PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - FEB. 1

PLAYER OF THE WEEK - ELIJAH WILSON, COASTAL CAROLINA, G. JR (WILMINGTON, N.C.)

Wilson averaged 22.0 points, 5.5 rebounds, shot 56.7 percent from the field and 46.2 percent from long range in leading the Chanticleers to two wins last week. Against conference leader UNC Asheville last Wednesday, Wilson scored a game-high 23 points in the victory -- including all five of CCU's overtime points. On Saturday against Campbell, he scored 21 points, shooting 8-of-15 from the field with four 3-pointers while also controlling eight rebounds. Wilson had 16 points after halftime during Coastal's game-defining 38-7 run in the first 10 minutes of the second stanza.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - CALEB HOMESLEY, LIBERTY, G. FR (INDIAN TRAIL, N.C.)

Homesley averaged 12.5 points, 4.5 rebounds, 1.5 steals and 1.5 assists in helping the Flames score two Big South road wins. He opened with 10 points, seven rebounds and three steals at Gardner-Webb, and followed with a 15-point performance and two assists at Presbyterian. Homesley hit a key three-pointer with 3:43 left to put Liberty ahead by six against the Blue Hose. For the week, Homesley was 9-of-17 from the floor (=52.9 percent) and 5-of-7 from the charity stripe (=71.4).

FRESHMAN 15

UNC Asheville has reached 15 wins for the ninth consecutive season -- the second-longest streak in Big South history. The record is 10 straight years, set by Winthrop from 1998-2008. The Bulldogs have now won at least 15 games in 18 of their 31 years in the Big South -- tied with the Eagles for the second-most 15-win seasons in conference annals. That record is held by Radford at 19, and the Highlanders are two victories away from its 20th 15-win campaign as Big South members. Meanwhile, Winthrop has posted its third straight 15-win effort during head coach **PAT KELSEY**'s four years on the sideline.

SMOKIN' HOT

Liberty, which was predicted to finish last in the Big South preseason poll, is currently tied for fifth in the league standings with a 6-5 mark -- the program's most league wins since 2012-13 (six). It is the first time since 2010-11 that the Flames are above .500 in conference play in February. Liberty, which has won three Big South road games for the first time since 2011-12, carries a four-game Big South win streak into this week's action.

BIG SOUTH 2,000-POINT ODYSSEY

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN**, who became the ninth player in Big South history with 2,000 career points when he reached the milestone Jan. 14 in the first half at Winthrop, is sixth all-time in conference annals with 2,096 points. The third Panther in the conference's 2,000-point club, Brown is 26 points from moving into the Top 5 and 116 away from moving into second-place. Brown needs to average 12.9 points in HPU's nine remaining scheduled games for that second spot. Below are the Big South's 2,000-point scorers:

HEAD OF THE CLASS

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** is among the 30 candidates for the national Senior CLASS Award. He is the Big South's first official candidate since former teammate **ALLAN CHANEY** in 2013-14.

GIVING THEM THE EAGLE EYE

During their current 6-game Big South win streak, the Winthrop Eagles are shooting 60.4 percent in the second half, going 96-of-159 from the field. The run includes 69.2 percent vs. HPU (18-of-26), 69.6 vs. LU (16-of-23), 63.3 vs. GWU (19-of-30) and 64.5 vs. CSU (20-of-31). Against both Longwood and Radford in the other two games of the win streak, the Eagles fell one field goal shy of hitting 50.0 percent in the second stanza.

ESPNU WILDCARD BROADCASTS FOR FEB. 11 AND FEB. 18 DETERMINED

ESPNU has selected the Feb. 11 Radford at UNC Asheville game and the Feb. 18 Charleston Southern at Gardner-Webb contest as its next "Wildcard" broadcasts. **KEVIN FITZGERALD** (play-by-play) and **ADRIAN BRANCH** (analyst) will handle both games. For the third consecutive season, four regular-season Big South games will appear on ESPNU in 2015-16. The 24-hour college sports network televised one January game (Jan. 14 High Point at Winthrop) with three February contests upcoming, which are all "Wildcard" selections 21 days in advance. The remaining telecast is Thursday, Feb. 25 at 9:00pm. That selection will be made later this week.

