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PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - FEB. 1

PLAYER OF THE WEEK - CHATORI MAJOR, UNC ASHEVILLE, G, JR. (CAMP LEJEUNE, N.C.)

Major shined in the Bulldogs' pair of conference victories last week, averaging 16.5 points per game and shooting 41.7 percent (10-for-24) from the field. To open the week, she dropped in a game-high 20 points in UNC Asheville's key 68-59 win over Presbyterian College on Tuesday. On Saturday, the guard matched a game-high 13 points on 5-of-10 shooting to pace the Bulldogs to a road win against Radford. With the wins, UNC Asheville remained deadlocked with Liberty for first place in the current league standings.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - EMMA BOCKRATH, HIGH POINT, G, (KETTERING, OHIO)

Bockrath averaged 13.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists, leading High Point in each category last week. The guard headlined her pair of contests with a team-high 17 points, six rebounds and five assists in the Panthers' road win at Radford on Tuesday, highlighted by a pair of 3-pointers. Bockrath shot 40.7 percent (11-for-27) from the field and 60 percent (3-for-5) from beyond the arc for the two games.

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MARGINAL NOTE

After 60 Big South games, the visiting teams are an even 30-30 (=50.0 percent) record and have won their 30 games by an average of 10.03 points. Twenty-eight of the 50 overall contests have been decided by less than 10 points (5.39 average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 11.38 points.

MOUNTAIN TOP

UNC Asheville leads the Big South with 71.0 points per game, and is looking to lead the Big South in scoring for just the second time. The Bulldogs' lone appearance as the Big South's top scoring team occurred in 1989-90 with a 73.0 average. Meanwhile, Asheville's +13.3 scoring margin leads the conference and ranks 32nd nationally as well, and is a category the Bulldogs have never finished as the league leader. The Big South single-season record for scoring margin is +17.2, which was set by Liberty in 2009-10.

WHAT A STEAL!

Winthrop's **ALIYAH KILPATRICK**, who tied the Big South single-game record with 10 steals at College of Charleston on Dec. 22, leads the league and is second nationally with 3.83 steals per game. The record is 4.32, set by Campbell's **JULIE SKINNER** in 1987-88. Kilpatrick has posted 12 steals in her last four games (=3.00) and has had at least five steals eight times. With four steals on Jan. 12, Kilpatrick became the 37th player in league annals with 200 in a career. Currently with 214 swipes, she needs 53 steals to crack the Top-10 in league history, but sat out Winthrop's last game with an injury.

BIG "E"

Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS** currently leads the Big South by averaging 16.4 points per game, a full point ahead of second-place **ALYSSA MANN** of Charleston Southern. Williams looks to hold the conference's highest scoring average by a Winthrop player for the fourth time in five seasons after former standout **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** led the conference three times from 2011-2014. Williams will be sidelined for substantial time following an injury late in the Jan. 30 game against Charleston Southern.

PARKING DECK

Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** became the 16th player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks when she eclipsed the scoring milestone on Dec. 31. In GWU's narrow win over UNC Asheville on Jan. 16, she became just the ninth player with 1,000 points, 800 caroms and 125 blocks in a career. Currently, Parker has scored 1,111 points (76th in Big South), grabbed 823 rebounds (18th) and blocked 141 shots (16th).

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Gardner-Webb's **CANDACE BROWN** became the third player this season and 102nd member of the Big South's 1,000-point club during GWU's win over Charleston Southern on Jan. 12. The Big South now has five active 1,000-point scorers, led by High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS**, who sits in 37th place with 1,296 career points. MAY WE ASSIST YOU?

Campbell's **RaeCHAUN EDWARDS** became the 15th player in Big South history with 400 career assists and 200 career steals when she eclipsed the steals milestone Dec. 29 vs. Liberty. Edwards, who became the 19th player in Big South history with 400 career assists in the season opener, currently ranks 11th all-time with 496 and needs four assists to become the 10th player with 500 career helpers. Meanwhile, Liberty's **SADALIA ELLIS** (372) is 28 assists away from 400 in her career, and would be the fifth Lady Flame on the league's all-time chart -- which would extend Liberty's Big South record.

GO FOUR IT

UNC Asheville opened 4-0 in the Big South for the first time since starting 4-0 in 2003-04. It was the fifth consecutive season that a Big South member started league play at least 4-0, and Asheville was the sixth different program to achieve the feat since 2011-12.

