PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - DEC. 7

CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - KEON JOHNSON, WINTHROP, G, JR (MANSFIELD, OHIO)

Johnson averaged 22.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists in leading the Eagles to a 2-0 Big South start. He opened the week scoring 18 of his game-high 27 points in the second half of a one-point win at Charleston Southern -- including Win throp's final 12 points. In Saturday's win over Presbyterian, Johnson led the squad with 18 points, including 10 in the second half, with six rebounds. For the week, Johnson was 12-of-17 from the field (=70.6 percent), 5-of-6 from beyond the arc (=83.3) and made 16-of-20 free throw attempts (=80.0).

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - ARMEL POTTER, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, G, FR (MARIETTA, GA.)

Potter poured in back-to-back 18-point efforts in his first two Big South games. He had two three-point plays in the final minute to nearly lift CSU past Winthrop, scored 13 of his 18 points after halftime and finished with four assists and no turnovers. Saturday at Liberty, Potter led the Bucs in scoring and tallied four rebounds and four assists in the crucial road victory. He notched 12 of his 18 markers after halftime, and hit consecutive jumpers during CSU's 10-1 run to start the second half.

OPENING TIP

Winthrop and High Point are 2-0 after the first wave of Big South games, and Campbell will look to join the duo this coming Sunday. When league games resume Dec. 31, Winthrop and High Point will seek 3-0 Big South starts for the first time since 2006-07. That season, the Eagles ran the table with a 14-0 mark, while the Panthers started league play 6-0. HPU's first Big South loss that year? Winthrop.

MARGINAL NOTE

Through nine Big South games, the home teams are 6-3 (=66.7 percent), but have won the six games by an average of just 7.5 points. Seven of the nine contests have been decided by less than 10 points (4.14 average), while the overal margin of victory thus far is 7.11 points. The 2014-15 margin was 10.76, compared to 9.83 in 2013-14.

RADFORD DUO DAVIS, ANDERSON ON CUSP OF FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE 1,000-POINT SCORERS

Radford senior guards **RASHUN DAVIS** and **YAYA ANDERSON** are on the cusp of becoming the 20th pair of four-year classmates to score 1,000 points during the same four-year period. Davis surpassed the milestone this past Sunday at Coastal Carolina and stands at 1,002 for his career. Anderson is one point away from the benchmark.

DUBY-DUBY-DO

Winthrop redshirt-sophomore **DUBY OKEKE** leads the Big South with 3.57 blocked shots per game. He has recorded multiple blocks in each game, including two games with four and two with five. The last (and only) Winthrop player to lead the Big South in blocked shots was **JOSH GRANT** in 2002-03 (2.28). Meanwhile, Okeke's career total stands at 71, and is 29 away from becoming the first Winthrop player with 100 career blocked shots since **BILLY HOUSTON** eclipsed the mark during the 2004-05 campaign. Just three Eagles reside in the Big South's 100-blocked shot club: Houston (139 from 2002-06), Grant (125 from 2001-04) and **TYRONE WALKER** (105 from 2000-04).

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

As mentioned above, Radford senior **RASHUN DAVIS** became the 137th member of the Big South's 1,000-point club when he eclipsed the milestone this past Sunday at Coastal Carolina. The Big South now has three active 1,000-point scorers, as High Point's **JOHN BROWN** sits in 15th-place in league annals with 1,834 career points. He is 166 away from becoming the ninth player in league history with 2,000 in a career. Coastal's **ELIJAH WILSON** (1,037) is the other active 1,000-point scorer. Below is a look at where all three rank among the all-time leaders, as well as the next players closing in on the 1,000-point milestone:

TAKING FLIGHT

Winthrop leads the Big South with 86.1 points per game, the highest scoring average in the league in two seasons and the only member thus far scoring at least 80 points a contest. The Eagles have led the Big South in scoring average twice, with the last time coming in 1992-93 (83.6 average). The first time was in the conference's first year of men's basketball in 1985-86. That season Winthrop was tops with 79.8 points per game.

MAD MAX

Liberty's **EVAN MAXWELL** leads the Big South and is fourth in the NCAA with a 71.6 field goal percentage, as he is 53-of-74 from the floor through nine games. He is pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of 69.6 percent, which was established by UNC Asheville's **KENNY GEORGE** when he led the nation in the category in 2007-08.

BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-junior **JOHN BROWN** is the second player in Big South history with 1,800 points (1,834), 600 rebounds (662), 100 blocked shots (135), 100 steals (144) and 100 assists (137). He will likely become just the second player with 2,000 points, 800 rebounds, 150 steals, 100 blocked shots and 100 assists by the end of the 2015-16 campaign. VMI's **STAN OKOYE** is the only Big South player with those benchmarks.

