PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - FEB. 28

CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK - ADAM WEARY, HIGH POINT, G. SR (MEMPHIS, TENN.)

Weary averaged 23.5 points, 6.0 assists, 3.5 rebounds, 1.5 steals and shot 60.7 percent (62.5 3pt FG%) in a 2-0 week for the Panthers. In Thursday's 87-85 win vs. Winthrop, Weary tallied 14 of his 24 points in the second half to help HPU overcome an injury to John Brown and move into a tie for first place. He also distributed a career-best eight assists.

CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK - LOTANNA NWOGBO, LONGWOOD, C. SR (LITHONIA, GA.)

Nwogbo averaged 26.5 points, 10.0 rebounds, 2.5 blocks and 1.0 steals in two games. He tallied 24 points, 12 rebounds and four blocks in the Lancers' one-point loss at the buzzer vs. PC, and followed with a career-high 29 points and eight boards in Saturday's comeback win at Radford. For the week, he was 20-of-28 from the field (=71.4 percent) and 13-of-20 from the free throw line (=65.0).

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - CHRIS CLEMONS, CAMPBELL, G. FR (RALEIGH, N.C.)

Clemons averaged 22.0 points, 4.5 rebounds and 1.5 steals in two games last week. He opened with 19 points, five boards and two steals against Radford, and followed with a team-high 25 points along with four caroms on Saturday vs. Winthrop.

BIG SOUTH HAS CO-CHAMPIONS FOR THIRD TIME IN FOUR SEASONS

High Point and Winthrop tied for the regular-season championship, and the Panthers are the No. 1 seed in this week's Big South Championship with the Eagles receiving the No. 2 seed, as determined by the league's tiebreaker. High Point has now captured four consecutive Big South regular-season titles, becoming just the third program in league history to accomplish this feat. Winthrop clinched its first regular-season crown since sharing the title in 2007-08. The Eagles now have eight outright/shared regular-season championships, most in Big South history.

SKY HIGH

High Point is guaranteed a NIT berth should the Panthers not win the Big South Championship Tournament. The Panthers will make their fourth consecutive postseason appearance, just the second Big South program with this distinction. Winthrop was the first with four straight postseason berths, accomplishing the feat twice (NCAAs in 1999-00-01-02 and 2005-06-07-08).

SWEET DOZEN

High Point is the first team in Big South history to win at least 12 conference games in four consecutive seasons.

HIGH FIVE

High Point and UNC Asheville opened the Big South schedule 5-0, the first time the league had two 5-0 teams since 2010-11 (Coastal Carolina and Liberty) and just the fourth time overall. Teams that have started 5-0 in league games have reached the Big South Championship game 17 times -- winning the title 10 times, including UNC Asheville in 2011-12. High Point is the No. 1 seed in this week's Big South Championship and the Bulldogs are the No. 4, which would set up a semifinal matchup should both teams win in the quarterfinal round.

WATCH BIG SOUTH BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP LIVE ON BSN & ESPN PLATFORMS

For the third consecutive year, ESPN3 will exclusively carry the quarterfinals of the Big South Basketball Championship, as **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **RALPH PATTERSON** (analyst) will call all four games on Friday. The duo will also handle Saturday's semifinal broadcasts on ESPN3, with Sunday's Championship game airing on ESPN2. **ROY PHILPOTT** (play-by-play) and **PAUL BIANCARDI** (analyst) will call the Big South Finals for the third straight year. The Big South Network will provide coverage of Thursday's first round contests.

MARGINAL NOTE

With the completion of the 99-game conference season, the visiting teams finished 46-53 (.465 percent), the third consecutive season at or above 40.0 percent and the highest road winning clip since 2008-09 when the road teams won 46.7 percent of Big South games. Meanwhile, 61 of the 99 contests (.616 percent) were decided by less than 10 points (4.28 winning average), and the overall margin of victory was 8.72 points. In fact, 37.4 percent of Big South games (37) were decided by four points-or-less -- tops in the nation.

