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PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - JAN. 11

PLAYER OF THE WEEK - JANAYLA WHITE, RADFORD, F. SOPH (VIRGINIA BEACH, VA.)

White led the Highlanders with an average of 15.0 points, 11.0 rebounds and 2.5 blocks in helping Radford to a pair of conference victories over Presbyterian College and Winthrop last week. White shined in the home win over the Eagles, scoring 18 points to go along with her game-high 15 rebounds. The sophomore also totaled 12 points and four blocks in RU's 64-53 road win over the Blue Hose to open the week. White closed the pair of contests 10-for-14 (71.4 percent) from the field.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - TAYLOR PETTY, PRESBYTERIAN, G. FR (SPARTANBURG, S.C.)

Petty, who claimed her second straight Freshman of the Week nod, headlined her week with an 18-point performance in Presbyterian's setback to Radford on Monday. The Spartanburg, S.C., native was 5-for-11 (45.5 percent) from the field, including a 4-for-8 mark from 3-point range.

MARGINAL NOTE

Through the first 30 Big South games, the visiting teams are 17-13 (=56.7 percent) and have won their 17 games by an average of 11.41 points. Twelve of the 30 overall contests have been decided by less than 10 points (5.67 average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 11.77 points.

GO FOUR IT

UNC Asheville opened 4-0 in the Big South for the first time since starting 4-0 in 2003-04. It was the fifth consecutive season that a Big South member started league play at least 4-0, and Asheville was the sixth different program to achieve the feat since 2011-12.

MOUNTAIN TOP

UNC Asheville leads the Big South with 71.9 points per game, and are looking to lead the Big South in scoring for just the second time. The Bulldogs' lone appearance as the Big South's top scoring team occurred in 1989-90 with a 73.0 average. Meanwhile, Asheville's +14.1 scoring margin leads the conference as well, and is a category the Bulldogs have never finished as the league leader. The Big South single-season record for scoring margin is +17.2, which was set by Liberty in 2009-10.

KAT IN THE HAT

High Point's **KAT HARRIS** leads the Big South with an 90.0 free throw percentage (36-of-40), which is currently the second-highest single-season clip in league history. Harris is looking to become just the second Big South player to make 90 percent of her free throws in a season (based on a minimum of 2.50 made per game), as the conference single-season record is 90.1 percent. Charleston Southern's **TRACEY DeLONG** established the mark in 1995-96 when she made 82-of-91 free throws.

WHAT A STEAL!

Winthrop's **ALIYAH KILPATRICK**, who tied the Big South single-game record with 10 steals at College of Charleston on Dec. 22, leads the league and is third nationally with 4.08 steals per game -- currently the third-highest per game total in single-season history. The record is 4.32, set by Campbell's **JULIE SKINNER** in 1987-88. Kilpatrick has posted 27 steals in her last four games (=6.75) and has had at least five steals seven times. She is two steals shy of becoming the 37th player in league annals with 200 in a career.

KEYS TO THE CITY

High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS** leads the Big South with 16.4 points per game, and is looking to become the first Panther to lead the league in scoring since **KATIE O'DELL** was tops with 14.3 points per outing in 2005-06. If Keys can maintain her position, she would be just the second HPU player to finish as the Big South's leading scorer since the Panthers joined the conference in 1998-99.

PARKING DECK

Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** became the 16th player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks when she eclipsed the scoring milestone during Dec. 31. She needs 19 boards to become just the ninth player with 1,000 points, 800 caroms and 125 blocks in a career.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** became the second player this season and 101st member of the Big South's 1,000-point club during the Bluefield game on Dec. 31. The Big South now has four active 1,000-point scorers, led by High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS**, who sits in 46th place with 1,250 career points. Below is a look at where all four rank among the all-time leaders, as well as the next players closing in on the 1,000-point milestone:

MAY WE ASSIST YOU?

Campbell's **RaeCHAUN EDWARDS** became the 15th player in Big South history with 400 career assists and 200 career steals when she eclipsed the steals milestone Dec. 29 vs. Liberty. Edwards, who became the 19th player in Big South history with 400 career assists in the season opener, currently ranks 12th all-time with 462 and needs 38 to become the 10th player with 500 career helpers. Meanwhile, Liberty's **SADALIA ELLIS** (358) is 42 assists away from 400 in her career, and would be the fifth Lady Flame on the league's all-time chart -- which would extend Liberty's Big South record.

STUFFING HER COFFERS

Campbell's **AMANDA COFFER** is second in the Big South with 2.57 blocked shots per game -- just 0.05 off the lead, and is looking to become the first Campbell Camel to lead the conference in blocks. Coffe has 127 in her career, good for 17th all-time in Big South history. She needs 56 to enter the Top 10.