BIG SOUTH'S ESPN3 GAME OF THE WEEK CONTINUES THIS SATURDAY

The Big South "Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 continues this week with the next broadcast being the Presbyterian at Gardner-Webb contest on Saturday, Feb. 6 live at 4:00pm. **MIKE HOGWOOD** (play-by-play) and **RALPH PATTERSON** (analyst) will call the action from Paul Porter Arena in Boiling Spring, N.C. For the fourth consecutive year, ESPN3 will exclusively carry eight Big South matchups, in addition to all four quarterfinal games of the 2016 Men's Basketball Championship tournament for the third straight year.

BIG SOUTH CAGERS BACK ON ASN SATURDAY

Big South basketball will again appear on the American Sports Network (ASN) in 2015-16, as seven games are scheduled for broadcast. The next telecast will be Saturday's Coastal Carolina at Radford contest live from Radford with **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) on the call. Clearances for the game will be made available later this week.

DOUBLE VISION

Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** owns the Big South's active leading double-figure scoring streak at 26 games, dating back to last season. Presbyterian College's **DeSEAN MURRAY** is next at 17, followed by High Point's **JOHN BROWN** and Liberty's **JOHN DAWSON** at nine games.

THE BIG 5-0

Gardner-Webb third-year head coach **TIM CRAFT** is one win away from 50 in his brief coaching career, and is looking to become just the 10th coach in Big South history to reach 50 overall wins in his third season in the league. Fellow third-year leader **RITCHIE McKAY** of Liberty is two wins shy of 50 victories at his school, while UNC Asheville's **NICK McDEVITT**, who is also in his third year on the Bulldogs' sideline, is three away.

MARGINAL NOTE

Through 59 Big South games, the home teams are 36-23 (=61.0 percent), and are seeking their first home winning percentage at or above 60.0 percent since a 63.5 success rate in 2012-13. Meanwhile, 33 of the 59 overall contests (=55.9 percent) have been decided by less than 10 points (4.24 average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 9.61 points. The 2014-15 margin was 10.76, compared to 9.83 in 2013-14.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

UNC Asheville is the only Big South program to have five players averaging double figures in points, while Campbell, Coastal Carolina and Longwood have four players at 10+ points per game. The Bulldogs are looking to become the first league member to have five players average at least 10.0 points since Charleston Southern in 2013-14.

BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN**, who is the only player in Big South history with 2,000 points (2,096), 700 rebounds (753), 150 blocked shots (161), 150 steals (168) and 150 assists (163), is third in Big South history with 805 career field goals. He needs 60 to surpass former Panther great **ARI-ZONA REID** (864) for second. Brown ranks seventh in the conference record book with 486 career free throws made, and is 14 makes from becoming just the second player with 500. The Big South free throw record is 513, currently held by Radford's **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** (2002-06).

BIG THINGS COME IN SMALL PACKAGES

Winthrop 5-7 guard **KEON JOHNSON** is tied for second in the Big South with 19.8 points per game, and is looking to become just the second Eagle to average 20.0 points since the Big South began sponsoring men's basketball in 1985-86. That year was the last time a Winthrop player averaged 20.0 points, as **FRED McKINNON** averaged a league-best 21.1 points that first season. Meanwhile, Johnson and teammate **JIMMY GAVIN** have scored 20 points in the same game four times this season, and the Eagles are 4-0 in those contests. In those four games, Johnson averaged 27.0 points with Gavin at 23.0.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Coastal Carolina's **BADOU DIAGNE** enters this week needing 20 points to become the seventh Big South player to reach the 1,000-point milestone this season, and the 142nd player overall. High Point's **LORENZO CUGINI** is 29 away from the same threshold. The Big South has seven active 1,000-point scorers, and below is a look at where all seven rank among the all-time leaders, as well as the next players approaching the 1,000-point milestone:

