PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - JAN. 4

PLAYER OF THE WEEK - CHATORI MAJOR, UNC ASHEVILLE, G, JR (CAMP LEJEUNE, N.C.)

Major averaged 22.5 points, 4.5 rebounds, 1.0 assists and 1.0 steals in two Big South wins. She delivered a career-high 28 points on 56 percent shooting with five rebounds and a steal in a victory over Winthrop on Dec. 29. Major then tallied a team-high 17 points, in addition to four rebounds, two assists, one blocked shot and one steal in Asheville's road win at Campbell on Jan. 2. For the week, she was 15-of-26 from the floor (=57.7 percent), 7-of-10 from behind the arc (=70.0) and made 8-of-12 free throws (=66.7).

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - TAYLOR PETTY, PRESBYTERIAN, G, FR (SPARTANBURG, S.C.)

Petty averaged 16.0 points and 1.5 steals in two victories. She opened with 16 points, three steals and one block in the Blue Hose's home win over High Point on Dec. 29, and followed with another 16 markers in a victory at Charleston Southern on Jan. 2. Petty drained four three-pointers and shot 50 percent from the field against the Bucs. For the week, she was 10-of-21 overall (=47.6), 5-of-13 from long range (=38.5) and 7-of-9 from the charity stripe (=77.8).

GO FOUR IT

UNC Asheville is 4-0 in the Big South for the first time since starting 4-0 in 2003-04. It is the fifth consecutive season that a Big South member started league play at least 4-0, and Asheville is the sixth different program to achieve the feat since 2011-12. Meanwhile, the Bulldogs are seeking their first-ever 5-0 conference start this week.

MARGINAL NOTE

Through the first 20 Big South games, the visiting teams are 11-9 (=55.0 percent) and have won their 11 games by an average of 10.27 points. Nine of the 20 overall contests have been decided by less than 10 points (5.56 average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 10.1 points.

MOUNTAIN TOP

UNC Asheville leads the Big South with 74.5 points per game, the highest average in the conference since 1996-97 when former member UNC Greensboro led the league with 75.7 points per contest. The Bulldogs have been the Big South's top scoring team just once -- 1989-90 with a 73.0 average. Meanwhile, Asheville's +17.0 scoring margin is just behind the Big South single-season record of +17.2, which is currently held by Liberty (2009-10).

WHAT A STEAL!

Winthrop's **ALIYAH KILPATRICK**, who tied the Big South single-game record with 10 steals at College of Charleston on Dec. 22, leads the league and is second nationally with 4.08 steals per game -- currently the third-highest per game total in single-season history. The record is 4.32, set by Campbell's **JULIE SKINNER** in 1987-88. Kilpatrick has posted 27 steals in her last four games (=6.75) and has had at least five steals seven times. She is two steals shy of becoming the 37th player in league annals with 200 in a career.

SHE'S THE MANN

Charleston Southern's **ALYSSA MANN** leads the Big South with 16.3 points per game, and is looking to become the first Buccaneer to lead the league in scoring since **KATIE TULL** was tops with 16.0 points per outing in 2010-11. If Mann can maintain her position, she would be just the third CSU player to finish as the Big South's leading scorer. In addition to Tull, **CHRISSY KELLY** led the Big South in 1995-96 (16.1).

PARKING DECK

Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** became the 16th player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks when she eclipsed the scoring milestone during Dec. 31. She needs 36 boards to become just the ninth player with 1,000 points, 800 caroms and 125 blocks in a career.

KAT IN THE HAT

High Point's **KAT HARRIS** leads the Big South with an 88.9 free throw percentage (32-of-36), which is currently tied for the second-highest single-season clip in league history. Harris is looking to become just the second Big South player to make 90 percent of her free throws in a season (based on a minimum of 2.50 made per game), as the conference single-season record is 90.1 percent. Charleston Southern's **TRACEY DeLONG** established the mark in 1995-96 when she made 82-of-91 free throws.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** became the second player this season and 101st member of the Big South's 1,000-point club during the Bluefield game on Dec. 31. The Big South now has four active 1,000-point scorers, led by Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER**, who sits in 47th place with 1,244 career points. She is 225 away from entering the league's Top 25 scorers. Below is a look at where all four rank among the all-time leaders, as well as the next players closing in on the 1,000-point milestone:

MAY WE ASSIST YOU?

Campbell's **RaeCHAUN EDWARDS** became the 15th player in Big South history with 400 career assists and 200 career steals when she eclipsed the steals milestone Dec. 29 vs. Liberty. Edwards, who became the 19th player in Big South history with 400 career assists in the season opener, currently ranks 12th all-time with 452 and needs 48 to become the 10th player with 500 career helpers. Meanwhile, Liberty's **SADALIA ELLIS** is 48 assists away from 400 in her career, and would be the fifth Lady Flame on the league's all-time chart -- which would extend Liberty's Big South record.