MAXIMUM EFFORT

Charleston Southern's **MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN** is third in the conference with 2.07 blocks per contest, the first Buccaneer averaging at least two blocks a game since **SHAUNTE SMALL** posted 2.03 per game in 2006-07. Maximilien's career total stands at 98, and is two away from becoming the 29th player in league annals with 100. Meanwhile, she became the 106th Big South player with 500 career rebounds when she eclipsed the milestone Dec. 29 at Longwood. Maximilien will become the fourth active player with 500 career boards and 100 career blocks once she reaches the 100-block plateau.

GOOD WORK YOUNG LADIES

A league-record four women's basketball players are official nominees for the Allstate WBCA Good Works Team®, as Coastal Carolina's **OLIVIA CARLTON**, Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER**, Presbyterian's **JANIE MILES** and UNC Asheville's **PAIGE LOVE** are among the 103 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA. The list will be pared down to a 10-person team featuring five Division I student-athletes in February.

RAGIN RININGER

Liberty redshirt-senior **ASHLEY RININGER** has missed the last five games due to injury. Upon her return, she will resume her pursuit of becoming the second player in league history with 1,500 points, 1,000 rebounds and 150 blocks. Her current career totals stand at 1,244 points, 864 boards and 145 rejections, and she needs to average 17.07 points, 9.07 rebounds and 0.33 blocks in the Lady Flames' remaining 15 scheduled games this season. Former Liberty star **KATIE FEENSTRA** is the lone member of the club, as she tallied 1,845 points, 1,033 rebounds and 257 blocks from 2001-05.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER** is the Big South's active-leading rebounder with 864, and needs 46 to enter the league's all-time Top 10. Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** is the 39th member of the 700-rebound club with 781, while Liberty's **KATELYN ADAMS** (697) and Gardner-Webb's **CANDACE BROWN** (661) are among the players with 600 career boards. Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS** is 11 rebounds away from 600. Below is a look at where all five rank among the all-time leaders, as well as the next players closing in on the 500-rebound milestone:

GARDNER-WEBB, COASTAL CAROLINA SCORE BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG WINS OF 2015-16

Gardner-Webb defeated North Carolina in the season opener, 66-65 in Chapel Hill, while Coastal Carolina knocked off Clemson during the opening weekend. It is the first time since 2006-07 (three wins) that the Big South has collected two victories over the ACC in the same year.

MAGIC WAND-A

Campbell head coach **WANDA WATKINS** needs seven wins for 550 in her coaching career, as she is 543-432 in 35 years in Buies Creek, which includes a 224-134 (.62.6 percent) in 14 total seasons in the Big South -- good for fourth in league history. She is five victories away from surpassing former Coastal Carolina coach **ALAN LeFORCE** (228) for third all-time. Watkins owns the second-most Big South victories with 130, and has recorded double-digit conference wins in her last eight seasons in the Big South -- 2011-to-present, and 1990-94 prior to the Camels' 17-year stay in the TAAC/Atlantic Sun from 1994-2011.

GREEN MACHINE

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** needs 10 wins for 400 in his coaching career. He entered the 2015-16 season ranked 13th all-time among active NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his 75.0 winning percentage -- ahead of renowned coaches **C. VIVIAN STRINGER**, **SYLVIA HATCHELL** and **BRENDA FRESE**. Green is the Big South's all-time winningest basketball coach -- men's or women's -- with his 390 overall wins, which includes 225 Big South victories.

CAMPBELL

AMANDA COFFER led the Lady Camels in two games last week with an average of 15.5 points per game between both contests and 5.5 rebounds per game. She recorded her ninth and 10th double-figure scoring efforts of the season with 13 points against the Runnin' Bulldogs and 18 against the Lancers ... **BRIA EMANUEL** averaged 8.5 points and rebounds between both contests and scored a career-high 13 points at Longwood.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern picked up its second Big South road win of the season last Monday behind **ELYSE KIPLOKS'** 10 points, five rebounds and two blocked shots against High Point. The junior forward connected on a late jumper, then blocked a HPU potential game-tying shot in the final minute to seal the Bucs' win ... **Nayla Long** scored a career-high 15 points in CSU's 64-62 win over High Point. The junior guard established career highs in field goals (6), three-pointers (2) and steals (2) in the Bucs' win over the Panthers.

