PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - DEC. 14

CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - JOHN BROWN, HIGH POINT, F, R-Sr (JACKSONVILLE, FLA.)

Brown averaged 26.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, 2.0 steals, 1.5 blocks and 1.5 assists in two wins last week. In Wednesday's 90-72 win over UNC Greensboro, he poured in 24 points and grabbed 11 rebounds for his first double-double of the season. Brown also had a team-high three assists with two blocks and two steals against the Spartans. One Sunday against Virginia-Wise, Brown scored 28 points in 22 minutes. For the week, he was 21-of-30 from the field (=70.0 percent) and 10-of-16 from the free throw line.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - DWAYNE SUTTON, UNC ASHEVILLE, G, Fr (LOUISVILLE, Ky.)

Sutton led Asheville with an 18-point effort in Sunday's Big South-opening win over Campbell. He was 8-of-12 from the floor and 2-of-3 from the charity stripe, and narrowly missed a double-double with nine rebounds. Sutton added an assist and a blocked shot in the victory.

C-SQUARED

Campbell freshman guard **CHRIS CLEMONS** is the Big South's leading freshman scorer with 17.1 points per game -- good for 5th among all freshman nationally. He ranks fifth overall in the league in scoring. Clemons' 3.25 3FG per game is third in the league, and he is challenging the conference's freshman mark of 3.31, set by Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** in 2013-14. Clemons' 46.4 three-point percentage is pacing ahead of the Big South record by a frosh, which is 42.5 percent (Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2004-05).

RADFORD DUO DAVIS, ANDERSON JOIN FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE 1,000-POINT SCORERS

Radford senior guards **RASHUN DAVIS** and **YAYA ANDERSON** are the 20th pair of four-year classmates to score 1,000 points during the same four-year period. Davis is at 1,029 career points, while Anderson stands at 1,012 after surpassing the milestone Dec. 9 vs. Virginia Tech. Their combined total of 2,041 is 213 points away from the 19th-highest point combination for a four-year duo with 1,000 points each.

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

High Point duo **JOHN BROWN** and **ADAM WEARY** are on the cusp of becoming the 21st pair of four-year classmates with 1,000 points during the same four-year span. Brown is at 1,886, while Weary is six points away from the milestone. Fellow senior **LORENZO CUGINI** is 154 points away from 1,000 in his career, which would mark just the third time a senior trio had 1,000 points during the same four-year period.

DUBY-DUBY-DO

Winthrop redshirt-sophomore **DUBY OKEKE** leads the Big South with 3.50 blocked shots per game. He has recorded multiple blocks in each of his eight games this season, including two games with four and two with five. The last (and only) Winthrop player to lead the Big South in blocked shots was **JOSH GRANT** in 2002-03 (2.28). Meanwhile, Okeke's career total stands at 74, and is 26 away from becoming the first Winthrop player with 100 career blocked shots since **BILLY HOUSTON** eclipsed the mark during the 2004-05 campaign. Just three Eagles reside in the Big South's 100-blocked shot club: Houston (139 from 2002-06), Grant (125 from 2001-04) and **TYRONE WALKER** (105 from 2000-04).

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

As mentioned above, Radford senior **YAYA ANDERSON** became the third player this season and 138th member of the Big South's 1,000-point club last week during the Virginia Tech game. The Big South now has four active 1,000-point scorers, led by High Point's **JOHN BROWN**, who sits in 13th-place in league annals with 1,886 career points. He is 114 away from becoming the ninth player in league history with 2,000 in a career. Below is a look at where all four rank among the all-time leaders, as well as the next players closing in on the 1,000-point milestone:

TAKING FLIGHT

Winthrop leads the Big South with 83.4 points per game, the highest scoring average in the league in two seasons. The Eagles have led the Big South in scoring average just twice, with the last time coming in 1992-93 (83.6 average). The first time was in the conference's first year of men's basketball in 1985-86. That season Winthrop was tops with 79.8 points per game.

OPENING TIP

Winthrop and High Point are 2-0 after the first wave of Big South games, and UNC Asheville will look to join the duo when league games resume Dec. 31. At that time, Winthrop and High Point will seek 3-0 Big South starts for the first time since 2006-07. That season, the Eagles ran the table with a 14-0 mark, while the Panthers started league play 6-0. HPU's first Big South loss that year? Winthrop.

MARGINAL NOTE

Through 10 Big South games, the home teams are 7-3 (=70.0 percent), and have won the seven games by an average of 9.29 points. Seven of the 10 contests have been decided by less than 10 points (4.14 average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 8.4 points. The 2014-15 margin was 10.76, compared to 9.83 in 2013-14.

