PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - JAN. 25

PLAYER OF THE WEEK - CAMERON JONES, RADFORD, G. SR (ROANOKE, VA.)

Jones, who entered last week averaging 12.2 points and 3.8 rebounds, led Radford to back-to-back Big South wins with 26.0 points and 6.0 rebounds. He opened with a career-high 35 points on 12-of-19 from the field in the Highlanders' victory over Campbell last Wednesday. Jones made a career-high six three-pointers and posted 19 markers in the first 20 minutes. In the second half, he recorded a steal and scored five straight points to put the game away after the Camels got within six points. Jones followed with 17 points Sunday against Gardner-Webb and tied for the team lead with seven boards. For the week, he was 18-of-30 from the field (=60.0 percent), 9-of-16 from three-point range (56.3) and made all seven of his free throw attempts.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - CHRIS CLEMONS, CAMPBELL, G. FR (RALEIGH, N.C.)

Clemons posted his third consecutive 20-point game with a team-high 25 points in the Camels' defeat at Radford. He was 10-of-21 from the field, including 5-of-10 from beyond the arc, and added two rebounds, two assists and one steal. It was Clemons' sixth game with at least 25 points, tied for the most in the Big South this season.

BIG SOUTH 2,000-POINT ODYSSEY

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN**, who became the ninth player in Big South history with 2,000 career points when he reached the milestone Jan. 14 in the first half at Winthrop, is sixth all-time in conference annals with 2,074 points. The third Panther in the conference's 2,000-point club, Brown is 48 points from moving into the Top 5 and 138 away from moving into second-place. Brown needs to average 13.8 points in HPU's 10 remaining scheduled games for that second spot. Below are the Big South's 2,000-point scorers:

HEAD OF THE CLASS

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** is among the 30 candidates for the national Senior CLASS Award. He is the Big South's first official candidate since former teammate **ALLAN CHANEY** in 2013-14.

GIVING THEM THE EAGLE EYE

During their current 4-game Big South win streak, the Winthrop Eagles are shooting 62.1 percent in the second half, going 67-of-108 from the field. The run includes 69.6 percent vs. HPU (18-of-26), 69.6 vs. LU (16-of-23) and 63.3 vs. GWU (63.3).

ESPNU SELECTS RADFORD AT UNC ASHEVILLE AS ITS FEB. 11 WILDCARD BROADCAST

ESPNU selected Radford at UNC Asheville as its "Wildcard" broadcast selection for Thursday, Feb. 11. **KEVIN FITZGERALD** (play-by-play) and **ADRIAN BRANCH** (analyst) will handle the 9:00pm call from courtside at Kimmel Arena. This will be the second Wildcard matchup featuring the two teams, as ESPNU televised Radford's 102-92 victory over the Bulldogs on Feb. 13, 2014 from the Dedmon Center in Radford. For the third consecutive season, four regular-season Big South games will appear on ESPNU in 2015-16. The 24-hour college sports network televised one January game (Jan. 14 High Point at Winthrop) with three February contests upcoming, which are all "Wildcard" selections 21 days in advance. The remaining two telecasts are Thursday, Feb. 18 at 7:00pm and Thursday, Feb. 25 at 9:00pm. The Feb. 18 selection will be made later this week.

BIG SOUTH'S ESPN3 GAME OF THE WEEK CONTINUES THIS SATURDAY

The Big South "Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 continues this week with the next broadcast being the Radford at Winthrop contest on Saturday, Jan. 30 live at 4:00pm. **MIKE HOGEWOOD** (play-by-play) and **JEFF JACKSON** (analyst) will call the action from Winthrop Coliseum in Rock Hill, S.C. For the fourth consecutive year, ESPN3 will exclusively carry eight Big South matchups, in addition to all four quarterfinal games of the 2016 Men's Basketball Championship tournament for the third straight year.

BIG SOUTH CAGERS BACK ON ASN SATURDAY

Big South basketball will again appear on the American Sports Network (ASN) in 2015-16, as seven games are scheduled for broadcast. The next telecast will be Saturday's Longwood at UNC Asheville contest live from Asheville with **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) on the call. Clearances for the game will be made available later this week.

MARGINAL NOTE

Through 49 Big South games, the home teams are 31-18 (.633 percent), and are seeking their first home winning percentage at or above 60.0 percent since a 63.5 success rate in 2012-13. Meanwhile, 29 of the 49 overall contests (.592 percent) have been decided by less than 10 points (4.00 average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 9.00 points. The 2014-15 margin was 10.76, compared to 9.83 in 2013-14.