BADOU'S BOARDS

Coastal Carolina's **BADOU DIAGNE** became the 31st player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Jan. 23 at Charleston Southern. He is now 24th with 722 and needs 25 to enter the league's all-time Top 20. Diagne, who became the 50th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he eclipsed the mark against Grace Bible College on Nov. 18, has an outside chance of joining the league's 1,000-point, 700-rebound and 100-blocked shot club (currently just 13 members), as his career totals include 980 points and 92 blocked shots.

DUBY-DUBY-DO

Winthrop redshirt-sophomore **DUBY OKEKE** leads the Big South with 2.89 blocks per game. He has recorded multiple blocks in 15 of his 19 appearances this season, including three games with four, three with five and one with six. The last (and only) Winthrop player to lead the Big South in blocked shots was **JOSH GRANT** in 2002-03 (2.28). Meanwhile, Okeke surpassed 100 career blocks this past Saturday during the Radford game and is the first Eagle with 100 rejections (101) since **BILLY HOUSTON** eclipsed the mark during the 2004-05 campaign. Okeke is one of four Eagles residing in the Big South's 100-blocked shot club: Houston (139 from 2002-06), Grant (125 from 2001-04) and **TYRONE WALKER** (105 from 2000-04).

C-SQUARED

Campbell freshman guard **CHRIS CLEMONS** is the Big South's leading freshman scorer with 17.8 points per game -- good for 6th among all freshman nationally. He ranks fourth overall in the league in scoring. Clemons' 3.24 3FG per game is first in the league, and he is just 0.07 behind the conference's freshman record of 3.31, set by Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** in 2013-14. Meanwhile, Clemons is tops in the Big South with an 87.0 free throw percentage (60-of-69), and is looking to become the first frosh since 2011-12 and fifth overall to lead the conference in free throw shooting. He is also 26 points away from becoming the 22nd Big South freshman to score 400 points in a season.

HIGH POINT DUO BROWN, WEARY JOIN FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE 1,000-POINT SCORERS

High Point duo **JOHN BROWN** and **ADAM WEARY** are the 21st pair of Big South four-year classmates with 1,000 points during the same four-year span. Brown is at 2,096, while Weary sits at 1,113, and the two are just the fifth four-year 1,000-point duo to combine for 3,000 points (3,209). They need 259 points to move into fourth. Meanwhile, fellow classmate **LORENZO CUGINI** is 29 points away from 1,000 in his career, which would mark just the third time a Big South senior trio had 1,000 points during the same four-year period.

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

Radford senior guards **RASHUN DAVIS** and **YAYA ANDERSON** became the 20th pair of Big South four-year classmates to score 1,000 points during the same four-year period on Dec. 9 when Anderson eclipsed the milestone. Davis is currently at 1,182 career points, while Anderson stands at 1,113. Their combined point total of 2,295 is the 18th-highest scoring combination for a four-year duo with 1,000 points each, and 29 points away from the 16th position.

BUC-ETS

Charleston Southern leads the Big South with 9.77 three-pointers per game, and is attempting to become just the second program to lead the conference in the category for four consecutive years. Former member VMI led the Big South in 3FG per games a record six straight seasons from 2006-12. The Buccaneers are looking to average double-digit treys for the first time as well.

HIGH TOPS

Radford senior **RASHUN DAVIS** became the 21st player in conference annals with 1,000 points (1,182) and 400 assists (418) when he eclipsed the assist milestone Jan. 20 against Campbell. He is the Big South's active career assist leader and 22nd all-time. Davis is also part of a 14-player group with 1,000 points, 400 assists and 150 steals. Meanwhile, teammate **BRANDON HOLCOMB** became the 80th Big South player with 500 rebounds Jan. 14 during the Asheville game, and is now the 24th player in the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club. Holcomb is 22nd all-time in league history with 138 career blocked shots.

