PLAYER OF THE WEEK - CATHERINE KEARNEY, LIBERTY, G/F, R-Sr. (MONROEVILLE, N.J.)

Kearney led the Lady Flames to a pair of victories last week, as she posted a game-high 16 points to go along with her 11 rebounds in LU's narrow 65-63 win at Coastal Carolina on Tuesday. On Sunday, Kearney closed the week with a 20-point performance on 8-for-8 shooting in Liberty's 72-67 road triumph at Longwood. For the week, Kearney averaged 18.0 points, 7.5 rebounds and 2.0 blocks while shooting 77.8 percent (14-for-18) from the field.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - SALINA VIROLA, PRESBYTERIAN, F. (HUNTSVILLE, ALA.)

Virola opened last week with a career-high 20 points on 7-for-10 shooting in the Blue Hose's convincing 69-45 victory at Campbell on Tuesday. The forward continued to shine on Saturday, as she dropped in 12 points, headlined by a perfect 5-for-5 mark from the free-throw line, and pulled down four rebounds in PC's 66-42 win over Coastal Carolina. Last week, Virola averaged 16.0 points, 2.5 rebounds, fired 62.5 percent (5-for-8) from three-point range and shot 87.5 percent (7-for-8) from the charity stripe.

MARGINAL NOTE

After 50 Big South games, the visiting teams are 27-23 (=54.0 percent) and have won their 27 games by an average of 10.48 points. Twenty-two of the 50 overall contests have been decided by less than 10 points (4.63 average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 11.56 points.

MOUNTAIN TOP

UNC Asheville leads the Big South with 72.1 points per game, and is looking to lead the Big South in scoring for just the second time. The Bulldogs' lone appearance as the Big South's top scoring team occurred in 1989-90 with a 73.0 average. Meanwhile, Asheville's +13.8 scoring margin leads the conference as well, and is a category the Bulldogs have never finished as the league leader. The Big South single-season record for scoring margin is +17.2, which was set by Liberty in 2009-10.

WHAT A STEAL!

Winthrop's **ALIYAH KILPATRICK**, who tied the Big South single-game record with 10 steals at College of Charleston on Dec. 22, leads the league and is second nationally with 4.00 steals per game -- currently the third-highest per game total in single-season history. The record is 4.32, set by Campbell's **JULIE SKINNER** in 1987-88. Kilpatrick has posted 20 steals in her last four games (=5.00) and has had at least five steals eight times. With four steals on Jan. 12, Kilpatrick became the 37th player in league annals with 200 in a career. Currently with 213 swipes, she needs 54 steals to crack the Top-10 in league history.

BIG "E"

Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS** currently leads the Big South by averaging 15.9 points per game, a full point ahead of second-place **KAYLAH KEYS** of High Point. Williams looks to hold the conference's highest scoring average by a Winthrop player for the fourth time in five seasons after former standout **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** led the conference three times from 2011-2014.

PARKING DECK

Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** became the 16th player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks when she eclipsed the scoring milestone on Dec. 31. In GWU's narrow win over UNC Asheville on Jan. 16, she became just the ninth player with 1,000 points, 800 caroms and 125 blocks in a career.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Gardner-Webb's **CANDACE BROWN** became the third player this season and 102nd member of the Big South's 1,000-point club during GWU's win over Charleston Southern on Jan. 12. The Big South now has five active 1,000-point scorers, led by High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS**, who sits in 40th place with 1,286 career points. MAY WE ASSIST YOU?

Campbell's **RAECHAUN EDWARDS** became the 15th player in Big South history with 400 career assists and 200 career steals when she eclipsed the steals milestone Dec. 29 vs. Liberty. Edwards, who became the 19th player in Big South history with 400 career assists in the season opener, currently ranks 11th all-time with 482 and needs 18 to become the 10th player with 500 career helpers. Meanwhile, Liberty's **SADALIA ELLIS** (363) is 37 assists away from 400 in her career, and would be the fifth Lady Flame on the league's all-time chart -- which would extend Liberty's Big South record.

GO FOUR IT

UNC Asheville opened 4-0 in the Big South for the first time since starting 4-0 in 2003-04. It was the fifth consecutive season that a Big South member started league play at least 4-0, and Asheville was the sixth different program to achieve the feat since 2011-12.

