## PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - FEB. 8

### PLAYER OF THE WEEK - LOTANNA NWOGBO, LONGWOOD, F/C, R-Sr (LITHONIA, GA.)

Nwogbo averaged 17.5 points, 12.0 rebounds, 78.9 percent from the field (15-of-19) and 2.0 blocks in leading the Lancers to back-to-back wins last week. He opened with 16 points and 11 rebounds in a one-point victory over Campbell, in which he tallied nine points and five boards after halftime. In Saturday's 78-76 double-overtime win at Charleston Southern, Nwogbo was 9-of-12 from the field en route to 19 points with 13 caroms and no fouls. Three of his four blocks came after intermission in what was a one-possession affair for the final nine minutes of regulation.

### THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - LOVELL CABBIL, LIBERTY, G, Fr (ARLINGTON, TEXAS)

Cabbil averaged 14.0 points, 2.0 assists, made 50 percent of his field goals and was a perfect 10-of-10 from the charity stripe in Liberty's two victories last week. He opened with 14 points plus a block and steal in the Flames' home win over Winthrop last Tuesday, and followed with 14 markers and three helpers in a road win at High Point on Saturday. Cabbil scored Liberty's final points against the Panthers as he closed out the remaining 36 seconds with a 6-of-6 free throw performance to seal the victory. For the week, he was 7-of-14 from the field and 4-of-8 from beyond the arc.

## SMOKIN' HOT

Liberty, which was predicted to finish last in the Big South preseason poll, is currently tied for fourth in the league standings with an 8-5 mark -- the program's most league wins since 2011-12 (nine). If the Big South Championship Tournament began this week, the Flames would have a first round bye into the Quarterfinals. Meanwhile, it is the first time since 2010-11 that Liberty is above .500 in conference play in February. The Flames, who have won four Big South road games for the first time since 2011-12 (four), carry a six-game Big South win streak into this week's action.

## McWIN SANDWICH

UNC Asheville head coach **NICK McDEVITT** is just the fifth coach in Big South history to win at least 15 games in each of his first three seasons in the league. He joined Liberty's **JEFF MEYER** (1991-94), Radford's **RON BRADLEY** (1991-94), Winthrop's **GREGG MARSHALL** (1998-01) and Birmingham-Southern's **DUANE REBOUL** (2003-06) as the only coaches to achieve this feat. Gardner-Webb's **TIM CRAFT** is two wins away from joining the club, while Liberty's **RITCHIE McKAY** is four victories shy of adding his name to the list.

## FRESHMAN 15

Coastal Carolina has reached 15 wins for the third straight season and 12th time during its Big South affiliation. UNC Asheville has 15 wins for the ninth consecutive year -- the second-longest streak in Big South history. The record is 10 straight years, set by Winthrop from 1998-2008. The Bulldogs have now won at least 15 games in 18 of their 31 years in the Big South -- tied with the Eagles for the second-most 15-win seasons in conference annals. That record is held by Radford at 19, and the Highlanders are two victories away from its 20th 15-win campaign as Big South members. Meanwhile, Winthrop has posted its third straight 15-win effort during head coach **PAT KELSEY**'s four years on the sideline.

## BIG SOUTH 2,000-POINT ODYSSEY

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN**, who became the ninth player in Big South history with 2,000 career points when he reached the milestone Jan. 14 in the first half at Winthrop, is tied for fourth all-time in conference annals with 2,146 points. The third Panther in the conference's 2,000-point club, Brown is 66 points away from moving into second-place, and needs to average 9.43 points in HPU's seven remaining scheduled games for that second spot. ## BIG SOUTH TO APPEAR ON ESPNU NEXT THREE THURSDAYS

The Big South will appear on ESPNU the next three Thursdays as part of its "Wildcard" TV package on the 24-hour college sports network. ESPNU will televise the Feb. 11 Radford at UNC Asheville game at 9:00pm, the Feb. 18 Charleston Southern at Gardner-Webb contest at 7:00pm, and the Feb. 25 Winthrop at High Point matchup at 9:00pm. **KEVIN FITZGERALD** (play-by-play) and **ADRIAN BRANCH** (analyst) will call each broadcast. For the third consecutive season, four regular-season Big South games will appear on ESPNU in 2015-16. The network televised one January game (Jan. 14 High Point at Winthrop) prior to the upcoming February tilts.

