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PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - JAN. 18

PLAYER OF THE WEEK - CANDACE BROWN, GARDNER-WEBB, G/F, SR. (HINTON, W.V.A.)

Brown shined in GWU's pair of victories last week with a 19-point performance on Tuesday in the Runnin' Bulldogs' 63-55 win over Charleston Southern. She followed that mark with 16 points in a narrow 58-56 road triumph over first-place UNC Asheville on Saturday. For the week, Brown averaged 17.5 points and 7.5 rebounds, to extend Gardner-Webb's winning streak to four. In the win over CSU, Brown became 21st player in program history and second Bulldog this year to score 1,000 career points.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - EMMA BOCKRATH, HIGH POINT, G. (KETTERING, OHIO)

Bockrath led the Panthers to two victories last week, headlined by a pair of game-winning free throws in HPU's 53-52 win over Coastal Carolina. On the week, Bockrath averaged 16.0 points per game and 3.5 rebounds, scoring 18 points against the Chanticleers, followed by a 14-point performance in a 69-55 triumph over Campbell on Sunday. Within her scoring average, the guard was a perfect 9-for-9 from the free throw line for the pair of contests.

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MARGINAL NOTE

After 40 Big South games, the visiting teams are 22-18 (=55.0 percent) and have won their 22 games by an average of 11.41 points. Sixteen of the 40 overall contests have been decided by less than 10 points (5.13 average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 11.75 points.

GO FOUR IT

UNC Asheville opened 4-0 in the Big South for the first time since starting 4-0 in 2003-04. It was the fifth consecutive season that a Big South member started league play at least 4-0, and Asheville was the sixth different program to achieve the feat since 2011-12.

MOUNTAIN TOP

UNC Asheville leads the Big South with 71.5 points per game, and is looking to lead the Big South in scoring for just the second time. The Bulldogs' lone appearance as the Big South's top scoring team occurred in 1989-90 with a 73.0 average. Meanwhile, Asheville's +14.6 scoring margin leads the conference as well, and is a category the Bulldogs have never finished as the league leader. The Big South single-season record for scoring margin is +17.2, which was set by Liberty in 2009-10.

WHAT A STEAL!

Winthrop's **ALIYAH KILPATRICK**, who tied the Big South single-game record with 10 steals at College of Charleston on Dec. 22, leads the league and is second nationally with 4.20 steals per game -- currently the third-highest per game total in single-season history. The record is 4.32, set by Campbell's **JULIE SKINNER** in 1987-88. Kilpatrick has posted 20 steals in her last four games (=5.00) and has had at least five steals eight times. With four steals on Jan. 12, Kilpatrick became the 37th player in league annals with 200 in a career. Currently with 208 swipes, she needs 59 steals to crack the Top-10 in league history.

KEYS TO THE CITY

High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS** ranks third in the Big South with 14.8 points per game, just 1.2 off the league led, and is looking to become the first Panther to lead the league in scoring since **KATIE O'DELL** was tops with 14.3 points per outing in 2005-06. If Keys can climb the table, she would be just the second HPU player to finish as the Big South's leading scorer since the Panthers joined the conference in 1998-99.

PARKING DECK

Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** became the 16th player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks when she eclipsed the scoring milestone during Dec. 31. She needs just two boards to become just the ninth player with 1,000 points, 800 caroms and 125 blocks in a career.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Gardner-Webb's **CANDACE BROWN** became the third player this season and 102nd member of the Big South's 1,000-point club during GWU's win over Charleston Southern on Jan. 12. The Big South now has five active 1,000-point scorers, led by High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS**, who sits in 46th place with 1,256 career points. MAY WE ASSIST YOU?

Campbell's **RaeCHAUN EDWARDS** became the 15th player in Big South history with 400 career assists and 200 career steals when she eclipsed the steals milestone Dec. 29 vs. Liberty. Edwards, who became the 19th player in Big South history with 400 career assists in the season opener, currently ranks 11th all-time with 478 and needs 22 to become the 10th player with 500 career helpers. Meanwhile, Liberty's **SADALIA ELLIS** (359) is 41 assists away from 400 in her career, and would be the fifth Lady Flame on the league's all-time chart -- which would extend Liberty's Big South record.

STUFFING HER COFFERS

Campbell's **AMANDA COFFER** is second in the Big South with 2.5 blocked shots per game -- just 0.1 off the lead, and is looking to become the first Campbell Camel to lead the conference in blocks. Coffe has 131 in her career, good for 16th all-time in Big South history. She needs 52 to enter the Top 10.