STUFFING HER COFFERS

Campbell's **AMANDA COFFER** leads the Big South with 2.35 blocked shots per game and is looking to become the first Campbell Camel to lead the conference in blocks. Coffe has 138 in her career, good for 16th all-time in Big South history. She needs 45 to enter the Top 10.

MAXIMUM EFFORT

Charleston Southern's **MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN** is third in the Big South with 1.95 blocks per contest, as she looks to become the first Buccaneer to average at least two blocks a game since **SHAUNTE SMALL** posted 2.03 per game in 2006-07. With a pair of blocks against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 16, Maximilien became the 30th player in Big South history with 100 career blocks. Meanwhile, she became the 106th Big South player with 500 career rebounds when she eclipsed the milestone Dec. 29 at Longwood. Maximilien is now the fourth active player with 500 career boards and 100 career blocks.

GOOD WORK YOUNG LADIES

A league-record four women's basketball players are official nominees for the Allstate WBCA Good Works Team®, as Coastal Carolina's **OLIVIA CARLTON**, Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER**, Presbyterian's **JANIE MILES** and UNC Asheville's **PAIGE LOVE** are among the 103 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA. The list will be pared down to a 10-person team featuring five Division I student-athletes in February.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER** is the Big South's active-leading rebounder with 870, and needs 42 to enter the league's all-time Top 10. Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** (823) became the 21st member of the 800-rebound club and Liberty's **KATELYN ADAMS** (748) became the 40th member of the 700-rebound club this season. Gardner-Webb's **CANDACE BROWN** (693) and Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS** (640) are among the 71 players with 600 career boards. Liberty's **CATHERINE KEARNEY** (517) became the 107th member of the 500-rebound club on Jan. 24 against Longwood. GARDNER-WEBB, COASTAL CAROLINA SCORE BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG WINS OF 2015-16

Gardner-Webb defeated North Carolina in the season opener, 66-65 in Chapel Hill, while Coastal Carolina knocked off Clemson during the opening weekend. It is the first time since 2006-07 (three wins) that the Big South has collected two victories over the ACC in the same year.

MAGIC WAND-A

Campbell head coach **WANDA WATKINS** needs six wins for 550 in her coaching career, as she is 544-437 in 35 years in Buies Creek, which includes a 225-139 (.61.8 percent) in 14 total seasons in the Big South -- good for fourth in league history. She is four victories away from surpassing former Coastal Carolina coach **ALAN LeFORCE** (228) for third all-time. Watkins owns the second-most Big South victories with 131, and has recorded double-digit conference wins in her last eight seasons in the Big South -- 2011-to-present, and 1990-94 prior to the Camels' 17-year stay in the TAAC/Atlantic Sun from 1994-2011.

GREEN MACHINE

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** needs five wins for 400 in his coaching career. He entered the 2015-16 season ranked 13th all-time among active NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his 75.0 winning percentage -- ahead of renowned coaches **C. VIVIAN STRINGER**, **SYLVIA HATCHELL** and **BRENDA FRESE**. Green is the Big South's all-time winningest basketball coach -- men's or women's -- with his 395 overall wins, which includes 230 Big South victories.

CAMPBELL

The Lady Camels split both contests last week, dropping a hard fought victory at Charleston Southern before earning a big win over Coastal Carolina. **RAECHAUN EDWARDS** led the way for CU with 11.0 points per game followed closely by **AMANDA COFFER** at 10.0. Edwards dished out seven assists per game. **SARAH SMITH** shined off the bench for Campbell averaging nine points per game including a game-high 15 points against Coastal. The Lady Camels picked up their largest victory of the season against the Chanticleers, leading wire-to-wire and holding a 27-point advantage before claiming the victory.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Buccaneers enter Monday having won back-to-back contests with wins over Campbell and Winthrop last week to improve to .500 on the season. **KE'ASIA JACKSON** paced the Bucs with 19 points on Saturday afternoon on ESPN3, while **ALYSSA MANN** was back in double-digits for the Bucs with 15 points in her second game back on the court.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal had its second bye last Tuesday and played just one game last week, falling 73-52 at Campbell on Saturday. Coastal's current three-game losing streak is tied for its longest of the season. **NICOLE ISAACS** hit six 3-pointers and led all players with 23 points at Campbell. Her two highest-scoring games of the season have been against the Camels as she previously scored a career-high 32 points in the teams' first meeting back in December. Coastal ranks second in the Big South averaging 64.0 ppg, but has scored below that average in each of the last three games of its current losing streak.