MAD MAX

Liberty's **EVAN MAXWELL** leads the Big South and is second in the NCAA with a 72.7 field goal percentage, as he is 64-of-88 from the floor through 11 games. He is pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of 69.6 percent, which was established by UNC Asheville's **KENNY GEORGE** when he led the nation in the category in 2007-08.

BUC-ETS

Charleston Southern leads the Big South with 11.0 three-pointers per game, the highest average in the league since 2010-11 when VMI averaged 11.32 triples that season, which is also the last time a Big South member averaged at least 10.00 per contest. CSU, which has led the conference in three-pointers per game every year since 2012-13, has never averaged double-digit treys per game.

BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** is the second player in Big South history with 1,800 points (1,886), 600 rebounds (678), 100 blocked shots (138), 100 steals (148) and 100 assists (140). He is on track to be the first player in league annals with 2,000 points, 800 rebounds, 150 steals, 150 blocked shots and 150 assists by the end of the 2015-16 campaign. Meanwhile, Brown is sixth in Big South history with 724 career field goals, and needs 51 to enter the all-time top five. He is 12th in the conference record book with 438 career free throws made.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is the third-active winningest coach in Division I with 775 career victories. Ellis, who is three wins shy of 700 Division I wins, is 19th all-time in NCAA history for career wins (regardless of affiliation with a minimum 10 head coaching seasons at NCAA schools), and is the sixth-active winningest coach across all NCAA classifications. He became the first head coach in NCAA history with 150 wins at four different Division I programs with the Chanticleers' 68-56 victory over UNC Asheville on Feb. 3, 2015. His Division I school-by-school breakdown is as follows: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 163, in addition to 78 wins during his three seasons leading Cumberland College from 1972-75.

GOOD WORK YOUNG MEN

A league-record three men's basketball players are official nominees for the Allstate NABC Good Works Team®, as High Point's **JOHN BROWN**, Longwood's **KANAYO OBI-RAPU** and Presbyterian's **WILL ADAMS** are among the 154 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA. The list will be pared down in February to a 10-person team featuring five Division I student-athletes.

BADOU'S BOARDS

Coastal Carolina's **BADOU DIAGNE** became the 50th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone against Grace Bible College on Nov. 18, and is currently tied for 43rd with 647. He has an outside chance of joining the league's 1,000-point, 600-rebound and 100-blocked shot club, as his career totals include 845 points and 80 blocked shots. Meanwhile, teammate **MICHEL ENANGA** became the 78th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he reached the total against Piedmont International on Nov. 21, and is currently 77th all-time with 520.

HIGH TOPS

Radford senior **RASHUN DAVIS** is the Big South's active career assist leader with 364, and is 36 away from becoming the 26th member of the league's 400-assist club. With 1,029 career points, he is poised to be the 21st player in conference annals with 1,000 points and 400 assists. Meanwhile, teammate **BRANDON HOLCOMB** has 463 rebounds and should become the just the 24th player in the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club. Holcomb is tied for 24th all-time in league history with 125 career blocked shots.

ESPNU GOING WILD FOR THE BIG SOUTH

For the third consecutive season, four regular-season Big South games will appear on ESPNU in 2015-16. The 24-hour college sports network will televise one January game and three February contests, which will be "Wildcard" selections 21 days in advance. Those four telecasts will be Thursday, Jan. 14 at 7:00pm; Thursday, Feb. 11 at 9:00pm; Thursday, Feb. 18 at 7:00pm, and Thursday, Feb. 25 at 9:00pm.

RADFORD GETS BIG SOUTH'S FIRST TWO BIG WINS OF THE SEASON

Radford defeated Penn State, 86-74 in State College, Pa., on Nov. 26, 12 days after the Highlanders downed Georgetown in double-overtime, 82-80, in their season opener. The win over the Nittany Lions marks the second straight year the Big South has defeated a Big Ten member, while the victory over the Hoyas was the league's fourth win over a BIG EAST member in the past five seasons. The last time the Big South had wins over both the BIG EAST and Big Ten in the same year was 2011-12.

