## PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - DEC. 23

### CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - ALYSSA MANN, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, G. R-Jr (BRADENTON, FLA.)

Mann averaged 18.7 points, 3.7 assists and 2.7 steals in three games. She scored 20 points against Virginia and added 22 in a win over Western Carolina. Against the Cavaliers, Mann scored 12 of CSU's 22 points in the third period and contributed four assists and four steals. She opened the week with 14 points and four three-pointers at Georgia Southern. For the week, Mann went 22-of-49 from the field (=44.9 percent) and 7-of-19 from long range (=36.8).

### THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - LYDIA RIVERS, RADFORD, F. Fr (KINSTON, N.C.)

Rivers averaged 8.5 points and 8.0 rebounds per game while connecting on 7-of-15 (=46.7) from the floor in two contests. She scored seven of her season-high 11 points in the first half at Wofford while going 5-of-9 from the field. At Virginia Tech, Rivers grabbed a game-high 12 rebounds and limited the Hokies' second-leading scorer to just two points.

## OPENING TIP

UNC Asheville and High Point are 2-0 after the first wave of Big South games, and Campbell will look to join the duo when league play resumes Dec. 29. At that time, Asheville will seek its first 3-0 Big South start since 2003-04, while the Panthers will pursue their second consecutive 3-0 start to league play.

## MARGINAL NOTE

Through the first 10 Big South games, the home teams are 6-4 (=60.0 percent), and have won the six games by an average of 8.83 points. Four of the 10 contests have been decided by less than 10 points (5.25 average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 10.7 points.

## MOUNTAIN TOP

UNC Asheville leads the Big South with 75.7 points per game, the highest average in the conference since 1996-97 when former member UNC Greensboro led the league with the same total. The Bulldogs have been the Big South's top scoring team just once -- 1989-90 with a 73.0 average. Meanwhile, Asheville's +18.1 scoring margin is pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of +17.2, which is currently held by Liberty (2009-10).

## STUFFING HER COFFERS

Campbell's **AMANDA COFFER** leads the Big South with 2.8 blocked shots per game, and is looking to become the first Campbell Camel to lead the conference in blocks. Coffey has 119 in her career, good for a tie for 17th all-time in Big South history. She needs 64 to enter the Top 10.

## MAXIMUM EFFORT

Charleston Southern's **MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN** is tied for second in the conference with 2.36 blocks per contest, the first Buccaneer averaging at least two blocks a game since **SHAUNTE SMALL** posted 2.03 per game in 2006-07. Maximilien's career total stands at 93, and is seven away from becoming the 29th player in league annals with 100. Meanwhile, she is eight rebounds shy of 500 in her career, which would make her the 106th player on the Big South's all-time list. Once she reaches both milestones, she will be the fourth active player with 500 career boards and 100 career blocks.

## BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS** became the first player this season and 100th member of the Big South's 1,000-point club during the Duke game on Nov. 15. The Big South now has three active 1,000-point scorers, led by Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER**, who sits in 47th place with 1,244 career points. She is 225 away from entering the league's Top 25 scorers. Below is a look at where all three rank among the all-time leaders, as well as the next players closing in on the 1,000-point milestone:

## GOOD WORK YOUNG LADIES

A league-record four women's basketball players are official nominees for the Allstate WBCA Good Works Team®, as Coastal Carolina's **OLIVIA CARLTON**, Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER**, Presbyterian's **JANIE MILES** and UNC Asheville's **PAIGE LOVE** are among the 103 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA. The list will be pared down to a 10-person team featuring five Division I student-athletes in February.

## RAGIN RININGER

Liberty redshirt-senior **ASHLEY RININGER** is on track to become the second player in league history with 1,500 points, 1,000 rebounds and 150 blocks. Her current career totals stand at 1,244 points, 864 boards and 145 rejections, and she needs to average 13.47 points, 7.16 rebounds and 0.26 blocks in the Lady Flames' remaining 19 scheduled games this season. Former Liberty star **KATIE FEENSTRA** is the lone member of the club, as she tallied 1,845 points, 1,033 rebounds and 257 blocks from 2001-05.

## MAY WE ASSIST YOU?

Campbell's **RaeCHAUN EDWARDS** became the 19th player in Big South history with 400 career assists in the season opener, and currently ranks 12th all-time with 437. She needs 63 to become the 10th player with 500 career helpers. Edwards also has 198 career steals, and is on the cusp of becoming just the 15th player with 400 assists and 200 steals. Meanwhile, Liberty's **SADALIA ELLIS** is 54 assists away from 400 in her career, and would be the fifth Lady Flame on the league's all-time chart -- which would extend Liberty's Big South record.

