PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - JAN. 18

PLAYER OF THE WEEK - JIMMY GAVIN, WINTHROP, G. R-Sr (ARLINGTON HEIGHTS, ILL.)

Gavin averaged 22.3 points, 3.3 assists and 3.0 rebounds in leading the Eagles to a 3-0 week, including a win over league-leading High Point on national television. He scored a game-high 29 points and was 6-of-11 from three-point range against the Panthers, and tallied 16 of his points in the second half as he was 5-of-9 from the field in the final 20 minutes. Gavin book-ended his week with 19 points against Ferrum last Monday and 19 vs. Liberty on Saturday. For the week, he was 20-of-34 from the field (=58.8 percent), 13-of-23 from three-point range (=56.5) and 14-of-15 from the charity stripe (=93.3).

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - ED POLITE JR, RADFORD, F. Fr (LANHAM, MD.)

Polite Jr. averaged 14.5 points, 12.5 rebounds and 3.0 blocks with a 64.7 field goal percentage (11-of-17) in two games last week. He had 14 points, 13 boards and three blocks in Radford's overtime win over league-leading UNC Asheville on Thursday -- with all 14 points and 10 of his rebounds after halftime to help the Highlanders rally from an 11-point deficit. Polite Jr. then tallied 15 points, 12 rebounds and three rejections against Presbyterian on Saturday.

BIG SOUTH 2,000-POINT ODYSSEY

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** became the ninth player in Big South history with 2,000 career points when he reached the milestone in the first half of this past Thursday's game at Winthrop. He is the third Panther in the conference's 2,000-point club, and is 186 points away from moving into second-place. Brown would need to average 15.5 points in HPU's 12 remaining scheduled games for that second spot. Below are the Big South's 2,000-point scorers:

HIGH FIVE

High Point and UNC Asheville opened the Big South schedule 5-0, the first time the league had two 5-0 teams since 2010-11 (Coastal Carolina and Liberty) and just the fourth time overall. Teams that have started 5-0 in league games have reached the Big South Championship game 17 times -- winning the title 10 times, including UNC Asheville in 2011-12.

BIG SOUTH'S ESPN3 GAME OF THE WEEK CONTINUES THIS SATURDAY

The Big South "Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 continues this week with the next broadcast being the Presbyterian at UNC Asheville contest on Saturday, Jan. 23 live at 4:30pm. **MIKE HOGWOOD** (play-by-play) and **JEFF JACKSON** (analyst) will call the action from Kimmel Arena in Asheville, N.C. For the fourth consecutive year, ESPN3 will exclusively carry eight Big South matchups, in addition to all four quarterfinal games of the 2016 Men's Basketball Championship tournament for the third straight year.

BIG SOUTH CAGERS BACK ON ASN SATURDAY

Big South basketball will again appear on the American Sports Network (ASN) in 2015-16, as seven games are scheduled for broadcast. The next telecast will be Saturday's High Point at Liberty contest live from Lynchburg with **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **DEAN KEENER** (analyst) on the call. Clearances for the game will be made available later this week.

ESPNU GOING WILD FOR THE BIG SOUTH - NEXT SELECTION IS FOR FEB. 11 GAME

For the third consecutive season, four regular-season Big South games will appear on ESPNU in 2015-16. The 24-hour college sports network will televise one January game and three February contests, which will be "Wildcard" selections 21 days in advance. The first selection was High Point at Winthrop on Jan. 14. The remaining three telecasts are Thursday, Feb. 11 at 9:00pm; Thursday, Feb. 18 at 7:00pm, and Thursday, Feb. 25 at 9:00pm. The Feb. 11 selection will be made later this week.

MARGINAL NOTE

Through 39 Big South games, the home teams are 25-14 (.641 percent), and are seeking their first home winning percentage at or above 60.0 percent since a 63.5 success rate in 2012-13. Meanwhile, 25 of the 39 overall contests (.641 percent) have been decided by less than 10 points (4.28 average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 9.13 points. The 2014-15 margin was 10.76, compared to 9.83 in 2013-14.

BIG THINGS COME IN SMALL PACKAGES

Winthrop 5-7 guard **KEON JOHNSON** is second in the Big South with 19.6 points per game, and is looking to become just the second Eagle to average 20.0 points since the Big South began sponsoring men's basketball in 1985-86. That year was the last time a Winthrop player averaged 20.0 points, as **FRED McKINNON** averaged a league-best 21.1 points that first season. Meanwhile, Johnson and teammate **JIMMY GAVIN** have scored 20 points in the same game four times this season, and the Eagles are 4-0 in those contests. In those four games, Johnson averaged 27.0 points with Gavin at 23.0.