BIG 10

For the third consecutive year, at least six teams won 10 Big South games in the same season. UNC Asheville was the first team with 10 conference wins -- the Bulldogs' record-tying ninth consecutive campaign with double-digit Big South victories. High Point and Gardner-Webb posted their fourth straight campaign with double-digit conference wins -- tied for the second-longest streak in league annals. Winthrop and Coastal Carolina each reached 10 league contests for the third straight season. It is also the 13th time the Eagles captured 10 Big South wins, extending their league record. Liberty notched 10 Big South wins for the first time since 2011.

DOWN AND GIVE ME 20

For just the fifth time in Big South history, two teams won 20 regular-season games in the same year. Winthrop reached 20 wins for the second time in three seasons, and posted 20 regular-season victories for the first time since 2006-07. It is the Eagles' 10th 20-win season as Big South members, extending their league record. High Point's 20 wins mark its second straight and third overall 20-win season since joining the Big South. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville can collect its fifth 20-win campaign and first since 2011-12 with a win over Liberty in the Big South quarterfinals this week.

FRESHMAN 15

Radford reached 15 wins in a season for the third consecutive year and 20th time as Big South members, extending its league record. Gardner-Webb has won 15 games each of the last four seasons, while High Point reached 15 wins for the fourth straight season and ninth time during its Big South affiliation. UNC Asheville amassed 15 wins for the ninth consecutive year -- the second-longest streak in Big South history. The Bulldogs have won at least 15 games in 18 of their 31 years in the Big South -- tied with Winthrop for the second-most 15-win seasons in conference annals.

BIG SOUTH 2,000-POINT ODYSSEY

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN**, who became the ninth player in Big South history with 2,000 career points when he reached the milestone Jan. 14 in the first half at Winthrop, will finish his career as the league's second all-time leading scorer. The third Panther in the conference's 2,000-point club, Brown is second with 2,229 points. Below are the Big South's 2,000-point scorers:

HE'S CRAFTY

Gardner-Webb head coach **TIM CRAFT** became the second coach this year and sixth in Big South history to win at least 15 games in each of his first three seasons in the league. He joins UNC Asheville's **NICK McDEVITT** with the accomplishment this year, as well as Liberty's **JEFF MEYER** (1991-94), Radford's **RON BRADLEY** (1991-94), Winthrop's **GREGG MARSHALL** (1998-01) and Birmingham-Southern's **DUANE REBOUL** (2003-06) as the only coaches to achieve this feat. Liberty's **RITCHIE McKAY** is two victories shy of adding his name to the list.

WHAT A STEAL!

Gardner-Webb freshman **LAQUINCY RIDEAU** leads the Big South with 66 steals and 2.20 steals per game. It is the highest per game average since Longwood's **TRISTAN CAREY** averaged 2.21 in 2012-13, as well as the second-highest by a freshman. Rideau is looking to become the first frosh ever to lead the conference in steals per game, while his season total is the second-most by a freshman in league history. Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** posted a Big South freshman record 70 swipes in 2004-05.

DOUBLE VISION

Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** owns the Big South's active leading double-figure scoring streak at 33 games, dating back to last season. High Point's **JOHN BROWN** is next at 16, followed by Campbell's **CHRIS CLEMONS** (14).

THE BIG 5-0

Head coaches **TIM CRAFT** (Gardner-Webb), **RITCHIE McKAY** (Liberty) and **NICK McDEVITT** (UNC Asheville) became the 10th, 11th and 12th coaches, respectively, in Big South history to reach 50 overall wins in their third season in the league. Craft achieved the benchmark in 92 games, while McKay secured win No. 50 in his 93rd game on Liberty's bench. McDevitt won No. 50 in his 90th game on the sideline. He is one of seven coaches in league history with 50 wins in 90 or less games.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

UNC Asheville and Longwood are the lone Big South programs to have five players averaging double figures in points, while Coastal Carolina has four players at 10+ points per game. The Bulldogs and Lancers are looking to become the first league member to have five players average at least 10.0 points since Charleston Southern in 2013-14.

BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** is second all-time in Big South history with 512 made free throws, and needs two to break the all-time mark of 513 currently held by Radford's **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** (2002-06). Brown's 712 career free throw attempts are second-most in league annals as well. Brown, who is the only player in Big South history with 2,000 points (2,229), 800 rebounds (801), 150 blocked shots (167), 150 steals (182) and 150 assists (180), is third in Big South history with 858 career field goals. He needs seven to surpass former Panther great **ARIZONA REID** (864) for second.

HEAD OF THE CLASS

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** was among the 30 candidates for the national Senior CLASS Award. He is the Big South's first official candidate since former teammate **ALLAN CHANEY** in 2013-14.

GOOD WORK YOUNG MEN

A league-record three men's basketball players were official nominees for the Allstate NABC Good Works Team®, as High Point's **JOHN BROWN**, Longwood's **KANAYO OBI-RAPU** and Presbyterian's **WILL ADAMS** were among the 154 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA.

C-SQUARED

Campbell freshman guard **CHRIS CLEMONS** is just the fifth Big South freshman in league history to score 500 points in a season, as he reached the total Feb. 20 at Charleston Southern. The Big South's leading freshman scorer with 18.8 points per game -- good for 7th among all freshman nationally, Clemons ranks fourth overall in the league in scoring. His 3.10 3FG per game is first in the league, and he is just 0.21 behind the conference's freshman record of 3.31, set by Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** in 2013-14. Meanwhile, Clemons is second in the Big South with an 84.1 free throw percentage, and is attempting to become the first frosh since 2011-12 and fifth overall to lead the conference in free throw shooting.

FRESH PERSPECTIVE

UNC Asheville freshman **DYLAN SMITH** added his name to the Big South's single-season freshman scoring list, as he is the 23rd such frosh to score 400 points in a campaign (406). Fellow freshman **ARMEL POTTER** of Charleston Southern is 14 points away from the benchmark. The last Bulldog frosh with 400 points prior to Smith was **ANDREW ROWSEY** in 2013-14 (648). The last Buccaneer freshman to score 400 points in a season was **SAAH NIMLEY** in 2011-12 (420). Potter is looking to join Smith and Campbell's **CHRIS CLEMONS** in the 400-point club this season, which would mark the third time in Big South history that three freshman scored 400 points in the same year (2008-09 and 2013-14).

BIG THINGS COME IN SMALL PACKAGES

Winthrop 5-7 guard **KEON JOHNSON** is second in the Big South with 19.8 points per game, and is looking to become just the second Eagle to average 20.0 points since the Big South began sponsoring men's basketball in 1985-86. That year was the last time a Winthrop player averaged 20.0 points, as **FRED MCKINNON** averaged a league-best 21.1 points that first season -- also the last time a Winthrop Eagle led the Big South in scoring.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

High Point's **LORENZO CUGINI** became the eighth Big South player this season to surpass the 1,000-point milestone on Feb. 25 (143rd player overall). The Big South has nine active 1,000-point scorers, and below is a look at where all nine rank among the all-time leaders:

THREE'S COMPANY

For just the third time in Big South history, a trio of four-year classmates have scored 1,000 career points during the same four-year period. High Point's **JOHN BROWN** (2,229), **ADAM WEARY** (1,258) and **LORENZO CUGINI** (1,020) have combined for 4,507 points since hitting the court together in 2012. It is the second-highest scoring trifecta and just 105 points behind the all-time high of 4,612 set by UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY**, **J.P. PRIMM** and **CHRIS STEPHENSON** from 2008-12. Meanwhile, Brown and Weary are the fourth-highest 1,000-point four-year duo to combine for 3,000 points (3,487), with Brown and Cugini sixth at 3,249.

