## PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - DEC. 23

**CHOICE HOTELS CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK - BADOU DIAGNE, COASTAL CAROLINA, F. SR (DAKAR, SENEGAL)**

Diagne averaged 16.0 points and 7.3 rebounds in leading the Chanticleers to a 2-1 record on the week. The highlight of his week was 24 points and seven boards at Wake Forest. He went 18-of-29 from the field (=62.1 percent), 6-of-11 from long range (=54.5) and 6-of-8 from the charity stripe (=75.0) in the three games.

**CHOICE HOTELS Co-PLAYER OF THE WEEK - KEON JOHNSON, WINTHROP, G, JR (MANSFIELD, OHIO)**

Johnson averaged 23.0 points and 4.3 rebounds in leading the Eagles to a 2-1 record. He opened with 25 points on 9-of-14 shooting at Alabama, then scored a game-high 30 points to lead Winthrop to a road win at Georgia Southern. In the three games, he was 22-of-40 from the floor (=55.0), 8-of-20 from beyond the arc (=40.0) and 17-of-20 from the free throw line (=85.0).

**THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - CHRIS CLEMONS, CAMPBELL, G. FR (RALEIGH, N.C.)**

Clemons averaged 18.7 points, 4.0 rebounds, 1.7 assists and 1.7 steals in leading the Camels to a 2-1 week. He had 11 points in a win over Johnson 8 Wales, then erupted for 31 points (25 in the second half) and eight rebounds in Campbell's win over The Citadel. He went 17-of-18 from the free throw line (=94.4 points) and averaged 3.0 three-pointers per game.

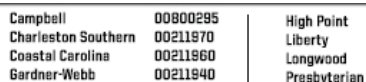

## BIG SOUTH STANDS 2-0 VS. THE BIG EAST

The Big South Conference is 2-0 against BIG EAST this season, with both wins over Georgetown. The last time the Big South had two wins vs. the BIG EAST was in 2012-13. Radford downed the Hoyas in double-overtime its season opener, followed by UNC Asheville on Dec. 19. In addition, the Highlanders defeated Penn State, 86-74 in State College, Pa., on Nov. 26, 12 days after the Georgetown victory. The win over the Nittany Lions marks the second straight year the Big South has defeated a Big Ten member. The Big South has defeated a BIG EAST member four times in the past five seasons, and the last time the Big South had wins over both the BIG EAST and Big Ten in the same year was 2011-12.

## C-SQUARED

Campbell freshman guard **CHRIS CLEMONS** is the Big South's leading freshman scorer with 17.5 points per game -- good for 3rd among all freshman nationally. He ranks fourth overall in the league in scoring. Clemons' 3.18 3FG per game is second in the league, and he is challenging the conference's freshman mark of 3.31, set by Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** in 2013-14. Clemons' 42.7 three-point percentage is pacing ahead of the Big South record by a frosh, which is 42.5 percent (Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** in 2004-05).

## HIGH POINT DUO BROWN, WEARY JOIN FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE 1,000-POINT SCORERS

High Point duo **JOHN BROWN** and **ADAM WEARY** are the 21st pair of Big South four-year classmates with 1,000 points during the same four-year span. Brown is at 1,911, while Weary surpassed the milestone Dec. 16. Fellow senior **LORENZO CUGINI** is 122 points away from 1,000 in his career, which would mark just the third time a senior trio had 1,000 points during the same four-year period. Brown and Weary have a combined total of 2,930, and are 70 points away from becoming just the fifth duo to combine for 3,000.

## BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

Radford senior guards **RASHUN DAVIS** and **YAYA ANDERSON** became the 20th pair of Big South four-year classmates to score 1,000 points during the same four-year period on Dec. 9 when Anderson eclipsed the milestone. Davis is currently at 1,057 career points, while Anderson stands at 1,016. Their combined total of 2,073 is 181 points away from the 19th-highest point combination for a four-year duo with 1,000 points each.

## BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

As mentioned above, High Point senior **ADAM WEARY** became the fourth player this season and 139th member of the Big South's 1,000-point club Dec. 16 during the N.C. State game. The Big South now has five active 1,000-point scorers, led by High Point's **JOHN BROWN**, who sits in a tie for 11th-place in league annals with 1,911 career points. He is 89 away from becoming the ninth player in league history with 2,000 in a career. Below is a look at where all five rank among the all-time leaders, as well as the next players closing in on the 1,000-point milestone:

## BADOU'S BOARDS

Coastal Carolina's **BADOU DIAGNE** became the 50th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone against Grace Bible College on Nov. 18, and is currently tied for 40th with 669. He has an outside chance of joining the league's 1,000-point, 600-rebound and 100-blocked shot club, as his career totals include 893 points and 83 blocked shots. Meanwhile, teammate **MICHEL ENANGA** became the 78th player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he reached the total against Piedmont International on Nov. 21, and is currently 76th all-time with 523.

