PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - NOV. 16

CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - RASHUN DAVIS, RADFORD, G. SR (CHARLOTTE, N.C.)

Davis was the hero of Radford's season-opening 82-80 upset of Georgetown, pulling up in front of the Highlanders' bench for the game-winning 3-pointer with 1.5 seconds left in double overtime. The basket also lifted him to a career-high 28 points, bettering his 25-point effort against VMI as a sophomore. Davis shot 6-of-6 from the field in the first half on his way to a 12-of-19 performance, setting career highs for made and attempted field goals. The game-winner was the last of his three 3-pointers. In addition, the point guard dished out five assists, while adding four rebounds and one steal.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - CHRIS CLEMONS, CAMPBELL, G. FR (RALEIGH, N.C.)

Clemons came off the bench to score 19 points in 18 minutes in his collegiate debut against Montreat on Friday. He went 7-of-9 from the field -- including 5-of-6 from three-point range, while adding seven rebounds and three steals in the victory.

RADFORD GETS BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG WIN OF THE SEASON

Radford won its season opener at Georgetown, 82-80 in double-overtime to post the Big South's fourth win over a BIG EAST member in the past five seasons (since 2011-12). **RASHUN DAVIS** hit the game-winning pull-up three-pointer with 1.5 seconds remaining in the second extra session to cap a career-high 28-point performance. The victory was the Highlanders' first in a true road season opener since 1987, ending a string of 11 defeats.

BIG SOUTH'S 2014-15 POWER FIVE

The Big South had six combined wins over the ACC (3), SEC (2) and Big Ten (1) in 2014-15, the first time since 2011-12 that the Big South recorded victories over the three leagues in the same season. The Big South posted three of the six wins during the opening week of the 2014-15 regular season -- a league first. Meanwhile, the Big South recorded multiple wins over both the ACC and SEC for the first time since 2010-11 when Big South programs had three SEC wins and two ACC victories. The Big South's three ACC wins last season were its most ever in a campaign.

MID-MAJOR MANIA

Radford is ranked No. 25 in this week's Collegeinsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 ranking, the second consecutive season a Big South member has appeared in the poll. Below is a look at where the Big South has stood this season thus far:

ESPNU GOING WILD FOR THE BIG SOUTH

For the third consecutive season, four regular-season Big South games will appear in ESPNU in 2015-16. The 24-hour college sports network will televise one January game and three February contests, which will be "Wildcard" selections 21 days in advance. Those four telecasts will be Thursday, Jan. 14 at 7:00pm; Thursday, Feb. 11 at 9:00pm; Thursday, Feb. 18 at 7:00pm, and Thursday, Feb. 25 at 9:00pm.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is the third-active winningest coach in Division I with 770 career victories. Ellis, who is eight wins shy of 700 Division I wins, is 19th all-time in NCAA history for career wins (regardless of affiliation with a minimum 10 head coaching seasons at NCAA schools), and is the seventh-active winningest coach across all NCAA classifications. He became the first head coach in NCAA history with 150 wins at four different Division I programs with the Chanticleers' 68-56 victory over UNC Asheville on Feb. 3, 2015. His Division I school-by-school breakdown is as follows: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 158, in addition to 78 wins during his three seasons leading Cumberland College from 1972-75.

HE'S CRAFTY

Gardner-Webb third-year head coach **TIM CRAFT** won 38 games in his first two seasons in Boiling Springs, tied for the third-most wins by a Big South head coach in his first two seasons in the league, joining **JEFF MEYER** (Liberty) and **MIKE DEMENT** (UNC Greensboro) with that total. The record is 42 (**TOMMY GAITHER** - Charleston Southern and **GREGG MARSHALL** - Winthrop), followed by 39 wins (**TERRY TRUAX** - Towson State and **RITCHIE MCKAY** - Liberty).

BADOU'S BOARDS

Coastal Carolina's **BADOU DIAGNE** is five rebounds away from becoming the 50th player in Big South history with 600 in a career. He has an outside chance of joining the league's 1,000-point, 600-rebound and 100-blocked shot club, as his career totals include 760 points and 74 blocked shots. Meanwhile, teammate **MICHEL ENANGA** is 12 rebounds away from 500 in his career.

HIGH POINT'S JOHN BROWN VOTED 2015-16 PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

For the third consecutive year, High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** has been voted the Big South Conference Men's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's head coaches and media panel. He is the first men's player in Big South history to be named Preseason Player of the Year in three consecutive seasons. Named to the Lou Henson Preseason Player of the Year Watch List, Brown is one of 20 initial preseason candidates for the Julius Erving Award, which is given annually to the top small forward in men's college basketball. He is the only player from a mid-major program on the watch list. Brown enters the 2015-16 season as the nation's No. 3 returning scorer (1,680 career points) and the NCAA Division I active leader in field goals made (646). He is just one of two returning players nationally to have posted 1,500 points and 600 rebounds in a career. A 2014 Associated Press Honorable Mention All-American and the 2014 Big South Player of the Year, Brown was named to the NABC All-District Team in 2015 for the second-straight season, and was named a finalist for the 2015 Lou Henson Award, given to the nation's top mid-major player. Brown proved to be one of the most consistent scorers in the nation in 2014-15, as he posted at least 20 points in 15 contests, ranked ninth in the country in field goals made (242), was 26th nationally in scoring (19.3 ppg) and 32nd in field goal percentage (.550). He averaged 26.3 points, 8.3 rebounds and shot 57.4 percent in High Point's three postseason contests a year ago, and is looking to become just the second player in Big South history with FOUR First-Team All-Conference selections.

BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-junior **JOHN BROWN** is the third player in Big South history with 1,700 points (1,716), 600 rebounds (614), 100 blocked shots (125), 100 steals (137) and 100 assists (123). He will likely become just the second player with 2,000 points, 800 rebounds, 150 steals, 100 blocked shots and 100 assists by the end of the 2015-16 campaign. VMI's **STAN OKOYE** is the only Big South player with those benchmarks.

HIGH TOPS

Radford senior **RASHUN DAVIS** is the Big South's active career assist leader with 313, and is 87 away from becoming the 26th member of the league's 400-assist club. He is approaching 1,000 career points as well (103 away), and is poised to be the 21st player in conference annals with 1,000 points and 400 assists. Meanwhile, teammate **BRANDON HOLCOMB** has 410 rebounds and should become the just the 24th player in the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club. Holcomb is 29th all-time in league history with 114 career blocked shots.

CLIMBING THE VICTORY LADDER

Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is the longest-tenured active Big South coach, as he is in his 11th year in 2015-16 -- just the third head coach in League history with at least 10 years of service. Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is the Big South's active win leader with 158 wins, which ranks fourth in the conference record books. Radebaugh sits in seventh-place all-time with 139 victories.