GARDNER-WEBB

GWU dropped both games this past week, falling Tuesday night at Liberty and PC on Saturday afternoon. The loss at Liberty snapped a six-game win streak, while the loss Saturday was just the second time this season GWU has lost when leading at half. Against PC, the Blue Hose hit their opening three-point attempt, but missed their next 10 attempts and shot just 2-of-17 from three in the first half, but the second half was a different story, as PC shot 42.3% and connected on 5-of-11 from downtown.

HIGH POINT

EMMA BOCKRATH paced HPU with 17 points, six rebounds and five assists at Radford on Tuesday. Bockrath is making a run for Freshman of the Year averaging 11.2 points, 4.2 rebounds and 3.1 assists in Big South action this season. **KAT HARRIS** delivered the Panthers' victory over the Highlanders with a last-second layup to give HPU a 56-54 win. Harris finished with 12 points for the Purple & White. Freshman **SHEA MORGAN** tallied a career high with 13 points on 6-7 shooting to go with six boards at Radford. **KAYLAH KEYS** is four points away from become the fourth Division I player in HPU's history to score 1,300 points.

LIBERTY

After starting the year 3-7, Liberty is 9-1 in its last 10 games. The Lady Flames have won a season-best five straight games overall, five consecutive home games and 19 straight home matchups with league opponents. The Lady Flames finished 7-1 in January and are now 12-17 during the year's first month under **CAREY GREEN**. Liberty needs one more victory to reach 10 Big South wins for the 17th consecutive season. After missing nine games due to injury, Big South Preseason Player of the Year **ASHLEY RININGER** returned to action against HPU on Saturday, tallying eight points, six rebounds, two assists, two blocks and two steals in 14 minutes.

LONGWOOD

Coming off a season sweep of Winthrop Tuesday, Longwood looks to avenge this season's earlier loss to Presbyterian when it faces the Blue Hose Monday night at Templeton Center. **DAEISHA BROWN** is just 19 points from becoming the 21st all-time player in Longwood women's basketball history to score 1,000 points in her career. Brown would become the third member to achieve the feat in the Division I era.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose took sole possession of third place in the Big South with a 60-53 win against Gardner-Webb on Saturday. PC ranks first in the Big South in: scoring defense (55.3), free throw percentage (.735), turnover margin (+3.65), assist/turnover ratio (0.9) and three-point field goals made (6.9). **CORTNEY STOREY** holds second in the conference averaging 4.1 assists per game and assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.6, while **TAYLOR PETTY** sits in second with 2.4 made three-pointers a game.

RADFORD

Radford is currently on a three-game skid after dropping single-digit decisions to High Point and UNC Asheville at home last week. Despite the losses, **JANAYLA WHITE** continues to shine as one of the top post players in the Big South. White dialed up her sixth and seventh double-doubles of the season and is now averaging a double-double (11.9 ppg, 10.2 rpg). The Highlanders will look to get back on track this week as they face a pair of road games at Coastal Carolina and at Liberty. Of Radford's 10 losses, nine have been by single digits. The Highlanders are only losing by an average of 6.4 points per game. That average drops to 5.0 points per game in their five league setbacks.

UNC ASHEVILLE

Asheville is part of a two-way tie atop the conference with Liberty, as Asheville has three more conference games before they face Liberty at home on Feb. 13. One of Asheville's greatest strengths is its depth of players who can score the basketball. In Saturday's win over Radford, Asheville had three Bulldogs with 13 points, while Asheville has outscored its opponents in bench points in all but three conference games this year (Campbell, Liberty and Presbyterian).

WINTHROP

Winthrop has lost **ERICA WILLIAMS** for an undetermined period due to a foot injury she suffered in the late moments of Saturday's game against Charleston Southern. At the time of her injury she had improved her league-leading scoring average to 16.4 points per game. With Williams unavailable, Winthrop is without three of its starters going into the season. The Eagles are not expected to have **ALIYAH KILPATRICK** available for Monday night's UNC Asheville game due to a tender ankle which she injured late in last Tuesday's game at Longwood and missing Saturday's tilt against CSU. Freshman center **ARIANNE WHITAKER**, who was ranked nationally in blocked shots at the time, suffered a concussion and has not played since Jan. 2, but could be cleared for the Asheville game, and sophomore forward/center **EZINNE MBAMALU** has missed the last four games due to an assortment of injuries. Despite losing a 74-67 decision at Longwood, Winthrop turned in its best shooting performance of the season as the Eagles connected on 50 percent (25 for 50).