STUFFING HER COFFERS

Campbell's **AMANDA COFFER** leads the Big South with 2.83 blocked shots per game, and is looking to become the first Campbell Camel to lead the conference in blocks. Coffe has 125 in her career, good for 17th all-time in Big South history. She needs 58 to enter the Top 10.

MAXIMUM EFFORT

Charleston Southern's **MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN** is third in the conference with 2.08 blocks per contest, the first Buccaneer averaging at least two blocks a game since **SHAUNTE SMALL** posted 2.03 per game in 2006-07. Maximilien's career total stands at 94, and is six away from becoming the 29th player in league annals with 100. Meanwhile, she became the 106th Big South player with 500 career rebounds when she eclipsed the milestone Dec. 29 at Longwood. Maximilien will become the fourth active player with 500 career boards and 100 career blocks once she reaches the 100-block plateau.

GOOD WORK YOUNG LADIES

A league-record four women's basketball players are official nominees for the Allstate WBCA Good Works Team®, as Coastal Carolina's **OLIVIA CARLTON**, Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER**, Presbyterian's **JANIE MILES** and UNC Asheville's **PAIGE LOVE** are among the 103 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA. The list will be pared down to a 10-person team featuring five Division I student-athletes in February.

RAGIN RININGER

Liberty redshirt-senior **ASHLEY RININGER** has missed the last three games due to injury. Upon her return, she will resume her pursuit of becoming the second player in league history with 1,500 points, 1,000 rebounds and 150 blocks. Her current career totals stand at 1,244 points, 864 boards and 145 rejections, and she needs to average 15.06 points, 8.00 rebounds and 0.29 blocks in the Lady Flames' remaining 17 scheduled games this season. Former Liberty star **KATIE FEENSTRA** is the lone member of the club, as she tallied 1,845 points, 1,033 rebounds and 257 blocks from 2001-05.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER** is the Big South's active-leading rebounder with 864, and needs 46 to enter the league's all-time Top 10. Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** is the 39th member of the 700-rebound club with 764, while Liberty's **KATELYN ADAMS** (680) and Gardner-Webb's **CANDACE BROWN** (652) are among the players with 600 career boards. Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS** is 19 rebounds away from 600. Below is a look at where all five rank among the all-time leaders, as well as the next players closing in on the 500-rebound milestone:

GARDNER-WEBB, COASTAL CAROLINA SCORE BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG WINS OF 2015-16

Gardner-Webb defeated North Carolina in the season opener, 66-65 in Chapel Hill, while Coastal Carolina knocked off Clemson during the opening weekend. It is the first time since 2006-07 (three wins) that the Big South has collected two victories over the ACC in the same year.

MAGIC WAND-A

Campbell head coach **WANDA WATKINS** needs eight wins for 550 in her coaching career, as she is 542-431 in 35 years in Buies Creek, which includes a 223-133 (.62.6 percent) in 14 total seasons in the Big South -- good for fourth in league history. She is six victories away from surpassing former Coastal Carolina coach **ALAN LeFORCE** (228) for third all-time. Watkins owns the second-most Big South victories with 129, and has recorded double-digit conference wins in her last eight seasons in the Big South -- 2011-to-present, and 1990-94 prior to the Camels' 17-year stay in the TAAC/Atlantic Sun from 1994-2011.

GREEN MACHINE

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** needs 11 wins for 400 in his coaching career. He entered the 2015-16 season ranked 13th all-time among active NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his 75.0 winning percentage -- ahead of renowned coaches **C. VIVIAN STRINGER**, **SYLVIA HATCHELL** and **BRENDA FRESE**. Green is the Big South's all-time winningest basketball coach -- men's or women's -- with his 389 overall wins, which includes 224 Big South victories.

CAMPBELL

Last week's loss to Liberty was CU's first loss in its Big South home opener since re-joining the league in 2011 ... **AMANDA COFFER** led the Lady Camels with an average of 12.5 points per game and 7.0 rebounds per game in two games last week. She recorded her fifth double-double of the season against Liberty with 16 points and a career-high 13 rebounds ... **RaeCHAUN EDWARDS** and **JESSICA PONE** each averaged 11.5 points per game last week with Edwards tallying 19 against Asheville ... Coffey became Campbell's all-time career block leader earlier this season, a feat she accomplished in less than two and a half seasons (now at 125).

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

SHAUNTAVIA DOBSON scored a career-high 29 points in CSU's win over Longwood last Tuesday, connecting on eight 3FG in the game. Dobson's eight treys tied for third all-time in a single game with **JOY GALLOWAY**, while her 17 3FG attempts tied for second all-time in the CSU single game record books ... **ALYSSA MANN** combined with Dobson with 16 points in the Bucs' win over the Lancers, her first double-digit scoring effort of the season in Big South play ... **ELYSE KIPLOKS** has crashed the boards in the past two games and averaged 7.0 rebounds per game over the week ... **ALECIA HARDY** had a season-high four steals off the bench and paced the Bucs on Saturday against Presbyterian.

