PLAYER OF THE WEEK - XAVIER COOKS, WINTHROP, F. SOPH (WOLLONGONG, NEW SOUTH WALES.)

Cooks averaged 20.5 points, 9.5 rebounds and 3.0 blocks in leading the Eagles to two key league wins and sole possession of first-place in the Big South standings. He opened his week with 26 points, 10 rebounds and four blocks in Winthrop's 79-67 win over Coastal Carolina, and followed with 15 points, nine boards and two rejections Saturday against Asheville, including nine second-half points. For the week, Cooks was 12-of-22 from the field (=54.5 percent), 9-of-13 from three-point range (=69.2) and 8-of-9 from the free throw line (=88.9).

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - DWAYNE SUTTON, UNC ASHEVILLE, G, FR (LOUISVILLE, Ky.)

Sutton averaged 15.5 points, 7.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists, 3.0 steals and 50.0 percent from the field in two games. He highlighted his week with a career-high 23 points plus nine rebounds, four steals and four helpers in the Bulldogs' comeback win at Presbyterian. Sutton added five rebounds, two assists and two steals Saturday at Winthrop.

WINTHROP CLINCHES FIRST FIRST ROUND BYE, COULD CLINCH REGULAR-SEASON ON THURSDAY

Winthrop was the first team to clinch one of the five first round byes of the 2016 Big South Basketball Championship, as the Eagles defeated UNC Asheville this past Saturday, 81-80, to move into sole possession of first-place at 12-4. Winthrop can clinch the regular-season championship with a win Thursday night at High Point **AND** a loss by UNC Asheville that evening. Meanwhile, six teams remain in contention for the final four byes. With 11 Big South wins each, High Point and Asheville can clinch a bye with their next victory.

ATOP THE PERCH

As mentioned above, Winthrop sits alone in first-place in the Big South standings with a 12-4 record. It is the first time since the 2007-08 season that the Eagles own the league's top spot this late into the season. On Feb. 25, 2008, Winthrop was first in the league standings at 9-3 entering the final week of the regular-season. As is the case this year, the Eagles also held a one-game advantage over UNC Asheville at that time.

BIG 10

For the third consecutive year, at least five teams have won 10 Big South games in the same season. UNC Asheville was the first team with 10 conference wins -- the Bulldogs' record-tying ninth consecutive campaign with double-digit Big South victories. High Point and Gardner-Webb have posted their fourth straight campaign with double-digit conference wins -- tied for the second-longest streak in league annals. Winthrop and Coastal Carolina have each won 10 league contests for the third straight season. It is also the 13th time the Eagles have captured 10 Big South wins, extending their league record. Meanwhile, Liberty is a victory shy of 10 Big South wins for the first time since 2011, and Radford needs to win its final two games for its third consecutive 10-win performance in league play.

DOWN AND GIVE ME 20

Winthrop has reached 20 wins for the second time in three seasons, and has posted 20 regular-season victories for the first time since 2006-07. It is the Eagles' 10th 20-win season as Big South members, extending their league record. Meanwhile, High Point and UNC Asheville are two wins away from 20 victories. It would be the Panthers' second straight and third overall 20-win season since joining the Big South, while the Bulldogs would collect their fifth 20-win campaign and first since 2011-12 once they reach the total.

HE'S CRAFTY

Gardner-Webb head coach **TIM CRAFT** became the second coach this year and sixth in Big South history to win at least 15 games in each of his first three seasons in the league. He joins UNC Asheville's **NICK McDEVITT** with the accomplishment this year, as well as Liberty's **JEFF MEYER** (1991-94), Radford's **RON BRADLEY** (1991-94), Winthrop's **GREGG MARSHALL** (1998-01) and Birmingham-Southern's **DUANE REBOUL** (2003-06) as the only coaches to achieve this feat. Liberty's **RITCHIE McKAY** is three victories shy of adding his name to the list.