STUFFING HER COFFERS

Campbell's **AMANDA COFFER** leads the Big South with 2.44 blocked shots per game and is looking to become the first Campbell Camel to lead the conference in blocks. Coffey has 135 in her career, good for 16th all-time in Big South history. She needs 48 to enter the Top 10.

MAXIMUM EFFORT

Charleston Southern's **MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN** is tied for second in the Big South with 1.9 blocks per contest, as she looks to become the first Buccaneer to average at least two blocks a game since **SHAUNTE SMALL** posted 2.03 per game in 2006-07. With a pair of blocks against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 16, Maximilien became the 30th player in Big South history with 100 career blocks. Meanwhile, she became the 106th Big South player with 500 career rebounds when she eclipsed the milestone Dec. 29 at Longwood. Maximilien is now the fourth active player with 500 career boards and 100 career blocks.

GOOD WORK YOUNG LADIES

A league-record four women's basketball players are official nominees for the Allstate WBCA Good Works Team®, as Coastal Carolina's **OLIVIA CARLTON**, Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER**, Presbyterian's **JANIE MILES** and UNC Asheville's **PAIGE LOVE** are among the 103 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA. The list will be pared down to a 10-person team featuring five Division I student-athletes in February.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER** is the Big South's active-leading rebounder with 864, and needs 46 to enter the league's all-time Top 10. Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** (816) became the 21st member of the 800-rebound club and Liberty's **KATELYN ADAMS** (731) became the 40th member of the 700-rebound club this season. Gardner-Webb's **CANDACE BROWN** (680) and Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS** (625) are among the 71 players with 600 career boards. Liberty's **CATHERINE KEARNEY** became the 107th member of the 500-rebound club on Jan. 24 against Longwood. GARDNER-WEBB, COASTAL CAROLINA SCORE BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG WINS OF 2015-16

Gardner-Webb defeated North Carolina in the season opener, 66-65 in Chapel Hill, while Coastal Carolina knocked off Clemson during the opening weekend. It is the first time since 2006-07 (three wins) that the Big South has collected two victories over the ACC in the same year.

MAGIC WAND-A

Campbell head coach **WANDA WATKINS** needs seven wins for 550 in her coaching career, as she is 543-436 in 35 years in Buies Creek, which includes a 224-138 (=61.9 percent) in 14 total seasons in the Big South -- good for fourth in league history. She is five victories away from surpassing former Coastal Carolina coach **ALAN LeFORCE** (228) for third all-time. Watkins owns the second-most Big South victories with 130, and has recorded double-digit conference wins in her last eight seasons in the Big South -- 2011-to-present, and 1990-94 prior to the Camels' 17-year stay in the TAAC/Atlantic Sun from 1994-2011.

GREEN MACHINE

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** needs seven wins for 400 in his coaching career. He entered the 2015-16 season ranked 13th all-time among active NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his 75.0 winning percentage -- ahead of renowned coaches **C. VIVIAN STRINGER**, **SYLVIA HATCHELL** and **BRENDA FRESE**. Green is the Big South's all-time winningest basketball coach -- men's or women's -- with his 393 overall wins, which includes 228 Big South victories.

CAMPBELL

The Lady Camels suffered losses in both their games last week, falling to Presbyterian on Tuesday and at Winthrop on Sunday. **JESSICA PONE** led the Lady Camel offense with an average of 9.5 points per game in both contests. **AMANDA COFFER** averaged 8.0 points per contest including her sixth double-double of the season at Winthrop with 12 points and 12 rebounds. Campbell dropped a heartbreaker at Winthrop when its game-winning putback lay-up at the buzzer went halfway down and rolled out, giving Winthrop the one-point victory.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Buccaneers fell in their lone competition last week, dropping a decision on the road at Radford on Tuesday. **ALYSSA MANN** returned to the floor after missing the last four games due to injury, finishing with six points, three assists and two steals against the Highlanders. At the time of her injury, Mann was the Big South's leading scorer at 15.4 points per game. **KE'ASIA JACKSON** continues to remain hot against the conference as the freshman guard has scored double-digits in each of the past four games. Jackson led the Bucs with 11 points, going 7-of-8 from the free throw line in the loss.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal suffered losses to Liberty and at Presbyterian last week, the first time this season that the Chants have lost two conference games in the same week. **CED GIBSON** sat out the Liberty game after injuring her ankle earlier in the week, but made her return at Presbyterian where she led Coastal in scoring with 12 points. Coastal made 12-of-36 3-point attempts against Liberty, the most attempts in a game this season and second-most makes behind the 13 made against Campbell on Dec. 1. Coastal returns to action on Saturday at Campbell, looking to avenge an earlier-season setback.