THE BIG 5-0

Gardner-Webb third-year head coach **TIM CRAFT** is two wins away from 50 in his brief coaching career, and is looking to become just the 10th coach in Big South history to reach 50 overall wins in his third season in the league. Fellow third-year leader **NICK McDEVITT** of UNC Asheville is five wins shy of 50 victories at his school, while Liberty's **RITCHIE McKAY**, who is also in his third year on the Flames' sideline, is six away.

BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** is the only player in Big South history with 2,000 points (2,026), 700 rebounds (732), 150 blocked shots (157), 150 steals (166) and 150 assists (160). Meanwhile, Brown is fifth in Big South history with 777 career field goals, and needs 23 to become the fourth player with 800. He is eighth in the conference record book with 472 career free throws made.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** (5th player this season) and Gardner-Webb's **TYRELL NELSON** (6th) became the 140th and 141st players, respectively, in the Big South's 1,000-point club the week of Dec. 28. The Big South now has seven active 1,000-point scorers, and below is a look at where all seven rank among the all-time leaders, as well as the next players approaching the 1,000-point milestone:

HIGH POINT DUO BROWN, WEARY JOIN FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE 1,000-POINT SCORERS

High Point duo **JOHN BROWN** and **ADAM WEARY** are the 21st pair of Big South four-year classmates with 1,000 points during the same four-year span. Brown is at 2,026, while Weary sits at 1,078, and the two are just the fifth four-year duo to combine for 3,000 points (3,104). They need 364 points to move into fourth. Meanwhile, fellow classmate **LORENZO CUGINI** is 59 points away from 1,000 in his career, which would mark just the third time a senior trio had 1,000 points during the same four-year period.

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

Radford senior guards **RASHUN DAVIS** and **YAYA ANDERSON** became the 20th pair of Big South four-year classmates to score 1,000 points during the same four-year period on Dec. 9 when Anderson eclipsed the milestone. Davis is currently at 1,140 career points, while Anderson stands at 1,065. Their combined total of 2,205 is 49 points away from the 20th-highest point combination for a four-year duo with 1,000 points each.

BADOU'S BOARDS

Coastal Carolina's **BADOU DIAGNE** needs two rebounds to become the 31st player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds. Diagne, who became the 50th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone against Grace Bible College on Nov. 18, has an outside chance of joining the league's 1,000-point, 700-rebound and 100-blocked shot club, as his career totals include 958 points and 87 blocked shots.

HIGH TOPS

Radford senior **RASHUN DAVIS** is the Big South's active career assist leader with 396, and is four away from becoming the 26th member of the league's 400-assist club. With 1,140 career points, he is on the cusp of becoming the 21st player in conference annals with 1,000 points and 400 assists. Meanwhile, teammate **BRANDON HOLCOMB** became the 80th Big South player with 500 rebounds Jan. 14 during the Asheville game, and is now the 24th player in the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club. Holcomb is 22nd all-time in league history with 136 career blocked shots.

BUC-ETS

Charleston Southern leads the Big South with 10.28 three-pointers per game, the highest average in the league since 2010-11 when VMI averaged 11.32 triples that season, which is also the last time a Big South member averaged at least 10.00 per contest. CSU, which has led the conference in three-pointers per game every year since 2012-13, has never averaged double-digit treys per game.

TAKING FLIGHT

Winthrop leads the Big South with 83.0 points per game, the highest scoring average in the league in two seasons. The Eagles have led the Big South in scoring average just twice, with the last time coming in 1992-93 (83.6 average). The first time was in the conference's first year of men's basketball in 1985-86. That season Winthrop was tops with 79.8 points per game.

DOUBLE VISION

Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** owns the Big South's active leading double-figure scoring streak at 22 games, dating back to last season. Presbyterian College's **DeSEAN MURRAY** is next at 14, followed by Campbell's **TROY HARPER** (11).

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is tied with West Virginia's **BOB HUGGINS** as the third-active winningest coach in Division I with 780 career victories. Ellis, who notched his 700th Division I win Jan. 2 against Winthrop, is tied for 18th all-time in NCAA history for career wins (regardless of affiliation with a minimum 10 head coaching seasons at NCAA schools), and is tied as the 7th-active winningest coach across all NCAA classifications. He became the first head coach in NCAA history with 150 wins at four different Division I programs with the Chanticleers' 68-56 victory over UNC Asheville on Feb. 3, 2015. His Division I school-by-school breakdown is as follows: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 168, in addition to 78 wins leading Cumberland College from 1972-75.