BIG SOUTH 2,000-POINT ODYSSEY

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN**, who became the ninth player in Big South history with 2,000 career points when he reached the milestone Jan. 14 in the first half at Winthrop, is third all-time in conference annals with 2,210 points. The third Panther in the conference's 2,000-point club, Brown is two points away from moving into second-place. Below are the Big South's 2,000-point scorers:

FRESHMAN 15

Radford has reached 15 wins in a season for the third consecutive year and 20th time as Big South members, extending its league record. Gardner-Webb has now won 15 games each of the last four seasons, while High Point has reached 15 wins for the fourth straight season and ninth time during its Big South affiliation. UNC Asheville has 15 wins for the ninth consecutive year -- the second-longest streak in Big South history. The record is 10 straight years, set by Winthrop from 1998-2008. The Bulldogs have now won at least 15 games in 18 of their 31 years in the Big South -- tied with the Eagles for the second-most 15-win seasons in conference annals.

BIG SOUTH'S FINAL ESPNU WILDCARD APPEARANCE IS THURSDAY

The Big South will appear on ESPNU for the final time this Thursday as part of its "Wildcard" TV package on the 24-hour college sports network. ESPNU will televise the Feb. 25 Winthrop at High Point matchup at 9:00pm, with **KEVIN FITZGERALD** (play-by-play) and **ADRIAN BRANCH** (analyst) on the call. For the third consecutive season, four regular-season Big South games appeared on ESPNU in 2015-16. The network televised one January game and three February contests on a "Wildcard" basis.

BIG SOUTH'S ESPN3 GAME OF THE WEEK CONCLUDES THIS SATURDAY

The Big South "Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 concludes this week with the final regular-season broadcast being the Coastal Carolina at UNC Asheville contest on Saturday, Feb. 27 live at 4:30pm. **MIKE HOGWOOD** (play-by-play) and **RALPH PATTERSON** (analyst) will call the action from Kimmel Arena in Asheville, N.C. For the fourth consecutive year, ESPN3 exclusively carried eight Big South matchups, in addition to all four quarterfinal games of the 2016 Men's Basketball Championship tournament for the third straight season.

BIG SOUTH CAGERS BACK ON ASN FOR FINAL TIME SATURDAY

Big South basketball again appeared on the American Sports Network (ASN) in 2015-16, as seven games were broadcast. The final telecast will be Saturday's Gardner-Webb at Liberty contest live from Lynchburg at 12:00pm with **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **TIM SCARBOROUGH** (analyst) on the call. Clearances for the game will be made available later this week.

WHAT A STEAL!

Gardner-Webb freshman **LAQUINCY RIDEAU** leads the Big South with 66 steals and 2.28 steals per game. It is the highest per game average since Radford's **BLAKE SMITH** averaged 2.44 in 2010-11, as well as the highest-ever by a freshman. Rideau is looking to become the first frosh ever to lead the conference in steals per game, while his season total is the second-most by a freshman in league history. Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** posted a Big South freshman record 70 swipes in 2004-05.

DOUBLE VISION

Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** owns the Big South's active leading double-figure scoring streak at 31 games, dating back to last season. High Point's **JOHN BROWN** is next at 15, followed by Campbell's **CHRIS CLEMONS** (12).

THE BIG 5-0

Head coaches **TIM CRAFT** (Gardner-Webb), **RITCHIE MCKAY** (Liberty) and **NICK McDEVITT** (UNC Asheville) became the 10th, 11th and 12th coaches, respectively, in Big South history to reach 50 overall wins in their third season in the league. Craft achieved the benchmark in 92 games, while McKay secured win No. 50 in his 93rd game on Liberty's bench. McDevitt won No. 50 in his 90th game on the sideline. He is one of seven coaches in league history with 50 wins in 90 or less games.