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

Radford senior guards **RASHUN DAVIS** and **YAYA ANDERSON** became the 20th pair of Big South four-year classmates to score 1,000 points during the same four-year period on Dec. 9 when Anderson eclipsed the milestone. Davis is currently at 1,289 career points, while Anderson stands at 1,141. Their combined point total of 2,430 is the 16th-highest scoring combination for a four-year duo with 1,000 points each.

DUBY-DUBY-DO

Winthrop redshirt-sophomore **DUBY OKEKE** leads the Big South with 2.42 blocks per game. He has recorded multiple blocks in 18 of his 26 appearances this season, including three games with four, three with five and one with six. The last (and only) Winthrop player to lead the Big South in blocked shots was **JOSH GRANT** in 2002-03 (2.28). Meanwhile, Okeke surpassed 100 career blocks Jan. 30 during the Radford game and is the first Eagle with 100 rejections (107) since **BILLY HOUSTON** eclipsed the mark during the 2004-05 campaign. Okeke is one of four Eagles residing in the Big South's 100-blocked shot club: Houston (139 from 2002-06), Grant (125 from 2001-04) and **TYRONE WALKER** (105 from 2000-04). Okeke's sophomore teammate **XAVIER COOKS** is four blocked shots away from 100 in his career.

COASTAL'S BOARDWALK

Coastal Carolina is the lone Big South member to have three players with at least 500 career rebounds. **TRISTAN CURTIS** eclipsed the milestone Feb. 13 to become the 81st player in league history with 500 (532), while injured forward **MICHEL ENANGA** reached the benchmark Nov. 21 and stands at 523. **BADOU DIAGNE** became the 31st player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Jan. 23 at Charleston Southern, and is tied for 18th all-time with 764. Meanwhile, Diagne, who became the 50th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he eclipsed the mark against Grace Bible College on Nov. 18, has an outside chance of joining the league's 1,000-point, 700-rebound and 100-blocked shot club (currently just 13 members), as his career totals include 1,027 points and 95 blocked shots.

BUC-ETS

Charleston Southern leads the Big South with 9.28 three-pointers per game, and is attempting to become just the second program to lead the conference in the category for four consecutive years. Former member VMI led the Big South in 3FGs per game a record six straight seasons from 2006-12. The Buccaneers are looking to average double-digit treys for the first time as well.

HIGH TOPS

Radford senior **RASHUN DAVIS** is the 21st player in conference annals with 1,000 points (1,289) and 400 assists (453), having eclipsed the assist milestone Jan. 20 against Campbell. He is the Big South's active career assist leader and 19th all-time. Davis is also part of a 14-player group with 1,000 points, 400 assists and 150 steals (167). Meanwhile, teammate **BRANDON HOLCOMB** became the 80th Big South player with 500 rebounds Jan. 14 during the Asheville game, and is now the 24th player in the Big South's 500-rebound (552), 100-blocked shot club (144). Holcomb is 19th all-time in career blocks.

TAKING FLIGHT

Winthrop leads the Big South with 83.2 points per game, the highest scoring average in the league in two seasons. The Eagles have led the Big South in scoring average just twice, with the last time coming in 1992-93 (83.6 average). The first time was in the conference's first year of men's basketball in 1985-86. That season Winthrop was tops with 79.8 points per game.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

High Point's **JOHN BROWN** is third in the Big South in scoring (19.6) and leads in field goal percentage (60.2). He is just 0.5 points off the scoring lead, and could become the first Big South player to finish as the league leader in both categories in the same season since Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** in 2009-10. That year, Parakhouski was tops with 21.4 points and 58.1 percent from the field. Brown is looking to become the fifth Big South player to achieve this feat.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is the 3rd-active winningest coach in Division I with 788 career victories. Ellis, who notched his 700th Division I win Jan. 2 against Winthrop, is tied for 15th all-time in NCAA history for career wins (regardless of affiliation with a minimum 10 head coaching seasons at NCAA schools), and is tied as the 6th-active winningest coach across all NCAA classifications. He became the first head coach in NCAA history with 150 wins at four different Division I programs with the Chanticleers' 68-56 victory over UNC Asheville on Feb. 3, 2015. His Division I school-by-school breakdown is as follows: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 176, in addition to 78 wins leading Cumberland College from 1972-75.