## GARDNER-WEBB, COASTAL CAROLINA SCORE BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG WINS OF 2015-16

Gardner-Webb defeated North Carolina in the season opener, 66-65 in Chapel Hill, while Coastal Carolina knocked off Clemson during the opening weekend. It is the first time since 2006-07 (three wins) that the Big South has collected two victories over the ACC in the same year.

## WHAT A STEAL!

Winthrop's **ALIYAH KILPATRICK** tied the Big South single-game record with 10 steals at College of Charleston on Dec. 22. She became the first player to achieve the feat since High Point's **NARELLE HENRY** posted 10 steals against Arkansas-Little Rock on Nov. 24, 2001. Kilpatrick is the sixth different Big South player with 10 steals in a game, and the second Winthrop Eagle on the list, as **SHEILA BAILEY** had 10 steals against UNC Asheville on Feb. 20, 1990. Kilpatrick's effort marked the seventh 10-steal game in league annals, as Elon's **JAYME CHIKOS** had two such performances during her Big South tenure.

## BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER** is the Big South's active-leading rebounder with 864, and needs 46 to enter the league's all-time Top 10. Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** is the 39th member of the 700-rebound club with 744, while Liberty's **KATELYN ADAMS** (669) and Gardner-Webb's **CANDACE BROWN** (642) are among the players with 600 career boards. Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS** is 19 rebounds away from 600. Below is a look at where all five rank among the all-time leaders, as well as the next players closing in on the 500-rebound milestone:

## MAGIC WAND-A

Campbell head coach **WANDA WATKINS** needs eight wins for 550 in her coaching career, as she is 542-429 in 35 years in Buies Creek, which includes a 223-131 (.63.0 percent) in 14 total seasons in the Big South -- good for fourth in league history. She is six victories away from surpassing former Coastal Carolina coach **ALAN LeFORCE** (228) for third all-time. Watkins owns the second-most Big South victories with 129, and has recorded double-digit conference wins in her last eight seasons in the Big South -- 2011-to-present, and 1990-94 prior to the Camels' 17-year stay in the TAAC/Atlantic Sun from 1994-2011.

## GREEN MACHINE

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** needs 13 wins for 400 in his coaching career. He entered the 2015-16 season ranked 13th all-time among active NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his 75.0 winning percentage -- ahead of renowned coaches **C. VIVIAN STRINGER**, **SYLVIA HATCHELL** and **BRENDA FRESE**. Green is the Big South's all-time winningest basketball coach -- men's or women's -- with his 387 overall wins, which includes 222 Big South victories.

## CLIMBING THE VICTORY LADDER

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** is the longest-tenured coach in Big South women's basketball history, as he is in his 17th year in 2015-16. Gardner-Webb's **RICK REEVES** is in his 16th total season in the league, while Campbell's **WANDA WATKINS** is in her 14th overall year in the Big South. The trio will soon be the top three winningest coaches in league annals. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College's **RONNY FISHER** is nine wins away from entering the all-time Top 10. ## CAMPBELL

The Lady Camels went 2-2 last week with wins over Western Carolina (73-66) and North Florida (66-55) ... **SUMMER PRICE** led CU over the Catamounts with a career-high 26 points while **RaeCHAUN EDWARDS** added a career-high 23 ... **AMANDA COFFER** became Campbell's all-time career block leader during the WCU game, a feat she accomplished in less than two and a half seasons ... Price paced CU once more with a team-high 22 points against the Ospreys while Coffey earned her fourth double-double of the season ... Campbell held UNF to a season-low 14.3 percent shooting in the second period.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern closed out the home portion of its 2015 schedule with an emphatic 80-59 win over Western Carolina to improve to 6-0 at home in the Buc Dome. The 80 points was a CSU season high on the year ... **MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN** recorded her fourth double-double of the season against Western Carolina on Tuesday afternoon, finishing the game with 12 points and 12 rebounds ... **RACHEL BURNS** scored a season-high 17 points in the Bucs' win against WCU as the freshman guard connected on 7-of-13 attempts from the floor in 24 minutes of play.

## COASTAL CAROLINA

The Chants finished 5-4 against non-conference opponents this season ... Last Friday's game against Wake Forest was played at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center as part of the Crescom Bank Carolinas Challenge. Coastal has lost its last five games played in the building, and is 3-9 in its 12 games played there since 2002 ... The win over Wofford on Monday moved Coastal to 9-0 all-time against the Terriers. Wofford is the only Division I opponent that Coastal has played more than four times and holds a perfect record against ... **NICOLE ISAACS** averaged 10.7 ppg for Coastal last week, shooting 41.2 percent (7-17) from beyond the arc. She has hit a 3-pointer in all but one game this season (vs. Hofstra).