THE BIG 5-0

Gardner-Webb third-year head coach **TIM CRAFT** is two wins away from 50 in his brief coaching career, and is looking to become just the 10th coach in Big South history to reach 50 overall wins in his third season in the league. Fellow third-year leader **NICK McDEVITT** of UNC Asheville is four wins shy of 50 victories at his school, while Liberty's **RITCHIE McKAY**, who is also in his third year on the Flames' sideline, is four away as well.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

UNC Asheville is the only Big South program to have five players averaging double figures in points, while Campbell, Coastal Carolina and Longwood have four players at 10+ points per game. The Bulldogs are looking to become the first league member to have five players average at least 10.0 points since Charleston Southern in 2013-14.

BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** is the only player in Big South history with 2,000 points (2,074), 700 rebounds (744), 150 blocked shots (161), 150 steals (168) and 150 assists (162). Meanwhile, Brown is fourth in Big South history with 797 career field goals, and needs three to become the fourth player with 800. He is eighth in the conference record book with 480 career free throws made.

BIG THINGS COME IN SMALL PACKAGES

Winthrop 5-7 guard **KEON JOHNSON** is third in the Big South with 19.2 points per game, and is looking to become just the second Eagle to average 20.0 points since the Big South began sponsoring men's basketball in 1985-86. That year was the last time a Winthrop player averaged 20.0 points, as **FRED MCKINNON** averaged a league-best 21.1 points that first season. Meanwhile, Johnson and teammate **JIMMY GAVIN** have scored 20 points in the same game four times this season, and the Eagles are 4-0 in those contests. In those four games, Johnson averaged 27.0 points with Gavin at 23.0.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** (5th player this season) and Gardner-Webb's **TYRELL NELSON** (6th) became the 140th and 141st players, respectively, in the Big South's 1,000-point club the week of Dec. 28. The Big South has seven active 1,000-point scorers, and below is a look at where all seven rank among the all-time leaders, as well as the next players approaching the 1,000-point milestone:

HIGH POINT DUO BROWN, WEARY JOIN FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE 1,000-POINT SCORERS

High Point duo **JOHN BROWN** and **ADAM WEARY** are the 21st pair of Big South four-year classmates with 1,000 points during the same four-year span. Brown is at 2,074, while Weary sits at 1,097, and the two are just the fifth four-year 1,000-point duo to combine for 3,000 points (3,171). They need 297 points to move into fourth. Meanwhile, fellow classmate **LORENZO CUGINI** is 45 points away from 1,000 in his career, which would mark just the third time a senior trio had 1,000 points during the same four-year period.

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

Radford senior guards **RASHUN DAVIS** and **YAYA ANDERSON** became the 20th pair of Big South four-year classmates to score 1,000 points during the same four-year period on Dec. 9 when Anderson eclipsed the milestone. Davis is currently at 1,160 career points, while Anderson stands at 1,087. Their combined total of 2,247 is seven points away from the 20th-highest point combination for a four-year duo with 1,000 points each.

BADOU'S BOARDS

Coastal Carolina's **BADOU DIAGNE** became the 31st player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone this past Saturday at Charleston Southern. He is now tied for 28th with 704 and needs eight to enter the league's all-time Top 25. Diagne, who became the 50th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone against Grace Bible College on Nov. 18, has an outside chance of joining the league's 1,000-point, 700-rebound and 100-blocked shot club, as his career totals include 958 points and 89 blocked shots.

BUC-ETS

Charleston Southern leads the Big South with 10.15 three-pointers per game, the highest average in the league since 2010-11 when VMI averaged 11.32 triples that season, which is also the last time a Big South member averaged at least 10.00 per contest. CSU, which has led the conference in three-pointers per game every year since 2012-13, has never averaged double-digit treys per game.

HIGH TOPS

Radford senior **RASHUN DAVIS** became the 21st player in conference annals with 1,000 points (1,160) and 400 assists (409) when he eclipsed the assist milestone Jan. 20 against Campbell. He is the Big South's active career assist leader and 25th all-time. Meanwhile, teammate **BRANDON HOLCOMB** became the 80th Big South player with 500 rebounds Jan. 14 during the Asheville game, and is now the 24th player in the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club. Holcomb is 22nd all-time in league history with 138 career blocked shots.

TAKING FLIGHT

Winthrop leads the Big South with 82.3 points per game, the highest scoring average in the league in two seasons. The Eagles have led the Big South in scoring average just twice, with the last time coming in 1992-93 (83.6 average). The first time was in the conference's first year of men's basketball in 1985-86. That season Winthrop was tops with 79.8 points per game.

