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PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - FEB. 8

PLAYER OF THE WEEK - KATELYN ADAMS, LIBERTY, F/C, R-Sr. (BURNSVILLE, MINN.)

In a pair of Big South victories last week, Adams paced the Lady Flames with a pair of double-doubles, beginning with an 11-point, 12-rebound performance in a 59-49 triumph at Charleston Southern on Monday. On Sunday, Adams totaled 10 points and 11 rebounds in a 14-point home victory over Radford, to finish with averages of 10.5 points and 11.5 rebounds. On the week, Adams shot 64.3 percent (9-of-14) from the floor and recorded 3.0 blocks.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - ARIANNE WHITAKER, WINTHROP, F. (CINCINNATI, OHIO)

Despite two setbacks last week, Whitaker headlined the Winthrop offense by scoring 15 points and pulling down nine rebounds in both contests against UNC Asheville and Gardner-Webb. Against the Bulldogs, the forward finished 7-for-12 (58.3 percent) from the field and totaled a pair of blocks, while also draining seven field goals and recording two rejections against GWU on Saturday. Whitaker closed the week shooting 56.0 percent (14-of-25) from the field and grabbed 18 rebounds.

MARGINAL NOTE

After 70 Big South games, the home teams are 37-33 (=52.8 percent) and have won their 37 games by an average of 13.03 points. Thirty-two of the 70 overall contests have been decided by less than 10 points (5.47 winning average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 11.63 points.

TOP DOGS

With its victory over Winthrop on Feb. 1, UNC Asheville eclipsed the 10-win plateau in Big South play for the first time in program history. Overall, the Bulldogs boast a 18-4 record, marking the most wins by the team since the 2006-07 campaign when they finished the year 21-12

MOUNTAIN TOP

UNC Asheville leads the Big South with 71.1 points per game, and is looking to lead the Big South in scoring for just the second time. The Bulldogs' lone appearance as the Big South's top scoring team occurred in 1989-90 with a 73.0 average. Meanwhile, Asheville's +12.8 scoring margin leads the conference and ranks 33rd nationally as well, and is a category the Bulldogs have never finished as the league leader. The Big South single-season record for scoring margin is +17.2, which was set by Liberty in 2009-10.

WHAT A STEAL!

Winthrop's **ALIYAH KILPATRICK**, who tied the Big South single-game record with 10 steals at College of Charleston on Dec. 22, leads the league and is third nationally with 3.89 steals per game. The record is 4.32, set by Campbell's **JULIE SKINNER** in 1987-88. Kilpatrick has posted 11 steals in her last four games (=2.75) and has had at least five steals nine times. With four steals on Jan. 12, Kilpatrick became the 37th player in league annals with 200 in a career. Currently with 219 swipes, she needs 48 steals to crack the Top-10 in league history.

BIG "E"

Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS**, who will be sidelined for the rest of the season following an injury late in the Jan. 30 game against Charleston Southern, currently leads the Big South by averaging 16.4 points per game, a full point ahead of second-place **ALYSSA MANN** of Charleston Southern. Williams looks to hold the conference's highest scoring average by a Winthrop player for the fourth time in five seasons after former standout **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** led the conference three times from 2011-2014.

PARKING DECK

Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** became the 16th player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks when she eclipsed the scoring milestone on Dec. 31. In GWU's narrow win over UNC Asheville on Jan. 16, she became just the ninth player with 1,000 points, 800 caroms and 125 blocks in a career. Currently, Parker has scored 1,120 points (75th in Big South), grabbed 828 rebounds (18th) and blocked 142 shots (16th).

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Gardner-Webb's **CANDACE BROWN** became the third player this season and 102nd member of the Big South's 1,000-point club during GWU's win over Charleston Southern on Jan. 12. The Big South now has five active 1,000-point scorers, led by High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS**, who sits in 36th place with 1,319 career points. MAY WE ASSIST YOU?

Campbell's **RAECHAUN EDWARDS** became the 15th player in Big South history with 400 career assists and 200 career steals when she eclipsed the steals milestone Dec. 29 vs. Liberty. Edwards, who became the 19th player in Big South history with 400 career assists in the season opener, became the 10th player in Big South history with 500 career assists on Feb. 1. She currently ranks seventh all-time with 503 helpers. Meanwhile, Liberty's **SADALIA ELLIS** (379) is 21 assists away from 400 in her career, and would be the fifth Lady Flame on the league's all-time chart -- which would extend Liberty's Big South record.