## BIG SOUTH'S ESPN3 GAME OF THE WEEK CONTINUES THIS SATURDAY

The Big South "Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 continues this week with the next broadcast being the Charleston Southern at High Point contest on Saturday, Feb. 13 live at 7:00pm. **CHRIS HEMEYER** (play-by-play) and **JEFF JACKSON** (analyst) will call the action from the Millis Center in High Point, N.C. For the fourth consecutive year, ESPN3 will exclusively carry eight Big South matchups, in addition to all four quarterfinal games of the 2016 Men's Basketball Championship tournament for the third straight year.

## BIG SOUTH CAGERS BACK ON ASN SATURDAY

Big South basketball will again appear on the American Sports Network (ASN) in 2015-16, as seven games are scheduled for broadcast. The next telecast will be Saturday's Winthrop at Radford contest live from Radford with **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) on the call. ## WHAT A STEAL!

Gardner-Webb freshman **LAQUINCY RIDEAU** leads the Big South with 61 steals and 2.44 steals per game. It is the highest per game average since Radford's **BLAKE SMITH** averaged the same amount in 2010-11, as well as the highest-ever by a freshman. Rideau is looking to become the first frosh ever to lead the conference in steals per game, while his season total is the fourth-most by a freshman in league history. Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** posted a Big South freshman record 70 swipes in 2004-05.

## DOUBLE VISION

Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** owns the Big South's active leading double-figure scoring streak at 27 games, dating back to last season. High Point's **JOHN BROWN** is next at 11, followed by UNC Asheville's **DYLAN SMITH** (9) and Campbell's **CHRIS CLEMONS** and Longwood's **TRA'VAUGHN WHITE** with eight each.

## THE BIG 5-0

Head coaches **TIM CRAFT** (Gardner-Webb) and **RITCHIE MCKAY** (Liberty) became the 10th and 11th coaches, respectively, in Big South history to reach 50 overalls in their third season in the league. Craft achieved the benchmark in 92 games, while McKay secured win No. 50 in his 93rd game on Liberty's bench. Fellow third-year leader **NICK McDEVITT** of UNC Asheville is one win away from 50 coaching victories.

## MARGINAL NOTE

Through 69 Big South games, the visiting teams are 29-40 (.42.0 percent), and are seeking their first road winning percentage at or above 40.0 percent for the third consecutive season. Meanwhile, 40 of the 69 overall contests (.58.0 percent) have been decided by less than 10 points (4.15 winning average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 9.07 points. The 2014-15 margin was 10.76, compared to 9.83 in 2013-14.

## DOUBLE TROUBLE

UNC Asheville is the only Big South program to have five players averaging double figures in points, while Campbell, Coastal Carolina and Longwood have four players at 10+ points per game. The Bulldogs are looking to become the first league member to have five players average at least 10.0 points since Charleston Southern in 2013-14.

## BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN**, who is the only player in Big South history with 2,000 points (2,146), 700 rebounds (774), 150 blocked shots (162), 150 steals (173) and 150 assists (168), is third in Big South history with 824 career field goals. He needs 41 to surpass former Panther great **ARI-ZONA REID** (864) for second. Brown ranks second in the conference record book with 497 career free throws made, and is three freebies shy of becoming just the second player with 500. The Big South career record for free throws is 513, currently held by Radford's **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** (2002-06).

## BIG THINGS COME IN SMALL PACKAGES

Winthrop 5-7 guard **KEON JOHNSON** is tied for second in the Big South with 19.9 points per game, and is looking to become just the second Eagle to average 20.0 points since the Big South began sponsoring men's basketball in 1985-86. That year was the last time a Winthrop player averaged 20.0 points, as **FRED MCKINNON** averaged a league-best 21.1 points that first season. Meanwhile, Johnson and teammate **JIMMY GAVIN** have scored 20 points in the same game four times this season, and the Eagles are 4-0 in those contests. In those four games, Johnson averaged 27.0 points with Gavin at 23.0.

## BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Coastal Carolina's **BADOU DIAGNE** became the seventh Big South player this season to surpass the 1,000-point milestone on Feb. 6 (142nd player overall). High Point's **LORENZO CUGINI** is 14 away from the same threshold. The Big South has eight active 1,000-point scorers, and below is a look at where all eight rank among the all-time leaders, as well as the next players approaching the 1,000-point milestone:

## C-SQUARED

Campbell freshman guard **CHRIS CLEMONS** became the 22nd Big South freshman to score 400 points in a season when he surpassed the total Feb. 6 vs. UNC Asheville. His current total of 414 ranks 19th on the list. The Big South's leading freshman scorer with 18.0 points per game -- good for 7th among all freshman nationally, Clemons ranks fourth overall in the league in scoring. His 3.22 3FG per game is first in the league, and he is just 0.09 behind the conference's freshman record of 3.31, set by Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** in 2013-14. Meanwhile, Clemons is tops in the Big South with an 88.0 free throw percentage (66-of-75), and is looking to become the first frosh since 2011-12 and fifth overall to lead the conference in free throw shooting.

## DUBY-DUBY-DO

Winthrop redshirt-sophomore **DUBY OKEKE** leads the Big South with 2.80 blocks per game. He has recorded multiple blocks in 15 of his 20 appearances this season, including three games with four, three with five and one with six. The last (and only) Winthrop player to lead the Big South in blocked shots was **JOSH GRANT** in 2002-03 (2.28). Meanwhile, Okeke surpassed 100 career blocks Jan. 30 during the Radford game and is the first Eagle with 100 rejections (102) since **BILLY HOUSTON** eclipsed the mark during the 2004-05 campaign. Okeke is one of four Eagles residing in the Big South's 100-blocked shot club: Houston (139 from 2002-06), Grant (125 from 2001-04) and **TYRONE WALKER** (105 from 2000-04).

## BADOU'S BOARDS

Coastal Carolina's **BADOU DIAGNE** became the 31st player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Jan. 23 at Charleston Southern. He is now 22nd with 744 and needs three boards to enter the league's all-time Top 20. Diagne, who became the 50th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he eclipsed the mark against Grace Bible College on Nov. 18, has an outside chance of joining the league's 1,000-point, 700-rebound and 100-blocked shot club (currently just 13 members), as his career totals include 1,005 points and 92 blocked shots.

## HIGH POINT DUO BROWN, WEARY JOIN FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE 1,000-POINT SCORERS

High Point duo **JOHN BROWN** and **ADAM WEARY** are the 21st pair of Big South four-year classmates with 1,000 points during the same four-year span. Brown is at 2,146, while Weary sits at 1,147, and the two are just the fifth four-year 1,000-point duo to combine for 3,000 points (3,293). They need 175 points to move into fourth. Meanwhile, fellow classmate **LORENZO CUGINI** is 14 points away from 1,000 in his career, which would mark just the third time a Big South senior trio had 1,000 points during the same four-year period.

## BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

Radford senior guards **RASHUN DAVIS** and **YAYA ANDERSON** became the 20th pair of Big South four-year classmates to score 1,000 points during the same four-year period on Dec. 9 when Anderson eclipsed the milestone. Davis is currently at 1,204 career points, while Anderson stands at 1,118. Their combined point total of 2,322 is the 17th-highest scoring combination for a four-year duo with 1,000 points each, and 89 points away from the 15th position.

## BUC-ETS

Charleston Southern leads the Big South with 9.75 three-pointers per game, and is attempting to become just the second program to lead the conference in the category for four consecutive years. Former member VMI led the Big South in 3FG per games a record six straight seasons from 2006-12. The Buccaneers are looking to average double-digit treys for the first time as well.