MARGINAL NOTE

Through 89 Big South games, the visiting teams are 40-49 (.44.9 percent), and are seeking a road winning percentage at or above 40.0 percent for the third consecutive season. It is the highest road winning clip since 2008-09 when the road teams won 46.7 percent of Big South games. Meanwhile, 55 of the 89 overall contests (.61.8 percent) have been decided by less than 10 points (4.34 winning average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 8.73 points. In fact, 37.1 percent of Big South games (33) have been decided by four points-or-less -- tops in the nation.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

UNC Asheville and Longwood are the lone Big South programs to have five players averaging double figures in points, while Coastal Carolina has four players at 10+ points per game. The Bulldogs and Lancers are looking to become the first league member to have five players average at least 10.0 points since Charleston Southern in 2013-14.

BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** is second all-time in Big South history with 511 made free throws, and needs three to break the all-time mark of 513 currently held by Radford's **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** (2002-06). Brown's 710 career free throw attempts are second-most in league annals. Brown, who is the only player in Big South history with 2,000 points (2,210), 700 rebounds (798), 150 blocked shots (167), 150 steals (178) and 150 assists (178), is third in Big South history with 849 career field goals. He needs 16 to surpass former Panther great **ARIZONA REID** (864) for second.

HEAD OF THE CLASS

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** was among the 30 candidates for the national Senior CLASS Award. He is the Big South's first official candidate since former teammate **ALLAN CHANEY** in 2013-14.

C-SQUARED

Campbell freshman guard **CHRIS CLEMONS** is just the fifth Big South freshman in league history to score 500 points in a season, as he reached the total Feb. 20 at Charleston Southern. The Big South's leading freshman scorer with 18.5 points per game -- good for 6th among all freshman nationally, Clemons ranks fourth overall in the league in scoring. His 3.15 3FG per game is first in the league, and he is just 0.16 behind the conference's freshman record of 3.31, set by Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** in 2013-14. Meanwhile, Clemons is tops in the Big South with an 86.5 free throw percentage, and is looking to become the first frosh since 2011-12 and fifth overall to lead the conference in free throw shooting.

FRESH PERSPECTIVE

Charleston Southern freshman **ARMEL POTTER** and UNC Asheville frosh **DYLAN SMITH** are on the cusp of adding their names to the list of 22 Big South freshmen to score 400 points in a season. Both players lead their respective teams in scoring, as Potter has 382 points and Smith has 381. The last Buccaneer freshman to score 400 points in a season was **SAAH NIMLEY** in 2011-12 (420). The last Bulldog frosh with 400 points was **ANDREW ROWSEY** in 2013-14 (648). Potter and Smith are looking to join Campbell's **CHRIS CLEMONS** in the 400-point club this season, which would mark the third time in Big South history that three freshman scored 400 points in the same year (2008-09 and 2013-14).

BIG THINGS COME IN SMALL PACKAGES

Winthrop 5-7 guard **KEON JOHNSON** is tied for second in the Big South with 19.6 points per game, and is looking to become just the second Eagle to average 20.0 points since the Big South began sponsoring men's basketball in 1985-86. That year was the last time a Winthrop player averaged 20.0 points, as **FRED MCKINNON** averaged a league-best 21.1 points that first season -- also the last time a Winthrop Eagle led the Big South in scoring.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Coastal Carolina's **BADOU DIAGNE** became the seventh Big South player this season to surpass the 1,000-point milestone on Feb. 6 (142nd player overall). High Point's **LORENZO CUGINI** is four away from the same threshold. The Big South has eight active 1,000-point scorers, and below is a look at where all eight rank among the all-time leaders:

DUBY-DUBY-DO

Winthrop redshirt-sophomore **DUBY OKEKE** leads the Big South with 2.54 blocks per game. He has recorded multiple blocks in 17 of his 24 appearances this season, including three games with four, three with five and one with six. The last (and only) Winthrop player to lead the Big South in blocked shots was **JOSH GRANT** in 2002-03 (2.28). Meanwhile, Okeke surpassed 100 career blocks Jan. 30 during the Radford game and is the first Eagle with 100 rejections (107) since **BILLY HOUSTON** eclipsed the mark during the 2004-05 campaign. Okeke is one of four Eagles residing in the Big South's 100-blocked shot club: Houston (139 from 2002-06), Grant (125 from 2001-04) and **TYRONE WALKER** (105 from 2000-04).

