### CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - TIANNA KNUCKLES, UNC ASHEVILLE, G. JR (WENDELL, N.C.)

Knuckles scored 15 points and grabbed six rebounds in 20 minutes in UNC Asheville's victory over UNC Greensboro last Thursday. All 15 points came from behind the arc, and she was a perfect 4-of-4 on three-point attempts in the first half. Knuckles finished the night 5-of-7 from long range in addition to two steals and one assist.

### THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - KEMARI JONES, LONGWOOD, F. FR (MELBOURNE, FLA.)

Jones posted her first career double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds in Saturday's win over North Carolina Wesleyan. Eight of her season-high 14 points and eight of her rebounds came in the first half. Jones added three assists and one steal in 23 minutes of action off the bench.

## CAMPBELL

- Campbell was off last week for exams and will be back in action this week with four non-conference matchups before taking a break for the Christmas holiday.
- **RaeCHAUN EDWARDS** and **AMANDA COFFER** lead the Lady Camel offense this season with an average of 14.7 (7th in the league) and 11.5 points per game, respectively.
- Coffey is just four blocks away from becoming Campbell's all-time career leader.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

- **ALYSSA MANN** has recorded three straight 20+ point efforts this season and sits among the conference leaders in averaging 16.7 points per game. She is also tops in the Big South with an 84.8 free throw percentage.
- **MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN** sits second overall in the Big South with 8.9 boards per game, in addition to averaging 2.50 blocked shots per contest.
- **SHAUNTAVIA DOBSON** has several double-digit scoring efforts on the season, including 19 points in the Bucs' win over Wofford. She sits among the Big South leaders in scoring, and is fourth in the Big South in three-pointers made per game at 2.13.
- Charleston Southern is the NCAA leader in three-point defense, allowing opponents to shoot just 17.1% from beyond the three-point line.

## COASTAL CAROLINA

- Coastal hit the century mark for the second time this season with a 100-49 win over Warren Wilson last week. It was the final non-DI opponent on Coastal's schedule.
- **NICOLE ISAACS** had 18 points to lead Coastal in scoring for the second straight game. The redshirt senior is averaging 25.0 points over Coastal's last two games while hitting 63.2 percent of her 3-point attempts. **OLIVIA CARLTON** (11), **RACHAEL GREGORY** (11) and **JAS ADAMS** (10) also finished in double figures for the Chants.
- Adams also had six assists and five steals in the game. The sophomore guards leads Coastal in both categories for the season, averaging 4.13 assists and 2.00 steals per game. She is also the team's top rebounder, pulling in 5.9 rpg.
- Coastal plays two games this week, hosting UNC Asheville for a Big South matchup Monday night before taking on Wake Forest in a neutral-site game at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center on Friday.

## GARDNER-WEBB

- GWU's victory over Liberty on Dec. 2 was its first over the Lady Flames since March 13, 2011, when the Runnin' Bulldogs won 67-66 to capture their first-ever Big South Tournament title.
- It was also the first regular-season victory for GWU over Liberty since Jan 2, 2010, as well as the first time GWU won its conference opener since the 2010-11 season
- Gardner-Webb forced 31 turnovers by Liberty and hauled down 23 offensive boards.

## HIGH POINT

- The Panthers will return from their 11-day break for finals on Wednesday at 7:00pm to take on VCU in the Millis Center. HPU wraps up non-conference play with a trip to Elon on Saturday at 3:30pm.
- Behind stellar weeks from junior **KAYLAH KEYS** and freshman **LINDSEY EDWARDS**, the Purple & White got off to a 2-0 start in Big South play from Dec. 1-5.
- Keys is second in the conference in scoring with 17.0 points per game and second among active players with 1,173 career points.
- Edwards is second among league freshmen with 9.3 points per game.
- The freshman class has accounted for 63 percent of the team's minutes while tallying 54 percent of the points and 66 percent of the steals.