GOOD WORK YOUNG MEN

A league-record three men's basketball players are official nominees for the Allstate NABC Good Works Team®, as High Point's **JOHN BROWN**, Longwood's **KANAYO OBI-RAPU** and Presbyterian's **WILL ADAMS** are among the 154 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA. The list will be pared down to a 10-person team featuring five Division I student-athletes in February.

RADFORD GETS BIG SOUTH'S FIRST TWO BIG WINS OF THE SEASON

Radford defeated Penn State, 86-74 in State College, Pa., on Nov. 26, 12 days after the Highlanders downed Georgetown in double-overtime, 82-80, in its season opener. The win over the Nittany Lions marks the second straight year the Big South has defeated a Big Ten member, while the victory over the Hoyas was the league's fourth win over a BIG EAST member in the past five seasons. The last time the Big South had wins over both the BIG EAST and Big Ten in the same year was 2011-12.

DATLY DOUBLE

Radford's wins over two Power 5 conferences marks the fourth time in the last six seasons that a Big South member has achieved this feat. Last season, it was Gardner-Webb (Clemson, Purdue), and prior to that, it was Coastal Carolina (LSU, Clemson in 2011-12) and Presbyterian (Auburn, Wake Forest in 2010-11).

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach CLIFF ELLIS is the third-active winningest coach in Division I with 774 career victories. Ellis, who is four wins shy of 700 Division I wins, is 19th all-time in NCAA history for career wins (regardless of affiliation with a minimum 10 head coaching seasons at NCAA schools), and is the sixth-active winningest coach across all NCAA classifications. He became the first head coach in NCAA history with 150 wins at four different Division I programs with the Chanticleers' 68-56 victory over UNC Asheville on Feb. 3, 2015. His Division I school-by-school breakdown is as follows: South Alabama -171, Clemson -177, Auburn -186, Coastal Carolina -162, in addition to 78 wins during his three seasons leading Cumberland College from 1972-75.

BADOU'S BOARDS

Coastal Carolina's **BADOU DIAGNE** became the 50th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone against Grace Bible College on Nov. 18. He has an outside chance of joining the league's 1,000-point, 600-rebound and 100-blocked shot club, as his career totals include 834 points and 79 blocked shots. Meanwhile, teammate **MICHEL ENANGA** became the 78th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he reached the total against Piedmont International on Nov. 21, and is currently 77th all-time with 520.

HTGH TOPS

Radford senior **RASHUN DAVIS** is the Big South's active career assist leader with 358, and is 42 away from becoming the 26th member of the league's 400-assist club. He surpassed 1,000 career points this past weekend, and is poised to be the 21st player in conference annals with 1,000 points and 400 assists. Meanwhile, teammate **BRANDON HOLCOMB** has 450 rebounds and should become the just the 24th player in the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club. Holcomb is 27th all-time in league history with 123 career blocked shots.

FIELD AND STREAM

High Point's **JOHN BROWN** is eighth in Big South history with 703 career field goals, and needs 73 to crack the all-time top five. Brown is also 13th in conference history with 428 career free throws made.

MID-MAJOR MANIA

Radford was ranked No. 25 in the Nov. 16 Collegeinsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 ranking, the second consecutive season a Big South member has appeared in the poll. Three teams received Top 25 consideration last week -- Radford, Winthrop and High Point. Below is a look at where the Big South has stood this season thus far:

CAMPBELL

The Camels extended their winning streak to 3 games with a 66-65 comeback win over VMI at Gore Arena. **CHRIS CLEM-ONS**' 3-pointer with 3 seconds left capped a rally from an 18-point second-half deficit. CU's rally from 18 down to win marked the program's greatest reversal since Feb. 28, 1983 ... **D.J. MASON** is averaging 16.5 points and 13.5 rebounds in his last two games ... Campbell's victory over VMI marked the third-straight game that CU trailed by as many as 8 in the second half before rallying to win ... CU set a school Gore Arena record for fewest turnovers (5) against VMI.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU went 26-for-68 (=38.2%) from three-point range last week ... The Bucs have hit 11 or more threes in five of their last six games ... Charleston Southern has three players averaging multiple 3FG per game while shooting 42 percent or better from downtown: RAE ROBINSON (2.4 per - 54.3%), ARMEL POTTER (2.1 per - 42.1%) and PATRICK WALLACE (3.6 per - 42%) ... Potter has scored 18 points in four consecutive games. He is averaging 17.7 points per game since scoring just five in the Bucs' loss at Stanford.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal enters the fall examination period 4-4 overall and 1-1 in Big South play ... ELIJAH WILSON led Coastal's comeback attempt from 18 down against Auburn, scoring 15 of his game-high 25 points after halftime. The official game attendance against Auburn was an arena capacity crowd of 3,286, matching the building record originally established on Dec. 12, 2012 against Clemson ... In the win over Radford, Coastal was co-led by JAYLEN SHAW and MARCUS FREEMAN's 12 points each off the bench. Also in double-figures for the Chants were BADOU DIAGNE and COLTON RAY-ST CYR with 10.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs opened Big South play with an 87-76 win at Presbyterian before falling by two points to High Point. GWU knocked down 12-of-22 three-pointers in the PC contest, its second-highest total of the season ... Gardner-Webb nearly rallied from a 16-point deficit with an inspired second-half comeback against HPU ... TYRELL NELSON posted his third double-double of the season with game-highs of 20 points and 11 rebounds against the Panthers. HAROLD MC-BRIDE nearly added a triple-double with 17 points, eight rebounds and six assists against no turnovers.

