PLAYER OF THE WEEK - CED GIBSON, COASTAL CAROLINA, G, R-Jr. (HIGH POINT, N.C.)

In a pair of Big South wins last week, Gibson led the Chanticleers with 23.0 points on 47.2 percent (17-for-36) from the field. On Tuesday, Gibson poured in 26 points, swiped five steals and grabbed five rebounds in Coastal's 61-40 triumph over Charleston Southern. She concluded her week with 20 points along with six assists on Saturday in the Chanticleers' first victory over Liberty since the 1995-96 season.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - HALEIGH HATFIELD, HIGH POINT, G/F. (WINSTON-SALEM, N.C.)

Hatfield averaged a double-double with 13.5 points and 11.5 rebounds in a pair of conference victories. The freshman shot 69.2 percent (9-for-13) from the field and finished 6-for-8 (75.0 percent) from the free throw line. Against Longwood on Tuesday, Hatfield dropped in 14 points on 4-of-4 from the floor and from the charity stripe, plus 13 rebounds, in the 89-70 triumph over the Lancers. On Saturday against Winthrop, Hatfield totaled 13 points and grabbed 10 rebounds, including eight on the defensive end.

MARGINAL NOTE

After 90 Big South games, the home teams are 52-38 (=57.7 percent) and have won their 52 games by an average of 12.73 points. Forty of the 90 overall contests have been decided by less than 10 points (5.57 winning average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 11.61 points.

TOP DOGS

With its victory over Winthrop on Feb. 1, UNC Asheville eclipsed the 10-win plateau in Big South play for the first time in program history. Overall, the Bulldogs boast a 21-4 record, marking the most wins by the team since the 2006-07 campaign when they finished the year 21-12, while riding the conference's longest active winning streak at eight straight.

MOUNTAIN TOP

UNC Asheville leads the Big South with 69.6 points per game, and is looking to lead the Big South in scoring for just the second time. The Bulldogs' lone appearance as the Big South's top scoring team occurred in 1989-90 with a 73.0 average. Meanwhile, Asheville's +12.2 scoring margin leads the conference and ranks 37th nationally as well, and is a category the Bulldogs have never finished as the league leader. The Big South single-season record for scoring margin is +17.2, which was set by Liberty in 2009-10.

WHAT A STEAL!

Winthrop's **ALIYAH KILPATRICK**, who tied the Big South single-game record with 10 steals at College of Charleston on Dec. 22, leads the league and is fourth nationally with 3.59 steals per game. The record is 4.32, set by Campbell's **JULIE SKINNER** in 1987-88. Kilpatrick has posted 10 steals in her last four games (=2.50) and has had at least five steals 10 times. With four steals on Jan. 12, Kilpatrick became the 37th player in league annals with 200 in a career. Currently with 224 swipes, she needs 43 steals to crack the Top-10 in league history.

"KEY" STAT

High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS** currently leads the Big South in scoring, as she averages 14.9 points per game. Keys looks to become the first Panther to lead the conference in scoring average since **KATIE O'DELL** paced the league in 2005-06. O'Dell was the first HPU player to lead the Big South in program history.

PARKING DECK

Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** became the 16th player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks when she eclipsed the scoring milestone on Dec. 31. In GWU's narrow win over UNC Asheville on Jan. 16, she became just the ninth player with 1,000 points, 800 caroms and 125 blocks in a career. Currently, Parker has scored 1,179 points (T-63rd in Big South), grabbed 880 rebounds (T-13th) and blocked 152 shots (14th).

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Longwood's Daeisha Brown became the fourth player this season and 103rd member of the Big South's 1,000-point club against Radford on Feb. 20. The Big South now has six active 1,000-point scorers, led by High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS**, who sits in 29th place with 1,393 career points. MAY WE ASSIST YOU?

Campbell's **RAECHAUN EDWARDS** became the 15th player in Big South history with 400 career assists and 200 career steals when she eclipsed the steals milestone Dec. 29 vs. Liberty. Edwards, who became the 19th player in Big South history with 400 career assists in the season opener, became the 10th player in Big South history with 500 career assists on Feb. 1. She currently ranks sixth all-time with 536 helpers. Meanwhile, Liberty's **SADALIA ELLIS** (386) is 14 assists away from 400 in her career, and would be the fifth Lady Flame on the league's all-time chart -- which would extend Liberty's Big South record.

STUFFING HER COFFERS

Campbell's **AMANDA COFFER** leads the Big South with 2.4 blocked shots per game and is looking to become the first Campbell Camel to lead the conference in blocks. Coffey has 151 in her career, good for 14th all-time in Big South history. She needs 32 to enter the Top 10.