STUFFING HER COFFERS

Campbell's **AMANDA COFFER** leads the Big South with 2.3 blocked shots per game and is looking to become the first Campbell Camel to lead the conference in blocks. Coffey has 140 in her career, good for 16th all-time in Big South history. She needs 43 to enter the Top 10.

MAXIMUM EFFORT

Charleston Southern's **MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN** is third in the Big South with 2.0 blocks per contest, as she looks to become the first Buccaneer to average at least two blocks a game since **SHAUNTE SMALL** posted 2.03 per game in 2006-07. With a pair of blocks against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 16, Maximilien became the 30th player in Big South history with 100 career blocks. Meanwhile, she became the 106th Big South player with 500 career rebounds when she eclipsed the milestone Dec. 29 at Longwood. Maximilien is now the fourth active player with 500 career boards and 100 career blocks.

GOOD WORK YOUNG LADIES

A league-record four women's basketball players are official nominees for the Allstate WBCA Good Works Team®, as Coastal Carolina's **OLIVIA CARLTON**, Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER**, Presbyterian's **JANIE MILES** and UNC Asheville's **PAIGE LOVE** are among the 103 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA. The list will be pared down to a 10-person team featuring five Division I student-athletes in February.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER** is the Big South's active-leading rebounder with 882, and needs 28 to enter the league's all-time Top 10. Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** (828) became the 21st member of the 800-rebound club and Liberty's **KATELYN ADAMS** (771) became the 40th member of the 700-rebound club this season. Gardner-Webb's **CANDACE BROWN** (717) joined Adams in the 700-rebound club, while Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS** (640) is among the 71 players with 600 career boards. Liberty's **CATHERINE KEARNEY** (527) became the 107th member of the 500-rebound club on Jan. 24 against Longwood. GARDNER-WEBB, COASTAL CAROLINA SCORE BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG WINS OF 2015-16

Gardner-Webb defeated North Carolina in the season opener, 66-65 in Chapel Hill, while Coastal Carolina knocked off Clemson during the opening weekend. It is the first time since 2006-07 (three wins) that the Big South has collected two victories over the ACC in the same year.

MAGIC WAND-A

Campbell head coach **WANDA WATKINS** needs six wins for 550 in her coaching career, as she is 544-438 in 35 years in Buies Creek, which includes a 225-140 (.61.6 percent) in 14 total seasons in the Big South -- good for fourth in league history. She is four victories away from surpassing former Coastal Carolina coach **ALAN LeFORCE** (228) for third all-time. Watkins owns the second-most Big South victories with 131, and has recorded double-digit conference wins in her last eight seasons in the Big South -- 2011-to-present, and 1990-94 prior to the Camels' 17-year stay in the TAAC/Atlantic Sun from 1994-2011.

GREEN MACHINE

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** needs three wins for 400 in his coaching career. He entered the 2015-16 season ranked 13th all-time among active NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his 75.0 winning percentage -- ahead of renowned coaches **C. VIVIAN STRINGER**, **SYLVIA HATCHELL** and **BRENDA FRESE**. Green is the Big South's all-time winningest basketball coach -- men's or women's -- with his 397 overall wins, which includes 232 Big South victories.

CAMPBELL

The Lady Camels dropped their lone contest last week, a tough 68-56 decision at Gardner-Webb. CU entered the fourth period down by 16 and cut the deficit to just four midway through the frame but couldn't complete the comeback. **AMANDA COFFER** led the way for the Lady Camels with 18 points, her 16th double-figure scoring effort of the season. Campbell returns to the court Tuesday night at Liberty before hosting its Play 4Kay game on Saturday versus Longwood.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN had arguably the best game of her collegiate career on Saturday afternoon to pace the Buccaneers over Longwood to cap of a solid week as CSU went 1-1 against Big South competition. The Bucs fell in their weekday game against Liberty on Monday with the senior center struggling to get traction in the middle against the Flames' bigs. However, Saturday against Longwood, Maximilien scored a career-high 20 points on 9-of-15 shooting from the floor and added six rebounds, three blocked shots and a pair of steals as the Bucs took the season sweep over the Lancers for the first time in program history. **ALYSSA MANN** had seven points, seven rebounds, five assists and two steals against Liberty, and then came back with seven points, six rebounds, five assists and four steals against Longwood. **KE'ASIA JACKSON** averaged 10.0 points per game this past week with a game-high 13 points coming at home against Liberty on Monday afternoon.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal's losing streak stretched to a season-long five games last week with losses to Radford and at Asheville. It's Coastal's longest skid since losing six straight from Jan. 24 - Feb. 10 of the 2014-15 season. The loss at Asheville came in overtime. It was Coastal's first overtime game since Jan. 10, 2015 when the Chants fell in double overtime to Presbyterian. Coastal shot 43.3 percent from the field at Asheville, its highest shooting percentage during the current losing streak. **YASMIN MILLER** led Coastal with a career-high 21 points at Asheville, her eighth time reaching double figures this season.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb went 2-0 last week with a 68-56 victory over Campbell and avenged an early season loss with a 70-52 win against Winthrop Saturday. Both games, GWU used an impressive second half performance to pick up two victories. Against Campbell, GWU led by as many as 16 in the second half, but Campbell cut the deficit to three with 3:31 remaining in the fourth quarter. GWU responded with an 8-0 run to put the game away. Against the Eagles, Gardner-Webb led 33-29 at half and 47-45 after three quarters, but ended the game on a 20-3 run over the final eight minutes.

