## PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - NOV. 23

### CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - JOSH WOODRUM, LIBERTY, QB, R-Sr (ROANOKE, VA.)

Woodrum rallied the Flames from two deficits with 262 passing yards and two touchdowns in a 24-21 win over then-No. 4/4 Coastal Carolina last Thursday night. He was 19-of-30 passing, tallied four of Liberty's eight third down conversions and converted two fourth down plays in the victory. His first touchdown pass tied the game at 14-14 midway through the third quarter. Woodrum then directed the game-winning drive with less than four minutes remaining as he first converted a key 4th-and-8 pass for 21 yards, then found his target two plays later for the go-ahead score with 1:27 left.

### DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - ED BRITT, PRESBYTERIAN, DB, Sr (GREENSBORO, N.C.)

Britt posted 10 tackles (six solo), one tackle-for-loss, one forced fumble and an interception for 37 yards against Kennesaw State in leading the Blue Hose to their first Big South win of the season. His two takeaways ended Owls drives. The first was a forced fumble in the first quarter that PC recovered, and his second thwarted a KSU scoring threat as he intercepted a pass at the PC 7-yard line.

### SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - TREY TURNER, LIBERTY, P, R-SOPH (ROME, GA.)

Turner punted seven times for a 41.3 average against Coastal Carolina. He placed four inside the 20-yard line -- including two inside the 10, and averaged 44.8 yards on his last four kicks. The Chanticleers' average starting field position following Turner's kicks was its own 19.3-yard line.

### THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - B.J. FARROW, LIBERTY, WR, R-Fr (LYNCHBURG, VA.)

Farrow caught two passes for 47 yards and one touchdown against Coastal Carolina, including the game-winning 40-yard catch-and-run score with 1:27 remaining. Farrow caught the pass in the middle of the field and broke two tackles to reach the end zone. The 40-yard play was the longest of his career.

## BIG SOUTH SENDS TWO TO FCS PLAYOFFS FOR THE THIRD TIME

For the third time in the Big South's six-year AQ history, the conference is sending two teams to the FCS Playoffs in the same season. Champion Charleston Southern claimed the league's automatic bid for the first time and earned the No. 8 seed plus a first round bye -- the Big South's second-ever Top 8 seed. Coastal Carolina received one of the 14 at-large berths for its fourth consecutive playoff appearance and sixth overall. The Big South is 7-8 all-time in the postseason -- including 4-1 at home -- and has had a team advance each of the past four years. The conference has won its last five first round playoff contests.

## BIG SOUTH FOUR-BY-FOUR

Coastal Carolina's at-large berth in the FCS Playoffs is the Big South's fourth at-large entry into the postseason. The previous times were 2006 (Coastal Carolina), 2012 (Stony Brook) and 2014 (Coastal Carolina). Meanwhile, the Chanticleers are one of six programs to have qualified for the last four Playoffs, joining North Dakota State, Jacksonville State, New Hampshire, Sam Houston State and South Dakota State.

## BUC-ING THE TREND -- CSU CLINCHES OUTRIGHT BIG SOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP, FCS PLAYOFF BID

Charleston Southern won the outright Big South Championship with its perfect 6-0 conference record. It is the Bucs' first outright title and second-ever conference crown, the first coming in 2005. CSU is just the second team in league history to finish 6-0 in Big South games, joining the 2011 Stony Brook Seawolves, and marks the eighth time that the Big South champion completed an undefeated conference campaign. The Buccaneers secured the Big South's automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs with their 28-14 win at Kennesaw State in Week 10 -- the program's first-ever playoff berth. It was the earliest that the Big South's automatic playoff representative has been determined since becoming an AQ conference in 2010, and the Buccaneers are the fourth different program to capture the league's automatic bid in that span.