CLIMBING THE VICTORY LADDER

High Point's **SCOTT CHERRY** is 9th all-time in Big South history for most coaching victories with 116 wins. Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is the Big South's active win leader with 176 wins, which ranks fourth in the conference record books. Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** is the longest-tenured active Big South coach, as he is in his 11th year in 2015-16 -- just the third head coach in League history with at least 10 years of service. He sits in sixth-place all-time with 148 victories, two away from sole possession of fifth-place. Here is a look at the Big South's Top 10 winningest coaches:

DID YOU KNOW...

Campbell is hosting the Big South Men's Basketball Championship for the first time. This week will mark the third time that all rounds of the men's postseason event will be held in the state of North Carolina. The previous times were in 1999 and 2000 in Asheville. In all, 31 Big South tournament games have been contested in the Tar Heel state.

NO WORRY WITH MURRAY

Presbyterian College's **DeSEAN MURRAY** is looking to become just the fifth Big South player to average 20.0 points and 2.0 steals in a campaign. His current per game totals stand at 20.1 points and 1.93 steals. The league's leading scorer, Murray has a league-high 17 20-point games and is contending to become the first Blue Hose to finish as the Big South's top scorer. He will need to score 16 points in his next game to keep the Big South in position for its fifth consecutive season with a 20.0 scorer.

ANOTHER YEAR OF BIG WINS FOR THE BIG SOUTH

The Big South Conference is 2-1 against BIG EAST this season, with both wins over Georgetown. The last time the Big South had two wins vs. the BIG EAST was in 2012-13. Radford downed the Hoyas in double-overtime in its season opener, followed by UNC Asheville on Dec. 19. In addition, the Highlanders defeated Penn State, 86-74 in State College, Pa., on Nov. 26, 12 days after the Georgetown victory. The win over the Nittany Lions marks the second straight year the Big South has defeated a Big Ten member. The Big South has defeated a BIG EAST member four times in the past five seasons, and the last time the Big South had wins over both the BIG EAST and Big Ten in the same year was 2011-12.

DAILY DOUBLE

Radford's wins over two Power 5 conferences marks the fourth time in the last six seasons that a Big South member has achieved this feat. Last season, it was Gardner-Webb (Clemson, Purdue), and prior to that, it was Coastal Carolina (LSU, Clemson in 2011-12) and Presbyterian (Auburn, Wake Forest in 2010-11).

MID-MAJOR MANIA

Radford was ranked No. 25 in the Nov. 16 Collegeinsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 ranking, the second consecutive season a Big South member has appeared in the poll. Five teams have received Top 25 consideration this season -- High Point, Winthrop, Coastal Carolina, Radford and UNC Asheville. Below is a look at where the Big South has stood each week:

HIGH POINT'S JOHN BROWN COLLECTS SEVERAL ACCOLADES

For the third consecutive year, High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** was voted the Big South Conference Men's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year by the League's head coaches and media panel. He is the first men's player in Big South history to be named Preseason Player of the Year in three consecutive seasons. Named to the Lou Henson Preseason Player of the Year Watch List as well as a Midseason candidate, Brown was one of 20 initial preseason candidates for the Julius Erving Award, which is given annually to the top small forward in men's college basketball. He was the only player from a mid-major program on the watch list. Brown is looking to become just the second player in Big South history with **FOUR** First-Team All-Conference selections.