COASTAL'S BOARDWALK

Coastal Carolina is the lone Big South member to have three players with at least 500 career rebounds. **TRISTAN CURTIS** eclipsed the milestone Feb. 13 to become the 81st player in league history with 500 (509), while injured forward **MICHEL ENANGA** reached the benchmark Nov. 21 and stands at 523. **BADOU DIAGNE** became the 31st player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Jan. 23 at Charleston Southern, and is tied for 18th all-time with 764. Meanwhile, Diagne, who became the 50th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he eclipsed the mark against Grace Bible College on Nov. 18, has an outside chance of joining the league's 1,000-point, 700-rebound and 100-blocked shot club (currently just 13 members), as his career totals include 1,027 points and 95 blocked shots.

HIGH POINT DUO BROWN, WEARY JOIN FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE 1,000-POINT SCORERS

High Point duo **JOHN BROWN** and **ADAM WEARY** are the 21st pair of Big South four-year classmates with 1,000 points each during the same four-year span. Brown is at 2,210, while Weary sits at 1,211, and the two are just the fifth four-year 1,000-point duo to combine for 3,000 points (3,421). They need 47 points to move into fourth. Meanwhile, fellow classmate **LORENZO CUGINI** is four points away from 1,000 in his career, which would mark just the third time a Big South senior trio scored 1,000 points during the same four-year period.

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

Radford senior guards **RASHUN DAVIS** and **YAYA ANDERSON** became the 20th pair of Big South four-year classmates to score 1,000 points during the same four-year period on Dec. 9 when Anderson eclipsed the milestone. Davis is currently at 1,267 career points, while Anderson stands at 1,141. Their combined point total of 2,408 is the 16th-highest scoring combination for a four-year duo with 1,000 points each, and three points away from the 15th position.

BUC-ETS

Charleston Southern leads the Big South with 9.32 three-pointers per game, and is attempting to become just the second program to lead the conference in the category for four consecutive years. Former member VMI led the Big South in 3FG per games a record six straight seasons from 2006-12. The Buccaneers are looking to average double-digit treys for the first time as well.

HIGH TOPS

Radford senior **RASHUN DAVIS** became the 21st player in conference annals with 1,000 points (1,267) and 400 assists (442) when he eclipsed the assist milestone Jan. 20 against Campbell. He is the Big South's active career assist leader and 20th all-time. Davis is also part of a 14-player group with 1,000 points, 400 assists and 150 steals (166). Meanwhile, teammate **BRANDON HOLCOMB** became the 80th Big South player with 500 rebounds Jan. 14 during the Asheville game, and is now the 24th player in the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club. Holcomb is tied for 20th all-time in league history with 140 career blocks.

TAKING FLIGHT

Winthrop leads the Big South with 83.0 points per game, the highest scoring average in the league in two seasons. The Eagles have led the Big South in scoring average just twice, with the last time coming in 1992-93 (83.6 average). The first time was in the conference's first year of men's basketball in 1985-86. That season Winthrop was tops with 79.8 points per game.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is the 3rd-active winningest coach in Division I with 786 career victories. Ellis, who notched his 700th Division I win Jan. 2 against Winthrop, is tied for 16th all-time in NCAA history for career wins (regardless of affiliation with a minimum 10 head coaching seasons at NCAA schools), and is the 7th-active winningest coach across all NCAA classifications. He became the first head coach in NCAA history with 150 wins at four different Division I programs with the Chanticleers' 68-56 victory over UNC Asheville on Feb. 3, 2015. His Division I school-by-school breakdown is as follows: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 174, in addition to 78 wins leading Cumberland College from 1972-75.