## HIGH TOPS

Radford senior **RASHUN DAVIS** became the 21st player in conference annals with 1,000 points (1,204) and 400 assists (421) when he eclipsed the assist milestone Jan. 20 against Campbell. He is the Big South's active career assist leader and 22nd all-time. Davis is also part of a 14-player group with 1,000 points, 400 assists and 150 steals. Meanwhile, teammate **BRANDON HOLCOMB** became the 80th Big South player with 500 rebounds Jan. 14 during the Asheville game, and is now the 24th player in the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club. Holcomb is 22nd all-time in league history with 138 career blocked shots.

## TAKING FLIGHT

Winthrop leads the Big South with 83.0 points per game, the highest scoring average in the league in two seasons. The Eagles have led the Big South in scoring average just twice, with the last time coming in 1992-93 (83.6 average). The first time was in the conference's first year of men's basketball in 1985-86. That season Winthrop was tops with 79.8 points per game.

## HEAD OF THE CLASS

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** is among the 30 candidates for the national Senior CLASS Award. He is the Big South's first official candidate since former teammate **ALLAN CHANEY** in 2013-14.

## WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

High Point's **JOHN BROWN** leads the Big South in scoring (20.3) and field goal percentage (59.1). The last Big South player to finish as the league leader in both categories in the same season was Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** in 2009-10. That year, Parakhouski was tops with 21.4 points and 58.1 percent from the field. Brown is looking to become the fifth Big South player to achieve this feat.

## CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is the third-active winningest coach in Division I with 785 career victories. Ellis, who notched his 700th Division I win Jan. 2 against Winthrop, is tied for 16th all-time in NCAA history for career wins (regardless of affiliation with a minimum 10 head coaching seasons at NCAA schools), and is tied as the 5th-active winningest coach across all NCAA classifications. He became the first head coach in NCAA history with 150 wins at four different Division I programs with the Chanticleers' 68-56 victory over UNC Asheville on Feb. 3, 2015. His Division I school-by-school breakdown is as follows: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 173, in addition to 78 wins leading Cumberland College from 1972-75.

## CLIMBING THE VICTORY LADDER

High Point's **SCOTT CHERRY** is 10th all-time in Big South history for most coaching victories with 110 wins. Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is the Big South's active win leader with 173 wins, which ranks fourth in the conference record books. Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is the longest-tenured active Big South coach, as he is in his 11th year in 2015-16 -- just the third head coach in League history with at least 10 years of service. He sits in sixth-place all-time with 147 victories, two away from moving into a tie for fifth. Here is a look at the Big South's Top 10 winningest coaches:

## HIGH FIVE

High Point and UNC Asheville opened the Big South schedule 5-0, the first time the league had two 5-0 teams since 2010-11 (Coastal Carolina and Liberty) and just the fourth time overall. Teams that have started 5-0 in league games have reached the Big South Championship game 17 times -- winning the title 10 times, including UNC Asheville in 2011-12.

## GOOD WORK YOUNG MEN

A league-record three men's basketball players are official nominees for the Allstate NABC Good Works Team®, as High Point's **JOHN BROWN**, Longwood's **KANAYO OBI-RAPU** and Presbyterian's **WILL ADAMS** are among the 154 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA. The list will be pared down in February to a 10-person team featuring five Division I student-athletes.

## ANOTHER YEAR OF BIG WINS FOR THE BIG SOUTH

The Big South Conference is 2-1 against BIG EAST this season, with both wins over Georgetown. The last time the Big South had two wins vs. the BIG EAST was in 2012-13. Radford downed the Hoyas in double-overtime in its season opener, followed by UNC Asheville on Dec. 19. In addition, the Highlanders defeated Penn State, 86-74 in State College, Pa., on Nov. 26, 12 days after the Georgetown victory. The win over the Nittany Lions marks the second straight year the Big South has defeated a Big Ten member. The Big South has defeated a BIG EAST member four times in the past five seasons, and the last time the Big South had wins over both the BIG EAST and Big Ten in the same year was 2011-12.

## DAILY DOUBLE

Radford's wins over two Power 5 conferences marks the fourth time in the last six seasons that a Big South member has achieved this feat. Last season, it was Gardner-Webb (Clemson, Purdue), and prior to that, it was Coastal Carolina (LSU, Clemson in 2011-12) and Presbyterian (Auburn, Wake Forest in 2010-11).