## GARDNER-WEBB

**OLIVIA PARKER** is off to a fantastic start to her senior season, as she has recorded a league-leading six double-doubles, which ranks among the Top 10 in the country. For her career, she has put up double-digit points and rebounds in a game 26 times. Parker is six points away from becoming the 33rd player in Big South history with 1,000 career points and 700 career rebounds. Once she reaches the scoring milestone, she will look to join the 18-member 1,000-point/800-rebound club.

## HIGH POINT

The Panthers are off for the Christmas break until they play Presbyterian on Dec. 29 in Clinton. HPU leads the all-time series with PC, 13-3 ... Junior **KAYLAH KEYS** scored 15 points in Saturday's game against Elon to pass **CHEYENNE PARKER** for fifth on HPU's Division I scoring list. Keys has 1,202 career points ... Freshman **SHEA MORGAN** and redshirt-freshman **KENNEDY CURRIE** combined for 19 of the reserves' 45 points in the contest at Elon.

## LIBERTY

At 3-7, Liberty got off to its worst 10-game start since the 2008-09 Lady Flames also started 3-7. That team went on to finish 24-9 and qualify for the NCAA Tournament ... Liberty faced No. 13/11 Duke on Dec. 17, marking the Lady Flames' third Top 25 opponent of the season. It was the first time since 2010-11 Liberty faced three Top 25 foes in a single season ... With 97 career three-pointers, **JAYMEE FISHER-DAVIS** needs two triples to move into Liberty's career top 10 ... **KATELYN ADAMS** has 669 career rebounds and needs four boards to overtake **TOLU OMOTOLA** for ninth place in school history.

## LONGWOOD

Longwood earned wins in two of its last four games and had an average margin of victory of 47.0 points in the two victories ... **DAEISHA BROWN** and **RAVEN WILLIAMS** are both on track to break the 1,000 point plateau in their respective careers. Williams is 157 points shy of the mark, while Brown is 109 points away ... **AUTUMN CHILDRESS** is enjoying the best stretch of her career. She has scored in double figures in two straight games for the first time in her career, while adding at least five boards in each game.

## PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose lead the Big South in scoring defense, allowing 56.8 points per game, free-throw percentage, shooting 71.3 percent, and 3-point field goals made with 6.82 per game ... PC broke the all-time series tie with a 60-50 win over N.C. Central on Monday ... Freshman **TAYLOR PETTY** leads PC in scoring and sits 10th in the conference averaging 12.2 points per game. She is also eighth in the conference shooting 32.9 percent from behind the 3-point line and second in 3-pointers made averaging 2.55 a game ... **CORTNEY STOREY** is third in the conference averaging 3.5 assists per game and third in assist/turnover ratio at 1.4.

## RADFORD

Radford dropped to 4-6 on the season after back-to-back road losses at Wofford (79-70) and Virginia Tech (47-40) ... The Highlanders have suffered nine straight road setbacks, dating back to last season ... **AISHA FOY** dialed up a career-high 26 points on 9 of 16 shooting at Wofford ... The Highlanders stood toe-to-toe with New River Valley rival Virginia Tech, which was receiving votes in the national rankings. They held the Hokies, who entered the game ranked 18th in the nation in 3FG percentage, without a 3-pointer (0-15) for the first time since Feb. 3, 2013 ... Radford held Tech to a season-low 28.6 FG percentage and a season-low 47 points.

## UNC ASHEVILLE

Asheville's 84-71 victory over Furman tied the all-time series at 14-14. Asheville jumped out to a 4-0 lead and never looked back ... The Bulldogs matched the best start in program history (9-1) by the 1984-85 squad, when they competed at the NAIA level ... Asheville's nine-game win streak was snapped on Monday at Clemson. The Bulldogs' only other loss this year was a six-point defeat in the season opener at ETSU ... In the first 10 games of the season, Asheville capitalized on its free throws, sinking 72.1 percent (158-of-219).

## WINTHROP

Winthrop is 2-9 after 11 games, equaling the worst previous season start in 2006-07. All 9 losses have been on the road ... **ALIYAH KILPATRICK** scored a career-high 28 points in a losing effort on the road at College of Charleston ... The "murderer's row" segment of the schedule is over for the Eagles after they faced three top 20 teams along with Auburn and two mid-major opponents (Akron and Ohio) who began the season ranked in the Mid-Major Top 25 ... **ERICA WILLIAMS** had her consecutive double figure scoring games streak snapped at 23 as she scored just two points at Auburn.