CLIMBING THE VICTORY LADDER

High Point's **SCOTT CHERRY** is 10th all-time in Big South history for most coaching victories with 114 wins. Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is the Big South's active win leader with 174 wins, which ranks fourth in the conference record books. Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is the longest-tenured active Big South coach, as he is in his 11th year in 2015-16 -- just the third head coach in League history with at least 10 years of service. He sits in sixth-place all-time with 148 victories, two away from sole possession of fifth-place. Here is a look at the Big South's Top 10 winningest coaches:

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

High Point's **JOHN BROWN** is tied for second in the Big South in scoring (19.6) and leads in field goal percentage (59.5). He is just 0.2 points off the scoring lead, and could become the first Big South player to finish as the league leader in both categories in the same season since Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** in 2009-10. That year, Parakhouski was tops with 21.4 points and 58.1 percent from the field. Brown is looking to become the fifth Big South player to achieve this feat.

HIGH FIVE

High Point and UNC Asheville opened the Big South schedule 5-0, the first time the league had two 5-0 teams since 2010-11 (Coastal Carolina and Liberty) and just the fourth time overall. Teams that have started 5-0 in league games have reached the Big South Championship game 17 times -- winning the title 10 times, including UNC Asheville in 2011-12.

GOOD WORK YOUNG MEN

A league-record three men's basketball players were official nominees for the Allstate NABC Good Works Team®, as High Point's **JOHN BROWN**, Longwood's **KANAYO OBI-RAPU** and Presbyterian's **WILL ADAMS** were among the 154 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA.

ANOTHER YEAR OF BIG WINS FOR THE BIG SOUTH

The Big South Conference is 2-1 against BIG EAST this season, with both wins over Georgetown. The last time the Big South had two wins vs. the BIG EAST was in 2012-13. Radford downed the Hoyas in double-overtime in its season opener, followed by UNC Asheville on Dec. 19. In addition, the Highlanders defeated Penn State, 86-74 in State College, Pa., on Nov. 26, 12 days after the Georgetown victory. The win over the Nittany Lions marks the second straight year the Big South has defeated a Big Ten member. The Big South has defeated a BIG EAST member four times in the past five seasons, and the last time the Big South had wins over both the BIG EAST and Big Ten in the same year was 2011-12.

DAILY DOUBLE

Radford's wins over two Power 5 conferences marks the fourth time in the last six seasons that a Big South member has achieved this feat. Last season, it was Gardner-Webb (Clemson, Purdue), and prior to that, it was Coastal Carolina (LSU, Clemson in 2011-12) and Presbyterian (Auburn, Wake Forest in 2010-11).

MID-MAJOR MANIA

Radford was ranked No. 25 in the Nov. 16 Collegeinsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 ranking, the second consecutive season a Big South member has appeared in the poll. Five teams have received Top 25 consideration this season -- High Point, Winthrop, Coastal Carolina, Radford and UNC Asheville. Below is a look at where the Big South has stood each week:

HIGH POINT'S JOHN BROWN COLLECTS SEVERAL ACCOLADES

For the third consecutive year, High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** was voted the Big South Conference Men's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's head coaches and media panel. He is the first men's player in Big South history to be named Preseason Player of the Year in three consecutive seasons. Named to the Lou Henson Preseason Player of the Year Watch List as well as a Midseason candidate, Brown was one of 20 initial preseason candidates for the Julius Erving Award, which is given annually to the top small forward in men's college basketball. He was the only player from a mid-major program on the watch list. Brown is looking to become just the second player in Big South history with **FOUR** First-Team All-Conference selections.