DOUBLE VISION

Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** owns the Big South's active leading double-figure scoring streak at 24 games, dating back to last season. Presbyterian College's **DeSEAN MURRAY** is next at 16, followed by Campbell's **TROY HARPER** (12).

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is tied with West Virginia's **BOB HUGGINS** as the third-active winningest coach in Division I with 781 career victories. Ellis, who notched his 700th Division I win Jan. 2 against Winthrop, is tied with Huggins for 18th all-time in NCAA history for career wins (regardless of affiliation with a minimum 10 head coaching seasons at NCAA schools), and is tied as the 7th-active winningest coach across all NCAA classifications. He became the first head coach in NCAA history with 150 wins at four different Division I programs with the Chanticleers' 68-56 victory over UNC Asheville on Feb. 3, 2015. His Division I school-by-school breakdown is as follows: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 169, in addition to 78 wins leading Cumberland College from 1972-75.

C-SQUARED

Campbell freshman guard **CHRIS CLEMONS** is the Big South's leading freshman scorer with 18.1 points per game -- good for 4th among all freshman nationally. He ranks fourth overall in the league in scoring. Clemons' 3.32 3FG per game is first in the league, and he is pacing ahead of the conference's freshman mark of 3.31, set by Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** in 2013-14. Meanwhile, Clemons is tops in the Big South with an 88.5 free throw percentage (54-of-61), which just trails the league's freshman mark of 88.9 percent.

DUBY-DUBY-DO

Winthrop redshirt-sophomore **DUBY OKEKE** leads the Big South with 2.82 blocks per game. He has recorded multiple blocks in 13 of his 17 appearances this season, including three games with four, two with five and one with six. The last (and only) Winthrop player to lead the Big South in blocked shots was **JOSH GRANT** in 2002-03 (2.28). Meanwhile, Okeke's career total stands at 94, and is six away from becoming the first Winthrop player with 100 career blocked shots since **BILLY HOUSTON** eclipsed the mark during the 2004-05 campaign. Just three Eagles reside in the Big South's 100-blocked shot club: Houston (139 from 2002-06), Grant (125 from 2001-04) and **TYRONE WALKER** (105 from 2000-04).

CLIMBING THE VICTORY LADDER

High Point's **SCOTT CHERRY** is 10th all-time in Big South history for most coaching victories with 109 wins. Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is the Big South's active win leader with 169 wins, which ranks fourth in the conference record books. Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is the longest-tenured active Big South coach, as he is in his 11th year in 2015-16 -- just the third head coach in League history with at least 10 years of service. He sits in sixth-place all-time with 147 victories, two away from moving into a tie for fifth. Here is a look at the Big South's Top 10 winningest coaches:

HIGH FIVE

High Point and UNC Asheville opened the Big South schedule 5-0, the first time the league had two 5-0 teams since 2010-11 (Coastal Carolina and Liberty) and just the fourth time overall. Teams that have started 5-0 in league games have reached the Big South Championship game 17 times -- winning the title 10 times, including UNC Asheville in 2011-12.

GOOD WORK YOUNG MEN

A league-record three men's basketball players are official nominees for the Allstate NABC Good Works Team®, as High Point's **JOHN BROWN**, Longwood's **KANAYO OBI-RAPU** and Presbyterian's **WILL ADAMS** are among the 154 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA. The list will be pared down in February to a 10-person team featuring five Division I student-athletes.

ANOTHER YEAR OF BIG WINS FOR THE BIG SOUTH

The Big South Conference is 2-1 against BIG EAST this season, with both wins over Georgetown. The last time the Big South had two wins vs. the BIG EAST was in 2012-13. Radford downed the Hoyas in double-overtime in its season opener, followed by UNC Asheville on Dec. 19. In addition, the Highlanders defeated Penn State, 86-74 in State College, Pa., on Nov. 26, 12 days after the Georgetown victory. The win over the Nittany Lions marks the second straight year the Big South has defeated a Big Ten member. The Big South has defeated a BIG EAST member four times in the past five seasons, and the last time the Big South had wins over both the BIG EAST and Big Ten in the same year was 2011-12.

DAILY DOUBLE

Radford's wins over two Power 5 conferences marks the fourth time in the last six seasons that a Big South member has achieved this feat. Last season, it was Gardner-Webb (Clemson, Purdue), and prior to that, it was Coastal Carolina (LSU, Clemson in 2011-12) and Presbyterian (Auburn, Wake Forest in 2010-11).

