PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - FEB. 15

Co-PLAYER OF THE WEEK - SHIVAUGHN WIGGINS, COASTAL CAROLINA, G, R-JR (CHARLOTTE, N.C.)

Wiggins averaged 24.0 points, 4.0 assists and 2.5 rebounds last week for the Chanticleers. Following a team-high 18 points against High Point on Thursday, he scored a career-high 30 points on 11-of-13 from the field in Saturday's win over Gardner-Webb. For the week, Wiggins was 16-of-23 from the field (=69.6 percent), 7-of-10 from beyond the arc (=70.0) and 9-of-10 from the charity stripe (=90.0).

Co-PLAYER OF THE WEEK - KEON JOHNSON, WINTHROP, G, JR (MANSFIELD, OHIO)

Johnson averaged 21.0 points, 3.0 assists, 2.5 rebounds and 2.0 steals in leading Winthrop to consecutive wins. He scored 32 points, including a 15-foot buzzer-beater as time expired, to cap the Eagles' 86-84 comeback victory Saturday at Radford. For the week, Johnson was 14-of-14 from the free throw line, including 10-of-10 against the Highlanders.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - CHRIS CLEMONS, CAMPBELL, G, FR (RALEIGH, N.C.)

Clemons shined with 21.0 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 2.0 steals in leading the Camels to two victories. He scored 24 points in Campbell's 89-85 overtime victory over Gardner-Webb. On Saturday at Presbyterian, Clemons tied for the team scoring lead with 18 points in addition to four assists and two steals. For the week, he was 14-of-25 from the field (=56.0), 6-of-11 from three-point range (=54.5) and made 8-of-10 free throws (=80.0).

TWO OF A KIND

For the second consecutive season and on this exact date a year ago, the Big South has a tie for first-place in the league standings at 10-4. Last season it was three teams (Radford, High Point, Charleston Southern) at 10-4 on Feb. 15, and this year it is UNC Asheville and Winthrop who share the lead with 10-4 conference records. Those two teams will go head-to-head this Saturday.

BIG 10

UNC Asheville was the first team with 10 conference wins this season -- the Bulldogs' record-tying ninth consecutive campaign with double-digit Big South victories. Winthrop and Coastal Carolina have each won 10 league contests for the third straight season. It is also the 13th time the Eagles have captured 10 Big South wins, extending their league record. High Point is one win away from its fourth consecutive 10-win conference season, while Liberty is a victory shy of 10 Big South wins for the first time since 2011.

SMOKIN' HOT

Liberty, which was predicted to finish last in the Big South preseason poll, is currently tied for fourth in the league standings with a 9-5 mark -- the program's most league wins since 2011-12 (also nine). If the Big South Championship Tournament began this week, the Flames would have a first round bye into the Quarterfinals. Meanwhile, it is the first time since 2010-11 that Liberty is four games above .500 in conference play in February. The Flames, who have won five Big South road games for the first time since 2010-11 (five), carry a seven-game Big South win streak into this week's action.

McWIN SANDWICH

UNC Asheville head coach **NICK McDEVITT** is just the fifth coach in Big South history to win at least 15 games in each of his first three seasons in the league. He joined Liberty's **JEFF MEYER** (1991-94), Radford's **RON BRADLEY** (1991-94), Winthrop's **GREGG MARSHALL** (1998-01) and Birmingham-Southern's **DUANE REBOUL** (2003-06) as the only coaches to achieve this feat. Gardner-Webb's **TIM CRAFT** is two wins away from joining the club, while Liberty's **RITCHIE McKAY** is three victories shy of adding his name to the list.

FRESHMAN 15

High Point has reached 15 wins for the fourth straight season and ninth time during its Big South affiliation. UNC Asheville has 15 wins for the ninth consecutive year -- the second-longest streak in Big South history. The record is 10 straight years, set by Winthrop from 1998-2008. The Bulldogs have now won at least 15 games in 18 of their 31 years in the Big South -- tied with the Eagles for the second-most 15-win seasons in conference annals. That record is held by Radford at 19, and the Highlanders are one victory away from its 20th 15-win campaign as Big South members. Meanwhile, Winthrop has posted its third straight 15-win effort during head coach **PAT KELSEY**'s four years on the sideline. Coastal Carolina has amassed 15 victories for the third straight season as well.