CAMPBELL

Campbell set a school single-game FG percentage record (74.5) after hitting 38-of-51 shots vs. Allen. The old record of 70.0 was set Jan. 20, 1986 at Carter Gym vs. Brooklyn. CU's 110 points were a Gore Arena record and the 3rd-highest single-game tally in CU's Division I era (since '77-78) ... Campbell's 4-game win streak matches the 4-game stretch the Camels reeled off from Nov. 24-Dec. 9 ... **CASEY PERRIN** scored a career-high 14 points (4-6 threes) in just 12 minutes of Campbell's 110-66 win over Allen ... **TROY HARPER** hit career highs with 26 points and 9 rebounds at Charleston Southern. Campbell won inside the CSU Field House for the first time since an 81-64 victory on Feb. 11, 1993.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU appeared on ESPN2 for the second time ever last Thursday against Gardner-Webb. **AARON WHEELER** scored a career-high 31 points in the game, and it was the second straight season he set a scoring high at GWU ... CSU collected a season-high 24 offensive rebounds on Saturday against Campbell, including 15 in the second half ... **REUBEN KING** set a career-high with 14 points against Campbell, and added 10 rebounds for his second double-double in as many weeks ... **RAE ROBINSON** drained seven 3FG -- one shy of the single-game program record -- against Campbell en route to a career-high 27 points.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina fell to Winthrop, 79-67 in its only game last week. **COLTON RAY-ST CYR** scored a career-high 20 in the loss, while **JAYLEN SHAW** added 19 ... With his 20-point performance at Winthrop, Ray-St Cyr became the sixth Chanticleer to reach the 20-point threshold this season. In all, the six Chants have combined for 17 20-plus point games ... The Chanticleers enter the final week of the regular season needing one victory to secure a top-five regular season finish and their third consecutive first round bye in the Big South Tournament.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb bounced back from a pair of tough losses with two hard-fought team wins last week, posting back-to-back double-digit victories over Charleston Southern and Longwood to jump into fifth in the Big South standings ... The Runnin' Bulldogs connected on exactly 50 percent of their attempts from the floor during the two-game homestand, while also shooting 44.1 percent from three-point range and combining for 40 assists ... **DYLAN POSTON** has been on fire over the past five games, leading GWU in scoring at 15.4 points per game and shooting 42.5 percent from downtown.

HIGH POINT

With the 75-72 overtime win at Radford on Saturday, HPU has matched the school record for Big South road wins in a season (6). **ANTHONY LINDAUER** nailed a 3-pointer with five seconds left to send the game into OT. HPU was +3 (9-6) in the OT session. **MILES BOWMAN** posted a career-high 17 points in 27 minutes ... At Longwood, **ADAM WEARY** posted a career-best 26 points and tied a school record for free throws without a miss (14-14). High Point went 32-of-35 from the line (91.4), and the 32 free throws made were fourth-most in HPU Div. I history.

LIBERTY

After going on a seven-game win streak, tied for the fourth-longest in program history, the Flames lost back-to-back contests, falling to Radford (69-67) and Presbyterian (79-73) last week ... With 43 steals on the year, **LOVELL CABBIL** is climbing closer to etching his name on the program's freshman steals list ... In Liberty's game against Radford, **JOHN DAWSON** finished the contest with a career-high 22 points ... In the last five games, **A.C. REID** is pacing the Flames' offense off the bench, averaging 15.2 ppg.

LONGWOOD

LOTANNA NWOGBO extended his double-double streak to six consecutive games last week, muscling his way to a pair of dominant post performances in losses to High Point and Gardner-Webb. Nwogbo averaged 17.5 points, 13.0 rebounds and 3.0 blocks per game while playing more than 30 minutes in both contests. Thirteen of his 26 rebounds were on the offensive glass and led to 18 of Longwood's 35 second-chance points for the week, including 14 scored by Nwogbo himself. Against the Panthers, Nwogbo turned in 21 points and 15 rebounds, including a career-high nine offensive boards.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC won on the road for the second time this season with its 79-73 win at Liberty, marking the second year in a row the Blue Hose have posted multiple road wins in a season ... In the last 10 games, the Blue Hose are 2-8, but of those games, seven have been decided by single digits, and of those seven, four have been within one possession ... Should it hold the rest of the season, the 68.2 scoring average would be the highest in PC's Division I history, 2.8 points higher than the 65.4 record in 2013-14 ... The current 43.5 field goal percentage is just 2.9 under the 46.4 set in 2014-15.