## LIBERTY

- Liberty's 36-point setback (92-56) to Seton Hall on Saturday marked the Lady Flames' largest margin of defeat in Vines Center history.
- **ASHLEY RININGER** moved into sixth place in program history with 862 career rebounds and needs 15 more boards to overtake **ELENA KISSELEVA** for fifth place.
- With 96 career three-pointers, **JAYMEE FISHER-DAVIS** needs three more triples to move past **MEGAN FRAZEE** and into Liberty's career top 10.
- The Lady Flames' first eight opponents this season have boasted a combined record of 29-8 at the time of the meeting.
- On Thursday, Liberty will travel to Duke for its third matchup against a Top 25 opponent this season. The Lady Flames are seeking their first win over a Top 25 foe since 2005 and their first victory over an ACC opponent since 2008.

## LONGWOOD

- Longwood's 100-point game this past Saturday against North Carolina Wesleyan was the most points scored in the **BILL REINSON** era and marked the first contest the Lancers have tallied 100 points since posting a 101-83 victory over St. Andrew's during the 2002-03 season.
- **KYNDAL SKERSICK** scored a team-high 20 points vs. N.C. Wesleyan, her first game with 20 points this season and the third of her career. She finished three points shy of her career-high of 23 points.

## PRESBYTERIAN

- PC's 59-38 win over Longwood Dec. 5 marked the fifth-straight win for the Blue Hose over the Lancers.
- **ALLIE WAGNER** provided the Blue Hose with her second career double-double with 14 points and 12 rebounds in the team's Big South win over Longwood. It was the second double-double for a PC player this season.
- Freshman guard **TAYLOR PETTY** tied the team-high 14 points against Longwood. Petty has led PC in scoring five times the season and leads the team with 11.5 points per game.
- Junior guard **AIANNA KELLY** leads the team with 5.4 rebounds per game. Kelly has led the Blue Hose in rebounding five times this season and scoring twice.

## RADFORD

- Radford split its two games last week, falling 63-56 at Xavier before cruising to a 92-36 triumph over Concord at home.
- Four Highlanders reached double figures in the win over the Mountain Lions, led by **JAYDA WORTHY**'s 18.
- Radford connected on a season-high 54.1 percent of its shots on its way to a season-high offensive output.
- The Highlanders out-rebounded Concord, 56-21, and scored 54 of their 92 points in the paint.
- With the win over the Mountain Lions, RU extended its home winning streak to 12 straight.

## UNC ASHEVILLE

- Asheville's 7-1 start is its best start since becoming an NCAA Division I program. The only time the program has had a better start was in 1984-85 when the Bulldogs opened 9-1 while competing at the NAIA level. The Bulldogs' 1983-84 NAIA National Championship season opened with just a 3-2 start before going on to win it all.
- In addition to building a seven-game win streak, Asheville leads the Big South in seven different team statistical categories, including scoring offense, scoring margin, field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage, turnover margin, three-point field goals made, and assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Asheville is shooting 44 percent from the field as a team. This is the most efficient offense the Bulldogs have had since the arrival of head coach **BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK**.

## WINTHROP

- **ERICA WILLIAMS** kept her consecutive double-figure scoring streak alive as she scored 10 points against No. 2/2 South Carolina on Sunday. She has now reached double digits in 23 straight games.
- Sophomore guard **NUBA JACKSON** came off the bench to score 7 points against South Carolina, tying her career-high output in the season opener against Oklahoma.
- Winthrop will face its second straight SEC foe on Wednesday when the Eagles meet Auburn at 12 noon EST in a game that will be televised on the SEC Network.
- Winthrop will not play a home game for the remainder of 2015 as the Eagles close out the calendar year with three more road games, including Auburn (Dec. 16), College of Charleston (Dec. 22) and UNC Asheville (Dec. 29). The first game of 2016 will be at home on Jan. 2 against Longwood. The Eagles are 2-0 at home.