## SIX PACK

As mentioned above, Coastal Carolina is making its sixth appearance in the FCS Playoffs, extending its Big South record. No other conference member has more than two. Head Coach **JOE MOGLIA** is the only Big South coach with four playoff berths -- making the field all four years on CCU's sideline, and owns a 4-3 all-time mark in the postseason.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BECOMES THIRD BIG SOUTH MEMBER TO DEFEAT NATION'S NUMBER 1

Charleston Southern's 33-25 win over then-No. 1/2 Coastal Carolina in Week 9 marked the third time in Big South history that a league member defeated the No. 1 ranked team in FCS. Coastal was the first in 2005 when the Chanticleers defeated No. 1 James Madison, 31-27, on Sept. 10. Liberty was second when the Flames defeated No. 1 CCU last season, 15-14, on Nov. 22. A Big South member has knocked off a nationally-ranked league counterpart at least once in the past 10 seasons (four times this year).

## STINGINESS

The average margin of victory in the Big South's 21 games of competition was 12.8 points -- the third-lowest margin in league annals. The record is 9.4 set during 2006 as part of a 10-game conference season that featured five teams. A league-record 12 of the 21 Big South contests this season were decided by single-digits bettering the previous record of 11 for such outcomes in 2009.

## SECOND TIME FOR EVERYTHING

The Big South's first round Playoff opponent is from a conference it has not faced in the postseason in nine years -- the Southern Conference. It will be just the second postseason meeting between the two leagues, as the first was in 2006 when Coastal Carolina faced Appalachian State in the Big South's first-ever Playoff berth.

## BIG SOUTH ENJOYS ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL NON-CONFERENCE SEASON

The Big South went 14-8 in 22 regular-season games against non-conference FCS opponents this season, the third consecutive year the league posted at least a .600 winning percentage against non-league foes. In 2014, the Big South was 22-5 in the regular-season (24-7 through the postseason) after going 16-9 in regular-season games in 2013 (18-10 overall). The three-year total stands at 52-22 (=.702) in regular-season competition and 56-25 including postseason in that span.

## THE GRAND FINALE

The final Big South game between Liberty and Coastal Carolina was another classic, as the Flames prevailed, 24-21, in front of a national TV audience on ESPNEWS. It was the first time a conference game aired on one of ESPN's linear networks, as well as the first league contest played on Thursday night. The teams met the final week for the second consecutive year, and Liberty moved ahead in the series, 7-6. The winner of the match-up had won or shared the Big South football championship 10 times.

## RANK AND FILE

The Big South has had a football squad nationally-ranked for 63 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 season (Oct. 24). In addition, the league has had two teams nationally-ranked at the same time for 13 consecutive weeks this year, as Coastal Carolina is No. 9 in the FCS Coaches poll and 10th in the STATS ranking, while Charleston Southern is No. 7 (FCS Coaches) and No. 9 (STATS) this week -- the fourth time this season two Big South teams were ranked in the Top 10 at the same time. The conference has had two teams nationally-ranked in the same week 36 times overall in league history -- including 31 times since the start of the 2013 campaign.

## ANOTHER BIG SOUTH FIRST -- TWO TOP 10 TEAMS

For the first time in Big South history, the league had two teams ranked in the Top 10 of the national polls during the week of Sept. 21. Coastal Carolina was No. 1 in the FCS Coaches poll and No. 2 in the STATS ranking, while Liberty was No. 10 in both the Coaches and STATS polls.

## HOME SWEET HOME

Coastal Carolina (6-0), Charleston Southern (5-0) and Liberty (5-0) are all undefeated at home this season. The Chants last finished unbeaten at home in 2013 (7-0), while the Flames' previous occurrence was in 2010 (5-0). The Bucs' last perfect home record was in 2008 (5-0). It is the first time three Big South members finished the regular-season undefeated at home, bettering the mark of two in 2009. The conference has had at least one member with an undefeated home record 12 times in its 14 seasons (2002-03-04-05-06-07-08-09-10-12-13-15).