GARDNER-WEBB

GWU defeated Longwood (67-42) Tuesday night and Radford (54-50) on Saturday. The Runnin' Bulldogs have won six straight conference games, its longest streak since it won 14 to end the 2009-10 regular-season. Radford held GWU to its second lowest rebounding total of the season (30) and the second lowest scoring total of the season. In Tuesday's game against Longwood, GWU led by 9 at half but put the game away with great second-half defense. GWU limited the Lancers to just two points in the third quarter and just 20.6% shooting in the second half.

HIGH POINT

HPU's season-best three-game winning streak was snapped when UNC Asheville split a pair of free throws with three seconds left to earn an 82-81 victory. Freshman **HALEIGH HATFIELD** starred for the Panthers with 15.5 points and 8.0 rebounds per game including a double-double against the Bulldogs and a career-high 20 points versus Winthrop. Junior **KAYLAH KEYS** passed 2014-15 Big South Player of the Year **STACIA ROBERTSON** in career points last week and is now fourth on HPU's Division I list with 1,286 points.

LIBERTY

After posting road wins at Coastal Carolina and Longwood, the Lady Flames have now won 45 straight games over the Chanticleers and 14 in a row over the Lancers. The Lady Flames have recorded 17 straight home wins over conference opponents since 2014. The Lady Flames shot 55.1 percent from the field during Sunday's win over Longwood, improving to 102-1 under **CAREY GREEN** when shooting 50 percent or better. **KATELYN ADAMS** pulled down a career-high 16 rebounds at Coastal Carolina on Tuesday, becoming the first Lady Flame with double-digit offensive boards since 2013. **CATHERINE KEARNEY**'s fourth career 20-point game Sunday at Longwood featured perfect 8-of-8 field goal shooting, marking the most field goals a Lady Flame has made in a single game without missing since 2011.

LONGWOOD

Longwood suffered a pair of setbacks last week, falling to a pair of first-place teams in Gardner-Webb and Liberty. **DEBORAH HEADEN** led the Lancers averaging 11.5 points per game for the two contests, while teammate **EBONI GILLIAM** grabbed a team-high 12 rebounds (6.5 rpg.). Looking to bounce back into the win column, Longwood seeks the season sweep over Winthrop on Tuesday in Farmville.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian is currently on a four-game winning streak, marking the longest streak for the Blue Hose since the 2013-14 season. The Blue Hose knocked off Campbell on Tuesday and Coastal Carolina on Saturday and remained in a four-way tie for first place in the conference standings. PC's **CORTNEY STOREY** sits second in the Big South in assists averaging 4.1 a game and assists to turnover ratio at 1.7. **TAYLOR PETTY** holds second in the conference in three-point field goals made with 2.3 a contest.

RADFORD

Radford saw its five-game winning streak come to an end at Gardner-Webb on Saturday. **JANAYLA WHITE** notched her third double-double in a row behind 15 points and a career-high 21 rebounds. Her 21 rebounds were three shy of tying the program's single-game record. Radford continues to lead the Big South in rebounding after posting its fifth straight double-digit rebounding margin in the narrow loss at Gardner-Webb. The Highlanders had 10 players available against the Runnin' Bulldogs, marking the first time since Nov. 20 at Youngstown State that has happened.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs improved to 7-2 in Big South Conference play with their win over HPU on Saturday and is part of a four-way tie atop the conference. Asheville will face Presbyterian at home on Tuesday to decide which team remains in contention for first place. Three of Asheville's last four conference games have been decided by 10 points or less. Asheville has come out on top in two of those three contests, beating Charleston Southern on the road earlier this season (58-50), and High Point (82-81).

WINTHROP

ALIYAH KILPATRICK connected on two free throws with 8.6 seconds left against Campbell to help Winthrop break a nine-game losing streak, its longest since 2004-05. **ERICA WILLIAMS** recorded her fourth double-double of the season and 26th of her career with 16 points and 20 rebounds in the win. The 20 rebounds ties her for second on the Winthrop single game record list. Sophomore **RONATA ROGERS** had her first career double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds against High Point. The Eagles dressed just seven players, including six scholarship players, for both games last week.
