PLAYER OF THE WEEK - CANDACE BROWN, GARDNER-WEBB, G/F, SR. (HINTON, W.VA.)

In a pair of Big South wins, Brown averaged a double-double with 17.5 points and 10.0 rebounds, as GWU knocked off league-leading UNC Asheville (57-51) on Tuesday, followed by triumph over Coastal Carolina (61-51) on Saturday. Against the Bulldogs, she dropped in 14 points and 11 rebounds in 39 minutes, as the home side earned a key conference victory over the first-place Bulldogs. On Saturday, the senior tallied a game-high 21 points and nine boards to lead the Runnin' Bulldogs over the Chanticleers to seal the 2-0 week.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - EMMA BOCKRATH, HIGH POINT, G. (KETTERING, OHIO)

Bockrath shined for the Panthers last week, as she averaged 19.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists in a pair of Big South contests. In a setback to Liberty on Tuesday, she poured in 12 points, and grabbed five boards with four assists. On Saturday, the guard scored a career-high 26 points, including 10 in the final period, to lead High Point past Charleston Southern on the road, 78-72.

MARGINAL NOTE

After 100 Big South games, the home teams are 56-44 (=56.0 percent) and have won their 56 games by an average of 13.11 points. Forty-four of the 100 overall contests have been decided by less than 10 points (5.64 winning average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 11.9 points.

TOP DOGS

With its victory over Winthrop on Feb. 1, UNC Asheville eclipsed the 10-win plateau in Big South play for the first time in program history. Overall, the Bulldogs boast a 21-6 record, marking the most wins by the team since the 2006-07 campaign when they finished the year 21-12, but saw its eight-game winning streak come to a close last Tuesday at Gardner-Webb.

MOUNTAIN TOP

UNC Asheville leads the Big South with 68.4 points per game, and is looking to lead the Big South in scoring for just the second time. The Bulldogs' lone appearance as the Big South's top scoring team occurred in 1989-90 with a 73.0 average. Meanwhile, Asheville's +10.8 scoring margin leads the conference and ranks 44th nationally as well, and is a category the Bulldogs have never finished as the league leader. The Big South single-season record for scoring margin is +17.2, which was set by Liberty in 2009-10.

WHAT A STEAL!

Winthrop's **ALIYAH KILPATRICK**, who tied the Big South single-game record with 10 steals at College of Charleston on Dec. 22, leads the league and is fourth nationally with 3.58 steals per game. The record is 4.32, set by Campbell's **JULIE SKINNER** in 1987-88. Kilpatrick has posted 11 steals in her last four games (=2.75) and has had at least five steals 11 times. With four steals on Jan. 12, Kilpatrick became the 37th player in league annals with 200 in a career. Currently with 231 swipes, she needs 36 steals to crack the Top-10 in league history.

"KEY" STAT

High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS** currently leads the Big South in scoring, as she averages 15.2 points per game. Keys looks to become the first Panther to lead the conference in scoring average since **KATIE O'DELL** paced the league in 2005-06. O'Dell was the first HPU player to lead the Big South in program history.

PARKING DECK

Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** became the 16th player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks when she eclipsed the scoring milestone on Dec. 31. In GWU's narrow win over UNC Asheville on Jan. 16, she became just the ninth player with 1,000 points, 800 caroms and 125 blocks in a career. Currently, Parker has scored 1,202 points (59th in Big South), grabbed 900 rebounds (12th) and blocked 155 shots (14th).

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Winthrop's **ALIYAH KILPATRICK** became the fifth player this season and 104th member of the Big South's 1,000-point club against Radford on Feb. 23. The Big South now has six active 1,000-point scorers, led by High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS**, who sits in 27th place with 1,431 career points. MAY WE ASSIST YOU?

Campbell's **RAECHAUN EDWARDS** became the 15th player in Big South history with 400 career assists and 200 career steals when she eclipsed the steals milestone Dec. 29 vs. Liberty. Edwards, who became the 19th player in Big South history with 400 career assists in the season opener, became the 10th player in Big South history with 500 career assists on Feb. 1. She currently ranks sixth all-time with 541 helpers. Meanwhile, Liberty's **SADALIA ELLIS** (393) is seven assists away from 400 in her career, and would be the fifth Lady Flame on the league's all-time chart -- which would extend Liberty's Big South record.

STUFFING HER COFFERS

Campbell's **AMANDA COFFER** leads the Big South with 2.3 blocked shots per game and is looking to become the first Campbell Camel to lead the conference in blocks. Coffey has 153 in her career, good for 14th all-time in Big South history. She needs 30 to enter the Top 10.

MAXIMUM EFFORT

Charleston Southern's **MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN** is fourth in the Big South with 1.82 blocks per contest, as she looks to become the first Buccaneer to average at least two blocks a game since **SHAUNTE SMALL** posted 2.03 per game in 2006-07. With a pair of blocks against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 16, Maximilien became the 30th player in Big South history with 100 career blocks. Meanwhile, she became the 106th Big South player with 500 career rebounds when she eclipsed the milestone Dec. 29 at Longwood. Maximilien is now the fourth active player with 500 career boards and 100 career blocks.

GOOD WORK YOUNG LADIES

A league-record four women's basketball players are official nominees for the Allstate WBCA Good Works Team®, as Coastal Carolina's **OLIVIA CARLTON**, Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER**, Presbyterian's **JANIE MILES** and UNC Asheville's **PAIGE LOVE** are among the 103 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA. The list will be pared down to a 10-person team featuring five Division I student-athletes in February.

