PLAYER OF THE WEEK - OLIVIA PARKER, GARDNER-WEBB, F, SR. (CHARLOTTE, N.C.)

Last week, Parker shined for the Runnin' Bulldogs, as she averaged 14.5 points and 13.5 rebounds while shooting 41.4 percent (12-for-29) from the field. In the process, Parker posted back-to-back double-doubles in a setback at Radford on Tuesday and a road victory over High Point on Saturday. Against the Highlanders, Parker scored a game-high 16 points and corralled 16 boards, including 10 on the offensive end leading to 11 second-chance points. Against the Panthers, Parker tallied 13 points and a game-high 11 rebounds in a seven-point victory.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - HALEIGH HATFIELD, HIGH POINT, G/F, (WINSTON-SALEM, N.C.)

Hatfield headlined her week with a career-high 24 points on 8-for-13 (61.5 percent) from the field in the 79-72 setback to Gardner-Webb. The freshman finished the contest with six 3-pointers and grabbed seven rebounds, as HPU out-rebounded the Runnin' Bulldogs, 40-39, for the contest. Hatfield also handed out an assist, grabbed one steal and posted a block for the afternoon.

MARGINAL NOTE

After 80 Big South games, the home teams are 44-36 (=55.0 percent) and have won their 44 games by an average of 12.68 points. Thirty-eight of the 80 overall contests have been decided by less than 10 points (5.61 winning average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 11.44 points.

TOP DOGS

With its victory over Winthrop on Feb. 1, UNC Asheville eclipsed the 10-win plateau in Big South play for the first time in program history. Overall, the Bulldogs boast a 20-4 record, marking the most wins by the team since the 2006-07 campaign when they finished the year 21-12, while riding the conference's longest active winning streak at seven straight.

MOUNTAIN TOP

UNC Asheville leads the Big South with 70.0 points per game, and is looking to lead the Big South in scoring for just the second time. The Bulldogs' lone appearance as the Big South's top scoring team occurred in 1989-90 with a 73.0 average. Meanwhile, Asheville's +12.2 scoring margin leads the conference and ranks 36th nationally as well, and is a category the Bulldogs have never finished as the league leader. The Big South single-season record for scoring margin is +17.2, which was set by Liberty in 2009-10.

WHAT A STEAL!

Winthrop's **ALIYAH KILPATRICK**, who tied the Big South single-game record with 10 steals at College of Charleston on Dec. 22, leads the league and is third nationally with 3.8 steals per game. The record is 4.32, set by Campbell's **JULIE SKINNER** in 1987-88. Kilpatrick has posted nine steals in her last four games (=2.25) and has had at least five steals 10 times. With four steals on Jan. 12, Kilpatrick became the 37th player in league annals with 200 in a career. Currently with 220 swipes, she needs 47 steals to crack the Top-10 in league history.

BIG "E"

Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS**, who will be sidelined for the rest of the season following an injury late in the Jan. 30 game against Charleston Southern, currently leads the Big South by averaging 16.4 points per game, almost two points ahead of second-place **KAYLAH KEYS** of High Point (14.5). Williams looks to hold the conference's highest scoring average by a Winthrop player for the fourth time in five seasons after former standout **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** led the conference three times from 2011-2014. Williams' scoring title may be in jeopardy if she does not compete in 75 percent of Winthrop's games.

PARKING DECK

Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** became the 16th player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks when she eclipsed the scoring milestone on Dec. 31. In GWU's narrow win over UNC Asheville on Jan. 16, she became just the ninth player with 1,000 points, 800 caroms and 125 blocks in a career. Currently, Parker has scored 1,120 points (75th in Big South), grabbed 828 rebounds (18th) and blocked 142 shots (16th).

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Gardner-Webb's **CANDACE BROWN** became the third player this season and 102nd member of the Big South's 1,000-point club during GWU's win over Charleston Southern on Jan. 12. The Big South now has five active 1,000-point scorers, led by High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS**, who sits in 28th place with 1,353 career points. MAY WE ASSIST YOU?

Campbell's **RAECHAUN EDWARDS** became the 15th player in Big South history with 400 career assists and 200 career steals when she eclipsed the steals milestone Dec. 29 vs. Liberty. Edwards, who became the 19th player in Big South history with 400 career assists in the season opener, became the 10th player in Big South history with 500 career assists on Feb. 1. She currently ranks seventh all-time with 521 helpers. Meanwhile, Liberty's **SADALIA ELLIS** (383) is 17 assists away from 400 in her career, and would be the fifth Lady Flame on the league's all-time chart -- which would extend Liberty's Big South record.

STUFFING HER COFFERS

Campbell's **AMANDA COFFER** leads the Big South with 2.4 blocked shots per game and is looking to become the first Campbell Camel to lead the conference in blocks. Coffey has 146 in her career, good for 14th all-time in Big South history. She needs 37 to enter the Top 10.