HIGH POINT'S JOHN BROWN COLLECTING SEVERAL ACCOLADES

For the third consecutive year, High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** was voted the Big South Conference Men's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's head coaches and media panel. He is the first men's player in Big South history to be named Preseason Player of the Year in three consecutive seasons. Named to the Lou Henson Preseason Player of the Year Watch List as well as a Midseason candidate last week, Brown is one of 20 initial preseason candidates for the Julius Erving Award, which is given annually to the top small forward in men's college basketball. He is the only player from a mid-major program on the watch list. Brown is looking to become just the second player in Big South history with **FOUR** First-Team All-Conference selections.

MID-MAJOR MANIA

Radford was ranked No. 25 in the Nov. 16 Collegeinsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 ranking, the second consecutive season a Big South member has appeared in the poll. Five teams have received Top 25 consideration this season -- High Point, Winthrop, Coastal Carolina, Radford and UNC Asheville. Below is a look at where the Big South has stood this season thus far:

CAMPBELL

As a team, the Camels are shooting 73.8% from the free throw line in Big South Conference games to rank 3rd in the league in the category. **CHRIS CLEMONS** (84.6), **TROY HARPER** (83.3) and **SHANE WHITFIELD** (82.4) were all shooting better than 80% from the stripe against league opponents through games of Jan. 20 ... Campbell returns to action Wednesday at home against preseason favorite High Point in the only regular season meeting between the schools this year. CU then travels Saturday to Coastal Carolina. The Camels defeated the Chanticleers, 79-73, on Nov. 28 in Buies Creek.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU defeated Presbyterian, 73-72, last Wednesday for its third one-point win of the season (ETSU, Liberty and PC). CSU fell to Winthrop, 83-82, at home ... **RAE ROBINSON** missed his first four threes against PC, but then proceeded to hit five in a row. Robinson also hit five threes at Radford, and has made four or more in eight games ... **AARON WHEELER** scored a career-high 20 points with 10 rebounds in the win at PC, in addition to three blocked shots ... CSU will look to snap a 13-game losing streak at Winthrop on Wednesday. The Bucs have not won in Rock Hill since 2001-02.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Last week's 78-63 win at CSU was Coastal's third straight and the first by a Chanticleer team inside CSU Field House since January 2012 ... Coastal made eight first-half 3-pointers on its way to a 21-point halftime lead. The Chants led by as many as 25 in the second half. **SHIVAUGHN WIGGINS** scored a game-high 23 points while **JAYLEN SHAW** added a career-best 22 points ... Since moving into the starting lineup on Dec. 20, Shaw is averaging a team-leading 13.7 points per game and has two 20-plus point performances ... **BADOU DIAGNE** ranks sixth on the CCU career rebounding list with 704.

GARDNER-WEBB

GWU was held to under 36 percent from the floor and 25 percent from three-point range for the third straight game on Sunday at Radford ... The Runnin' Bulldogs are a combined 17-of-73 from downtown (23.3 percent) during their current three-game losing streak ... **TYRELL NELSON** posted his Big South-leading ninth double-double of the season with game-highs of 17 points and 13 rebounds at Radford ... Freshman **LAQUINCY RIDEAU** is 24 steals shy of tying GWU's Division I single-season record of 78 ... Gardner-Webb is 10-2 this season when leading at halftime.

HIGH POINT

HPU improved to 10-1 at home this season with last week's win over UNC Asheville, and is 29-3 in its last 32 home games ... **JOHN BROWN** posted a game-high 26 points (11-16 FG), 10 rebounds and four blocks in the win over the Bulldogs ... HPU was +22 (45-23) on the glass and +16 (22-6) in second chance points in the victory. HPU also forced 18 Bulldog turnovers and made 11 steals in the game.

LIBERTY

Each of the Flames' four Big South wins have been decided by one possession, while four of Liberty's five losses have been decided by seven points or less ... **JOHN DAWSON** hit a layup with less than two seconds left to seal Saturday's victory over High Point ... The Flames hit a combined 24 three-pointers in two games last week, shooting 43.6 percent (24-of-55) from downtown ... Liberty is now 6-1 all-time against Longwood in the Vines Center ... The home win over High Point snapped a four-game skid versus the Panthers inside Vines, as LU's last win over HPU in the facility was in 2010-11.

