PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - JAN. 4

PLAYER OF THE WEEK - DESEAN MURRAY, PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE, F. SOPH (STANLEY, N.C.)

Murray averaged 22.0 points, 12.0 rebounds (5.0 offensive), 2.0 blocks and 2.0 steals in two games, as he recorded 20-point/10-rebound efforts in road contests at Marquette and Campbell. He opened with 20 points, 11 rebounds, three steals and two blocks at Marquette on Dec. 27. Murray then posted 24 points, 13 boards and two blocks to lead PC past Campbell on Jan. 2. He scored 16 points in the second half to stave off several Camel rallies. For the week, Murray was 19-of-37 from the floor (51.4 percent) and was 6-of-10 from the free throw line.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - DYLAN SMITH, UNC ASHEVILLE, G. FR (MOBILE, ALA.)

Smith averaged 18.7 points, 4.0 rebounds and 1.3 steals in helping Asheville go 3-0. He opened with 20 points, five rebounds and the game-winning bucket against Furman on Dec. 29. Smith dropped another 20 in the next game at Longwood on Dec. 31, and finished with 16 points in a victory at Liberty on Jan. 2. For the week, Smith was 16-of-39 from the field (=41.0), 9-of-24 from three-point range (=37.5) and 15-of-18 from the charity stripe (=83.3).

THE IMPORTANCE OF A GREAT START

High Point has opened 4-0 in Big South games for the first time since 2006-07 (6-0) and just the second time overall as conference members. The Panthers have now won their first three Big South games four times since joining the league, and the previous three times (2003-04, 2004-05 and 2006-07), HPU reached the Conference Semifinals. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville has started 3-0 for the second consecutive year and league-record tying ninth time. The Bulldogs are looking for their first 4-0 start since 2011-12 (8-0).

MARGINAL NOTE

Through 19 Big South games, the visiting teams are 9-10 (=47.4 percent), and are seeking their fourth road winning percentage at or above 40.0 percent in five years. The highest road win percentage in league games since 2002-03 was 46.7 percent in 2008-09. Meanwhile, 14 of the 19 overall contests have been decided by less than 10 points (4.93 average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 8.42 points. The 2014-15 margin was 10.76, compared to 9.83 in 2013-14.

ESPNU GOING WILD FOR THE BIG SOUTH - SELECTS HIGH POINT AT WINTHROP FOR JAN. 14

ESPNU has selected High Point at Winthrop as its "Wildcard" broadcast selection for Thursday, Jan. 14. **KEVIN FITZGERALD** (play-by-play) and **ADRIAN BRANCH** (analyst) will handle the call from courtside at the Winthrop Coliseum. For the third consecutive season, four regular-season Big South games will appear on ESPNU in 2015-16. The 24-hour college sports network will televise one January game and three February contests, which will be "Wildcard" selections 21 days in advance. The remaining three telecasts are Thursday, Feb. 11 at 9:00pm; Thursday, Feb. 18 at 7:00pm, and Thursday, Feb. 25 at 9:00pm.

BIG SOUTH'S ESPN3 GAME OF THE WEEK TIPS OFF THIS WEEK

The Big South "Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 returns this season with the first broadcast being the Campbell at Liberty contest on Saturday, Jan. 9 live at 2:00pm. **MIKE HOGWOOD** (play-by-play) and **JEFF JACKSON** (analyst) will call the action from the Vines Center in Lynchburg, Va. For the fourth consecutive year, ESPN3 will exclusively carry eight Big South matchups, in addition to all four quarterfinal games of the 2016 Men's Basketball Championship tournament for the third straight year.

BIG SOUTH CAGERS TO MAKE SEASON DEBUT ON ASN NEXT SATURDAY

Big South basketball will again appear on the American Sports Network (ASN) in 2015-16, as seven games are scheduled for broadcast. The first telecast will be the Jan. 16 Charleston Southern at Campbell contest. Clearances for the game will be made available during game week.

C-SQUARED

Campbell freshman guard **CHRIS CLEMONS** is the Big South's leading freshman scorer with 17.6 points per game -- good for 4th among all freshman nationally. He ranks fourth overall in the league in scoring. Clemons' 3.07 3FG per game is second in the league, and he is challenging the conference's freshman mark of 3.31, set by Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** in 2013-14. Meanwhile, Clemons is tops in the Big South with a 91.7 free throw percentage (44-of-48), which is pacing ahead of the league's freshman mark of 88.9 percent and just trails the overall single-season record of 92.5.