C-SQUARED

Campbell freshman guard **CHRIS CLEMONS** is the Big South's leading freshman scorer with 17.7 points per game -- good for 6th among all freshman nationally. He ranks fourth overall in the league in scoring. Clemons' 3.22 3FG per game is first in the league, and he is challenging the conference's freshman mark of 3.31, set by Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** in 2013-14. Meanwhile, Clemons is tops in the Big South with an 88.5 free throw percentage (54-of-61), which just trails the league's freshman mark of 88.9 percent.

DUBY-DUBY-DO

Winthrop redshirt-sophomore **DUBY OKEKE** leads the Big South with 2.93 blocks per game. He has recorded multiple blocks in 12 of his 15 appearances this season, including three games with four, two with five and one with six. The last (and only) Winthrop player to lead the Big South in blocked shots was **JOSH GRANT** in 2002-03 (2.28). Meanwhile, Okeke's career total stands at 90, and is 10 away from becoming the first Winthrop player with 100 career blocked shots since **BILLY HOUSTON** eclipsed the mark during the 2004-05 campaign. Just three Eagles reside in the Big South's 100-blocked shot club: Houston (139 from 2002-06), Grant (125 from 2001-04) and **TYRONE WALKER** (105 from 2000-04).

CLIMBING THE VICTORY LADDER

High Point's **SCOTT CHERRY** is tied for 10th all-time in Big South history for most coaching victories, as he is tied with **JEFF MEYER** for 10th with 108 wins. Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is the Big South's active win leader with 168 wins, which ranks fourth in the conference record books. Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is the longest-tenured active Big South coach, as he is in his 11th year in 2015-16 -- just the third head coach in League history with at least 10 years of service. He sits in sixth-place all-time with 146 victories. Here is a look at the Big South's Top 10 winningest coaches:

ANOTHER YEAR OF BIG WINS FOR THE BIG SOUTH

The Big South Conference is 2-1 against BIG EAST this season, with both wins over Georgetown. The last time the Big South had two wins vs. the BIG EAST was in 2012-13. Radford downed the Hoyas in double-overtime in its season opener, followed by UNC Asheville on Dec. 19. In addition, the Highlanders defeated Penn State, 86-74 in State College, Pa., on Nov. 26, 12 days after the Georgetown victory. The win over the Nittany Lions marks the second straight year the Big South has defeated a Big Ten member. The Big South has defeated a BIG EAST member four times in the past five seasons, and the last time the Big South had wins over both the BIG EAST and Big Ten in the same year was 2011-12.

DAILY DOUBLE

Radford's wins over two Power 5 conferences marks the fourth time in the last six seasons that a Big South member has achieved this feat. Last season, it was Gardner-Webb (Clemson, Purdue), and prior to that, it was Coastal Carolina (LSU, Clemson in 2011-12) and Presbyterian (Auburn, Wake Forest in 2010-11).

CAMPBELL

Four of Campbell's five losses in its current streak have come by seven, or fewer, points ... In Big South games, Campbell is shooting 73.2 percent from the line as a team, 3rd-best in the league. CU knocked down a season-best 80% from the line (12-15) in the loss to CSU ... With 318 points in 18 games, **CHRIS CLEMONS** already stands sixth on CU's all-time Division I era freshman scoring list (since '77-78). He needs just 7 points to move past 1991 Big South Freshman of the Year and Big South Hall of Fame member **JOE SPINKS** (324 in 28 games) into fifth place on the list.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

AARON WHEELER is averaging 15.6 PPG and 6.8 RPG over his last five outings. Wheeler also has 18 assists over that stretch, and has handed out at least three in every game ... CSU had season-lows in both 3FG attempted (14) and made (5) in its win over Liberty on Thursday ... The Bucs held the Flames to 25 percent shooting in the first half, and limited leading scorer **JOHN DAWSON** to a 2-of-10 effort ... CSU connected on 10-of-17 from beyond the arc in Saturday's win over Campbell. The Bucs were 7-for-9 from 3FG range in the second half, and shot 57 percent overall while placing five players in double figures ... **RAE ROBINSON** had three triples and scored 11 of his career-high 19 points during a deciding 19-2 run.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal started the Presbyterian game with a 25-0 run over the opening five minutes. The 25-0 run was CCU's largest of the season. The Chants shot 52.4 percent for the game, including 42.3 percent from deep ... **RON TRAPPS** turned in a career night against the Blue Hose, posting career-highs in points (21), rebounds (7), field goals made (8) and minutes (27) ... The Coastal win at HPU snapped the Panthers' 12-game win streak ... **BADOU DIAGNE** and **MARCUS FREEMAN** combined to limit **DeSEAN MURRAY** (PC) and **JOHN BROWN** (HPU) to a combined 28 points and 10 rebounds last week.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb saw its five-game winning streak snapped on Saturday in a heartbreaking 75-69 loss at UNC Asheville ... The loss marks the Runnin' Bulldogs' fifth straight setback against Asheville and is also their first loss this season after leading at halftime (now 10-1) ... Gardner-Webb is off to its best start in Big South play since joining the conference with five wins in its first seven games ... **TYRELL NELSON** is averaging a double-double in the last five games, posting 19.6 points and 10.4 rebounds per contest with three double-doubles in that span ... With 51 steals, freshman **LAQUINCY RIDEAU** is on pace to challenge GWU's Division I single-season steals record of 78, set by **TIM JENNINGS** in 2004-05.