LONGWOOD

TRA'VAUGHN WHITE averaged 14.5 points, 4.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.0 steals per game last week against Liberty and Winthrop. He scored in double figures in both games, going off for 18 points and four steals in a 55-53 loss at Liberty and then scoring 11 points with a career-high six assists against Winthrop. White's 18 points at Liberty included back-to-back three-pointers in the final 10 seconds to put the Lancers within one point with eight seconds to play ... Against Winthrop, White's six assists led directly to five three-pointers and a dunk ... **DARRION ALLEN** has hit a three-pointer in nine consecutive games, including multiple treys in four of those contests. He is tied for the lead among all Big South guards with 15 blocks.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose are making tremendous strides in their journey into Division I, posting better numbers from last season in scoring (69.2-61.8), rebounding (34.6-32.2), assists (11.8-10.7) and steals (7.5-5.2) ... PC, which finished last season 7-8 at home -- its best since going 7-6 during 2013-14 -- looks to defend its current 7-3 home mark when the Blue Hose host Liberty, Jan. 30. The three losses at home are the fewest since the team went 9-2 in 2008 ... PC has won its last four of five at the Templeton Center.

RADFORD

Radford went 2-0 last week with home victories over Campbell (78-66) on Wednesday and Gardner-Webb (69-59) on Sunday. The back-to-back wins were the team's first since defeating Howard and UNC Wilmington on Dec. 12 and Dec. 19 ... The Highlanders are a perfect 5-0 in Big South play at home and 8-2 at the Dedmon Center overall this season, including six straight wins ... **CAMERON JONES** has made at least three 3-pointers in each of the last four games while shooting 48 percent (16-of-33) from beyond the arc ... Radford is 8-0 this season when leading at halftime.

UNC ASHEVILLE

Asheville has won the rebounding battle in 15 of its 21 games and is 12-3 when outrebounding its opponents. The Bulldogs are 2-4 when losing the rebounding battle, with victories over Georgetown and Furman ... Asheville has mastered turning its defense into offense, with the Bulldogs averaging 9.2 steals/game this season -- a number that has grown to 11.2 steals/game in league play -- while notching a +4.8 margin in the turnover battle this season.

WINTHROP

The Eagles have won five straight games for the first time since they won five straight at the end of the 2014-15 season before falling in the conference title game ... Winthrop has won four straight league games for the first time since the 2009-10 team won seven in a row ... **JOSHUA DAVENPORT** came off the bench in both games last week to average 11.5 points and 3.0 rebounds while shooting 77 percent from the floor. With the Eagles trailing by double-figures in both games, he sparked the necessary runs to bring the team back in front ... Winthrop rallied from double-figure deficits in both games last week to win each game by double-figures, as 16 of their last 26 victories have been by 10 or more points.

BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

A new tiebreaking procedure implemented prior to the 2015-16 season addresses the Big South's 18-game unbalanced schedule. Each team plays eight teams twice and two teams once, and the new tiebreaker below will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Championship tournament, if necessary.

TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING TWO-TEAM TIE

- Regular season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to the next step below.
- If the tied teams played each other twice in the regular season and split their games, then each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings (or in case of a tie for first place, the next highest position in the regular season standings) and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
- When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tie-breaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
- When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against a team or group is unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1; 1-0 is the same as 2-0; 2-0 is the same as 4-0; 2-1 is the same as 4-2; 1-0 is better than 1-1; 0-1 is the same as 0-2; 0-2 is the same as 0-4). If the winning percentage of the tied teams is equal against a team, or a group of tied teams, continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING MULTI-TEAM TIE

- The combined record of conference games between the tied teams involved will be compiled. Ties will be broken and seeding assigned based on the winning percentage of the combined conference records. The higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group is unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1; 1-0 is the same as 2-0; 2-0 is the same as 4-0; 2-1 is the same as 4-2; 1-0 is better than 1-1; 0-1 is the same as 0-2; 0-2 is the same as 0-4).
- If the first procedure fails to break the tie, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage by a higher winning percentage.
- If the tie is broken by (a) or (b) regarding one or more teams, but three or more teams remain tied, then procedures (a) and (b) will be re-applied among those tied teams only.
- If two teams remain tied, the two-team tiebreaker policy will be applied.
- If there is more than one tie in the standings, and when utilizing the tie-breaking procedures there are a pair of teams tied, a team's record against the combined tied teams (prior to their own tie-breaking procedures) is used, rather than performance against the individual tied team.
- If procedures two-team and/or multi-team tiebreakers fail to establish an advantage, the team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report will be awarded the higher seed.