MAXIMUM EFFORT

Charleston Southern's **MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN** is fourth in the Big South with 1.8 blocks per contest, as she looks to become the first Buccaneer to average at least two blocks a game since **SHAUNTE SMALL** posted 2.03 per game in 2006-07. With a pair of blocks against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 16, Maximilien became the 30th player in Big South history with 100 career blocks. Meanwhile, she became the 106th Big South player with 500 career rebounds when she eclipsed the milestone Dec. 29 at Longwood. Maximilien is now the fourth active player with 500 career boards and 100 career blocks.

GOOD WORK YOUNG LADIES

A league-record four women's basketball players are official nominees for the Allstate WBCA Good Works Team®, as Coastal Carolina's **OLIVIA CARLTON**, Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER**, Presbyterian's **JANIE MILES** and UNC Asheville's **PAIGE LOVE** are among the 103 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA. The list will be pared down to a 10-person team featuring five Division I student-athletes in February.

A'S FOR ASHLEY

For the second straight season, Liberty women's basketball redshirt senior post player **ASHLEY RININGER** has been voted to the 2015-16 CoSIDA Academic All-District III team, it was announced Feb. 11. After just three years on campus, Rininger graduated with a bachelor's degree in criminal justice in May 2014, maintaining a 4.0 GPA. She then completed a master's degree in human services counseling with a focus in crisis response and trauma in May 2015 with a 4.0 GPA. Rininger, who aspires to be an FBI agent, is currently working toward a second master's degree, in criminal justice. Again, her GPA stands at 4.0.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER** is the Big South's active-leading rebounder with 882, and needs 28 to enter the league's all-time Top 10. Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** (828) became the 21st member of the 800-rebound club and Liberty's **KATELYN ADAMS** (771) became the 40th member of the 700-rebound club this season. Gardner-Webb's **CANDACE BROWN** (717) joined Adams in the 700-rebound club, while Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS** (640) is among the 71 players with 600 career boards. Liberty's **CATHERINE KEARNEY** (527) became the 107th member of the 500-rebound club on Jan. 24 against Longwood. GARDNER-WEBB, COASTAL CAROLINA SCORE BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG WINS OF 2015-16

Gardner-Webb defeated North Carolina in the season opener, 66-65 in Chapel Hill, while Coastal Carolina knocked off Clemson during the opening weekend. It is the first time since 2006-07 (three wins) that the Big South has collected two victories over the ACC in the same year.

MAGIC WAND-A

Campbell head coach **WANDA WATKINS** needs six wins for 551 in her coaching career, as she is 546-439 in 35 years in Buies Creek, which includes a 226-141 (.61.6 percent) in 14 total seasons in the Big South -- good for fourth in league history. She is three victories away from surpassing former Coastal Carolina coach **ALAN LeFORCE** (228) for third all-time. Watkins owns the second-most Big South victories with 132, and has recorded double-digit conference wins in her last eight seasons in the Big South -- 2011-to-present, and 1990-94 prior to the Camels' 17-year stay in the TAAC/Atlantic Sun from 1994-2011.

GREEN MACHINE

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** needs two wins for 400 in his coaching career. He entered the 2015-16 season ranked 13th all-time among active NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his 75.0 winning percentage -- ahead of renowned coaches **C. VIVIAN STRINGER**, **SYLVIA HATCHELL** and **BRENDA FRESE**. Green is the Big South's all-time winningest basketball coach -- men's or women's -- with his 398 overall wins, which includes 233 Big South victories.

Four Lady Camels finished in double-figures led by **SUMMER PRICE**'s 22 points, her third 20-point effort of the season. **JESSICA PONE** fell just short of a double-double with 12 points and a team-high nine rebounds. Edwards remained hot with 12 points and added a game-high eight assists and five steals.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

ALYSSA MANN had double-digits in the scoring category for the Buccaneers this past week as she scored 10 points in CSU's loss to Presbyterian and 14 points against Radford on Saturday. **ELYSE KIPLOKS** recorded her third double-digit rebound effort of the season on Saturday against RU with 10 rebounds (eight defensive) in the loss to the Highlanders. **RACHEL BURNS** was in double-digits for the Bucs on Tuesday night against Presbyterian as the freshman guard led CSU with 12 points in 18 minutes' action on the court. CSU has two remaining games in the Buc Dome in the 2015-16 season, hosting Gardner-Webb and High Point on back-to-back Saturdays