CAMPBELL

CU's 5-3 start is its best to open the season since the 2011-12 club began that year 8-1 ... The Camels rallied from second-half deficits of at least eight points in 3-straight wins before leading wire-to-wire in Wednesday's 76-70 victory at Charlotte ... Six of Campbell's eight games have been decided by six-or-fewer points. CU stands 4-2 in those outings ... CU's 4-game win streak was its longest since a 5-game stretch Dec. 29-Jan. 12, 2012-13 ... **CHRIS CLEMONS** matched his career-high with 26 points in Campbell's 76-70 win at Conference USA member Charlotte ... **TROY HARPER** scored a career-high 21 points (11-15 FTs) in Sunday's loss at Asheville.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU went 12-of-39 from 3-point range in its loss to Rider on Saturday. Through nine games, CSU has attempted 50.3% of its shots from beyond the arc ... CSU has hit 11 or more threes in six of its last seven games. The Bucs have attempted 25 or more threes in seven of nine games to start the year. They rank 5th nationally in 3's made per game, and 15th in 3's attempted ... **RAE ROBINSON** has hit four or more three-pointers in each of his last three games. He missed all five shot attempts in the first half against Rider, before knocking down his first five of the second to rally the Bucs.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Due to final exams, Coastal Carolina played only one game last week -- a 98-73 win over N.C. Wesleyan. **ELIJAH WILSON** (22) and **JAYLEN SHAW** (18) combined for 40 points in the win. Wilson posted his third 20-plus point game of the season, while Shaw's 18 were his collegiate career-high. **BADOU DIAGNE** recorded his third double-double of the season and 16th of his career with 11 points and 11 rebounds against N.C. Wesleyan ... Coastal guards **COLTON RAY-ST CYR** (3.00 apg), Shaw (2.33 apg) and **SHIVAUGHN WIGGINS** (1.28) all rank in the top 10 in the Big South in assist/turnovers ratio per game.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb notched a convincing 20-point win over Furman Saturday, placing four players in double figures while holding the Paladins to just 53 points ... **ADONIS BURBAGE** led the Runnin' Bulldogs with a game-high 16 points -- including 13 in the second half -- as **TYRELL NELSON** added 14 points and a game-high seven rebounds ... **DAVID EFIANAYI** scored 10 of his 12 points in the first half to help GWU to a 34-28 halftime lead ... Gardner-Webb is now 4-0 this season when leading at the half ... The Runnin' Bulldogs have 92 three-pointers this season, 16 more than at this point last year.

HIGH POINT

HPU shot 57.1 percent from the floor (32-56) against UNC Greensboro, and has now won six of the past seven meetings with the Spartans ... The Panthers' 111 points Sunday marked the fourth-most in the program's single-game history ... High Point was +42 (64-22) in points in the paint and held a 31-0 advantage in points off turnovers against Virginia-Wise.

LIBERTY

Against Lamar, **EVAN MAXWELL** and freshman **LOVELL CABBIL** paced Liberty with 15 and 14 points, respectively. Receiving his first collegiate start, freshman guard **CALEB HOMESLEY** finished with nine tallies ... Maxwell has shot 71.0 percent or better in the last five games, including the Flames' most recent contest against Lamar in which he went 6-of-7 (85.7) from the field ... Liberty's 14 points in the first half versus Lamar tied a Vines Center record for the fewest in a half ... Cabbil is second on the team in points (11.0 ppg) and assists (2.5 apg), third in rebounds (3.4 rpg) and leader in steals (1.5 spg).

LONGWOOD

Longwood will play a nationally-televised primetime matchup on ESPNU Tuesday at Oklahoma State. The game will be LW's second straight TV appearance after facing Richmond on WTVR-CBS 6 in the Richmond area this past Saturday ... **SHAQUILLE JOHNSON** flirted with a triple-double at UR, amassing 10 points, 11 rebounds and six assists in 25 minutes off the bench ... **LOTANNA NWOGBO** is one of just two players in the Big South averaging at least 14.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 1.0 blocks per game ... **KANAYO OBI-RAPU** has made at least one trey in every game and leads the team with 15.4 ppg.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose head to Greenville to take on ACC foe Clemson Tuesday evening. The Tigers are playing their home games at Bon Secours Wellness Arena this season while Littlejohn Coliseum is undergoing renovations ... **DeSEAN MURRAY** is 14th in the nation in field goal percentage (65.4), 9th in free throws made (58.0), 7th in free throw attempts (76.0), 17th in points per game (21.6), and 10th in total points (194.0) ... PC's current 77.3 scoring average would be the highest in PC's Division I history, almost 12 points higher than the 65.4 record in 2013-14. The current 47.6 field goal percentage is tops and is 1.2 higher than the 46.4 set in 2014-15.

RADFORD

Radford split two games last week, falling to Virginia Tech on Wednesday before pulling out a 92-91 double overtime victory at Howard on Saturday ... **RASHUN DAVIS** hit his second game-winning 3-pointer of the season to give the Highlanders the win, with both coming in 20T games played in Washington, D.C. ... Freshman **ED POLITE, JR.** posted career highs of 27 points and 11 rebounds in the Howard game. He pulled down eight offensive rebounds and now has a conference-leading 40 on the season ... **YAYA ANDERSON** became the 29th Highlander in program history with 1,000 career points and the fourth in the last two seasons.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs have now opened Big South Conference play with a victory in each of the last 11 seasons, dating back to the 2005-06 campaign. Prior to Sunday's win, Asheville had started the league schedule with wins on the road the last six seasons. Its last home conference-opening victory prior to Sunday was in 2008 against Liberty ... Asheville has held opponents under 65 points five times this season ...