## HENDERSON OWNS FCS RECORD FOR CONSECUTIVE GAMES WITH TOUCHDOWN

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** owns the FCS record for consecutive games with a touchdown at 25. He surpassed the previous mark of 20 that was held by Monmouth's **DAVID SINISI** from 2006-07 in Week 8 at Monmouth. Henderson has 38 TDs (35 rush, 3 receive) during his streak, and is two games away from tying the overall NCAA Division I record of 27 consecutive games (Virginia Tech's **LEE SUGGS** from Sept. 2, 2000 through Dec. 31, 2002). Henderson broke the Big South record of 18 consecutive games, which was established by Liberty's **ZACH TERRELL** from 2006-08.

## DOUBLE DIP

Coastal Carolina is looking to become the first Big South program to win 10 games in three consecutive seasons, as well as the first with four 10-win campaigns. No other Big South member has more than one. Charleston Southern is one victory shy of its second 10-win season in three years.

## PIRATES COVE

Charleston Southern is second nationally in total defense with 266.5 yards allowed per game, but has held its eight FCS opponents to 235.9 yards -- including 228.2 against Big South opponents. The Bucs became the first team in Big South history to hold three consecutive opponents to less than 200 yards of offense -- 112 to Monmouth in Week 6, 142 to PC in Week 7 and 110 to Gardner-Webb in Week 8. The Bucs have held seven of their 11 opponents below 300 offensive yards -- including a Big South record-tying five consecutive contests.

## CUP OF JOE

Coastal Carolina head coach **JOE MOGLIA** became the fastest Big South coach to win 40 games when he reached the total in his 51st game as Coastal's head coach -- a 46-0 win over Gardner-Webb in Week 10. The previous fastest was 55 games by former Liberty head coach **DANNY ROCCO**. Moglia is the fifth coach in Big South history to reach the 40-win plateau (41).

## TREASURE MAP

Charleston Southern set the Big South single-season record for most consecutive games holding a league foe to less than 10 points at three, as the Bucs held Monmouth and PC to seven points each and shutout Gardner-Webb in Week 8. CSU's effort matched the overall record of three, which was first set by Coastal Carolina in non-conference games in 2008 and 2014.

## OFFENSIVE JUGGERNAUTS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** is the Big South's all-time leader for total offense with 11,028 yards. In Week 11, he broke the mark of 10,571 yards that was held by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** from 2003-06. Liberty's **JOSH WOODRUM** supplanted Drafts for second-place all-time in the season-finale against the Chanticleers, ending his career with 10,690 yards. Ross and Woodrum have amassed nearly identical totals in their respective careers, as detailed below:

## BROWN NOT BAGGING IT

Charleston Southern redshirt-freshman LB **SOLOMON BROWN** is third in the Big South with 6.0 sacks and tied for seventh with 11.0 tackles-for-loss. Brown's sack total is the third-most by a freshman in league history -- just one shy of matching the mark of 7.0 set by Gardner-Webb's **PRESTON PEMASA** in 2010.

## THE LONE GRANGER

Coastal Carolina kicker **RYAN GRANGER** leads the Big South with 15 field goals, which ties the school record of 15 set by **ALEX CATRON** in 2014. Granger is 15-of-19 on field goals attempts (=78.9 percent) and is looking to become the third Big South kicker to make 80 percent of his field goal attempts in a season (based on a minimum 15 made).

## HIGH RATE OF RETURN

Coastal Carolina is 69-5 (=93.2 percent) when rushing for 200 yards in game, including 30-1 under head coach **JOE MOGLIA**. The Chanticleers have reached the 200-yard rushing plateau 58.5 percent of the time during Moglia's 53 games as head coach.