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal snapped its season-long, five-game losing streak on Tuesday with a 79-53 win over High Point. It was the most points scored by the Chants against a conference opponent this season, and the first win against the Panthers in the teams' last five meetings. Coastal then suffered its fourth straight loss in Rock Hill on Saturday, falling to Winthrop 52-43 after trailing by only two points heading into the fourth quarter. Coastal's 45 rebounds at Winthrop were its most in conference play this season, and fourth-best overall. **CED GIBSON** scored 24 points against High Point, matching her career high set earlier this season against Campbell on Dec. 1. For the week, the junior guard led Coastal averaging 16.5 points, 5.0 assists, 3.5 steals and 52.0 percent from the floor.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb went 1-w this past week with a loss at Radford and a good road win at High Point. The Runnin' Bulldogs led the entire game at Radford but a Highlander 3-pointer with 28.5 seconds left lifted Radford to a 54-51 victory. In the first half GWU shot 46.2%, but scored just seven points in the fourth quarter, including going scoreless for nearly five minutes. In the victory at High Point, GWU trailed for much of the game and HPU hit 6-of its first 8 shots and saw on a 14-0 run. High Point continued to lead until the fourth quarter, when GWU clamped down on defense, limiting the Panthers to just 25.0% from the field. GWU outscored HPU 25-12 in the fourth quarter and shot 64.3% to claim the 79-72 victory.

HIGH POINT

Junior **KAYLAH KEYS** averaged 17.0 per game on the week to move past **KATIE O'DELL** and **JURICA HARGRAVES** and into second on HPU's Division I scoring list. Freshman **HALEIGH HATFIELD** posted a career-high 24 points on the strength of 6-of-8 shooting from beyond the arc in Saturday's game against Gardner-Webb, while senior **AARIEL ALLEN** had a seven-point, eight-rebound performance against the Runnin' Bulldogs to anchor the Purple & White inside. HPU continues to be the top free-throw shooting team in the country hitting 16-of-22 this week to keep its season average at .728.

LIBERTY

Liberty's 56-51 loss at UNC Asheville on Saturday ended the Lady Flames' season-best winning streak at eight games. The Lady Flames did extend their Big South home winning streak to 21 games with a 67-55 triumph over Campbell on Tuesday. **MICKAYLA SANDERS**' next three-pointer will make her the 11th Lady Flame ever to hit 100 career triples. Liberty will seek its 46th consecutive head-to-head win over Coastal Carolina, Saturday at the Vines Center.

LONGWOOD

The Lancers dropped both of their contests last week, falling to UNC Asheville at home and Campbell on the road. **DAEISHA BROWN** is just 11 points from becoming the 21st all-time player in Longwood women's basketball history to score 1,000 points in her career. Brown would become the third member to achieve the feat in the Division I era.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose lead the Big South in scoring defense (54.5 ppg.), turnover margin (+4.39), assist-to-turnover ratio (0.9) and three-pointers made (6.9 a game). **CORTNEY STOREY** leads the conference in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.8) and stands second in assists (4.2 a game), while **TAYLOR PETTY** sits second in three-point field goals made (2.3 a game). The Blue Hose stand third in the conference after a 52-37 win over Charleston Southern last week. With the win, PC tied the conference win total from a season ago. The Blue Hose are chasing the 2012-13 squad that went 19-10, 14-4 on the season, the most Division I and Big South Conference wins in school history.

RADFORD

Radford was one of only two teams in the Big South to go 2-0 last week. RU tightened its grip on fifth place in the Big South standings with its two wins, combined with a pair of High Point losses. **JANAYLA WHITE** delivered her eighth double-double of the season at Charleston Southern and ranks second among Big South players in double-doubles. Radford outscored Gardner-Webb and Charleston Southern by a combined 25 points in the fourth quarter alone last week and trailed by as many as 11 vs. Gardner-Webb and 15 at Charleston Southern.

UNC ASHEVILLE

Asheville's win over Liberty on Saturday gave the Bulldogs their 13th conference win, marking the most conference victories in program history, replacing their previous season-best of nine conference wins by the 2003-04 campaign. Junior Tianna Knuckles currently leads the Big South in 3-point shooting percentage at 37.8 percent. Teammate Chatori Major also makes the top three in the league in three-point percentage, tying for third with 36.6 percent efficiency. Including their two wins this week, the Bulldogs have strung together six wins for their second significant winning streak this season.

WINTHROP

Winthrop snapped its four-game losing streak with a 52-43 home win over Coastal Carolina. The home court has produced all four Eagle victories this season. In the win, the Eagles held a halftime lead for just the fourth time this year. Junior guard/forward **CIICII BUFORD** scored a career-high 12 points in the win, as she connected on a career-best three 3-pointers. Although **ALIYAH KILPATRICK**, the NCAA's third ranked steals per game leader, made one theft, it came at a key time when she made the swipe and drove the game clinching layup to give Winthrop an eight point lead with just under two minutes left.