TAKING FLIGHT

Winthrop leads the Big South with 83.2 points per game, the highest scoring average in the league in two seasons. The Eagles have led the Big South in scoring average just twice, with the last time coming in 1992-93 (83.6 average). The first time was in the conference's first year of men's basketball in 1985-86. That season Winthrop was tops with 79.8 points per game.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is the third-active winningest coach in Division I with 783 career victories. Ellis, who notched his 700th Division I win Jan. 2 against Winthrop, is 18th all-time in NCAA history for career wins (regardless of affiliation with a minimum 10 head coaching seasons at NCAA schools), and is the 7th-active winningest coach across all NCAA classifications. He became the first head coach in NCAA history with 150 wins at four different Division I programs with the Chanticleers' 68-56 victory over UNC Asheville on Feb. 3, 2015. His Division I school-by-school breakdown is as follows: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 171, in addition to 78 wins leading Cumberland College from 1972-75.

CLIMBING THE VICTORY LADDER

High Point's **SCOTT CHERRY** is 10th all-time in Big South history for most coaching victories with 110 wins. Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is the Big South's active win leader with 171 wins, which ranks fourth in the conference record books. Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is the longest-tenured active Big South coach, as he is in his 11th year in 2015-16 -- just the third head coach in League history with at least 10 years of service. He sits in sixth-place all-time with 147 victories, two away from moving into a tie for fifth. Here is a look at the Big South's Top 10 winningest coaches:

HIGH FIVE

High Point and UNC Asheville opened the Big South schedule 5-0, the first time the league had two 5-0 teams since 2010-11 (Coastal Carolina and Liberty) and just the fourth time overall. Teams that have started 5-0 in league games have reached the Big South Championship game 17 times -- winning the title 10 times, including UNC Asheville in 2011-12.

GOOD WORK YOUNG MEN

A league-record three men's basketball players are official nominees for the Allstate NABC Good Works Team®, as High Point's **JOHN BROWN**, Longwood's **KANAYO OBI-RAPU** and Presbyterian's **WILL ADAMS** are among the 154 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA. The list will be pared down in February to a 10-person team featuring five Division I student-athletes.

ANOTHER YEAR OF BIG WINS FOR THE BIG SOUTH

The Big South Conference is 2-1 against BIG EAST this season, with both wins over Georgetown. The last time the Big South had two wins vs. the BIG EAST was in 2012-13. Radford downed the Hoyas in double-overtime in its season opener, followed by UNC Asheville on Dec. 19. In addition, the Highlanders defeated Penn State, 86-74 in State College, Pa., on Nov. 26, 12 days after the Georgetown victory. The win over the Nittany Lions marks the second straight year the Big South has defeated a Big Ten member. The Big South has defeated a BIG EAST member four times in the past five seasons, and the last time the Big South had wins over both the BIG EAST and Big Ten in the same year was 2011-12.

DAILY DOUBLE

Radford's wins over two Power 5 conferences marks the fourth time in the last six seasons that a Big South member has achieved this feat. Last season, it was Gardner-Webb (Clemson, Purdue), and prior to that, it was Coastal Carolina (LSU, Clemson in 2011-12) and Presbyterian (Auburn, Wake Forest in 2010-11).

