carolina's 10-game regular-season road win streak in Week 9, which included three Big South road victories. It was the Chanticleers' first regular-season road loss and conference road defeat since Nov. 9, 2013 -- also at the hands of the Buccaneers.

## MAN WITH A PURPOSE

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** has 3,814 career all-purpose yards, good for seventh all-time in league history. He is 186 yards away from becoming the seventh player with 4,000 in a career. He leads the league with 1,353 all-purpose yards and 150.3 per game, and is looking to become the third consecutive Chanticleer to lead the Big South in all-purpose yards. Henderson was tops last season with 1,823, and could become just the third player to lead the conference in the category in consecutive seasons. Meanwhile, Henderson became the first running back in Big South history to have 100 receiving yards in a game with his 129 at Furman in Week 1.

## OWLS TAKE FLIGHT

Kennesaw State set the Big South single-game record for total offense with 699 yards in Week 6 against Point. The Owls bettered the old mark of 695 set by Charleston Southern against West Virginia Wesleyan on Oct. 15, 2005. Kennesaw State amassed 391 rushing yards and 308 passing yards against the Skyhawks, becoming just the second team in Big South history with 300 rushing and 300 passing yards in the same game. The first was Coastal Carolina in 2006 against Gardner-Webb (332 rush, 306 pass).

## COUNTING BENJAMINS

For the first time in league history, the Big South has four individual 100-yard rushing/100-yard passing performances in a single season. Gardner-Webb's **TYRELL MAXWELL** and Kennesaw State's **TREY WHITE** each have two such efforts this year -- tied for the most in a career.

## BIRDS OF PREY

Kennesaw State has returned three fumbles for touchdowns this season, tying the Big South single-season record. The Owls join Charleston Southern (2007), Stony Brook (2011), Liberty (2014) and Coastal Carolina (2014) as the only teams with three fumble return TDs in a season. KSU became the first Big South program to record a defensive TD in each of its first three games of a season. The Owls also were the first team in league annals to return two fumbles in a game during Week 2 against Edwards Waters.

## CAN'T FUMBLE THIS NOTE

Charleston Southern DE **ANTHONY ELLIS** returned a fumble 61 yards for a touchdown this past Saturday at Kennesaw State. It was the league's sixth fumble return TD this season -- the second-most in conference annals. That record is eight, set just last season. Three different teams -- Kennesaw State (3), Charleston Southern (2) and Presbyterian -- have fumble return touchdowns in 2015.

## THOMPSON TWIN

Kennesaw State K **JUSTIN THOMPSON** tied the Big South single-game record with four field goals in Week 7 against Gardner-Webb. It was the second time this season Thompson made four field goals in a game (also vs. Shorter in Week 3), becoming just the third kicker in league history with multiple 4-field goal efforts. Liberty's **MATT BEVINS** did it a record four times in his career, while VMI's **MATT SHARPE** achieved it twice in 2003. Thompson attempted a Big South single-game record seven field goals in the Shorter game, breaking the previous record of five.

## APPOINTMENT TELEVISION

The highly-anticipated Coastal Carolina at Liberty season finale on Nov. 21 has been moved to Thursday night, Nov. 19, at 7:00pm and will be televised live on ESPNEWS. It will be the first time a conference game will air on one of ESPN's linear networks, as well as the first league contest to be played on Thursday night. The teams will meet the final week for the second consecutive year, and the series is tied, 6-6, and the winner of the match-up has won or shared the Big South football Championship 10 times. The Chanticleers won three-straight over Liberty from 2004-06 en route to three consecutive titles (two outright, one shared). The Flames were victorious from 2007-09 while winning three-straight Big South crowns (two outright, one shared). Liberty won last season's meeting and both teams shared the title in 2014, as well as 2010, 2012 and 2013.

## LIBERTY COLLECTS BIG SOUTH'S FIFTH-EVER FBS WIN

The Big South Conference notched its fifth-ever win over an FBS opponent with Liberty's 41-33 win at Georgia State in Week 5 -- marking the league's second consecutive season with an FBS victory and third in four years. It was also Liberty's second straight win over a Sun Belt foe. The Big South's five wins have all come since 2010, and the Flames now own three of those victories.

## MOVING THE CHAINS

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** is the first running back in Big South history with three career touchdown passes, and the second overall non-quarterback with three TD strikes, joining former Liberty WR **ADRIAN HALL** (2002-03). Chaney had two last year during his sophomore campaign, and recorded his third career TD pass on a 64-yard TD connection with WR **UGO EZEMMA** at Wagner in Week 3.

## HENDERSON ADDED TO STATS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** was added to the STATS National Offensive Player of the Year Watch List on Oct. 7, joining teammate **ALEX ROSS** and Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** has official candidates for the national honor. Henderson's addition gives the Big South three student-athletes on the offensive award Watch List for the first time.

## MAU, UZOWIHE NAMED CANDIDATES FOR NATIONAL DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR AWARD

For the second consecutive year, the Big South has multiple players among the candidates for the FCS National Defensive Player of the Year Award, as Gardner-Webb DL **O.J. MAU** and Liberty DL **CHIMA UZOWIHE** are on this year's watch list. The Big South had a record three candidates in 2014.

## LARENZO'S OIL

Charleston Southern DB **LARENZO MATHIS** recorded an 87-yard interception return touchdown against East Tennessee State in Week 3, the fifth-longest INT return in Big South history. It was the longest return in the league since Liberty's **KaJUAN LEE**'s 100-yard pick-6 against CSU in 2011.

## RICE, RICE BABY

Liberty RB **DESMOND RICE** rushed for three touchdowns in Week 5 at Georgia State, marking his fourth career 3-TD game. He is tied for the fourth-most 3-touchdown games in league history. The record is seven, shared by Liberty's **RASHAD JENNINGS** and Stony Brook's **MIGUEL MAYSONET**.

## FILE AND RANK

Nationally-ranked Liberty defeated nationally-ranked Montana in Week 3, pushing the Big South to 10-10 all-time in games featuring a ranked league member against a ranked non-conference foe -- including 5-4 in regular-season matchups. Since 2008, the Flames have played 10 ranked non-league opponents as a nationally-ranked program, going 5-5 in that span.

## BOSS ROSS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** threw four touchdown passes in Week 5 against Alabama A&M, his Big South-record 10th career game with at least three TD strikes. He had shared the record of nine with Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** and Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS**.

## BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL FIRST: 7-0 WEEK

The Big South Conference went 7-0 during Week 3 action, the first 7-0 week in league history and just the second time that every conference member won its respective non-league matchup in the same week -- which first occurred in Week 3 in 2014. Five of the Week 7 wins were against FCS foes, one more than the total in Week 3 in both 2013 and 2014.

## ANOTHER BIG SOUTH FIRST -- TWO TOP 10 TEAMS

For the first time in Big South history, the league had two teams ranked in the Top 10 of the national polls during the week of Sept. 21. Coastal Carolina was No. 1 in the FCS Coaches poll and No. 2 in the STATS ranking, while Liberty was No. 10 in both the Coaches and STATS polls.
