## PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - JAN. 11

### PLAYER OF THE WEEK - TYRELL NELSON, GARDNER-WEBB, F, JR (CHARLOTTE, N.C.)

Nelson averaged 23.0 points, 13.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists in helping Gardner-Webb win two Big South games last week. He opened his week with 27 points and 16 rebounds -- including 17 and 11 in the second half alone -- to lead the Runnin' Bulldogs in a 71-68 come-from-behind victory over Campbell. He posted 10 offensive rebounds and was 10-of-12 from the field. Nelson then posted 19 points and 10 boards against Radford on Saturday for his seventh double-double of the season. For the week, he was 17-of-24 from the field (=70.8 percent) and 11-of-16 from the charity stripe (=68.8).

### THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - DWAYNE SUTTON, UNC ASHEVILLE, G, FR (LOUISVILLE, Ky.)

Sutton averaged 15.5 points, 10.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.5 steals in two wins last week. He scored 13 points with seven rebounds and four steals against Winthrop last Wednesday, and followed with 18 points, 13 caroms and four assists at Charleston Southern on Saturday. For the week, Sutton was 8-of-18 from the field and 15-of-20 from the free throw line (=75.0).

## BIG SOUTH 2,000-POINT ODYSSEY

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** enters this week needing 17 points to become just the ninth player in Big South history with 2,000 career points. Brown is ninth all-time in league history with 1,983 and would be the third Panther in the conference's 2,000-point club once he reaches the milestone. He could very well finish as the Big South's second-leading all-time scorer.

## ESPNU GOING WILD FOR THE BIG SOUTH - SELECTS HIGH POINT AT WINTHROP FOR JAN. 14

ESPNU selected High Point at Winthrop as its "Wildcard" broadcast selection for Thursday, Jan. 14. **KEVIN FITZGERALD** (play-by-play) and **ADRIAN BRANCH** (analyst) will handle the call from courtside at the Winthrop Coliseum. For the third consecutive season, four regular-season Big South games will appear on ESPNU in 2015-16. The 24-hour college sports network will televise one January game and three February contests, which will be "Wildcard" selections 21 days in advance. The remaining three telecasts are Thursday, Feb. 11 at 9:00pm; Thursday, Feb. 18 at 7:00pm, and Thursday, Feb. 25 at 9:00pm. The Feb. 11 selection will be made the week of Jan. 18.

## THE IMPORTANCE OF A GREAT START

High Point has opened 5-0 in Big South games for the first time since 2006-07 (6-0) and just the second time overall as conference members. UNC Asheville has started 5-0 for the first time since 2011-12 (8-0) and seventh time during its Big South affiliation. It is the first time since 2010-11 (Coastal Carolina and Liberty) that two teams opened league play 5-0 and just the fourth time overall.

## MARGINAL NOTE

Through 29 Big South games, the home teams are 18-11 (.62.1 percent), and are seeking their first home winning percentage at or above 60.0 percent since a 63.5 success rate in 2012-13. Meanwhile, 19 of the 29 overall contests (.65.5 percent) have been decided by less than 10 points (4.42 average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 8.66 points. The 2014-15 margin was 10.76, compared to 9.83 in 2013-14.

## BIG SOUTH'S ESPN3 GAME OF THE WEEK CONTINUES THIS WEEK

The Big South "Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 continues this week with the next broadcast being the Coastal Carolina at High Point contest on Saturday, Jan. 16 live at 7:00pm. **MIKE HOGWOOD** (play-by-play) and **RALPH PATTERSON** (analyst) will call the action from the Millis Center in High Point, N.C. For the fourth consecutive year, ESPN3 will exclusively carry eight Big South matchups, in addition to all four quarterfinal games of the 2016 Men's Basketball Championship tournament for the third straight year.

## BIG SOUTH CAGERS TO MAKE SEASON DEBUT ON ASN SATURDAY

Big South basketball will again appear on the American Sports Network (ASN) in 2015-16, as seven games are scheduled for broadcast. The first telecast will be Saturday's Charleston Southern at Campbell contest live from Buies Creek with **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) on the call. Clearances for the game will be made available later this week.

## C-SQUARED

Campbell freshman guard **CHRIS CLEMONS** is the Big South's leading freshman scorer with 16.9 points per game -- good for 7th among all freshman nationally. He ranks fourth overall in the league in scoring. Clemons' 3.06 3FG per game is second in the league, and he is challenging the conference's freshman mark of 3.31, set by Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** in 2013-14. Meanwhile, Clemons is tops in the Big South with an 87.5 free throw percentage (49-of-56), which just trails the league's freshman mark of 88.9 percent.