**CHRIS CLEMONS** has moved into 2nd place on Campbell's freshman Division I era (since '77-78) scoring list. He needs just 15 points to move into 10th on the Big South list ... **ROD DAYS** scored a career-high 15 points (6-8 FG) in CU's 80-79 loss at Longwood ... Freshman **KHADRE' LANE** scored a season-high 10 points vs. Asheville ... CU's bench outscored its opponents by a 61-23 margin in two games last week, an average of 30.5 to 11.5 ... **D.J. MASON** (858) is 42 points shy of moving into 20th place on Campbell's career Division I era (since '77-78) scoring list.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

**ARMEL POTTER** (21 points) and **JAVIS HOWARD** (16 points) each tallied career highs in Saturday's loss to Longwood. Howard has scored in double figures in 5 straight games for the first time in his career ... CSU out-rebounded Asheville, 40-34 overall and 14-7 on the offensive glass ... **RAE ROBINSON** hit a career-high six threes in the loss to Longwood. He had a long 3 to tie the game and force a second overtime ... CSU is bidding for its 10th straight win over PC, and 5th straight season sweep on Thursday.

## COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal's nine Big South Conference wins have come by an average of 13.3 points, while its four league losses have been decided by an average of 6.5 points ... Coastal's current seven-game win streak is the longest by a Chanticleer team since the 2010-11 squad won 22 straight ... **BADOU DIAGNE** became the 21st member of Coastal Carolina's 1,000-point club as he surpassed the career milestone with a 3-pointer at the 16:44 mark of the second half at Radford. He and **ELIJAH WILSON** make up one of the Big South's three active pairs of 1,000-point scoring teammates ... Diagne has played with each of Coastal's last four 1,000 point scorers (Wilson, **WARREN GILLIS**, **KIERRE GREENWOOD**, **ANTHONY RAFFA**).

## GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs' shooters returned to form in Wednesday's win over High Point, draining 57.4 percent of their attempts from the floor and 11-of-22 from downtown to give GWU its first win at HPU since 2009. The victory was **TIM CRAFT**'s 50th career win and moves him into third on the program's all-time winning percentage list ... GWU followed with a 69-66 overtime win over Presbyterian, rallying from a five-point deficit in the extra period after PC came back from 13 points down in the second half. **ISAIAH IVEY**'s corner trey with 2.5 seconds left gave GWU the three-point victory.

## HIGH POINT

**JOHN BROWN** posted season highs of 32 points (12-of-18 FG) and 13 rebounds in High Point's loss to Gardner-Webb last week. With his 26th point against the Runnin' Bulldogs, he became the all-time leading scorer in HPU's Division I history with 2,128 points, surpassing **NICK BARBOUR** ... The Panthers shot 53.1 percent (26-49) in the Gardner-Webb game, including a sizzling 68 percent (17-25) in the second half.

## LIBERTY

The Flames' six-game win streak is their first since the 2006-07 season and the first in Big South play since the 2003-04 campaign. That year, Liberty won seven straight and eventually captured the 2004 Big South title ... The Flames have also won three straight on the road and will now step into a facility where they are winless all-time. Liberty will play Longwood on Saturday, where it is 0-14 inside Willett Hall ... On Saturday at High Point, Liberty had five players finish in double-digit scoring figures for the second time this season -- **A.C. REID** (16), **RYAN KEMRITE** (14), **LOVELL CABBIL** (14), **ANTHONY FIELDS** (14) and **EZRA TALBERT** (11).

## LONGWOOD

Longwood is now 4-4 over the past eight games and 4-1 with a healthy **SHAQUILLE JOHNSON** during that span, with that lone loss coming at Liberty, 55-53. Johnson came off the bench Saturday at Charleston Southern to contribute nine points, seven rebounds, six assists and a career-high five steals in just his second game back since a three-game, injury-related absence. He grabbed five of those boards in overtime as CSU hit just 4-of-13 shots after regulation. It was the Lancers' second consecutive victory over the Buccaneers.