CAMPBELL

CHRIS CLEMONS set the school freshman record for most points scored in a season (544) ... **D.J. MASON** has moved into 20th place on Campbell's Division I era (since '77-78) scoring list with 913 career points. He also stands 10th in career offensive (171) and total (476) rebounds ... As a team, the 2015-16 Camels shot 74.1% from the line in conference games, third-best in the league ... Campbell carries a 10-12 all-time record in Big South Tournament history into this week's event. The Camels reached the Big South final in 1987, 1989, 1992 and 1994, winning the title in '92.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

WESLEY JOHNSON had 10 points and a career-high 8 rebounds in last week's loss to Coastal Carolina ... CSU has lost 10 games this season by single-digit margins, including nine in conference play and three by one possession ... **ARMEL POTTER**'s scoring (386) and assist (92) totals are the most for a CSU freshman since **SAAH NIMLEY** in 2011-12 ... **RAE ROBINSON**'s 82 three-pointers are tied for the fourth-most in a single-season in program history.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal reached 12 league wins for the eighth time in program history, with five of those coming under the direction of **CLIFF ELLIS** ... Coastal is the No. 3 seed in this week's Big South Tournament, the same seed as last year when the Chanticleers won it all ... **SHIVAUGHN WIGGINS** averaged 21.0 points per game last week. He is averaging 17.7 points per outing over the last 10 games ... **TRISTIAN CURTIS** averaged 11.5 rebounds, pulling down 13 against Charleston Southern and 10 at UNC Asheville ... The Chanticleers were without the services of **BADOU DIAGNE**, who missed both games due to injury. Last Thursday's game against CSU marked the first time in 75 games he had not been in the starting lineup.

GARDNER-WEBB

ISAAH IVEY poured in a game- and career-high 32 points with a true shooting percentage of 96.0 percent Saturday at Liberty. Over the last eight games, he has led the team with a true shooting percentage of 74.3 percent in that span while averaging 12.9 points -- good for second on the team ... Six players are averaging double figures over the last eight games ... Ivey, **DYLAN POSTON**, and **ADONIS BURBAGE** have combined for 67 three-pointers in that span, with Ivey knocking down 17-of-30 (56.7 percent).

HIGH POINT

The Panthers set a program record with their seventh Big South road win of the year in the season finale at PC ... Thursday's 87-85 win over Winthrop was in front of a sellout crowd on ESPNU. **ADAM WEARY** posted a team-high 24 points and eight assists. **JOHN BROWN** had 19 points and was 9-of-11 from the field in just 12 minutes before leaving with an injury. **MILES BOWMAN JR.** registered his first career double-double (15 pts, 11 reb) against the Eagles.

LIBERTY

Liberty drained 17 three-pointers this past Saturday vs. Gardner-Webb, tying the program and Vines Center record set in a 103-88 over VMI in the quarterfinals of the 2008 Big South Championship ... Liberty also went 17-of-18 (94.4) from the foul line, tying the fifth-best single-game free throw percentage in program history ... **CALEB HOMESLEY** paced the Flames with a career-high 22 points against GWU. He went 6-of-9 from the field, which included five three-pointers. Homesley was also a perfect 5-of-5 from the charity stripe.

LONGWOOD

The eighth-place finish is Longwood's highest since joining the Big South in 2012-13 and comes in head coach **JAYSON GEE**'s third season leading the program. The Lancers ascended to eighth-place in the conference standings after overcoming a 20-point deficit on the road at Radford Saturday, thanks to three 20-point efforts from the senior trio of **SHAQUILLE JOHNSON** (21), **LOTANNA NWOGBO** (29) and **TRA'VAUGHN WHITE** (20). Those three engineered a 51-20 run over the game's final 14 minutes, scoring 45 points during that span as the Lancers matched last year's program record with their fifth Big South win this season.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC won on the road for the third time this season with the 74-73 win over Longwood, Feb. 25 ... **DeSEAN MURRAY**'s 34 points against Longwood was not only a career-high but now ranks tied for second in PC's Division I record book for most points in a game. Murray's 14 free throws made against the Lancers is a PC record ... PC's 79 points against Liberty was the most in a conference game this season and the fourth-most points by the Blue Hose overall.