COASTAL CAROLINA

At Gardner-Webb, **RACHAEL GREGORY** was one rebound shy of being the first Chant to record a double-double this season as the graduate transfer recorded 19 points and nine rebounds. Gregory's 19 points matched her career high, and her rebound total was a personal best ... Coastal continued its strong offensive rebounding as just under half (47 percent) of its total rebounds came off the offensive glass ... Outside shooting has been one of the Chants' strengths this season, but over half of Coastal's points against Gardner-Webb came in the paint.

GARDNER-WEBB

GWU defeated NAIA opponent Bluefield College, 64-51, on New Year's Eve before dropping a 59-56 matchup against Coastal Carolina on Saturday ... The loss to Coastal Carolina was just the second defeat for Gardner-Webb on its home court this season and just the second victory by the Chanticleers in Boiling Springs since GWU joined the Division I ranks in 2000-01 ... After winning six of their first seven games, the Runnin' Bulldogs have lost four of their last five.

HIGH POINT

KAT HARRIS tallied a career-high 17 points to go along with four rebounds and four assists at Presbyterian last Tuesday. **KAYLAH KEYS** scored in double figures for the 10th consecutive game and is now second in the league in scoring with 16.1 points per game. Freshman **EMMA BOCKRATH** finished one point shy of a season-high with 14 points while equalling her season-high with eight rebounds against the Blue Hose ... The Panthers (3-9, 2-1) look to move to 3-1 and stay among the conference leaders on Monday when they host Charleston Southern (7-6, 2-2).

LIBERTY

Liberty has won a season-best three straight games following a 3-7 start. All three wins have come without injured leading scorer **ASHLEY RININGER** ... **CATHERINE KEARNEY** scored a career-high 22 points at Campbell on Dec. 29, becoming the first Lady Flame with back-to-back 20-point games since Rininger on Jan. 16 & 18, 2014 ... The Lady Flames' 49-43 win at Radford on Jan. 2 marked their first victory when scoring less than 50 points since a 45-43 triumph at Virginia Tech in 2008 ... The Lady Flames have won 15 straight Big South home games since a 94-89 double overtime loss to High Point on Jan. 30, 2014 ... Liberty, which opened the month with a win at Radford, is 115-16 in January contests under **CAREY GREEN**.

LONGWOOD

KEMARI JONES has come on strong in her last six games, averaging 7.8 points in that stretch after starting the year averaging just 3.4 points in her first five games. The freshman averaged 10.0 RPG and 9.5 PPG in two outings last week ... **KYNDAL SKERSICK** continues to be strong for the Lancers, as she has scored in double figures in nine of her last 11 games ... **DAEISHA BROWN** has climbed to sixth in the league in FT percentage, as she has hit 19 of her last 20 free throws in her last five games ... **EBONI GILLIAM** has grabbed six or more rebounds in eight games this season.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC is in the midst of a three-game winning streak after a 63-49 win at Charleston Southern, its longest of the season. The Blue Hose won all their games in a given week for the first time this season ... The Blue Hose lead the Big South in free throw percentage (73.4), rebounding defense (33.9), turnover margin (+3.33) and three-pointers made (6.7). PC sits second in the conference in scoring defense (57.2), scoring margin (+7.5) and assist to turnover ratio (0.8) ... **CORTNEY STOREY** is second in the conference with 3.9 assists per game, while **TAYLOR PETTY** sits second with 2.54 3FG made per game.

RADFORD

Radford split its pair of Big South games last week, defeating Coastal Carolina (61-45) before falling to Liberty (49-43) ... The Highlanders' loss to Liberty ended their 13-game home winning streak ... **GABY GILMORE** delivered a career-high 19 points in RU's victory over the Chanticleers ... The Highlanders outrebounded both opponents and have now won the rebounding battle in 10 of their 12 games ... Radford has held its last three opponents below 50 points, marking the first time that has happened since the 2006-07 season.

UNC ASHEVILLE

Last Saturday's win against Campbell was the first time that Asheville has defeated Campbell since the Camels re-joined the Big South in 2011. Three Bulldogs scored in double figures in the win - **CHATORI MAJOR** (17), **TIANNA KNUCKLES** (15) and **JADA BRAYBOY** (12) ... Asheville leads the Big South in four statistical categories: rebounding margin, three-point field goal percentage, scoring offense and field goal percentage ... The Bulldogs' 11 wins already matches the most wins in a season since head coach **BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK** took over the program in 2012.

WINTHROP

Winthrop got career-high rebound performances from freshman **ARIANNE WHITAKER** and **RONATA ROGERS** in the Longwood game, as Whitaker pulled down 14 rebounds while Rogers grabbed 15. Whitaker also recorded a career-high 8 blocked shots against the Lancers ... The Eagles got back-to-back career-high scoring performances last week from point guard **JIMECHEIA BANKS**. She had 12 points at Asheville followed by 13 points against Longwood ... Winthrop's five straight losses are the most since the Eagles had that same streak during the 2010-11 season, and its 2-11 start equals that of the 2004-05 squad.