MID-MAJOR MANIA

Radford was ranked No. 25 in the Nov. 16 Collegeinsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 ranking, the second consecutive season a Big South member has appeared in the poll. Five teams have received Top 25 consideration this season -- High Point, Winthrop, Coastal Carolina, Radford and UNC Asheville. Below is a look at where the Big South has stood this season thus far:

CAMPBELL

Campbell has made 74.7% of its free throws in Big South games, tops in the league. **TROY HARPER** (84.9), **CHRIS CLEM-ONS** (82.4) and **SHANE WHITFIELD** (80.8) are all shooting better than 80% from the line ... With 374 points in just 21 games, Clemmons has already moved into 3rd place on Campbell's freshman class scoring charts. He is 30 points behind 2nd place -- **TREY FREEMAN** (404 in 2011-12) ... **ROD DAYS** scored a season-high 13 points at Coastal on Saturday... **KYRE' HAMER** averaged 14 points in 2 games last week, when he shot 53% from the floor and made all 10 of his free throws.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

AARON WHEELER had a career-high 22 points in the loss at Winthrop. He added 12 rebounds for his second double-double in as many weeks and third of the year ... CSU has now lost 15 straight games at Winthrop ... **ARMEL POTTER** and **JAVIS HOWARD** sparked the Bucs against Gardner-Webb, combining for 25 of their 30 points after halftime as CSU cut a 16-point deficit down to four. Potter played a career-high 36 minutes against GWU ... CSU is just 18-for-73 from three-point range over its last three games (=24.7 percent) ... CSU held Gardner-Webb to 24 percent shooting in the 2nd half.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina extended its winning streak to five games with victories over UNC Asheville (68-66/OT) and Campbell (97-68) ... During the win streak the Chanticleers are averaging 80.2 points per game and have won two games by 29 and another by 15 ... Coastal has now defeated each of the three teams that have shared first-place in the Big South standings (Winthrop, High Point, UNC Asheville) ... The Chanticleers poured in 67 second-half points against Campbell after the Camels had tied the game at 30 ... Coastal shot 74.1 percent in the second half, making 20-of-27 shots.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb snapped its four-game skid with a hard-fought 68-59 road win at Charleston Southern Saturday despite shooting at a lower percentage than its opponent for the fifth straight game ... GWU's three-point shooters have connected on just 30-of-124 attempts in the last five games (=24.2 percent) ... **JAMAAL ROBATEAU** poured in a season-high 13 points with a 4-for-5 night -- including a 3-for-4 clip from downtown -- in Wednesday's loss to Liberty ... Freshman **LAQUINCY RIDEAU** ranks fourth in the nation -- and first among all Division I freshmen -- with 58 steals. He is 20 steals shy of tying GWU's Division I single-season record of 78.

HIGH POINT

In High Point's 73-63 victory over Campbell last week, **JOHN BROWN** notched a game-high 22 points on 8-of-15 shooting and grabbed nine rebounds. It marked Brown's third-straight game with at least 20 points (23.3 average in that span) ... **LORENZO CUGINI** broke out of a 2-for-13 slump from deep with a 3-of-4 performance from 3-point range. He finished with 16 points and grabbed three rebounds ... The Panthers have now won four straight against the Camels and seven of the past eight meetings.

LIBERTY

During its current four-game win streak, Liberty is shooting 47.2 percent overall (91-of-193) and 43.0 percent from three-point land (43-of-100). The Flames are also making 10.8 three-pointers per game. Defensively, Liberty is holding opponents to 59.0 ppg ... **JOHN DAWSON** leads the team in scoring (15.3 ppg), rebounding (6.5) and assists (4.3 apg) during the span. **CALEB HOMESLEY** is averaging 10.5 ppg in the stretch ... Five of Liberty's six conference wins have been decided by four points or less ... Liberty's four-game win streak is its first since the 2012-13 season.

LONGWOOD

TRA'VAUGHN WHITE has scored in double figures in six straight games, averaging a team-high 18.3 points per game during that stretch ... **SHAQUILLE JOHNSON** has missed three straight games with an injury. In the three games since, opponents have shot a combined 52.6 percent (91-of-173) from the field while averaging 86.7 points per game ... Longwood has cut down on its turnovers over the past six games, averaging just 13.0 turnovers per game ... **KANAYO OBI-RAPU** has scored 20-plus points in two of his past three games.