## MALCOLM IN THE MIDDLE

Charleston Southern DB **MALCOLM JACKSON** is second all-time in Big South history with 32 career pass break-ups, just three away from the record of 35 set by Coastal's **JOSH NORMAN** from 2008-11. Jackson owns 38 career passes defended, which is tied for second-most in the conference record book. That record is 48, shared by Norman and former Chanticleer **QUINTON TEAL** (2003-06).

## BALANCED ATTACK

Coastal Carolina is the only Big South member to average more than 200 rushing yards and 200 passing yards in the same season, as the Chanticleers have achieved the feat twice (2013 and 2014). Coastal is seeking its third consecutive 200/200 campaign, as CCU is averaging 192.2 rushing yards and 251.6 passing yards through 11 games this season.

## RECEIVING BACKS

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** is second all-time in Big South history for most receptions by a running back with 74, while Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** is third with 72. The record is 75 by Gardner-Webb's **DAVID MONTGOMERY** from 2006-09. Henderson became the Big South's career leader for receiving yards by a running back during Week 5, when he surpassed VMI's **SEAN MIZZER**'s (2003-06) then-record of 574. Henderson's record yardage total is 671. Chaney is fifth in league annals with 535.

## CAKE ROSS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** recorded his 15th career game with 300 yards of offense in the regular-season finale at Liberty as he amassed 339 yards against the Flames. He is tied for first in league annals for most games with 300 yards of offense, matching **MIKE BROWN**'s record of 15. Meanwhile, Ross is tied as the conference career record-holder for most rushing touchdowns by a QB with 19, matching Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS** (2002-05) and Brown (2008-11). Ross is third in Big South history for most rushing yards by a quarterback with 1,525. He needs 114 to unseat former Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** (1,638) for second.

## CAN'T FUMBLE THIS NOTE

Charleston Southern DE **ANTHONY ELLIS** returned a fumble 61 yards for a touchdown at Kennesaw State in Week 10. It was the league's sixth fumble return TD this season -- the second-most in conference annals. That record is eight, set just last season. Three different teams -- Kennesaw State (3), Charleston Southern (2) and Presbyterian -- had fumble return touchdowns in 2015.

## COASTAL IS FIRST TO WIN 100 GAMES AS BIG SOUTH MEMBERS...

Coastal Carolina won its 100th game in Week 5 against Alabama A&M, becoming the first program to win 100 games during the Big South's 14-year existence. The Chants' record total stands at 104. Liberty is second at 91 wins since 2002, followed by Charleston Southern (79) and Gardner-Webb (76).

## ...WHILE LIBERTY IS APPROACHING 50 BIG SOUTH VICTORIES

Liberty has won a league-high 49 Big South games during its time in the conference since the league started football in 2002. Coastal Carolina is second with 44 Big South wins, followed by Gardner-Webb (31) and Charleston Southern (30).

## LARENZO'S OIL

Charleston Southern DB **LARENZO MATHIS** recorded an 87-yard interception return touchdown against East Tennessee State in Week 3, the fifth-longest INT return in Big South history. It was the longest return in the league since Liberty's **KaJUAN LEE**'s 100-yard pick-6 against CSU in 2011.

## HENDERSON HOPPING THROUGH BIG SOUTH RECORD BOOK

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** is one of three players in Big South history with 3,000 career rushing yards (3,378) and 40 career rushing touchdowns (41). The other two are Big South all-time leading rusher **MIGUEL MAYSONET** (4,725 yards, 48 TD) and **RASHAD JENNINGS** (3,633 yards, 42 TD). Henderson, who became the fifth player with 3,000 rushing yards in Week 9 and fifth with 40 career TDs in Week 10, is fourth all-time in rushing yards and needs 31 to match Liberty's **DRE BARNES** for third-place at 3,409.

## IT'S ACADEMIC

The Big South had three players receive CoSIDA Academic All-District honors this season. Monmouth's **JOE JOHNSON** and Presbyterian College's **UGONNA AKOH** are repeat honorees, and were joined by Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS**. All three players advanced to the Academic All-America ballot.