RADFORD

Radford finished up its regular season by alternating wins and losses over seven February games, capped by a comeback road win at Campbell and loss to Longwood in the season finale ... After going 4-0 at home and 1-3 on the road in January, the Highlanders were 0-4 at home and 3-0 on the road in February ... **RASHUN DAVIS** finished the regular season with 145 assists, sixth-most in single-season program history. He needs 25 points to move into the top 10 on RU's career scoring list ... **CAMERON JONES** scored in double figures in each of the last 13 games and has a team-high 14.8 ppg.

UNC ASHEVILLE

DWAYNE SUTTON scored 20 points in two of Asheville's final four games. He had 23 points in the Bulldog comeback win against Presbyterian (2/18) and then eclipsed that career-high with a 24-point effort in Saturday's loss to Coastal Carolina ... The Bulldogs finished the regular season with the sixth-most total steals (276) and the seventh-best steals per game average (9.2 per) in the nation. Asheville's three-point defense was also stingy all season and is ninth in the country with its 29.7 percent allowed from long range.

WINTHROP

Winthrop captured 21 regular season wins for the first time since the 2006-07 team, as well as the first time since 2007-08 the team had 21 wins in a season ... The Eagles' 13 league wins are the most since the 2006-07 team went 14-0 and are tied for the third-most conference wins by a Winthrop team in the history of the program ... **KEON JOHNSON** moved into 7th in school history for the most points in a season ... **JIMMY GAVIN** is just the 5th player in program history with 80 or more threes in a season (82) ... Head coach **PAT KELSEY** has 41 league wins in his first four seasons, which ties **GREGG MARSHALL** for the most league wins through the first four years by any Winthrop coach.

BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

A new tiebreaking procedure implemented prior to the 2015-16 season addresses the Big South's 18-game unbalanced schedule. Each team plays eight teams twice and two teams once, and the new tiebreaker below will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Championship tournament, if necessary.

TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING TWO-TEAM TIE

i) Regular season head-to-head results. If the tied teams split their two games, then proceed to the next step below.

ii) If the tied teams played each other twice in the regular season and split their games, then each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings (or in case of a tie for first place, the next highest position in the regular season standings) and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

iii) When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tie-breaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.

iv) When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against a team or group is unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1; 1-0 is the same as 2-0; 2-0 is the same as 4-0; 2-1 is the same as 4-2; 1-0 is better than 1-1; 0-1 is the same as 0-2; 0-2 is the same as 0-4). If the winning percentage of the tied teams is equal against a team, or a group of tied teams, continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE FOR SEEDING MULTI-TEAM TIE

i) The combined record of conference games between the tied teams involved will be compiled. Ties will be broken and seeding's assigned based on the winning percentage of the combined conference records. The higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group is unequal (i.e., 2-0 is better than 3-1; 1-0 is the same as 2-0; 2-0 is the same as 4-0; 2-1 is the same as 4-2; 1-0 is better than 1-1; 0-1 is the same as 0-2; 0-2 is the same as 0-4).

ii) If the first procedure fails to break the tie, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the final regular-season standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage by a higher winning percentage.

iii) If the tie is broken by (a) or (b) regarding one or more teams, but three or more teams remain tied, then procedures (a) and (b) will be re-applied among those tied teams only.

iv) If two teams remain tied, the two-team tiebreaker policy will be applied.

v) If there is more than one tie in the standings, and when utilizing the tie-breaking procedures there are a pair of teams tied, a team's record against the combined tied teams (prior to their own tie-breaking procedures) is used, rather than performance against the individual tied team.

xi) If procedures two-team and/or multi-team tiebreakers fail to establish an advantage, the team with the highest ranking on the most recent College Basketball RPI Report will be awarded the higher seed.