BIG SOUTH 2,000-POINT ODYSSEY

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN**, who became the ninth player in Big South history with 2,000 career points when he reached the milestone Jan. 14 in the first half at Winthrop, is third all-time in conference annals with 2,175 points. The third Panther in the conference's 2,000-point club, Brown is 37 points away from moving into second-place. Below are the Big South's 2,000-point scorers:

BIG SOUTH'S ESPN3 GAME OF THE WEEK CONTINUES THIS SATURDAY

The Big South "Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 continues this week with the next broadcast being the Longwood at Gardner-Webb contest on Saturday, Feb. 20 live at 7:00pm. **MIKE HOGWOOD** (play-by-play) and **JEFF JACKSON** (analyst) will call the action from Paul Porter Arena in Boiling Springs, N.C. For the fourth consecutive year, ESPN3 will exclusively carry eight Big South matchups, in addition to all four quarterfinal games of the 2016 Men's Basketball Championship tournament for the third straight season.

BIG SOUTH CAGERS BACK ON ASN SATURDAY

Big South basketball will again appear on the American Sports Network (ASN) in 2015-16, as seven games are scheduled for broadcast. The next telecast will be Saturday's UNC Asheville at Winthrop contest live from Rock Hill with **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **DEAN KEENER** (analyst) on the call. Clearances for the game will be made available later this week.

WHAT A STEAL!

Gardner-Webb freshman **LAQUINCY RIDEAU** leads the Big South with 62 steals and 2.30 steals per game. It is the highest per game average since Radford's **BLAKE SMITH** averaged 2.44 in 2010-11, as well as the highest-ever by a freshman. Rideau is looking to become the first frosh ever to lead the conference in steals per game, while his season total is tied as the third-most by a freshman in league history. Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** posted a Big South freshman record 70 swipes in 2004-05.

DOUBLE VISION

Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** owns the Big South's active leading double-figure scoring streak at 29 games, dating back to last season. High Point's **JOHN BROWN** is next at 13, followed by UNC Asheville's **DYLAN SMITH** (11), and Campbell's **CHRIS CLEMONS** and Longwood's **TRA'VAUGHN WHITE** with 10 each.

THE BIG 5-0

Head coaches **TIM CRAFT** (Gardner-Webb) and **RITCHIE MCKAY** (Liberty) became the 10th and 11th coaches, respectively, in Big South history to reach 50 overalls in their third season in the league. Craft achieved the benchmark in 92 games, while McKay secured win No. 50 in his 93rd game on Liberty's bench. Fellow third-year leader **NICK McDEVITT** of UNC Asheville is one win away from 50 coaching victories.

MARGINAL NOTE

Through 79 Big South games, the visiting teams are 34-45 (.43.0 percent), and are seeking a road winning percentage at or above 40.0 percent for the third consecutive season. Meanwhile, 47 of the 79 overall contests (.59.5 percent) have been decided by less than 10 points (4.04 winning average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 9.06 points. The 2014-15 margin was 10.76, compared to 9.83 in 2013-14.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

UNC Asheville is the only Big South program to have five players averaging double figures in points, while Coastal Carolina and Longwood have four players at 10+ points per game. The Bulldogs are looking to become the first league member to have five players average at least 10.0 points since Charleston Southern in 2013-14.

BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN**, who is the only player in Big South history with 2,000 points (2,175), 700 rebounds (790), 150 blocked shots (166), 150 steals (174) and 150 assists (173), is third in Big South history with 837 career field goals. He needs 28 to surpass former Panther great **ARI-ZONA REID** (864) for second. Brown ranks second in the conference record book with 500 career free throws made -- just the second player with that benchmark. The Big South career record for free throws made is 513, currently held by Radford's **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** (2002-06).

BIG THINGS COME IN SMALL PACKAGES

Winthrop 5-7 guard **KEON JOHNSON** leads the Big South with 20.0 points per game, and is looking to become just the second Eagle to average 20.0 points since the Big South began sponsoring men's basketball in 1985-86. That year was the last time a Winthrop player averaged 20.0 points, as **FRED MCKINNON** averaged a league-best 21.1 points that first season -- also the last time a Winthrop Eagle led the Big South in scoring. Meanwhile, Johnson and teammate **JIMMY GAVIN** have scored 20 points in the same game four times this season, and the Eagles are 4-0 in those contests. In those four games, Johnson averaged 27.0 points with Gavin at 23.0.