## ROAD BLOCK

Charleston Southern ended Coastal Carolina's 10-game regular-season road win streak in Week 9, which included three Big South road victories. It was the Chanticleers' first regular-season road loss and conference road defeat since Nov. 9, 2013 -- also at the hands of the Buccaneers.

## MAN WITH A PURPOSE

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** has 4,049 career all-purpose yards, good for seventh all-time in league history. He is 107 yards away from surpassing **RASHAD JENNINGS** (4,155) for sixth. Henderson leads the league with 1,588 all-purpose yards and 144.4 per game, and is looking to become the third consecutive Chanticleer to lead the Big South in all-purpose yards. He was tops last season with 1,823, and could become just the third player to lead the conference in the category in consecutive seasons. Meanwhile, Henderson became the first running back in Big South history to have 100 receiving yards in a game with his 129 at Furman in Week 1.

## GONE IN 60 SECONDS

Coastal Carolina's **ALEX ROSS** and Liberty's **JOSH WOODRUM** are two of three players in Big South history to throw 60 career touchdown passes. Ross is second all-time with 69 career scoring strikes after becoming the Chanticleers' all-time leader during Week 2. Woodrum became the third member of the 60-TD pass club in the season-finale against Coastal and ends his career third with 61. Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** is the all-time leader with 73. Meanwhile, Ross is second all-time with 88 touchdowns responsible for (TDs scored and passed for), two away from Drafts' Big South-record of 90. Woodrum tallied 75 -- fourth all-time.

## BROWN'S RECORD HOUSE CALLS

Coastal Carolina KR **DEVIN BROWN** is the Big South's all-time leader for career kickoff return touchdowns with five, as he had two in the first three games of the season and three in a four-game span dating back to 2014. The NCAA FCS record for career kickoff return touchdowns is six. He became the Big South career leader in Week 1 with a 100-yard return at Furman -- just the third 100-yard kickoff return in league history.

## POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 122, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (56). In addition, Liberty is the Big South's record holder for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 66. Meanwhile, Liberty has scored a point in all 68 of its Big South games, the longest such streak in league annals. Of those 68 games, the last 56 have been in double digits. Charleston Southern's current streak of 42 conference games with a point is third-longest, just ahead of PC's active streak of 40 games.

## PASSING GRADES

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** ends his career as the Big South's all-time leader in passing yards with 10,266 -- the first player in league history over 10,000. He broke the record of 9,768 (Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** from 2003-06) in Week 10 against Presbyterian. Already the Big South's career record-holder for most 300-yard passing games with nine, Woodrum fell one completion shy of matching Drafts' Big South-record total of 833. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** is third all-time with 9,503 passing yards, and needs 265 yards to catch Drafts for second-place in league history. Ross is 497 yards shy from 10,000.

## GOLDEN GATE BRIDGES

Presbyterian College RB **DARRELL BRIDGES** finished second in the Big South with a career-high 1,065 rushing yards -- the most by a PC rusher in the school's Division I history and the first Blue Hose back with 1,000 rushing yards since PC became a Big South member in 2008. Bridges scored eight of PC's 17 touchdowns this season, which were the most by a Blue Hose player since **LANCE BYRD** had eight in 2011.

## BOSS ROSS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** tied the Big South single-game record with five touchdown passes against Kennesaw State in Week 11. He extended his Big South record for most games with at least three TD strikes to 11. Entering this season, Ross had shared the career mark of nine with Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** and Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS**.