MAXIMUM EFFORT

Charleston Southern's **MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN** is third in the conference with 1.9 blocks per contest, as she looks to become the first Buccaneer to average at least two blocks a game since **SHAUNTE SMALL** posted 2.03 per game in 2006-07. With a pair of blocks against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 16, Maximilien became the 30th player in Big South history with 100 career blocks. Meanwhile, she became the 106th Big South player with 500 career rebounds when she eclipsed the milestone Dec. 29 at Longwood. Maximilien is now the fourth active player with 500 career boards and 100 career blocks.

GOOD WORK YOUNG LADIES

A league-record four women's basketball players are official nominees for the Allstate WBCA Good Works Team®, as Coastal Carolina's **OLIVIA CARLTON**, Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER**, Presbyterian's **JANIE MILES** and UNC Asheville's **PAIGE LOVE** are among the 103 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA. The list will be pared down to a 10-person team featuring five Division I student-athletes in February.

RAGIN RININGER

Liberty redshirt-senior **ASHLEY RININGER** has missed the last six games due to injury. Upon her return, she will resume her pursuit of becoming the second player in league history with 1,500 points, 1,000 rebounds and 150 blocks. Her current career totals stand at 1,244 points, 864 boards and 145 rejections. Former Liberty star **KATIE FEENSTRA** is the lone member of the club, as she tallied 1,845 points, 1,033 rebounds and 257 blocks from 2001-05.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER** is the Big South's active-leading rebounder with 864, and needs 46 to enter the league's all-time Top 10. Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** (798) and Liberty's **KATELYN ADAMS** (703) became the 39th and 40th members of the 700-rebound club this season, while Gardner-Webb's **CANDACE BROWN** (667) is among the players with 600 career boards. Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS** is one rebound away from 600. Below is a look at where all five rank among the all-time leaders, as well as the next players closing in on the 500-rebound milestone:

GARDNER-WEBB, COASTAL CAROLINA SCORE BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG WINS OF 2015-16

Gardner-Webb defeated North Carolina in the season opener, 66-65 in Chapel Hill, while Coastal Carolina knocked off Clemson during the opening weekend. It is the first time since 2006-07 (three wins) that the Big South has collected two victories over the ACC in the same year.

MAGIC WAND-A

Campbell head coach **WANDA WATKINS** needs seven wins for 550 in her coaching career, as she is 543-434 in 35 years in Buies Creek, which includes a 224-136 (=62.2 percent) in 14 total seasons in the Big South -- good for fourth in league history. She is five victories away from surpassing former Coastal Carolina coach **ALAN LeFORCE** (228) for third all-time. Watkins owns the second-most Big South victories with 130, and has recorded double-digit conference wins in her last eight seasons in the Big South -- 2011-to-present, and 1990-94 prior to the Camels' 17-year stay in the TAAC/Atlantic Sun from 1994-2011.

GREEN MACHINE

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** needs nine wins for 400 in his coaching career. He entered the 2015-16 season ranked 13th all-time among active NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his 75.0 winning percentage -- ahead of renowned coaches **C. VIVIAN STRINGER**, **SYLVIA HATCHELL** and **BRENDA FRESE**. Green is the Big South's all-time winningest basketball coach -- men's or women's -- with his 391 overall wins, which includes 226 Big South victories.

CAMPBELL

The Lady Camels dropped both their games last week, falling at Radford on Monday and suffering a home loss to High Point on Sunday. **AMANDA COFFER** continued her outstanding play, leading the Lady Camels with an average of 16.0 points and 6.0 rebounds per game between both contests. She tallied 18 points at Radford and 14 vs. High Point. Coffey became Campbell's all-time career block leader earlier this season.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern struggled in its two contests over the past week, falling on the road at Gardner-Webb and at home on Saturday against Coastal Carolina. **KE'ASIA JACKSON** led the Buccaneers over the past week with 14.0 points per game and five assists. **NAYLA LONG** averaged double-digits in an expanded scoring role for the CSU junior guard with 10.5 points per game on a team-best 53.8% field goal percentage. **ELYSE KIPOKLOS** led the Bucs averaging 11.0 rebounds per game and 2.5 blocked shots per game. She had a career-high 14 rebounds on Saturday against Coastal. **SHAUNTAVIA DOBSON** connected on six three-pointers and shot 50.0% from the three-point line on the week.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal split its pair of games last week, falling in the final seconds at High Point before picking up a win at Charleston Southern. At HPU, the Chants led by one in the closing seconds before HPU drew a foul and converted both free throws to give the Panthers a narrow 53-52 win. At CSU, Coastal trailed by five at the half before outscoring the Bucs by 16 in the second. **The ISSACS twins, STEPHANIE** and **NICOLE**, each had 17 points at CSU. Stephanie scored 13 of her points in the second half, and Nicole added 11 as the pair helped lead Coastal to the come-from-behind win. It is the first time this season that both reached double figures in the same game.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb went 2-0 this past week with victories over Charleston Southern (63-55) and at UNC Asheville (58-56). The Runnin' Bulldogs trailed 29-28 at halftime against CSU and continued to trail after three quarters, but GWU sealed the victory shooting 55.6% and 11-13 from the line in the 4th quarter. For the final quarter, GWU outscored CSU 22-10 to seal the win. On Saturday, Gardner-Webb pulled out a narrow 58-56 victory at UNC Asheville Saturday afternoon. **CANDACE BROWN** made a jump shot with 9.2 seconds left to lift GWU to victory. Gardner-Webb shot 47.2% in the game which is the second best shooting performance this season.