HIGH POINT DUO BROWN, WEARY JOIN FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE 1,000-POINT SCORERS

High Point duo **JOHN BROWN** and **ADAM WEARY** are the 21st pair of Big South four-year classmates with 1,000 points during the same four-year span. Brown is at 1,964, while Weary sits at 1,037, and the two are just the fifth four-year duo to combine for 3,000 points (3,001). They need 467 points to move into fourth. Meanwhile, fellow classmate **LORENZO CUGINI** is 90 points away from 1,000 in his career, which would mark just the third time a senior trio had 1,000 points during the same four-year period.

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

Radford senior guards **RASHUN DAVIS** and **YAYA ANDERSON** became the 20th pair of Big South four-year classmates to score 1,000 points during the same four-year period on Dec. 9 when Anderson eclipsed the milestone. Davis is currently at 1,075 career points, while Anderson stands at 1,025. Their combined total of 2,100 is 154 points away from the 20th-highest point combination for a four-year duo with 1,000 points each.

BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** is the second player in Big South history with 1,900 points (1,964), 700 rebounds (710), 100 blocked shots (149), 100 steals (158) and 100 assists (154). He is on track to be the first player in league annals with 2,000 points, 800 rebounds, 150 steals, 150 blocked shots and 150 assists by the end of the 2015-16 campaign. Meanwhile, Brown is sixth in Big South history with 751 career field goals, and needs 24 to enter the all-time top five. He is eighth in the conference record book with 462 career free throws made.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** (5th player this season) and Gardner-Webb's **TYRELL NELSON** (6th) became the 140th and 141st players, respectively, in the Big South's 1,000-point club last week. The Big South now has seven active 1,000-point scorers, led by High Point's **JOHN BROWN**, who sits in 10th-place in league annals with 1,964 career points. He is 36 away from becoming the ninth player in league history with 2,000 in a career. Below is a look at where all seven rank among the all-time leaders, as well as the next players closing in on the 1,000-point milestone:

BADOU'S BOARDS

Coastal Carolina's **BADOU DIAGNE** became the 50th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone against Grace Bible College on Nov. 18, and is currently tied for 36th with 676. He needs 24 to become the 31st player with 700, and has an outside chance of joining the league's 1,000-point, 700-rebound and 100-blocked shot club, as his career totals include 908 points and 83 blocked shots.

HIGH TOPS

Radford senior **RASHUN DAVIS** is the Big South's active career assist leader with 374, and is 26 away from becoming the 26th member of the league's 400-assist club. With 1,075 career points, he is poised to be the 21st player in conference annals with 1,000 points and 400 assists. Meanwhile, teammate **BRANDON HOLCOMB** has 490 rebounds and should become the just the 24th player in the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club. Holcomb is 22nd all-time in league history with 130 career blocked shots.

BUC-ETS

Charleston Southern leads the Big South with 10.79 three-pointers per game, the highest average in the league since 2010-11 when VMI averaged 11.32 triples that season, which is also the last time a Big South member averaged at least 10.00 per contest. CSU, which has led the conference in three-pointers per game every year since 2012-13, has never averaged double-digit treys per game.

TAKING FLIGHT

Winthrop leads the Big South with 83.5 points per game, the highest scoring average in the league in two seasons. The Eagles have led the Big South in scoring average just twice, with the last time coming in 1992-93 (83.6 average). The first time was in the conference's first year of men's basketball in 1985-86. That season Winthrop was tops with 79.8 points per game.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is the third-active winningest coach in Division I with 778 career victories and notched his 700th Division I win Jan. 2 against Winthrop. He is 19th all-time in NCAA history for career wins (regardless of affiliation with a minimum 10 head coaching seasons at NCAA schools), and is the sixth-active winningest coach across all NCAA classifications. He became the first head coach in NCAA history with 150 wins at four different Division I programs with the Chanticleers' 68-56 victory over UNC Asheville on Feb. 3, 2015. His Division I school-by-school breakdown is as follows: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 166, in addition to 78 wins during his three seasons leading Cumberland College from 1972-75.

DUBY-DUBY-DO

Winthrop redshirt-sophomore **DUBY OKEKE** leads the Big South with 2.82 blocks per game. He has recorded multiple blocks in nine of his 11 appearances this season, including two games with four and two with five. The last (and only) Winthrop player to lead the Big South in blocked shots was **JOSH GRANT** in 2002-03 (2.28). Meanwhile, Okeke's career total stands at 77, and is 23 away from becoming the first Winthrop player with 100 career blocked shots since **BILLY HOUSTON** eclipsed the mark during the 2004-05 campaign. Just three Eagles reside in the Big South's 100-blocked shot club: Houston (139 from 2002-06), Grant (125 from 2001-04) and **TYRONE WALKER** (105 from 2000-04).