COASTAL CAROLINA

CED GIBSON led Coastal with 16 points against Longwood last week, nine of which came in the fourth quarter as the junior guard helped erase an 18-point deficit and bring the Chants within four with less than a minute to play. Gibson has finished first or second in scoring in three of Coastal's last four games ... **JAS ADAMS** is the only Chant to reach double figure rebounds in a game this season ... For the fourth time in its last five games, Coastal surpassed 15 offensive rebounds and ranks 13th in the NCAA in offensive boards per game.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb went 2-0 with victories at Campbell and against High Point. The win at Campbell was just the second time since GWU moved to Division I (2000-01) that it won in Buies Creek. GWU tied a season-high with eight three-pointers in the victory ... The Runnin' Bulldogs recorded an 82-70 victory over High Point Saturday afternoon in Boiling Springs. The team shot 49.1% in the victory for the second-best shooting performance this season.

HIGH POINT

KAYLAH KEYS averaged 18.5 points per game on the week and is now the leading scorer in the conference (16.4). Keys posted 24 points against Charleston Southern while also racking up a career-high six steals ... Freshman **EMMA BOCKRATH** tallied a career high with 17 points on 7-of-8 shooting in a road game at Gardner-Webb on Saturday ... **KAT HARRIS** leads the league in free throw shooting at 90.0 and Keys is second shooting at a 80.9 clip. Keys and Harris are the top two scorers on the roster with next five top scorers being freshmen.

LIBERTY

Liberty's 71-53 home win over UNC Asheville on Jan. 4 was the Lady Flames' 16th straight home victory over a Big South opponent ... After recording zero 20-point games during her first 102 career appearances, **CATHERINE KEARNEY** has scored 20+ points three times in the last five outings. That includes a 22-point effort on 11-of-12 from the field versus Asheville on Jan. 4 ... **JAYMEE FISHER-DAVIS** made a career-high five three-pointers at Presbyterian on Jan. 9, becoming the 10th Lady Flame ever to sink 100 or more career triples. She enters the week tied with **SARAH WILKERSON** for eighth place in program history with 104 career three-pointers made ... Liberty enters Saturday's matchup with Winthrop having recorded 23 straight home wins over the Eagles.

LONGWOOD

DAEISHA BROWN tallied 32 combined points in Longwood's last two games, as she is now 59 points shy of joining the 1,000 point club ... With her nine boards in Saturday's game, junior college transfer **EBONI GILLIAM** has now posted 6+ blocks in 10 of her first 15 games at the Division I level ... Longwood enjoyed its best defensive performance of the year at Coastal Carolina, holding the Chanticleers to .250 shooting which marks the lowest shooting percentage for a Longwood opponent this season.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose knocked off conference favorite Liberty, 60-42, Saturday at the Templeton Center. It was the first time a Big South opponent defeated Liberty by double digits since March 3, 2007 ... PC jumped to second place in the Big South Conference standings after the 60-42 win over Liberty on Saturday. **REBECCA WALKER** led all scorers with a career-high 18 points in the game ... The Blue Hose sit first in the conference in free throw percentage (73.9), turnover margin (+3.53) and three-pointers made per game (6.9).

RADFORD

Radford won back-to-back Big South games for the first time this season, stealing a 64-53 win at Presbyterian College before returning home to take care of Winthrop, 66-44 ... The Highlanders improved to 6-1 at home this season and have won 14 of their last 15 games inside the Dedmon Center ... **JANAYLA WHITE** notched her third double-double of the season in the victory over Winthrop, tallying 18 points and 15 rebounds ... The Highlanders out-rebounded both opponents and have now won the rebounding battle in 12 of their 14 games ... Radford ranks in the top three in 11 statistical categories in the Big South. RU has the top mark in seven of those.

UNC ASHEVILLE

Asheville's 12 wins this season is the most for the Bulldogs in a season in the **BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK** era ... The Bulldogs have a rebounding margin of +6.1 on the season. Asheville has out-rebounded ITS opponents in all of their wins this season except for one, a non-conference road game against Western Carolina. On average, the Bulldogs pull down 41.6 to per game their opponents 35.5 ... Three of Asheville's five conference wins have been decided by the start of the third quarter.

WINTHROP

Winthrop's injury problems worsened before and during the Radford game last Saturday as freshman center **ARIANNE WHITAKER** missed the game due to concussion protocol and sophomore point guard **JIMECHEIA BANKS** played just four minutes after suffering an ankle sprain in the early going. Add to those issue, junior guard **ALIYAH KILPATRICK** was not available due to a death in her family ... Leading scorer **ERICA WILLIAMS**, who had missed the two previous games due to a bone bruise in her foot, returned to action and led the Eagles with 20 points and eight rebounds while playing 38 minutes.