RADFORD

Radford played two more tight games last week, edging Liberty, 69-67 before falling in overtime to High Point, 75-72 ... RU's last four games have been decided by a total of eight points, with each coming down to the final seconds of regulation or going to overtime ... **RASHUN DAVIS** has five game-winning baskets with 22 seconds or less on the clock this season. Davis is now tied for 12th on RU's all-time scoring list with 1,267 points and tied for sixth in career steals with 166 ... **ED POLITE, JR.**'s 52 blocks are sixth-most in Radford single-season history.

UNC ASHEVILLE

Following the loss at Winthrop on Saturday, the Bulldogs have now lost five conference games by a total of 13 points, including two games in the last 10 days by one point each (Radford on Feb. 11 and Saturday) ... The 19 first-half points the Bulldogs had against Presbyterian were the fewest in a game this season for Asheville, while the 51 second half points were the third-most points in a single half this season (55 pts. vs. Drexel 11/26, 52 pts. vs. Longwood 1/30).

WINTHROP

The Eagles hit 10 threes in the win over UNC Asheville on Feb. 20 and now have 239 on the year, which is 5th-most in a single-season in program history ... The squad extended its streak to a program record 13 straight games scoring 70 or more points ... **KEON JOHNSON** moved into 10th place on Winthrop's all-time scoring list with 1,292 points and is now 4th all-time in made free throws with 333 (3rd most at the D1 level) ... The Eagles have 12 league wins for third time in program history, and just three other Winthrop teams have won more in a single-season (2005-06 w/13, 2006-07 w/14 and 2004-05 w/15).

BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

A new tiebreaking procedure implemented prior to the 2015-16 season addresses the Big South's 18-game unbalanced schedule. Each team plays eight teams twice and two teams once, and the new tiebreaker below will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Championship tournament, if necessary.

TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING TWO-TEAM TIE

- Regular season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to the next step below.
- If the tied teams played each other twice in the regular season and split their games, then each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings (or in case of a tie for first place, the next highest position in the regular season standings) and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
- When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tie-breaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.
- When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against a team or group is unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1; 1-0 is the same as 2-0; 2-0 is the same as 4-0; 2-1 is the same as 4-2; 1-0 is better than 1-1; 0-1 is the same as 0-2; 0-2 is the same as 0-4). If the winning percentage of the tied teams is equal against a team, or a group of tied teams, continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING MULTI-TEAM TIE

- The combined record of conference games between the tied teams involved will be compiled. Ties will be broken and seeding's assigned based on the winning percentage of the combined conference records. The higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group is unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1; 1-0 is the same as 2-0; 2-0 is the same as 4-0; 2-1 is the same as 4-2; 1-0 is better than 1-1; 0-1 is the same as 0-2; 0-2 is the same as 0-4).
- If the first procedure fails to break the tie, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage by a higher winning percentage.
- If the tie is broken by (a) or (b) regarding one or more teams, but three or more teams remain tied, then procedures (a) and (b) will be re-applied among those tied teams only.
- If two teams remain tied, the two-team tiebreaker policy will be applied.
- If there is more than one tie in the standings, and when utilizing the tie-breaking procedures there are a pair of teams tied, a team's record against the combined tied teams (prior to their own tie-breaking procedures) is used, rather than performance against the individual tied team.
- If procedures two-team and/or multi-team tiebreakers fail to establish an advantage, the team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report will be awarded the higher seed.