PRESBYTERIAN

Should it hold the rest of the season, the 69.5 scoring average would be the highest in PC's Division I history, 4.1 points higher than the 65.4 record in 2013-14 ... Rebounding is peaking as well at 34.5, 1.8 more than the previous record of 32.7 set in the 2008-09 season ... In over 250 games the team has played since moving to Division I in 2007, there have been just 10 one-point games -- three this season. The Blue Hose hold a 6-4 mark (2-1 this season) after the CSU 72-73 loss Jan. 20 ... PC has won its last four of six at the Templeton Center.

RADFORD

Radford picked up its first Big South road win of the season last week (Wednesday at Longwood, 90-81) ... **RASHUN DAVIS** moved into third place on RU's all-time assists list with 418, passing **WHIT-HOLCOMB FAYE**. Davis also ranks 20th on the scoring list with 1,182. Additionally, he surpassed 300 rebounds for his career and now has 150 steals ... **ED POLITE, JR.** has grabbed at least seven rebounds in seven consecutive games and at least six in 10 straight ... **BRANDON HOLCOMB** posted a career-high with 18 points in the Winthrop game on 9-of-10 shooting.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs have won the turnover battle in 16 of 23 games this season, including each of the last 14 games dating back to Dec. 15 against ETSU. Asheville is 10-4 over that stretch, including a 7-3 record over Big South opponents ... Asheville has mastered turning its defense into offense, with the Bulldogs averaging 9.1 steals/game this season -- a number that has grown to 10.6 steals/game in league play -- while notching a +2.0 margin in the turnover battle this season.

WINTHROP

Winthrop is riding a 7-game winning streak (6 in league play), which is the longest since 2009-10. That same year was the last time the Eagles won six straight Big South games ... All seven victories have been by double-figures and the Eagles have won six straight league games by double-figures for the first time in the history of the program ... **KEON JOHNSON** scored a career-high 36 points in the win over Charleston Southern, as he also set a career-high with 10 made threes and is the first player in the last 10 seasons to hit 10 or more threes in a game ... The 36 points by Johnson were also the second-most ever scored in a home Big South contest.

BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

A new tiebreaking procedure implemented prior to the 2015-16 season addresses the Big South's 18-game unbalanced schedule. Each team plays eight teams twice and two teams once, and the new tiebreaker below will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Championship tournament, if necessary.

TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING TWO-TEAM TIE

- i) Regular season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to the next step below.
- ii) If the tied teams played each other twice in the regular season and split their games, then each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings (or in case of a tie for first place, the next highest position in the regular season standings) and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
- iii) When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tie-breaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
- iv) When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against a team or group is unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1; 1-0 is the same as 2-0; 2-0 is the same as 4-0; 2-1 is the same as 4-2; 1-0 is better than 1-1; 0-1 is the same as 0-2; 0-2 is the same as 0-4). If the winning percentage of the tied teams is equal against a team, or a group of tied teams, continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING MULTI-TEAM TIE

- i) The combined record of conference games between the tied teams involved will be compiled. Ties will be broken and seeding's assigned based on the winning percentage of the combined conference records. The higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group is unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1; 1-0 is the same as 2-0; 2-0 is the same as 4-0; 2-1 is the same as 4-2; 1-0 is better than 1-1; 0-1 is the same as 0-2; 0-2 is the same as 0-4).
- ii) If the first procedure fails to break the tie, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage by a higher winning percentage.
- iii) If the tie is broken by (a) or (b) regarding one or more teams, but three or more teams remain tied, then procedures (a) and (b) will be re-applied among those tied teams only.
- iv) If two teams remain tied, the two-team tiebreaker policy will be applied.
- v) If there is more than one tie in the standings, and when utilizing the tie-breaking procedures there are a pair of teams tied, a team's record against the combined tied teams (prior to their own tie-breaking procedures) is used, rather than performance against the individual tied team.
- xi) If procedures two-team and/or multi-team tiebreakers fail to establish an advantage, the team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report will be awarded the higher seed.