BIG THINGS COME IN SMALL PACKAGES

Winthrop 5-7 guard **KEON JOHNSON** is second in the Big South with 20.5 points per game, and is looking to become just the second Eagle to average 20.0 points since the Big South began sponsoring men's basketball in 1985-86. That year was the last time a Winthrop player averaged 20.0 points, as **FRED McKINNON** averaged a league-best 21.1 points that first season. Meanwhile, Johnson's three 30-point games this season has tied the program career record established by **TORRELL MARTIN**.

HIGH POINT'S JOHN BROWN COLLECTS SEVERAL PRESEASON HONORS

For the third consecutive year, High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** was voted the Big South Conference Men's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's head coaches and media panel. He is the first men's player in Big South history to be named Preseason Player of the Year in three consecutive seasons. Named to the Lou Henson Preseason Player of the Year Watch List, Brown is one of 20 initial preseason candidates for the Julius Erving Award, which is given annually to the top small forward in men's college basketball. He is the only player from a mid-major program on the watch list. Brown is looking to become just the second player in Big South history with **FOUR** First-Team All-Conference selections.

DISCOUNT DOUBLE CHECK

Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** owns the Big South's active leading double-figure scoring streak at 18 games, dating back to last season. Campbell's **CHRIS CLEMONS** is next at 14 games, followed by Presbyterian College's **DeSEAN MURRAY** (10).

DAILY DOUBLE

Radford's wins over two Power 5 conferences marks the fourth time in the last six seasons that a Big South member has achieved this feat. Last season, it was Gardner-Webb (Clemson, Purdue), and prior to that, it was Coastal Carolina (LSU, Clemson in 2011-12) and Presbyterian (Auburn, Wake Forest in 2010-11).

ANOTHER YEAR OF BIG WINS FOR THE BIG SOUTH

The Big South Conference is 2-1 against BIG EAST this season, with both wins over Georgetown. The last time the Big South had two wins vs. the BIG EAST was in 2012-13. Radford downed the Hoyas in double-overtime in its season opener, followed by UNC Asheville on Dec. 19. In addition, the Highlanders defeated Penn State, 86-74 in State College, Pa., on Nov. 26, 12 days after the Georgetown victory. The win over the Nittany Lions marks the second straight year the Big South has defeated a Big Ten member. The Big South has defeated a BIG EAST member four times in the past five seasons, and the last time the Big South had wins over both the BIG EAST and Big Ten in the same year was 2011-12.

THE BIG 5-0

Gardner-Webb third-year head coach **TIM CRAFT** is four wins away from 50 in his brief coaching career, and is looking to become just the 10th coach in Big South history to reach 50 overall wins in his third season in the league. Fellow third-year leader **NICK McDEVITT** of UNC Asheville is eight wins shy of 50 victories at his school, as is Liberty's **RITCHIE McKAY**, who is also in his third year on the Flames' sideline.

CLIMBING THE VICTORY LADDER

High Point's **SCOTT CHERRY** needs one victory to move into a tie for 10th all-time in Big South history for most coaching victories, as he is tied with **RANDY PEELE** for 11th with 107 wins. Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is the Big South's active win leader with 166 wins, which ranks fourth in the conference record books. Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is the longest-tenured active Big South coach, as he is in his 11th year in 2015-16 -- just the third head coach in League history with at least 10 years of service. He sits in sixth-place all-time with 144 victories. Here is a look at the Big South's Top 10 winningest coaches:

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

TYRELL NELSON surpassed 1,000 points and 500 rebounds during the Longwood game last week.

HIGH POINT

HPU closed the CSU game with a 17-4 run to prevail, 78-73, and held the Bucs scoreless over the final 4:24. JOHN BROWN posted a game-high 27 points and tallied seven rebounds, three steals and two blocks. The win marked High Point's first victory in the Buc Dome since the 2008-09 season ... JORGE PEREZ-LAHAM posted a career-high 14 points while Brown added 14 points and 10 rebounds in the Panthers' win over Radford. Longwood has forced its last three opponents into an average of 17.7 turnovers per game ... DARRION ALLEN has scored in double figures in three straight games (14.3 average), the longest such stretch of his career. He posted his first career double-double with a season-high 18 points and 10 rebounds in a 67-66 loss to Gardner-Webb Saturday ...