## PRESBYTERIAN

The loss to Gardner-Webb marked the fifth time in the last six games the contest has been decided by four points or less ... The game also marked the first regular-season overtime contest for PC since the 2012-13 season ... **DeSEAN MURRAY** is looking to become just the fifth Big South player to average 20.0 points and 2.0 steals in a campaign. His current per game totals stand at 19.9 points and 2.04 steals.

## RADFORD

Radford suffered its first Big South home loss Saturday, falling to Coastal Carolina, 72-60. The defeat also snapped a six-game home winning streak overall and marked the Highlanders' first back-to-back losses since Dec. 6 and 9 ... The 60 points against Coastal was the team's lowest at home since the Big South opener against Liberty on Dec. 3 ... **RASHUN DAVIS** moved into 15th place on RU's all-time scoring list with 1,204 points ... **ED POLITE, JR.** extended his streak of games with at least seven rebounds to eight straight, pulling down eight against the Chanticleers.

## UNC ASHEVILLE

Asheville is holding opponents to just 28.4 percent from beyond the arc, tops in the Big South and 5th in the country. The league record for 3FG defense is 27.5 percent (Coastal Carolina in 2009-10), and the Bulldogs currently own the second-best percentage allowed in Big South annals ... The Bulldogs have used their defense to lead to offense all season long, and rank third nationally in total steals (233 total), just five takeaways behind national leader Green Bay. Asheville's 9.3 steals per game average is 7th-best in the nation.

## WINTHROP

Winthrop ran off seven straight wins before falling at Liberty Feb. 2, which was the program's longest winning streak since 2009-10. The team won six straight league games during that stretch for the first time since 2009-10 as well ... During the seven-game winning streak, the Eagles won all seven by double-figures (18 of Winthrop's last 28 victories overall have come by double-figures) ... **KEON JOHNSON** surpassed 1,200 career points and is now 13th all-time at Winthrop with 1,220. He is within 25 points of 12th all-time ... **DUBY OKEKE** has a career-high 56 blocks this season and became just the 5th player in school history to reach 100 career blocks. His 56 rejections are second-most in a single-season (school record is 66).

## BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

A new tiebreaking procedure implemented prior to the 2015-16 season addresses the Big South's 18-game unbalanced schedule. Each team plays eight teams twice and two teams once, and the new tiebreaker below will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Championship tournament, if necessary.

### TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING TWO-TEAM TIE

- Regular season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to the next step below.
- If the tied teams played each other twice in the regular season and split their games, then each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings (or in case of a tie for first place, the next highest position in the regular season standings) and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
- When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tie-breaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
- When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against a team or group is unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1; 1-0 is the same as 2-0; 2-0 is the same as 4-0; 2-1 is the same as 4-2; 1-0 is better than 1-1; 0-1 is the same as 0-2; 0-2 is the same as 0-4). If the winning percentage of the tied teams is equal against a team, or a group of tied teams, continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

### TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING MULTI-TEAM TIE

- The combined record of conference games between the tied teams involved will be compiled. Ties will be broken and seeding's assigned based on the winning percentage of the combined conference records. The higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group is unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1; 1-0 is the same as 2-0; 2-0 is the same as 4-0; 2-1 is the same as 4-2; 1-0 is better than 1-1; 0-1 is the same as 0-2; 0-2 is the same as 0-4).
- If the first procedure fails to break the tie, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage by a higher winning percentage.
- If the tie is broken by (a) or (b) regarding one or more teams, but three or more teams remain tied, then procedures (a) and (b) will be re-applied among those tied teams only.
- If two teams remain tied, the two-team tiebreaker policy will be applied.
- If there is more than one tie in the standings, and when utilizing the tie-breaking procedures there are a pair of teams tied, a team's record against the combined tied teams (prior to their own tie-breaking procedures) is used, rather than performance against the individual tied team.
- If procedures two-team and/or multi-team tiebreakers fail to establish an advantage, the team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report will be awarded the higher seed.