## HIGH POINT DUO BROWN, WEARY JOIN FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE 1,000-POINT SCORERS

High Point duo **JOHN BROWN** and **ADAM WEARY** are the 21st pair of Big South four-year classmates with 1,000 points during the same four-year span. Brown is at 1,983, while Weary sits at 1,048, and the two are just the fifth four-year duo to combine for 3,000 points (3,031). They need 437 points to move into fourth. Meanwhile, fellow classmate **LORENZO CUGINI** is 78 points away from 1,000 in his career, which would mark just the third time a senior trio had 1,000 points during the same four-year period.

## BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

Radford senior guards **RASHUN DAVIS** and **YAYA ANDERSON** became the 20th pair of Big South four-year classmates to score 1,000 points during the same four-year period on Dec. 9 when Anderson eclipsed the milestone. Davis is currently at 1,109 career points, while Anderson stands at 1,054. Their combined total of 2,163 is 91 points away from the 20th-highest point combination for a four-year duo with 1,000 points each.

## BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** is the only player in Big South history with 1,900 points (1,983), 700 rebounds (717), 150 blocked shots (154), 150 steals (161) and 150 assists (157). Meanwhile, Brown is sixth in Big South history with 759 career field goals, and needs 16 to enter the all-time top five. He is eighth in the conference record book with 465 career free throws made.

## BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** (5th player this season) and Gardner-Webb's **TYRELL NELSON** (6th) became the 140th and 141st players, respectively, in the Big South's 1,000-point club the week of Dec. 28. The Big South now has seven active 1,000-point scorers, and below is a look at where all seven rank among the all-time leaders, as well as the next players approaching the 1,000-point milestone:

## BADOU'S BOARDS

Coastal Carolina's **BADOU DIAGNE** needs 12 rebounds to become the 31st player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds, and is currently 33rd all-time in league annals. Diagne, who became the 50th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone against Grace Bible College on Nov. 18, has an outside chance of joining the league's 1,000-point, 700-rebound and 100-blocked shot club, as his career totals include 935 points and 83 blocked shots.

## HIGH TOPS

Radford senior **RASHUN DAVIS** is the Big South's active career assist leader with 384, and is 16 away from becoming the 26th member of the league's 400-assist club. With 1,109 career points, he is poised to be the 21st player in conference annals with 1,000 points and 400 assists. Meanwhile, teammate **BRANDON HOLCOMB** has 498 rebounds and is on the cusp of becoming the 24th player in the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club. Holcomb is 22nd all-time in league history with 134 career blocked shots.

## BUC-ETS

Charleston Southern leads the Big South with 10.63 three-pointers per game, the highest average in the league since 2010-11 when VMI averaged 11.32 triples that season, which is also the last time a Big South member averaged at least 10.00 per contest. CSU, which has led the conference in three-pointers per game every year since 2012-13, has never averaged double-digit treys per game.

## TAKING FLIGHT

Winthrop leads the Big South with 83.5 points per game, the highest scoring average in the league in two seasons. The Eagles have led the Big South in scoring average just twice, with the last time coming in 1992-93 (83.6 average). The first time was in the conference's first year of men's basketball in 1985-86. That season Winthrop was tops with 79.8 points per game.

## CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is the third-active winningest coach in Division I with 778 career victories and notched his 700th Division I win Jan. 2 against Winthrop. He is 21st all-time in NCAA history for career wins (regardless of affiliation with a minimum 10 head coaching seasons at NCAA schools), and is the 8th-active winningest coach across all NCAA classifications. He became the first head coach in NCAA history with 150 wins at four different Division I programs with the Chanticleers' 68-56 victory over UNC Asheville on Feb. 3, 2015. His Division I school-by-school breakdown is as follows: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 166, in addition to 78 wins during his three seasons leading Cumberland College from 1972-75.

## BIG THINGS COME IN SMALL PACKAGES

Winthrop 5-7 guard **KEON JOHNSON** is second in the Big South with 20.7 points per game, and is looking to become just the second Eagle to average 20.0 points since the Big South began sponsoring men's basketball in 1985-86. That year was the last time a Winthrop player averaged 20.0 points, as **FRED MCKINNON** averaged a league-best 21.1 points that first season. Meanwhile, Johnson's three 30-point games this season has tied the program career record established by **TORRELL MARTIN**.