C-SQUARED

Campbell freshman guard **CHRIS CLEMONS** became the 22nd Big South freshman to score 400 points in a season when he surpassed the total Feb. 6 vs. UNC Asheville. His current total of 456 ranks 7th on the list, and he is 44 points away from becoming the fifth freshman with 500 points. The Big South's leading freshman scorer with 18.2 points per game -- good for 6th among all freshman nationally, Clemons ranks fourth overall in the league in scoring. His 3.20 3FG per game is first in the league, and he is just 0.11 behind the conference's freshman record of 3.31, set by Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** in 2013-14. Meanwhile, Clemons is tops in the Big South with an 87.1 free throw percentage (74-of-85), and is looking to become the first frosh since 2011-12 and fifth overall to lead the conference in free throw shooting.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Coastal Carolina's **BADOU DIAGNE** became the seventh Big South player this season to surpass the 1,000-point milestone on Feb. 6 (142nd player overall). High Point's **LORENZO CUGINI** is nine away from the same threshold. The Big South has eight active 1,000-point scorers, and below is a look at where all eight rank among the all-time leaders, as well as the next players approaching the 1,000-point milestone:

DUBY-DUBY-DO

Winthrop redshirt-sophomore **DUBY OKEKE** leads the Big South with 2.59 blocks per game. He has recorded multiple blocks in 15 of his 22 appearances this season, including three games with four, three with five and one with six. The last (and only) Winthrop player to lead the Big South in blocked shots was **JOSH GRANT** in 2002-03 (2.28). Meanwhile, Okeke surpassed 100 career blocks Jan. 30 during the Radford game and is the first Eagle with 100 rejections (103) since **BILLY HOUSTON** eclipsed the mark during the 2004-05 campaign. Okeke is one of four Eagles residing in the Big South's 100-blocked shot club: Houston (139 from 2002-06), Grant (125 from 2001-04) and **TYRONE WALKER** (105 from 2000-04).

COASTAL'S BOARDWALK

Coastal Carolina is the lone Big South member to have three players with at least 500 career rebounds. **TRISTAN CURTIS** eclipsed the milestone this past Saturday to become the 81st player in league history with 500 (504), while injured forward **MICHEL ENANGA** reached the benchmark Nov. 21 and stands at 523. **BADOU DIAGNE** became the 31st player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Jan. 23 at Charleston Southern, and is 20th all-time with 754. Meanwhile, Diagne, who became the 50th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he eclipsed the mark against Grace Bible College on Nov. 18, has an outside chance of joining the league's 1,000-point, 700-rebound and 100-blocked shot club (currently just 13 members), as his career totals include 1,025 points and 93 blocked shots.

HIGH POINT DUO BROWN, WEARY JOIN FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE 1,000-POINT SCORERS

High Point duo **JOHN BROWN** and **ADAM WEARY** are the 21st pair of Big South four-year classmates with 1,000 points during the same four-year span. Brown is at 2,175, while Weary sits at 1,175, and the two are just the fifth four-year 1,000-point duo to combine for 3,000 points (3,350). They need 118 points to move into fourth. Meanwhile, fellow classmate **LORENZO CUGINI** is nine points away from 1,000 in his career, which would mark just the third time a Big South senior trio had 1,000 points during the same four-year period.

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

Radford senior guards **RASHUN DAVIS** and **YAYA ANDERSON** became the 20th pair of Big South four-year classmates to score 1,000 points during the same four-year period on Dec. 9 when Anderson eclipsed the milestone. Davis is currently at 1,237 career points, while Anderson stands at 1,141. Their combined point total of 2,378 is the 16th-highest scoring combination for a four-year duo with 1,000 points each, and 33 points away from the 15th position.

BUC-ETS

Charleston Southern leads the Big South with 9.42 three-pointers per game, and is attempting to become just the second program to lead the conference in the category for four consecutive years. Former member VMI led the Big South in 3FG per games a record six straight seasons from 2006-12. The Buccaneers are looking to average double-digit treys for the first time as well.

HIGH TOPS

Radford senior **RASHUN DAVIS** became the 21st player in conference annals with 1,000 points (1,237) and 400 assists (432) when he eclipsed the assist milestone Jan. 20 against Campbell. He is the Big South's active career assist leader and 20th all-time. Davis is also part of a 14-player group with 1,000 points, 400 assists and 150 steals. Meanwhile, teammate **BRANDON HOLCOMB** became the 80th Big South player with 500 rebounds Jan. 14 during the Asheville game, and is now the 24th player in the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club. Holcomb is 22nd all-time in league history with 138 career blocked shots.

TAKING FLIGHT

Winthrop leads the Big South with 83.3 points per game, the highest scoring average in the league in two seasons. The Eagles have led the Big South in scoring average just twice, with the last time coming in 1992-93 (83.6 average). The first time was in the conference's first year of men's basketball in 1985-86. That season Winthrop was tops with 79.8 points per game.