HIGH POINT

HPU nearly erased a 12-point second half deficit but could not hit a game-tying 3-pointer in the final seconds against Coastal Carolina. **ADAM WEARY** led the Panthers with a season-high 19 points while adding six rebounds and four assists. **JOHN BROWN** added 18 points (6-9 FG), five rebounds, three steals and two blocks ... Brown became the 4th player in school history with 2,000 career points on Jan. 14.

LIBERTY

Liberty is coming off its largest margin of defeat in Big South play this season, falling to Winthrop by 16 points. Prior to that loss, Liberty's largest defeat was 7 (Charleston Southern and UNC Asheville) ... **CALEB HOMESLEY** finished the CSU contest with 17 points, one point shy of tying his career-high. He knocked down a career-best four 3FG ... **JOHN DAWSON** continues to score consistently for the Flames, posting 15 points on Saturday at Winthrop. Dawson is averaging 15.3 ppg in the last five games.

LONGWOOD

LOTANNA NWOGBO scored 19 points and grabbed seven rebounds in Thursday's 74-57 win over Campbell. He hit 8-of-10 shots from the field en route to his ninth consecutive double-figure scoring game and his 16th such game this season. Nwogbo's 80% clip from the field was his highest of the season. He is averaging 14.2 points, 6.8 rebounds and 1.0 blocks per game while shooting 55.2 (96-of-174) from the field. He has scored in double figures in 28 of his 36 games as a Lancer.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC, which finished last season 7-8 at home, its best since going 7-6 during 2013-14, looks to defend its 7-2 home record this year when the Blue Hose host Charleston Southern Jan. 20 ... PC has won its last four in a row at the Templeton Center ... The 69-68 home win over Radford this past Saturday marked just the ninth time in PC's Division I history a game was decided by one point. PC is now 6-3 in those contests ... The Blue Hose offense continues to pace ahead of the school's Division I record, as the squad's current 69.8 points is 4.4 points higher than the 65.4 record in 2013-14.

RADFORD

Radford downed UNC Asheville in overtime on Thursday, but dropped a one-point decision at Presbyterian on Saturday ... The Highlanders have now exchanged losses and wins over the last eight games and are 7-1 on the season coming off a loss, but just 2-8 following a victory ... **ED POLITE, JR.** posted back-to-back double-doubles to give the freshman four on the season. He also totaled three blocks in both games, giving him five contests on the year with three blocks ... **RASHUN DAVIS** will become the fourth player in RU history to reach 400 assists. He has had four games this season with at least eight assists ... Radford is now 3-0 in overtime games this year after going just 1-6 over the previous four seasons.

UNC ASHEVILLE

Despite its perceived height disadvantage, Asheville has won the rebounding battle in 14 of its 19 games and is 11-3 when outrebounding its opponents. The Bulldogs are 2-3 when losing the rebounding battle, with victories over Georgetown and Furman ... The Bulldogs are the only team in the Big South with five players averaging double-digits in scoring, with Asheville's five starters all averaging 10 points or more both overall and in league play. Three other Big South teams (Campbell, Coastal Carolina, Longwood) have four players averaging double figures.

WINTHROP

The Eagles went 3-0 last week, including key wins over High Point and Liberty to get back over .500 in league play at 4-3 ... **DUBY OKEKE** had a career-high six blocks in the win over High Point and now has 90 in his career, which ranks 9th all-time in school history. His 44 blocks on the year are tied for 6th in a single-season ... **KEON JOHNSON** surpassed 1,100 career points last week and is 17th all-time at Winthrop (1,115). He is one pace to move into the Top 10 by the end of the season ... The Eagles have now won 15 of the last 16 games at the Winthrop Coliseum and 9 of the last 10 versus league opponents.