## DUBY-DUBY-DO

Winthrop redshirt-sophomore **DUBY OKEKE** leads the Big South with 2.75 blocks per game. He has recorded multiple blocks in 10 of his 12 appearances this season, including two games with four and two with five. The last (and only) Winthrop player to lead the Big South in blocked shots was **JOSH GRANT** in 2002-03 (2.28). Meanwhile, Okeke's career total stands at 79, and is 21 away from becoming the first Winthrop player with 100 career blocked shots since **BILLY HOUSTON** eclipsed the mark during the 2004-05 campaign. Just three Eagles reside in the Big South's 100-blocked shot club: Houston (139 from 2002-06), Grant (125 from 2001-04) and **TYRONE WALKER** (105 from 2000-04).

## HIGH POINT'S JOHN BROWN COLLECTING SEVERAL ACCOLADES

For the third consecutive year, High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** was voted the Big South Conference Men's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's head coaches and media panel. He is the first men's player in Big South history to be named Preseason Player of the Year in three consecutive seasons. Named to the Lou Henson Preseason Player of the Year Watch List as well as a Midseason candidate last week, Brown is one of 20 initial preseason candidates for the Julius Erving Award, which is given annually to the top small forward in men's college basketball. He is the only player from a mid-major program on the watch list. Brown is looking to become just the second player in Big South history with **FOUR** First-Team All-Conference selections.

## DISCOUNT DOUBLE CHECK

Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** owns the Big South's active leading double-figure scoring streak at 19 games, dating back to last season. Presbyterian College's **DeSEAN MURRAY** is next at 12, followed by Campbell's **TROY HARPER** (9).

## THE BIG 5-0

Gardner-Webb third-year head coach **TIM CRAFT** is two wins away from 50 in his brief coaching career, and is looking to become just the 10th coach in Big South history to reach 50 overall wins in his third season in the league. Fellow third-year leader **NICK McDEVITT** of UNC Asheville is six wins shy of 50 victories at his school, as is Liberty's **RITCHIE McKAY**, who is also in his third year on the Flames' sideline.

## CLIMBING THE VICTORY LADDER

High Point's **SCOTT CHERRY** is tied for 10th all-time in Big South history for most coaching victories, as he is tied with **JEFF MEYER** for 10th with 108 wins. Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is the Big South's active win leader with 166 wins, which ranks fourth in the conference record books. Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is the longest-tenured active Big South coach, as he is in his 11th year in 2015-16 -- just the third head coach in League history with at least 10 years of service. He sits in sixth-place all-time with 144 victories. Here is a look at the Big South's Top 10 winningest coaches:

## ANOTHER YEAR OF BIG WINS FOR THE BIG SOUTH

The Big South Conference is 2-1 against BIG EAST this season, with both wins over Georgetown. The last time the Big South had two wins vs. the BIG EAST was in 2012-13. Radford downed the Hoyas in double-overtime in its season opener, followed by UNC Asheville on Dec. 19. In addition, the Highlanders defeated Penn State, 86-74 in State College, Pa., on Nov. 26, 12 days after the Georgetown victory. The win over the Nittany Lions marks the second straight year the Big South has defeated a Big Ten member. The Big South has defeated a BIG EAST member four times in the past five seasons, and the last time the Big South had wins over both the BIG EAST and Big Ten in the same year was 2011-12.

## DAILY DOUBLE

Radford's wins over two Power 5 conferences marks the fourth time in the last six seasons that a Big South member has achieved this feat. Last season, it was Gardner-Webb (Clemson, Purdue), and prior to that, it was Coastal Carolina (LSU, Clemson in 2011-12) and Presbyterian (Auburn, Wake Forest in 2010-11).

In just 16 games, **CHRIS CLEMONS** has scored 270 points, already the 10th-most by a freshman in Campbell's Division I era (since '77-'78). He needs just eight points to move past **RON CURTIS** (277 in 1978-'79) into seventh place ... As a team, the Camels are shooting 72.1% from the free throw line in conference games, third-best in the Big South.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

**AARON WHEELER** has scored in double figures in four straight games after doing so just three times in CSU's first 12 games. Wheeler is averaging 14.5 PPG on 50% FG during that time. He is also averaging 8.0 rpg over that stretch ... CSU shot 57 percent in the first half against UNC Asheville on Saturday. The Bucs got out to a 14-2 lead and hit 10 of their first 13 shots ... CSU made 12 threes against Radford. It was the fourth straight game, and 10th time this year, the Bucs connected on 10 or more threes.

## COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal's back-to-back losses last week were the first against Big South opponents since Jan. 28 & 31 of 2015. Following those two losses, Coastal won nine of its next 11 games against league opponents on its way to the 2015 Big South Tournament championship ... **BADOU DIAGNE** averaged 13.5 points last week to lead Coastal. He scored a game-high 21 points against Longwood, marking his third 20-plus point game of the season and fifth of his career ... **MARCUS FREEMAN** notched an 11-point, 11-rebound double-double against Longwood for his fifth career double-double in a league game.

## GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb is off to its best start in Big South play since joining the conference with five wins in its first six ... The Runnin' Bulldogs' 22-point margin of victory over Radford is the largest in program history against the Highlanders ... **TYRELL NELSON** is averaging 19.8 points and 8.6 rebounds in the last five games after posting a pair of double-doubles last week ... The Runnin' Bulldogs currently rank second in the nation in total steals (170) ... GWU is a perfect 10-0 this season when leading at halftime.

## HIGH POINT

**JOHN BROWN** led the Panthers with 19 points (8-12 FG), seven rebounds, five blocks, three steals and three assists in HPU's 82-66 win over PC. High Point shot 62 percent (31-50) and dished out 25 assists in the game ... The Panthers improved to 28-2 in their last 30 home games and have now won 12-straight inside the Millis Center.

## LIBERTY

Following its win over Campbell on Saturday, Liberty is now 9-0 all-time against the Fighting Camels inside the Vines Center ... Liberty's win at Coastal Carolina snapped a 12-game skid. The Flames also picked up their first road win since defeating Campbell at Gore Arena on Feb. 22, 2014 ... With two wins in Big South play last week, the Flames scored back-to-back wins in conference play for the first time since the 2013-14 season ... **JOHN DAWSON** has paced the Flames' scoring in the last three games, averaging 15.0 ppg. Dawson's string of performances includes a career-high 18 points at Coastal Carolina, a contest in which he hit the game-winning three-pointer with 14 ticks left.

## LONGWOOD

**KANAYO OBI-RAPU** averaged 15.5 points, 3.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.5 steals per game last week as Longwood avenged a 78-65 mid-week loss at Presbyterian by knocking off two-time reigning Big South Champion Coastal Carolina, 76-61, Saturday. Obi-Rapu scored in double figures in both games, including a team-high 17 points in the 15-point win over the Chanticleers. He added six rebounds, four assists and two steals in that game as the Lancers defeated Coastal Carolina for the first time since joining the Big South in 2012-13.

## PRESBYTERIAN

As PC visits Coastal this week, the Blue Hose gave Head Coach **GREGG NIBERT** his 400th career win with an 80-69 victory in the last meeting against Coastal Carolina Feb. 26, 2015, at the Templeton Center ... The 70-63 victory at Campbell Jan. 2, 2016, snapped a nine-game road skid dating back to February of 2015 ... **DeSEAN MURRAY** has led the team in scoring in 14 games this season, including the last 12 in a row. He averaged 24.5 ppg in two games last week, including a 26-point effort at High Point, and pulled down 15 rebounds against Longwood for his sixth double-double of the season.

## RADFORD

Radford split a pair of conference games last week, downing Charleston Southern at home on Wednesday before falling at Gardner-Webb on Saturday ... The Highlanders have won or lost more than one game in a row just one time each this year, going 6-1 after a defeat, but 2-7 following a victory ... **RASHUN DAVIS** upped his career assist total 384, taking over fourth place in program history, passing **ROD COUSIN** ... **ED POLITE, JR.** had four offensive rebounds against Gardner-Webb and maintains the conference lead with 61.

## UNC ASHEVILLE

Asheville's 23-point second half comeback win over Winthrop will have its own place in the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball history books, now tied for the 12th-largest second half comeback, with just six larger comebacks coming with less time remaining than Asheville had (15:31 remaining). Bulldog head coach **NICK McDEVITT** has now been a part of the two largest comebacks in Asheville program history: Wednesday night (largest second half comeback) and as a player on Feb. 20, 2000 when the Bulldogs overcame a 29-point deficit in the first half to beat Coastal Carolina inside the Justice Center.

## WINTHROP

The Eagles dropped their third straight league contest after opening 2-0, which is the first three-game losing streak in league play since WU opened conference play 0-3 in 2012-13 ... **KEON JOHNSON** reached the 20-point mark for the 8th time in the loss at UNC Asheville as he also moved into 17th on the school's career scoring list, passing his former teammate **ANDRE SMITH** ... **DUBY OKEKE** has moved into the program's Top 10 for career blocked shots with 79 in 44 career games, which ranks 10th.