HIGH POINT

The Panthers are riding a two-game conference winning streak for the second time this season. Freshman **EMMA BOCKRATH** posted 16.0 points and 5.0 assists per game to lead the team to back-to-back wins. Freshman **LINDSEY EDWARDS** tallied a career-high with 19 points in the victory at Campbell. Freshman **HALEIGH HATFIELD** racked up a double-double (11 points and 12 rebounds) at Campbell. The squad's seven freshman scored 101 of the team's 122 points on the week. HPU looks to make it three straight wins when it visits Winthrop on Tuesday.

LIBERTY

The Lady Flames hit 11 three-pointers vs. Winthrop, equaling the most they have ever made in a single game at the Vines Center. During Saturday's game, **KATELYN ADAMS** became the ninth Lady Flame ever to grab 700 career rebounds. **JAYMEE FISHER-DAVIS** has moved into seventh place in program history with 107 career triples. This week, the Lady Flames will play at Coastal Carolina (Tuesday) and Longwood (Saturday). Liberty has won 44 straight matchups with Coastal and 13 consecutive meetings with Longwood.

LONGWOOD

EBONI GILLIAM averaged 13.0 points per game to go along with 8.5 rebounds. In Longwood's game at UNC Asheville, Gilliam tallied a career-high 16 points to go along with nine boards. On Saturday, Gilliam added 10 points to go along with eight boards to narrowly miss a double-double. **CIARAH BENNETT** tallied a career-high 20 points in Longwood's loss against Radford Saturday. With the Lancers playing with just eight of 16 players on the roster, Bennett finished the afternoon 7-of-14 from the floor, 6-of-7 from the foul line to go along with three rebounds and two assists.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose topped Winthrop 59-48 on Tuesday to stay tied for second in the Big South Conference standings. **ALLIE WAGNER** led the Blue Hose with her third career double-double and second of the season with 12 points and 11 rebounds. **CORTNEY STOREY** holds second in the Big South in assists with 4.2 per game and assist to turnover ratio at 1.7, while **TAYLOR PETTY** stands second in three-point field goals made with 2.4.

RADFORD

Radford extended its winning streak to four straight, which is tied with GWU for the longest winning streak in the Big South. The Highlanders have matched their 5-2 conference start from a season ago where they recorded a program single-season record 14 Big South wins. RU improved to 7-1 inside the Dedmon Center this season following its 62-59 win over Campbell Monday night.

UNC ASHEVILLE

In Asheville's Tuesday win over Longwood, the Bulldogs scored 32 points in the first quarter, their highest scoring first quarter this season, topping their previous best (27 points). Asheville leads the conference in scoring offense (71.5 points per game) and field-goal percentage (43.1 percent). The Bulldogs suffered their first home loss of the season on Saturday against Gardner-Webb, as the showdown featured seven lead changes and 12 ties.

WINTHROP

ALIYAH KILPATRICK moved up to second in the nation in steals per game with her 4.20 average. She had 10 last week, including six against Liberty. Her total of 63 steals ranks fourth nationally. Despite missing her third straight game due to concussion symptoms, freshman center **ARIANNE WHITAKER** moved up to 27th in the nation in blocks per game with 2.62. Winthrop had its best shooting performance of the year against Liberty as the Eagles connected on 43 percent (23 of 58). Winthrop played both games last week with just seven scholarship players in uniform due to injuries. Opponents have nearly tripled the Eagles in made threes (124-43) and four times this year the opponents have connected on double-digit triples, including 11 by Liberty on Saturday.