## LUNSFORD OWNS FCS CAREER RECORD FOR MOST FIELD GOALS FROM 50+ YARDS

Liberty All-American kicker **JOHN LUNSFORD** is the all-time career leader in the Big South and FCS with 12 career field goals from 50 yards-or-longer following his record-breaking 57-yarder against Kennesaw State in Week 8. Lunsford was tied with Western Carolina's **KIRK ROACH** (1984-87) and Idaho State's **PETE GARCES** (1998-99) with 11 career field goals from 50-yards and beyond. Lunsford ended his career 12-of-19 from 50-plus yards ( =63.2 percent). Meanwhile, his 20 career FG from 40 yards-or-longer are a Big South record as well, and he became the fifth Big South placekicker with 40 career field goals when he reached the milestone in Week 4 during the Southern Illinois game. He concludes his career second all-time in league annals with 48 career field goals.

## TURF BUILDERS

Kennesaw State finished as the Big South leader with 293.0 rushing yards per game, the second-highest per game average in league history. The Owls rushed for 3,223 yards this season, the fifth-highest single-season total in Big South history. KSU tallied five 300-yard rushing games in its inaugural year; the conference record for most 300-yard rushing games is eight (VMI - 2008).

## DON OF A NEW DAY

Presbyterian College LB **DONELLE WILLIAMS** ends his career as the third Big South player with 400 career tackles, as he eclipsed the milestone in the season finale against Kennesaw State. Williams' 402 career stops rank third in league history. In addition, Williams is second all-time with 218 career solo tackles. His 112 tackles this season marked his second 100-tackle campaign.

## CHIM CHIMINY

Liberty DE **CHIMA UZOWIHE** ends his career as the Big South's all-time leader for quarterback sacks with a record total 25.0. He surpassed the previous mark of 20.5 (set by Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** from 2004-07) against Montana in Week 3. Uzowihe is third all-time in Big South history with 44.0 career TFL -- the third player over 40.

## EXCEPTIONAL ESTES

Gardner-Webb redshirt-junior TE **MIKE ESTES** had five touchdown receptions this season, a Big South single-season record for tight ends. He has eight in his career -- tying the conference record set by Liberty's **BRANDON APON** from 2010-13. Estes is also the Big South's all-time leader for receiving yards by a tight end with 1,039 -- the first with 1,000 career yards. He broke the old mark of 910 yards, held by Coastal Carolina's **DAVID DURAN**, in Week 9. Meanwhile, Estes is second all-time among Big South tight ends with 81 career receptions, and is nine away from matching the record of 90 set by former teammate **SETH CRANFILL** from 2010-14.

## THIS IS SARGENT PETERSON

Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** departs as the Big South's all-time leader with 3,170 career receiving yards. He surpassed the previous record of 2,720 (Coastal Carolina's **JEROME SIMPSON**) in Week 7. Peterson's 15 career 100-yard receiving games are also a conference record, and he ends his time in the Big South second all-time with 215 catches.

## CODE BLUE

Monmouth redshirt-freshman QB **CODY WILLIAMS** finished third in the Big South with 202.7 yards of offense -- becoming the first freshman QB in league history to average 200 yards of offense. Williams recorded a 71-yard rush at Fordham in Week 4, tied for the fourth-longest rush by a quarterback in Big South history. It was the longest by a signal-caller since 2011, when Presbyterian College QB **RYAN SINGER** scampered 74 yards for a TD at Liberty on Oct. 29.

## BIRDS OF PREY

Kennesaw State returned three fumbles for touchdowns this season, tying the Big South single-season record. The Owls joined Charleston Southern (2007), Stony Brook (2011), Liberty (2014) and Coastal Carolina (2014) as the only teams with three fumble return TDs in a season. KSU became the first Big South program to record a defensive TD in each of its first three games of a season. The Owls also were the first team in league annals to return two fumbles for touchdowns in a game during Week 2 against Edwards Waters.

## LIBERTY COLLECTS BIG SOUTH'S FIFTH-EVER FBS WIN

The Big South Conference notched its fifth-ever win over an FBS opponent with Liberty's 41-33 win at Georgia State in Week 5 -- marking the league's second consecutive season with an FBS victory and third in four years. It was also Liberty's second straight win over a Sun Belt foe. The Big South's five wins have all come since 2010, and the Flames now own three of those victories.

## BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL FIRST: 7-0 WEEK

The Big South Conference went 7-0 during Week 3 action, the first 7-0 week in league history and just the second time that every conference member won its respective non-league matchup in the same week -- which first occurred in Week 3 in 2014. Five of the Week 7 wins were against FCS foes, one more than the total in Week 3 in both 2013 and 2014.

## MOVING THE CHAINS

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** is the first running back in Big South history with three career touch-down passes, and the second overall non-quarterback with three TD strikes, joining former Liberty WR **ADRIAN HALL** (2002-03). Chaney had two last year during his sophomore campaign, and recorded his third career TD pass on a 64-yard TD connection with WR **UGO EZEMMA** at Wagner in Week 3.

## HENDERSON ADDED TO STATS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

Coastal Carolina RB **De'ANGELO HENDERSON** was added to the STATS National Offensive Player of the Year Watch List on Oct. 7, joining teammate **ALEX ROSS** and Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** as official candidates for the national honor. Henderson's addition gives the Big South three student-athletes on the offensive award Watch List for the first time.

## MAU, UZOWIHE NAMED CANDIDATES FOR NATIONAL DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR AWARD

For the second consecutive year, the Big South has multiple players among the candidates for the FCS National Defensive Player of the Year Award, as Gardner-Webb DL **O.J. MAU** and Liberty DL **CHIMA UZOWIHE** are on this year's watch list. The Big South had a record three candidates in 2014.

## COUNTING BENJAMINS

For the first time in league history, the Big South has four individual 100-yard rushing/100-yard passing performances in a single season. Gardner-Webb's **TYRELL MAXWELL** and Kennesaw State's **TREY WHITE** each have two such efforts this year -- tied for the most in a career.

## ATOP THE PERCH

With the exception of the first season of Big South football in 2002, Kennesaw State's six wins are tied for the most by a program in its first season in the Big South. The Owls clinched a winning season in their first year of existence, and join Coastal Carolina (2003), VMI (2003) and Monmouth (2014), who all won six games during their respective inaugural seasons in the Big South. When adding 2002 to the equation, Gardner-Webb had nine wins during the league's first year of football. KSU became the first newcomer to the league to win its first-ever conference game, as the Owls defeated Gardner-Webb, 12-7, in Week 7. When including 2002, KSU is just the second team on the list, as GWU won its debut Big South game.

## THOMPSON TWIN

Kennesaw State K **JUSTIN THOMPSON** tied the Big South single-game record with four field goals in Week 7 against Gardner-Webb. It was the second time this season Thompson made four field goals in a game (also vs. Shorter in Week 3), becoming just the third kicker in league history with multiple 4-field goal efforts. He attempted a Big South single-game record seven field goals in the Shorter game, breaking the previous record of five.

## TWO TREYS FOR TREY

Kennesaw State QB **TREY WHITE** is just the second quarterback in Big South history to record a 3-TD rush game and 3-TD pass game in the same season, joining Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN**, who achieved the feat in 2005. White rushed for three touchdowns against Edward Waters in Week 2 to become the first Big South quarterback with three rushing TDs in a game since VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2008. In Week 6 against Point, White threw three TD passes for the first time. He also is the first quarterback in Big South history to rush for three touchdowns in a game twice in the same season (Week 2 vs. Edwards Waters and Week 8 at Liberty).

## OWLS TAKE FLIGHT

Kennesaw State set the Big South single-game record for total offense with 699 yards in Week 6 against Point. The Owls bettered the old mark of 695 set by Charleston Southern against West Virginia Wesleyan on Oct. 15, 2005. KSU amassed 391 rushing yards and 308 passing yards against the Skyhawks, becoming just the second team in Big South history with 300 rushing and 300 passing yards in the same game. The first was Coastal Carolina in 2006 against Gardner-Webb (332 rush, 306 pass).