HEAD OF THE CLASS

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** is among the 30 candidates for the national Senior CLASS Award. He is the Big South's first official candidate since former teammate **ALLAN CHANEY** in 2013-14.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is the third-active winningest coach in Division I with 786 career victories. Ellis, who notched his 700th Division I win Jan. 2 against Winthrop, is tied for 16th all-time in NCAA history for career wins (regardless of affiliation with a minimum 10 head coaching seasons at NCAA schools), and is the 7th-active winningest coach across all NCAA classifications. He became the first head coach in NCAA history with 150 wins at four different Division I programs with the Chanticleers' 68-56 victory over UNC Asheville on Feb. 3, 2015. His Division I school-by-school breakdown is as follows: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 174, in addition to 78 wins leading Cumberland College from 1972-75.

CLIMBING THE VICTORY LADDER

High Point's **SCOTT CHERRY** is 10th all-time in Big South history for most coaching victories with 112 wins. Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is the Big South's active win leader with 174 wins, which ranks fourth in the conference record books. Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is the longest-tenured active Big South coach, as he is in his 11th year in 2015-16 -- just the third head coach in League history with at least 10 years of service. He sits in sixth-place all-time with 148 victories, two away from sole possession of fifth-place. Here is a look at the Big South's Top 10 winningest coaches:

A league-record three men's basketball players were official nominees for the Allstate NABC Good Works Team®, as High Point's **JOHN BROWN**, Longwood's **KANAYO OBI-RAPU** and Presbyterian's **WILL ADAMS** were among the 154 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA.

CAMPBELL

Freshman **KHADRE' LANE** scored a career-high 20 points in Thursday's win over GWU, the 3rd-straight game in which he scored a career-best total ... CU's 30-point margin of victory at Presbyterian (91-61) marked Campbell's largest in a Big South road win since the Camels returned to the league in 2011-12 ... CU has won 10 of its last 12 overtime games dating to the 2007-08 season. CU and GWU played extra time for the third time in four seasons ... Campbell's bench has outscored its opponents by a 128-56 margin over the last four games, including a 33-12 gap Saturday at PC.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

ARMEL POTTER has scored 17 or more points in 5 straight games. He is averaging 20.4 PPG over that stretch ... **REUBEN KING** notched his first career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds against Presbyterian. Both were career highs. He had 12 points against High Point, marking the first time in his career he's scored in double figures in two consecutive games ... CSU will appear on ESPNU Thursday against Gardner-Webb in its second-ever contest on the network.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Last week's loss to High Point snapped the Chanticleers' seven-game win streak, while the GWU win broke the Runnin' Bulldogs' three-game regular season win streak over CCU ... The Chants' 10-5 league mark is a half game back of conference leaders UNC Asheville and Winthrop (10-4). Coastal plays each in the season's final three games ... **SHIVAUGHN WIGGINS** averaged 24.0 points last week, scoring a team-high 18 against High Point and a career-high 30 against Gardner-Webb. His 30-point game, which came on 11-of-13 from the field (5-of-6 3FG), marked the first time since 2012 that a Coastal player hit the 30-point mark ... **TRISTIAN CURTIS** controlled a career-best 15 rebounds against High Point, followed by 13 against Gardner-Webb.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb surrendered a halftime lead for the third and fourth times this season in a pair of gut-wrenching road losses to Campbell and Coastal Carolina last week ... The Runnin' Bulldogs are 13-4 this season when leading at halftime -- including two straight setbacks ... Gardner-Webb is currently eighth in the nation in total steals (239) and ninth in thefts per game (8.9) ... Freshman **LAQUINCY RIDEAU** is 16 thefts away from equaling GWU's Division I single-season record of 78, set by **TIM JENNINGS** in 2004-05.

HIGH POINT

The Panthers made two stops on Coastal's final possession to grab last week's 68-67 road victory. HPU held a +5 (41-36) advantage on the glass against the league's best rebounding team ... HPU held Charleston Southern to 36 percent shooting in the second half and 4-for-22 (.182) from 3-point land for the game ... The Panther reserves held a +19 (28-9) edge in bench scoring. **JOHN BROWN** (16), **ANDRE FOX** (15) and **ADAM WEARY** (15) all hit the 15-point plateau vs. CSU.

LIBERTY

The Liberty men's basketball team escaped with its first-ever win inside Willett Hall Saturday afternoon with a 69-68 victory over Longwood. **A.C. REID** posted a career-high 20 points, which included six three-pointers. **ANTHONY FIELDS** also had a career-high eight assists ... Liberty's seven-game win streak is its first since 2003-04. The Flames won seven straight contests in Big South play that season, eventually capturing its second Big South Championship in program history ... Liberty went 16-of-30 (53.3 percent) from long distance, marking the second-most 3FG made in school history.