HIGH POINT

High Point is 2-0 in Big South play for the first time since 2010-11... ANTHONY LINDAUER (16 pts, 6-9 FG) and JOHN BROWN (16 pts, 8 reb) led HPU in scoring at Gardner-Webb. The Purple 6 White limited Gardner-Webb to 36.5 percent shooting for the game ... In the 90-66 win over Longwood, HPU led by as many as 30 points and led for 39:08 of a possible 40 minutes of the game. Brown tallied a career-high seven assists to go along with 18 points and nine rebounds against the Lancers. The Panthers shot a season-best 57.9 percent (11-19) from 3-point range in the Longwood win.

LIBERTY

EVAN MAXWELL is currently fourth in the nation in field goal percentage (71.4). Maxwell went 7-of-9 from the field on Saturday vs. CSU, finishing with 14 points. He also finished with a career-high 24 points at Radford this past Thursday ... **A.C. REID** led Liberty with a career-high 20 points, scoring 18 in the opening period, against the Buccaneers ... The Flames posted their second-highest point total in the paint this season, outscoring the Bucs down low, 40-10. Liberty also capitalized on second chance points, 12-4.

LONGWOOD

LOTANNA NWOGBO averaged 15.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game last week, including a 19-point, 10-rebound double-double against Big South preseason favorite High Point Wednesday. Nwogbo scored in double figures in both games, adding 11 points against UMBC despite playing just 22 minutes ... Freshman **CHRIS SHIELDS** averaged 9.0 points, 2.5 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game last week. He came off the bench against HPU to hit 4-of-5 shots from the field and 2-of-3 three-pointers en route to 11 points.

PRESBYTERIAN

DeSEAN MURRAY is 19th in the nation in FG percentage (63.3), 18th in total points (169), 8th in free throws made (55), 9th in free throw attempts (71) and 27th in points per game (21.1) ... PC has played three road games so far this season and is 0-3. The Blue Hose went 3-14 on the road last year, the last win a 69-65 decision at UNC Asheville Feb. 12, 2015 ... The Liberty win Jan. 3, 2015 actually marked the first road win since Dec. 3, 2013, when PC took down Southern Conference foe UNCG, 87-66 ... The three road wins last season were the most since the team went 7-7 in 2011-12.

RADFORD

Radford went 1-2 in three games last week, including a split of its first two conference games — with a home win over Liberty and a loss at Coastal Carolina ... **RASHUN DAVIS** became the 28th member of RU's 1,000-point club on Sunday against Coastal and now has 1,002 for his career. **YAYA ANDERSON** is set to join him, as he sits at 999 heading into Wednesday night's home game against Virginia Tech. Anderson will be the fourth Highlander to reach the milestone in the last three years ... Radford hosts Virginia Tech for the first time, looking to add to its recent victories over major conference foes.

UNC ASHEVILLE

Asheville scored 100 points in a game for the first time since Feb. 26, 2014 (107-100 OT loss at Winthrop). The last time the Bulldogs hit 100 points in a win was just prior to the WU game, a 100-85 victory over Coastal Carolina on Feb. 22, 2014 ... Asheville opened up the season with six of its first seven games on the road due to the Great Alaska Shootout, but the Bulldogs will catch up on their time in front of the home fans in December, as five of their seven games are inside Kimmel Arena. The Bulldogs are 46-14 all-time at in the 5-year old facility, including 32-8 against Big South opponents.

WINTHROP

The Eagles' 6-1 start is their best since 1989-90, which is also the last time the Eagles started 7-1. The best start in school history is 8-1, accomplished in 1978-79, 1980-81 and 1989-90 ... Winthrop has won 10 straight home games and seven straight at home against Big South opponents ... If **DUBY OKEKE** (3.57 blocks per game) maintains even a 3.0 bpg average, he will break the school record for blocks in a season of 66 set by **JOSH GRANT** in 2002-03 ... The Eagles started league play 2-0 for the second time in the past three seasons.