## HIGH TOPS

Radford senior **RASHUN DAVIS** is the Big South's active career assist leader with 368, and is 32 away from becoming the 26th member of the league's 400-assist club. With 1,057 career points, he is poised to be the 21st player in conference annals with 1,000 points and 400 assists. Meanwhile, teammate **BRANDON HOLCOMB** has 474 rebounds and should become the just the 24th player in the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club. Holcomb is 23rd all-time in league history with 128 career blocked shots.

## BUC-ETS

Charleston Southern leads the Big South with 10.33 three-pointers per game, the highest average in the league since 2010-11 when VMI averaged 11.32 triples that season, which is also the last time a Big South member averaged at least 10.00 per contest. CSU, which has led the conference in three-pointers per game every year since 2012-13, has never averaged double-digit treys per game.

## TAKING FLIGHT

Winthrop leads the Big South with 82.5 points per game, the highest scoring average in the league in two seasons. The Eagles have led the Big South in scoring average just twice, with the last time coming in 1992-93 (83.6 average). The first time was in the conference's first year of men's basketball in 1985-86. That season Winthrop was tops with 79.8 points per game.

## MAD MAX

Liberty's **EVAN MAXWELL** leads the Big South and is second in the NCAA with a 71.0 field goal percentage, as he is 76-of-107 from the floor through 13 games. He is pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of 69.6 percent, which was established by UNC Asheville's **KENNY GEORGE** when he led the nation in the category in 2007-08.

## BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** is the second player in Big South history with 1,900 points (1,911), 600 rebounds (691), 100 blocked shots (143), 100 steals (151) and 100 assists (145). He is on track to be the first player in league annals with 2,000 points, 800 rebounds, 150 steals, 150 blocked shots and 150 assists by the end of the 2015-16 campaign. Meanwhile, Brown is sixth in Big South history with 731 career field goals, and needs 44 to enter the all-time top five. He is 11th in the conference record book with 449 career free throws made.

## CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is the third-active winningest coach in Division I with 777 career victories. Ellis, who is one win shy of 700 Division I wins, is 19th all-time in NCAA history for career wins (regardless of affiliation with a minimum 10 head coaching seasons at NCAA schools), and is the sixth-active winningest coach across all NCAA classifications. He became the first head coach in NCAA history with 150 wins at four different Division I programs with the Chanticleers' 68-56 victory over UNC Asheville on Feb. 3, 2015. His Division I school-by-school breakdown is as follows: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 165, in addition to 78 wins during his three seasons leading Cumberland College from 1972-75.

## ESPNU GOING WILD FOR THE BIG SOUTH

For the third consecutive season, four regular-season Big South games will appear on ESPNU in 2015-16. The 24-hour college sports network will televise one January game and three February contests, which will be "Wildcard" selections 21 days in advance. Those four telecasts will be Thursday, Jan. 14 at 7:00pm; Thursday, Feb. 11 at 9:00pm; Thursday, Feb. 18 at 7:00pm, and Thursday, Feb. 25 at 9:00pm.

## DUBY-DUBY-DO

Injured Winthrop redshirt-sophomore **DUBY OKEKE** was averaging 3.50 blocked shots per game before suffering his setback. He had recorded multiple blocks in each of his eight games this season, including two games with four and two with five. The last (and only) Winthrop player to lead the Big South in blocked shots was **JOSH GRANT** in 2002-03 (2.28). Meanwhile, Okeke's career total stands at 74, and is 26 away from becoming the first Winthrop player with 100 career blocked shots since **BILLY HOUSTON** eclipsed the mark during the 2004-05 campaign. Just three Eagles reside in the Big South's 100-blocked shot club: Houston (139 from 2002-06), Grant (125 from 2001-04) and **TYRONE WALKER** (105 from 2000-04).

## OPENING TIP

Winthrop and High Point are 2-0 after the first wave of Big South games, and UNC Asheville will look to join the duo when league games resume Dec. 31. At that time, Winthrop and High Point will seek 3-0 Big South starts for the first time since 2006-07. That season, the Eagles ran the table with a 14-0 mark, while the Panthers started league play 6-0. HPU's first Big South loss that year? Winthrop.

## MARGINAL NOTE

Through 10 Big South games, the home teams are 7-3 (.70.0 percent), and have won the seven games by an average of 9.29 points. Seven of the 10 contests have been decided by less than 10 points (4.14 average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 8.4 points. The 2014-15 margin was 10.76, compared to 9.83 in 2013-14.

## CAMPBELL

Campbell's 7-4 start is the program's best since the 2011-12 team opened the year with an 8-3 record ... CU equaled the Gore Arena record for most points scored against a Division I opponent (101) in its 101-82 victory over The Citadel. The Camels eclipsed the century mark for the first time since a 101-82 win over Appalachian State on Nov. 16, 2012 ... With wins over VMI and The Citadel this year, CU improved to 5-1 against SoCon members under head coach **KEVIN MCGEEHAN** ... With 31 points vs. The Citadel, **CHRIS CLEMONS** broke the school freshman scoring record of 30 points.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU held Wright State to 35 percent shooting in the 2nd half of its loss to the Raiders last Thursday. It was the Bucs' second best defensive half of the season ... CSU ranks 7th nationally in three-point attempts, and 14th in threes made per game ... **PATRICK WALLACE** ranks 5th and 22nd in those two categories, respectively ... CSU has made 11 or more threes six times already this year ... **ARMEL POTTER** scored a career-high tying 20 points at Florida State on Monday ... **RAE ROBINSON** has scored in double figures in six straight games. He is 19-for-47 (40%) from three-point range over that stretch.

## COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal played its first 'three-game' week of the season, going 2-1 with wins over Wofford (71-63) and Alabama State (68-65) and a slim defeat at Wake Forest (83-77) ... **BADOU DIAGNE** averaged 16.0 points per game to pace Coastal last week. Diagne posted a season-high 24 points at Wake Forest, while **JAYLEN SHAW** posted a career-high 21 against the Demon Deacons ... Shaw also provided the heroics to lift Coastal to the 68-65 win over Alabama State with his 3-pointer with 2.1 seconds to play ... **TRISTIAN CURTIS** has made 37-of-46 field goal attempts this season (=80.4 percent).

## GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs posted their second-lowest FT percentage of the season on Monday night, converting just 54.2 percent (19-of-35) in a one-point loss to VMI ... **TYRELL NELSON** averaged a double-double last week with 13.3 points and 10.3 rebounds per game. He is 10 rebounds away from 500 in his career ... Freshman **LAQUINCY RIDEAU** tallied 15 steals last week -- including five against VMI -- to push his season total to 36 in just 13 games. Rideau is on pace to surpass the program's Division I single-season record of 78, set by **TIM JENNINGS** in 2004-05 ... GWU is 5-0 this season when leading at the half (0-8 when trailing at intermission).

## HIGH POINT

**LORENZO CUGINI** posted a season-high 20 points (7-12 FG) and eight rebounds Monday at William & Mary ... **HAISHEN MCINTYRE** notched 11 points against the Tribe, including the bucket to send the game to OT ... **ANTHONY LINDAUER** (18), **JOHN BROWN** (17) and **ADAM WEARY** (15) led HPU in scoring at N.C. State, a game the Panthers lost on a 3FG as time expired ... HPU's four losses this season have come by a total of 13 points (3.25 average).

## LIBERTY

**JOHN DAWSON** posted 15 points and four assists in his Liberty debut against Princeton last week. He followed with a 15-point, 10-rebound performance on Sunday at St. Francis Brooklyn ... Against Princeton, the Flames shot 53.8 percent (28-of-52) in the contest, their second-best shooting performance of the season. **EVAN MAXWELL** paced Liberty with 22 points against the Tigers, marking his third 20-point performance of the season ... Liberty has not won a road game since the 2013-14 season, when the Flames defeated Campbell, 79-59, on Feb. 22, 2014.

## LONGWOOD

Longwood concludes its non-conference schedule Tuesday, Dec. 28 against Division III foe Cairn inside Willett Hall. The game will mark the first of three straight at home for the squad, including two Big South games ... Longwood has played nine of its last 10 games on the road ... Since his return, **SHAQUILLE JOHNSON** has scored in double figures in three contests he has played, including a double-double performance at George Mason ... Longwood ranks third in the Big South in 3FG percentage at 35.9, while **KANAYO OBI-RAPU** leads the squad with a 47.9 clip from beyond the arc.

## PRESBYTERIAN

PC returns to action at Marquette on Dec. 27. Marquette owns a 2-0 record in the overall series, with the last game a 102-62 decision ... This season's non-conference schedule featured four SoCon opponents, and one team from the Atlantic Sun, ACC, A-10, and the BIG EAST ... Should it hold the rest of the season, the team's 72.7 scoring average would be the highest in PC's Division I history, and more than seven points higher than the 65.4 record in 2013-14.

## RADFORD

Radford split a pair of hard-fought two-point non-conference games against fellow mid-majors, edging UNC Wilmington on Dec. 19 before falling on the road at Chattanooga Tuesday ... **KION BROWN** and **TAJ OWENS** set career bests with 17 and 16 points, respectively, against UNCW ... Freshman **CALEB TANNER** also had a career high in the UNCW game, but then more than doubled that output with 13 points against Chattanooga ... **RASHUN DAVIS** recorded his fourth 20-point outing of the season in the Chattanooga game, tallying 24, his highest total since scoring 28 in the season-opener at Georgetown ... **ED POLITE, JR.** added to his conference-leading offensive rebound total and now has 46 on the season.

## UNC ASHEVILLE

Asheville had five players score in double figures in Saturday's win over Georgetown and in Monday night's loss to Elon, the second and third times this season that feat has been accomplished. Overall, the Bulldogs have seen at least three players score in double-digits in nine of the team's 11 games ... Asheville has held opponents under 65 points five times this season and are allowing 66.2 points per game, the best mark in the Big South ... Despite their height disadvantage, Asheville has outrebounded its opponents in nine of 11 games so far this season. For the season, Asheville has collected 72 percent (337 rebounds) of its 469 total rebounds on the defensive end of the floor.

## WINTHROP

The Eagles are 8-3 for the first time since 2006-07 and the fourth time in program history ...