MAXIMUM EFFORT

Charleston Southern's **MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN** is fourth in the Big South with 1.85 blocks per contest, as she looks to become the first Buccaneer to average at least two blocks a game since **SHAUNTE SMALL** posted 2.03 per game in 2006-07. With a pair of blocks against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 16, Maximilien became the 30th player in Big South history with 100 career blocks. Meanwhile, she became the 106th Big South player with 500 career rebounds when she eclipsed the milestone Dec. 29 at Longwood. Maximilien is now the fourth active player with 500 career boards and 100 career blocks.

GOOD WORK YOUNG LADIES

A league-record four women's basketball players are official nominees for the Allstate WBCA Good Works Team®, as Coastal Carolina's **OLIVIA CARLTON**, Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER**, Presbyterian's **JANIE MILES** and UNC Asheville's **PAIGE LOVE** are among the 103 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA. The list will be pared down to a 10-person team featuring five Division I student-athletes in February.

A'S FOR ASHLEY

For the second straight season, Liberty women's basketball redshirt senior post player **ASHLEY RININGER** has been voted to the 2015-16 CoSIDA Academic All-District III team, it was announced Feb. 11. After just three years on campus, Rininger graduated with a bachelor's degree in criminal justice in May 2014, maintaining a 4.0 GPA. She then completed a master's degree in human services counseling with a focus in crisis response and trauma in May 2015 with a 4.0 GPA. Rininger, who aspires to be an FBI agent, is currently working toward a second master's degree, in criminal justice. Again, her GPA stands at 4.0.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER** is the Big South's active-leading rebounder with 897, and needs 13 to enter the league's all-time Top 10. Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** (880) and Liberty's **KATELYN ADAMS** (801) became the 21st and 22nd members of the 800-rebound club, while Gardner-Webb's **CANDACE BROWN** (744) became the 41st member of the 700-rebound club, while Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS** (640) is among the 71 players with 600 career boards. Liberty's **CATHERINE KEARNEY** (555) became the 107th member of the 500-rebound club on Jan. 24 against Longwood. GARDNER-WEBB, COASTAL CAROLINA SCORE BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG WINS OF 2015-16

Gardner-Webb defeated North Carolina in the season opener, 66-65 in Chapel Hill, while Coastal Carolina knocked off Clemson during the opening weekend. It is the first time since 2006-07 (three wins) that the Big South has collected two victories over the ACC in the same year.

MAGIC WAND-A

Campbell head coach **WANDA WATKINS** needs five wins for 551 in her coaching career, as she is 547-440 in 35 years in Buies Creek, which includes a 227-142 (=61.5 percent) in 14 total seasons in the Big South -- good for fourth in league history. She is two victories away from surpassing former Coastal Carolina coach **ALAN LeFORCE** (228) for third all-time. Watkins owns the second-most Big South victories with 133, and has recorded double-digit conference wins in her last eight seasons in the Big South -- 2011-to-present, and 1990-94 prior to the Camels' 17-year stay in the TAAC/Atlantic Sun from 1994-2011.

GREEN MACHINE

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** needs two wins for 400 in his coaching career. He entered the 2015-16 season ranked 13th all-time among active NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his 75.0 winning percentage -- ahead of renowned coaches **C. VIVIAN STRINGER**, **SYLVIA HATCHELL** and **BRENDA FRESE**. Green is the Big South's all-time winningest basketball coach -- men's or women's -- with his 398 overall wins, which includes 233 Big South victories.

CAMPBELL

The Lady Camels finished 1-1 last week including a victory over Winthrop. **SUMMER PRICE** paced CU last week with an average of 16.0 points and 4.5 rebounds per game. **RAECHAUN EDWARDS** kept dishing out assists at a torrid pace, averaging 7.5 per game between both contests. Twelve Campbell players finished in the scoring column and the Lady Camels trailed for just 53 seconds in its 69-56 victory over Winthrop on Tuesday.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern split their two decisions this past week falling on the road to Coastal Carolina, while topping Gardner-Webb at home on Saturday afternoon. **MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN** nearly completed her fifth double-double of the season on Tuesday night against Coastal Carolina, finishing the game with nine points and nine rebounds in the Bucs' loss. Four Buccaneers were in double-digits in CSU's 66-63 win over Gardner-Webb on Saturday afternoon led by **Alecia Hardy's** 11 points off the bench. **BRIANNA LAKES** sparked the CSU offense in the fourth quarter as the Bucs' erased a seven-point deficit with six points on CSU's 15-7 run that gave the Bucs the lead for good.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal went 2-0 last week with wins against Charleston Southern and at Liberty. It's the first time this season that the Chants have won consecutive games against a conference opponent. The Chants have won each of their last nine games against Charleston Southern, Coastal's longest active streak against a conference opponent. Coastal's win over the Liberty was the first in 20 years, snapping a 45-game win streak the Flames had held since Feb. 19, 1996. **CED GIBSON** averaged 23.0 points last week, including a career-high 26 against Charleston Southern and 20 at Liberty. Gibson has scored 19 or more points in four of Coastal's last five games.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb split its two games played this past week, as it defeated Presbyterian 51-40 on Tuesday then dropped a 66-63 decision at Charleston Southern on Saturday. GWU led 20-16 at halftime against the Blue Hose and put the game away outscoring PC 25-2 in the third quarter, including not allowing a field goal by PC. Saturday's matchup at CSU remained close throughout but the difference was free-throw shooting, as the Bucs hit 15-of-16 from the line while GWU went 17-of-28.