LONGWOOD

LOTANNA NWOGBO has recorded four consecutive double-doubles and five double-doubles in his past seven games ... **TRA'VAUGHN WHITE** has scored in double figures in 10 consecutive games, averaging 18.2 points and 2.9 assists per game during that stretch. White leads Longwood in free throws made (41) and attempted (46) during that 10-game period along with a 89.1 FT clip ... The Lancers are 4-6 over their past 10 games with two of those losses -- both to Liberty -- being decided by a combined three points. Both of those losses came down to Longwood's final possession ... Both White and **DARRION ALLEN** are on pace to break into Longwood's top three for the highest free throw percentages.

PRESBYTERIAN

DeSEAN MURRAY was nearly flawless on offense last week, hitting 9-of-10 from the field in a 20-point performance against Campbell ... At Charleston Southern, he made up for a 4-of-12 effort from the field by hitting 10-of-11 free throws to finish with 18 points. He recorded two steals and one block against the Bucs, with just one turnover, and averaged 19 points and 27 minutes in the two games played.

RADFORD

The Highlanders have played four straight games against teams in either first or second place at the time ... **RASHUN DAVIS'** go-ahead basket with 15 seconds left at Asheville was his third game-winner of the season. He is now 14th on RU's all-time scoring list. Davis dished out nine assists against Winthrop, giving him four games with at least nine assists this season ... **CAMERON JONES** has scored in double figures in nine straight games, including four with more than 20. Jones is averaging 18.9 ppg during the last nine outings ... **YAYA ANDERSON** now ranks fifth in program history with 222 career 3-pointers.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs have used their length to force turnovers all season, as their 241 total steals ranking seventh nationally and first in the Big South Conference. In addition to the total number of steals, Asheville has remained consistent with its thievery, forcing an average of 9.3 steals per game (8th-most in the country) ... Asheville has all but eliminated opponents' use of the three-ball this season, holding foes to 28.6 percent shooting from long range, a mark that is fourth nationally.

WINTHROP

The Eagles bounced back to win two hard fought games (at home vs. Longwood and on the road at Radford) last week ... Winthrop continues to lead the league in scoring as it averaged 87.0 ppg on the week and has now scored 70 or more points in 11 straight games and has 16 games scoring 80 or more points ... **KEON JOHNSON** ended his week with a 32-point performance at Radford that included the game-winning jumper at the buzzer as he passed **MICHAEL JENKINS** and **TYRONE WALKER** on the all-time scoring list and is now 11th all-time with 1,262 ... **XAVIER COOKS** recorded his seventh career double-double in the win over Longwood (20 points and 12 rebounds).

BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

A new tiebreaking procedure implemented prior to the 2015-16 season addresses the Big South's 18-game unbalanced schedule. Each team plays eight teams twice and two teams once, and the new tiebreaker below will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Championship tournament, if necessary.

TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING TWO-TEAM TIE

- Regular season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to the next step below.
- If the tied teams played each other twice in the regular season and split their games, then each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings (or in case of a tie for first place, the next highest position in the regular season standings) and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
- When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tie-breaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
- When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against a team or group is unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1; 1-0 is the same as 2-0; 2-0 is the same as 4-0; 2-1 is the same as 4-2; 1-0 is better than 1-1; 0-1 is the same as 0-2; 0-2 is the same as 0-4). If the winning percentage of the tied teams is equal against a team, or a group of tied teams, continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING MULTI-TEAM TIE

- The combined record of conference games between the tied teams involved will be compiled. Ties will be broken and seeding's assigned based on the winning percentage of the combined conference records. The higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group is unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1; 1-0 is the same as 2-0; 2-0 is the same as 4-0; 2-1 is the same as 4-2; 1-0 is better than 1-1; 0-1 is the same as 0-2; 0-2 is the same as 0-4).
- If the first procedure fails to break the tie, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage by a higher winning percentage.
- If the tie is broken by (a) or (b) regarding one or more teams, but three or more teams remain tied, then procedures (a) and (b) will be re-applied among those tied teams only.
- If two teams remain tied, the two-team tiebreaker policy will be applied.
- If there is more than one tie in the standings, and when utilizing the tie-breaking procedures there are a pair of teams tied, a team's record against the combined tied teams (prior to their own tie-breaking procedures) is used, rather than performance against the individual tied team.
- If procedures two-team and/or multi-team tiebreakers fail to establish an advantage, the team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report will be awarded the higher seed.