HIGH POINT

The Panthers picked up a critical win on Saturday to best Presbyterian and move to 7-5 in conference play. Junior **KAYLAH KEYS** scored 23 points by hitting 5-6 three-pointers to lead HPU to the victory. The Purple & White grabbed 44 rebounds while the Blue Hose could muster just 24 boards. The Panthers hit the road to Coastal Carolina on Tuesday before hosting Gardner-Webb on Saturday at 4 p.m. on ESPN3.

LIBERTY

At 11-2 in conference play, Liberty has recorded double-digit Big South victories for the 17th consecutive season. Liberty has won six straight home games, seven consecutive games overall and 20 straight home games against Big South opponents. The Lady Flames have won their first two games in February, improving to 11-3-10 in February contests under **CAREY GREEN**. Liberty has won each of the last three games it has trailed at halftime. In three games since returning from injury, **ASHLEY RININGER** has totaled 34 points and 18 rebounds in 54 minutes played.

LONGWOOD

The Lancers dropped both of their contests last week, falling to Presbyterian and Charleston Southern on the road. **DAEISHA BROWN** is just 11 points from becoming the 21st all-time player in Longwood women's basketball history to score 1,000 points in her career. Brown would become the third member to achieve the feat in the Division I era.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose knocked down a school-record 14 three-pointers in their win over Longwood on Feb. 1. **TAYLOR PETTY** tied the school-record with six in the game. PC sits first in the Big South in assists (12.9 per game), turnover margin (+4.27), assist/turnover ratio (0.9) and three-point field goals made (7.1 per game). Petty stands second in the Big South with 2.4 three-pointers made a contest. **CORTNEY STOREY** leads the conference with a 1.8 assist to turnover ratio and holds second in with 4.2 assists per game.

RADFORD

Radford ended its three-game skid by picking up a 49-36 win at Coastal Carolina, last Monday. However, the Highlanders were unable to end their 10-game losing streak to Liberty, as the Flames used a strong second quarter on their way to a 67-53 victory, Sunday. With the loss, RU falls outside the top five of the conference standings at 7-6, as Liberty became just the second opponent this season to defeat the Highlanders by double digits, joining NC State. **JANAYLA WHITE** delivered her second 20-plus-rebound performance of the season against Coastal. Her 10.6 rebounding average continues to lead all Big South players. White also continues to be the only Big South player averaging a double-double (11.6 ppg, 10.6 rpg).

UNC ASHEVILLE

After a loss to Gardner-Webb followed by a five-game win streak, Asheville is knotted at the top of the conference with Liberty at 11-2. If both teams' records stay the same this week, Saturday's game will decide who remains in first place. In both wins last week, Asheville had four Bulldogs scoring in double-figures.

WINTHROP

Big South leading scorer **ERICA WILLIAMS'** foot injury was confirmed as a broken bone that will require season-ending surgery next week. Her career point total is put on hold at 1,275. **NAIMA JACKSON**, who had not connected on a 3-pointer in her first 45 college games, drained three in Winthrop's home loss to UNC Asheville on Feb. 1. She also finished that game with a career-high 21 points. Due to injuries, Coach **KEVIN COOK** added freshman soccer player **JOJO TAYLOR** to the roster last Friday. Taylor is a 5-6 guard from Prince George, Va. who was an All-Region basketball performer in high school.