HIGH POINT

The Panthers offense exploded with 89 points at Longwood behind 11 three-pointers on the night before the team racked up 80 points in the win over Winthrop. Junior **KAYLAH KEYS** tallied 20.0 points per game to go along with nine assists and seven steals on the week. Freshman **HALEIGH HATFIELD** posted back-to-back double-doubles with 14 points and 13 rebounds at Longwood and 11 and 10 against Winthrop. Freshman **EMMA BOCKRATH** contributed her first career double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds in the win over the Eagles. The Panthers host Liberty on Tuesday before playing at Charleston Southern on Saturday.

LIBERTY

Liberty's 58-51 home loss to Coastal Carolina on Saturday marked the its first setback against the Chanticleers since Feb. 19, 1996. Prior to Saturday, Liberty had won 20 straight home matchups with Coastal, 21 straight Big South home games and 45 straight meetings with the Chanticleers overall. Liberty has now lost back-to-back Big South games for just the second time in **CAREY GREEN's** 17 seasons as head coach. The Lady Flames have never lost three consecutive conference games under Green's direction. During Saturday's game, **KATELYN ADAMS** became the ninth Lady Flame ever to pull down 800 career rebounds.

LONGWOOD

DAEISHA BROWN became the 21st player and the third in the Division I era to go over the 1,000-point plateau, as the redshirt-junior averaged 12.5 points per game this week in a pair of losses to High Point and Radford. Brown, who is the fastest player in the D-I era to reach 1,000 points, accomplished the feat in the fourth quarter of Longwood's victory over Radford Saturday afternoon. In the game against the Highlanders, Brown finished with 17 points, including a 5-of-12 performance from the field and 6-of-6 from the foul line. In the game against High Point, Brown added eight points after sitting out the previous four games due to a leg injury.

PRESBYTERIAN

With the win against Campbell on Saturday, the Blue Hose moved into sole possession of second in the most wins in a season (15-10) and the most conference wins in a season (11-5) in Division I school history. PC leads the conference in scoring defense (54.3 points per game), turnover margin (+4.36), assists to turnover ratio (0.9) and three-points field goals made (6.9 per game). **CORTNEY STOREY** leads the league in assist to turnover ratio (1.8) and sits second in the conference in assists (4.3 per game).

RADFORD

Radford remains in sole possession of fifth place in the Big South standings entering its final three games of the regular season. After falling 58-48 to UNC Asheville on Tuesday, the Highlanders bounced back to tear Longwood, 80-64, at Senior Day inside the Dedmon Center. **AISHA FOY** will be out for the remainder of the season after tearing her ACL on Feb. 13 at Charleston Southern. Four Highlanders have torn their ACL this season, shrinking their lineup to nine available players. RU notched its 10th Big South win of the season, marking the second straight year and 14th time overall the Highlanders have reached double-digit conference wins.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs continue to break records in the 2015-16 season, earning their 21st win on Tuesday over the Highlanders. This matches the most regular season wins by a Bulldogs campaign in the Division I Era set by the 2006-07 team. Asheville travels to Gardner-Webb on Tuesday, as GWU handed the Bulldogs one of their two conference losses this season on Asheville's home court on Jan. 16th. The Bulldogs are currently ranked first in the Big South standings and are separated by two games from the second place, Liberty. Asheville has never won a regular season title since earning Division I status, with the highest finish coming from the 2006-07 campaign who finished the regular season in second place.

WINTHROP

ALIYAH KILPATRICK has scored in double figures in 10 straight games and is averaging 16.4 points per game during that stretch. Kilpatrick dished out a season-high seven assists in Saturday's loss at High Point. Junior guard/forward **CIICHI BUFORD** has had three straight career-high scoring performances. She had 13 against Campbell and 14 at High Point last week following a 12-point performance on Feb. 12 against Coastal Carolina. Over her last three games, she is averaging 13 points and has connected on 14 of 30 FGs, including 7 of 16 from behind the arc. Winthrop is still winless on the road with an 0-16 record. Not since the 2003-04 season has Winthrop gone winless away from home. It has also happened four other times in 1990-91, 1993-94, 1994-95, and 1997-98.
