## PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - NOV. 30

### CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - JIMMY GAVIN, WINTHROP, G, R-Sr (ARLINGTON HEIGHTS, ILL.)

Gavin averaged 30.0 points, 3.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.0 steals in two games last week. He opened the week with 22 points, four rebounds and a team-high four assists in Winthrop's win at USC Upstate. Gavin scored 16 points in the second half and made 9-of-11 free throws to give the Eagles their first 4-0 start since 2005-06. At N.C. State on Friday, Gavin dropped in 38 points in 36 minutes -- the third-highest point total in PNC Arena history. He tallied 22 points in the second half, went 7-of-12 from three-point range and 11-of-12 from the charity stripe.

### THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - CHRIS CLEMONS, CAMPBELL, G, Fr (RALEIGH, N.C.)

Clemons averaged 21.0 points and 4.5 rebounds in leading the Camels to a pair of wins last week. He scored a career-high 26 points in Campbell's 77-74 win at SIU-Edwardsville. He was 8-of-14 from the floor, 4-of-8 from three-point land and made all six of his free throws. Clemons followed with 16 points in the Camels' 79-73 Big South-opening win over Coastal Carolina on Saturday. His three-pointer with 4:23 to play gave Campbell the lead for good at 67-64.

## TIS THE SEASON -- CONFERENCE SEASON

For the first time since 2011-12, conference games will be played prior to Christmas. The first league game of the 2015-16 campaign was actually this past Saturday--just the second time in Big South history that the conference season began in November. Campbell sits alone at the top of the standings at 1-0 following its 79-73 home win over Coastal Carolina. The remaining league slate begins this week.

## MARGINAL NOTE

As Big South play begins in earnest this week, a quick refresher on last year's league season is in order. In 2014-15, the home teams went 59-40 (.59.6 percent) in league games, while 49 of the 99 games (49.5 percent) were decided by 10 points or less (5.29 average). The overall average margin of victory in the 2014-15 league season was 10.76 points. The margin in 2013-14 was 9.83.

## RADFORD GETS BIG SOUTH'S FIRST TWO BIG WINS OF THE SEASON

Radford defeated Penn State last week, 86-74 in State College, Pa., 12 days after the Highlanders downed Georgetown in double-overtime, 82-80, in its season opener. The win over the Nittany Lions marks the second straight year the Big South has defeated a Big Ten member, while the victory over the Hoyas was the league's fourth win over a BIG EAST member in the past five seasons (since 2011-12). The last time the Big South had wins over both the BIG EAST and Big Ten in the same year was 2010-11.

## DAILY DOUBLE

Radford's wins over two Power 5 conferences marks the fourth time in the last six seasons that a Big South member has achieved this feat. Last season, it was Gardner-Webb (Clemson, Purdue), and prior to that, it was Coastal Carolina (LSU, Clemson in 2011-12) and Presbyterian (Auburn, Wake Forest in 2010-11).

## DUBY-DUBY-DO

Winthrop redshirt-sophomore **DUBY OKEKE** leads the Big South with 3.40 blocked shots per game. He has recorded multiple blocks in each game, including two games with four and one with five. The last (and only) Winthrop player to lead the Big South in blocked shots was **JOSH GRANT** in 2002-03 (2.28). Meanwhile, Okeke's career total stands at 63, and is 37 away from becoming the first Winthrop player with 100 career blocked shots since **BILLY HOUSTON** eclipsed the mark during the 2004-05 campaign. Just three Eagles reside in the Big South's 100-blocked shot club: Houston (139 from 2002-06), Grant (125 from 2001-04) and **TYRONE WALKER** (105 from 2000-04).

## CHRIS-CROSS

Campbell freshman **CHRIS CLEMONS** leads the team in scoring with 17.6 points, ranking 4th in the Big South and the top scorer among all league freshmen. He also tops the conference in three-point shooting (54.8 percent) and is tied for the conference lead in steals per game (2.0). The last freshman to lead the Big South in three-point percentage was Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2004-05 at 42.5 percent. Clemons is averaging 3.40 three-pointers per game, which is pacing ahead of the Big South freshman record of 3.31 (UNC Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** in 2013-14).

## BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Coastal Carolina junior **ELIJAH WILSON** became the 136th member of the Big South's 1,000-point club when he eclipsed the milestone this past Saturday at Campbell. The Big South now has two active 1,000-point scorers, as High Point's **JOHN BROWN** sits in 15th-place in league annals with 1,800 career points. He is 200 away from becoming the ninth player in league history with 2,000 in a career. Below is a look at where Brown and Wilson rank among the all-time leaders, as well as the next players closing in on the 1,000-point milestone:

## ESPNU GOING WILD FOR THE BIG SOUTH

For the third consecutive season, four regular-season Big South games will appear on ESPNU in 2015-16. The 24-hour college sports network will televise one January game and three February contests, which will be "Wildcard" selections 21 days in advance. Those four telecasts will be Thursday, Jan. 14 at 7:00pm; Thursday, Feb. 11 at 9:00pm; Thursday, Feb. 18 at 7:00pm, and Thursday, Feb. 25 at 9:00pm.

## CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is the third-active winningest coach in Division I with 773 career victories. Ellis, who is five wins shy of 700 Division I wins, is 19th all-time in NCAA history for career wins (regardless of affiliation with a minimum 10 head coaching seasons at NCAA schools), and is the seventh-active winningest coach across all NCAA classifications. He became the first head coach in NCAA history with 150 wins at four different Division I programs with the Chanticleers' 68-56 victory over UNC Asheville on Feb. 3, 2015. His Division I school-by-school breakdown is as follows: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 161, in addition to 78 wins during his three seasons leading Cumberland College from 1972-75.

## BADOU'S BOARDS

Coastal Carolina's **BADOU DIAGNE** became the 50th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone against Grace Bible College on Nov. 18. He has an outside chance of joining the league's 1,000-point, 600-rebound and 100-blocked shot club, as his career totals include 817 points and 76 blocked shots. Meanwhile, teammate **MICHEL ENANGA** became the 78th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he reached the total against Piedmont International on Nov. 21.

## BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-junior **JOHN BROWN** is the second player in Big South history with 1,800 points (1,800), 600 rebounds (645), 100 blocked shots (133), 100 steals (144) and 100 assists (130). He will likely become just the second player with 2,000 points, 800 rebounds, 150 steals, 100 blocked shots and 100 assists by the end of the 2015-16 campaign. VMI's **STAN OKOYE** is the only Big South player with those benchmarks.

## HIGH TOPS

Radford senior **RASHUN DAVIS** is the Big South's active career assist leader with 347, and is 53 away from becoming the 26th member of the league's 400-assist club. He is approaching 1,000 career points as well (40 away), and is poised to be the 21st player in conference annals with 1,000 points and 400 assists. Meanwhile, teammate **BRANDON HOLCOMB** has 438 rebounds and should become the just the 24th player in the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club. Holcomb is tied for 27th all-time in league history with 122 career blocked shots.

## FIELD AND STREAM

High Point's **JOHN BROWN** is eighth in Big South history with 690 career field goals. He is 10 away from becoming the eighth player in league annals with 700, and needs 86 to crack the all-time top five. Brown is also tied for 13th in conference history with 420 career free throws made.

## HIGH POINT'S JOHN BROWN VOTED 2015-16 PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

For the third consecutive year, High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** has been voted the Big South Conference Men's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's head coaches and media panel. He is the first men's player in Big South history to be named Preseason Player of the Year in three consecutive seasons. Named to the Lou Henson Preseason Player of the Year Watch List, Brown is one of 20 initial preseason candidates for the Julius Erving Award, which is given annually to the top small forward in men's college basketball. He is the only player from a mid-major program on the watch list. Brown is looking to become just the second player in Big South history with **FOUR** First-Team All-Conference selections.

## MID-MAJOR MANIA

Radford was ranked No. 25 in the Nov. 16 Collegeinsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 ranking, the second consecutive season a Big South member has appeared in the poll. Three teams received Top 25 consideration last week -- Radford, Winthrop and High Point. Below is a look at where the Big South has stood this season thus far:

## CAMPBELL

Campbell held Southern Illinois-Edwardsville to only one field goal over the final seven minutes of play as the Camels defeated the host Cougars, 77-74. In a game that featured 13 lead changes and 11 ties, freshman **CHRIS CLEMONS** scored a career-high 26 points and grabbed 6 rebounds for the Camels, who used a late 15-2 run to take the lead and held a taller SIUE squad to just 35 percent shooting in the final period ... CU won its league opener for the seventh-straight year by knocking off Coastal, 79-73, at Gore Arena. **D.J. MASON** led four Camels in double figures with a season-high 17 points and grabbed a career-best 14 rebounds.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU shot a season-best of 53 percent overall, and 58 percent (11-of-19) from three-point range in its win over ETSU on Tuesday ... **RAE ROBINSON** tallied his third consecutive double-digit scoring effort with 14 points against ETSU. He added a team-high six rebounds as CSU outrebounded a Division I opponent for the first time this year ... **JAVIS HOWARD** scored 13 points on an efficient 6-of-9 shooting against ETSU, a career-high against Division I foes ... CSU last dipped into conference play in the first week of December in 2011-12. The Bucs went 2-0.

## COASTAL CAROLINA

The Chanticleers' 67-61 win at College of Charleston marked the first win against the Cougars in Charleston since January 1977 ... **ELIJAH WILSON**'s 3-pointer at the 17:16 mark of the second half against Campbell gave him 1,000 career points. He is the 20th Chanticleer to reach the career milestone and the sixth to do so under the tutelage of head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** ... **SHIVAUGHN WIGGINS** produced his finest game as a Chanticleer as he finished with a CCU career-high 24 points to go along with seven assists and no turnovers at Campbell.

## GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb picked up its first Division I win of the season on Friday, holding on for a 77-68 win over Southeastern Louisiana behind a career-high 21 points from **ISAIAH IVEY** ... The Runnin' Bulldogs rallied from a 25-point first-half deficit against Army and forced overtime on a buzzer-beating three by **DYLAN POSTON** ... **HAROLD McBRIDE** has scored in double figures in all but one game, including a career-high 31 points at Army ... The Runnin' Bulldogs have hit 67 three pointers through seven games -- 12 more than at this point last season ... **TYRELL NELSON** is now 10th on the program's Division I list with 864 career points.

## HIGH POINT

**JOHN BROWN** averaged 20.5 points, 6.5 rebounds, 3.5 blocks and 2.0 steals while shooting 60 percent (15-25) from the field in two games for the Panthers last week. In Saturday's game vs. Morgan State, Brown put up arguably the best stat line of his career. He poured in a season-high 30 points on 10-of-14 shooting (=71.4) while adding game highs of nine rebounds and five blocks. Brown also tallied three steals and three assists while making 10-of-12 (=83.3) free throws.

## LIBERTY

Liberty dropped three games in the Challenge in Music City. **EVAN MAXWELL** was named to the Challenge in Music City All-Tournament Team after averaging 8.7 points and 4.3 rebounds during the three-game stretch ... In Liberty's game against Western Michigan, **CALEB HOMESLEY** scored a career-high 11 points with a trio of three-pointers in a 58-second span before the game's first media timeout ... Freshman 6-3 guard **LOVELL CABBIL** leads the Flames with four blocked shots ... On Thursday, the Flames look for their first win inside Radford's Dedmon Center since a 73-56 victory on March 2, 2013.

## LONGWOOD

**LERON FISHER** averaged 16.5 points, 5.5 assists, 5.5 rebounds and 1.0 steals per game in road games at Maine and Columbia last week. Making his first two starts of the season at point guard in place of injured starter **TRAV'VAUGHN WHITE**, Fisher scored in double figures in both games, including an 18-point, eight-assist effort at Columbia ... Freshman **CHRIS SHIELDS** averaged 13.5 points and 5.0 rebounds per game last week and hit the game-winning layup with six seconds left to propel the Lancers to a 70-69 comeback win at Columbia. He scored a career-high 19 points off the bench at Maine Tuesday.

## PRESBYTERIAN

PC's 76.2 scoring average is pacing as the highest in the school's Division I history, 11 points higher than the record of 65.4 in 2013-14 ... The Blue Hose's 47.9 field goal percentage is also ahead of the program Div. I record of 46.4 in 2014-15 ... Presbyterian's 37.2 rebounds per game is ahead of the current mark of 32.7 set in 2008-09 ... On tap for PC is its Big South opener with Gardner-Webb slated for Wednesday. GWU leads the overall series, 21-20, and has won the last four, including an 81-64 decision Dec. 31, 2014, in Boiling Springs, N.C.

## RADFORD

Radford won at Penn State last week for the program's first-ever victory over a Big Ten opponent. The Highlanders are now 4-1 in their last five games against Power 5 conference teams dating back to the 2013-14 campaign. RU owns victories over the ACC (Virginia Tech), Big Ten (Penn State), Big East (Georgetown) and Pac-12 (Oregon State) ... **RASHUN DAVIS** leads the Big South with 6.5 assists per game and is seventh in scoring at 15.2 per contest ... Freshman **ED POLITE, JR.** has scored in double figures in four straight games, while fellow frosh **DARIUS BOLSTAD** has made 12 of his 13 field goal attempts (=92.3 percent).

## UNC ASHEVILLE

Asheville's third-place finish in the Great Alaska Shootout was its highest in recent seasons, with the previous recent best a seventh-place finish in the 2011 Battle 4 Atlantis ... The Great Alaska Shootout was just the third time in the last 17 seasons that Asheville has played games on three consecutive dates ... Asheville scored 124 of its 205 total points in Alaska (60 percent) in the final 20 minutes of its three contests ... The Bulldogs' trip to Alaska spanned 10 days (Nov. 20-29), included airports in five states (North Carolina, Illinois, Texas, Colorado, Alaska), four games (at Texas A&M; vs. Drexel, Middle Tennessee and Loyola-Chicago in Alaska) and a final total of 10,935 miles traveled.

## WINTHROP

The Eagles started the season 4-0 for the first time since 2005-06 ... The loss at N.C. State on Nov. 27 ended the Eagles' 7-game winning streak over non-conference opponents ... Winthrop has opened the season 3-0 at home and has now won nine straight at the Winthrop Coliseum ... **KEON JOHNSON** scored 32 points in the win at USC Upstate and then the next game, **JIMMY GAVIN** posted 38 points in the loss at N.C. State. Gavin's 38 is tied for the 6th-highest point total in a single-game in the program's history and the 3rd-highest total in the history of PNC Arena.

## 2015-16 PRESEASON POLL
