PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - NOV. 23

CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - JOHN BROWN, HIGH POINT, F, R-Sr (JACKSONVILLE, FLA.)

Brown averaged 21.5 points, 9.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.5 steals while shooting 57.1 percent (16-of-28) from the field in a 2-0 week for High Point. He also converted 11-of-15 free throw attempts (=73.3) in the two games. On Wednesday in a 75-66 road win at CAA foe Drexel, Brown poured in a game-high 23 points (8-of-13 FG), while grabbing nine rebounds and two steals in 33 minutes on the floor. In Saturday's 75-69 home win over SoCon opponent Western Carolina, Brown once again led all players on the floor in points (20) and rebounds (9) while distributing a team-high three assists and making all four of his free throw attempts.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - DWAYNE SUTTON, UNC ASHEVILLE, G, Fr (LOUISVILLE, Ky.)

Sutton was Asheville's leading scorer in both contests last week, as he averaged 15.0 points with 9.5 rebounds while shooting 57.1 percent from the field (12-of-19). He scored a game-high 16 points and grabbed seven rebounds in the Bulldogs' victory over Mars Hill, then followed with a 14-point, 12-rebound performance at Texas A&M on Saturday for the game's only double-double.

SOARING TO NEW HEIGHTS

The Winthrop Eagles are 3-0 for the first time since 2009-10 and seeking their first 4-0 start since 2005-06. Winthrop posted 102 points in its season opener and followed that up with 106 points in the second game -- the first time in the history of the program that the Eagles scored 100 or more points in back-to-back games. In addition, the Eagles' 288 points through their first three games of the season is also a school record.

BIG UPS

High Point is 3-1 for the second consecutive season following its 2-0 week last week with wins over Drexel and Western Carolina. The win over the Catamounts pushed the Panthers to 21-2 in their past 23 home games (=91.3). In fact, High Point has a 23-7 (=76.7) record in the Millis Center since the start of the 2013-14 season. The Panthers have not lost a non-conference home game since a setback to James Madison on Dec. 14, 2014.

MY BLUE HEAVEN

With a 3-1 record, the Presbyterian College Blue Hose are off to the best start in their Division I history. The last time PC started this well was when the team opened the 2006-07 season 4-0. Meanwhile, PC's 74-73 win over USC Upstate last week was just the eighth one-point game since PC moved to Division I in 2007 -- nearly 250 games in that span.

HUMP DAY

Through three games, Campbell stands second in the nation in steals (13.3 per game) and eighth in scoring defense (53.3). The Camels also lead the Big South in defensive field goal percentage (.338). Meanwhile, CU's two losses this season have come by a total of seven points.

CHRIS-CROSS

Campbell freshman **CHRIS CLEMONS** leads the team in scoring with 15.3 points, ranking 7th in the Big South and the top scorer among all league freshmen. He also tops the conference in steals (3.0), a total that is 20th in the nation, while his 3-point field goal percentage of 60.0 is 18th nationally. Clemons tallied six steals this past Saturday against Morgan State, just one shy of the Gore Arena record. He has scored in double figures in all three of his collegiate games.

ADJUSTING TO THE TIMES

UNC Asheville's trip out to Anchorage for the Great Alaska Shootout this week will take some getting used to as far as the time differences. Not since the 1996-97 season has the Bulldogs played a game in the western-third of the United States. Asheville traveled to New Mexico State early in that 1996-97 season, coming away with a 65-64 victory. Asheville's last game in the Pacific Time Zone was a 58-53 victory over California in the 1987-88 season. UNC Asheville has never played in Alaska.

BAGGAGE CLAIM

By the time Charleston Southern arrived back to Charleston this past Saturday, the Buccaneers had flown approximately 7,670 miles in nine days to start the year. Over that time, CSU played three teams (Wichita State, Stanford and Arkansas) that combined for 81 wins, 2 NCAA Tournament berths and an NIT title last season. CSU will play four of its next six games in the friendly confines of the Buc Dome.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

High Point's **JOHN BROWN** is 17th all-time in Big South history with 1,759 career points, and is 241 points away from becoming the ninth player in league history with 2,000 career points. Meanwhile, below is a look at the which players are closing in on the 1,000-point milestone:

MID-MAJOR MANIA

Radford was ranked No. 25 in the Nov. 16 Collegeinsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 ranking, the second consecutive season a Big South member has appeared in the poll. Three teams received Top 25 consideration this week -- Radford, Winthrop and High Point. Below is a look at where the Big South has stood this season thus far:

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is the third-active winningest coach in Division I with 772 career victories. Ellis, who is six wins shy of 700 Division I wins, is 19th all-time in NCAA history for career wins (regardless of affiliation with a minimum 10 head coaching seasons at NCAA schools), and is the seventh-active winningest coach across all NCAA classifications. He became the first head coach in NCAA history with 150 wins at four different Division I programs with the Chanticleers' 68-56 victory over UNC Asheville on Feb. 3, 2015. His Division I school-by-school breakdown is as follows: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 160, in addition to 78 wins during his three seasons leading Cumberland College from 1972-75.

BADOU'S BOARDS

Coastal Carolina's **BADOU DIAGNE** became the 50th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone against Grace Bible College on Nov. 18. He has an outside chance of joining the league's 1,000-point, 600-rebound and 100-blocked shot club, as his career totals include 793 points and 74 blocked shots. Meanwhile, teammate **MICHEL ENANGA** became the 78th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he reached the total against Piedmont International this past Saturday.

RADFORD GETS BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG WIN OF THE SEASON

Radford won its season opener at Georgetown, 82-80 in double-overtime to post the Big South's fourth win over a BIG EAST member in the past five seasons (since 2011-12). **RASHUN DAVIS** hit the game-winning pull-up three-pointer with 1.5 seconds remaining in the second extra session to cap a career-high 28-point performance. The victory was the Highlanders' first in a true road season opener since 1987, ending a string of 11 defeats.

HIGH POINT'S JOHN BROWN VOTED 2015-16 PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

For the third consecutive year, High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** has been voted the Big South Conference Men's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's head coaches and media panel. He is the first men's player in Big South history to be named Preseason Player of the Year in three consecutive seasons. Named to the Lou Henson Preseason Player of the Year Watch List, Brown is one of 20 initial preseason candidates for the Julius Erving Award, which is given annually to the top small forward in men's college basketball. He is the only player from a mid-major program on the watch list. Brown is looking to become just the second player in Big South history with **FOUR** First-Team All-Conference selections.

BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-junior **JOHN BROWN** is the third player in Big South history with 1,700 points (1,759), 600 rebounds (632), 100 blocked shots (126), 100 steals (140) and 100 assists (127). He will likely become just the second player with 2,000 points, 800 rebounds, 150 steals, 100 blocked shots and 100 assists by the end of the 2015-16 campaign. VMI's **STAN OKOYE** is the only Big South player with those benchmarks.

HIGH TOPS

Radford senior **RASHUN DAVIS** is the Big South's active career assist leader with 338, and is 62 away from becoming the 26th member of the league's 400-assist club. He is approaching 1,000 career points as well (58 away), and is poised to be the 21st player in conference annals with 1,000 points and 400 assists. Meanwhile, teammate **BRANDON HOLCOMB** has 427 rebounds and should become the just the 24th player in the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club. Holcomb is 28th all-time in league history with 119 career blocked shots.

FIELD AND STREAM

High Point's **JOHN BROWN** is eighth in Big South history with 675 career field goals. He is 25 away from becoming the eighth player in league annals with 700, and needs 101 to crack the all-time top five. Brown is also 14th in conference history with 409 career free throws made.