A'S FOR ASHLEY

For the second straight season, Liberty women's basketball redshirt senior post player **ASHLEY RININGER** has been voted to the 2015-16 CoSIDA Academic All-District III team, it was announced Feb. 11. After just three years on campus, Rininger graduated with a bachelor's degree in criminal justice in May 2014, maintaining a 4.0 GPA. She then completed a master's degree in human services counseling with a focus in crisis response and trauma in May 2015 with a 4.0 GPA. Rininger, who aspires to be an FBI agent, is currently working toward a second master's degree, in criminal justice. Again, her GPA stands at 4.0.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER** is the Big South's active-leading rebounder with 906, and needs four to enter the league's all-time Top 10, while Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** (900) became the 12th player in Big South history with 900 rebounds. Liberty's **KATELYN ADAMS** (819) became the 22nd member of the 800-rebound club, while Gardner-Webb's **CANDACE BROWN** (764) became the 41st member of the 700-rebound club, while Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS** (640) and Charleston Southern's **MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN** (603) are among the 72 players with 600 career boards. Liberty's **CATHERINE KEARNEY** (565) became the 107th member of the 500-rebound club on Jan. 24. GARDNER-WEBB, COASTAL CAROLINA SCORE BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG WINS OF 2015-16

Gardner-Webb defeated North Carolina in the season opener, 66-65 in Chapel Hill, while Coastal Carolina knocked off Clemson during the opening weekend. It is the first time since 2006-07 (three wins) that the Big South has collected two victories over the ACC in the same year.

MAGIC WAND-A

Campbell head coach **WANDA WATKINS** needs three wins for 550 in her coaching career, as she is 547-441 in 35 years in Buies Creek, which includes a 228-143 (=61.5 percent) in 14 total seasons in the Big South -- good for fourth in league history. She is currently tied with former Coastal Carolina coach **ALAN LeFORCE** (228) for third all-time. Watkins owns the second-most Big South victories with 134, and has recorded double-digit conference wins in her last eight seasons in the Big South -- 2011-to-present, and 1990-94 prior to the Camels' 17-year stay in the TAAC/Atlantic Sun from 1994-2011.

GREEN MACHINE

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** reached the 400-win mark in his coaching career on Feb. 27 against Longwood. He entered the 2015-16 season ranked 13th all-time among active NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his 75.0 winning percentage -- ahead of renowned coaches **C. VIVIAN STRINGER**, **SYLVIA HATCHELL** and **BRENDA FRESE**. Green is the Big South's all-time winningest basketball coach -- men's or women's -- with his 400 overall wins, which includes 235 Big South victories.

CAMPBELL

The Lady Camels finished 1-1 last week including an upset of conference leaders UNC Asheville. After the Bulldogs reeled off a 9-2 run to cut the Lady Camel lead to three midway through the fourth, CU scored the 11 of the game's final 14 points to seal the upset win. **SUMMER PRICE** continued her strong play of late and finished with 23 points on 8-of-20 shooting with four three pointers to pace Campbell in the victory. The Lady Camels suffered a 60-45 setback to Charleston Southern on Tuesday. Price led CU in that contest as well with 14 points and finished the week averaging 18.5 points per game.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern went 1-1 overall on the week with a win over Campbell on the road, before falling to High Point for Senior Day at home. **MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN** capped her career in the Buc Dome with her fifth double-double of the season, as she led the Bucs with 13 points and 16 rebounds in the contest against HPU. **ALYSSA MANN** scored eight of her team-high 13 points in the second half, including the first four CSU points in the fourth quarter as the Buccaneers staved off any attempt of a Campbell comeback in recording their second Big South Conference sweep of the season. Mann added five assists and three steals in the win.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal split its pair of games last week, reaching its first three-game winning streak of the season with a 60-47 victory over Presbyterian on Tuesday, before having that streak broken on Saturday in a 61-51 loss to Gardner-Webb. The loss to GWU was Coastal's first at home since Feb. 1. **CED GIBSON** led Coastal averaging 17.5 points last week, and 17.4 ppg over eight contests in the month of February. The junior guard scored 20 or more points in four of those eight games, and reached double figures in six. **NICOLE ISAACS** finished second for the Chants averaging 11.0 points last week. All of her baskets came from 3-point range, and the senior guard shot 80.0 percent from the line.

GARDNER-WEBB

GWU picked up key victories over UNC Asheville and Coastal Carolina, as the Runnin' Bulldogs completed the season-sweep of Asheville. GWU improved its home court record this season to 14-2, which matches the best record on its home court under Coach **RICK REEVES**. The Runnin' Bulldogs shot just 6-for-28 in the second half, but did a great job of getting to the free-throw line, hitting 11-of-22 and out rebounded UNCA 47-33, including 23-14 on the offensive glass.

HIGH POINT

Freshman **EMMA BOCKRATH** posted 19.0 points and 5.0 rebounds per game as the Purple & White went 1-1 on the week. Bockrath started with 10 fourth-quarter points en route to a career-high 26-point performance against CSU. Junior **KAY-LAH KEYS** averaged 19.0 points on the week and has scored at least 13 points in the last seven contests. Sophomore **KAT HARRIS** hit 7-of-17 three-point attempts to tally 14.5 points and 3.5 assists per game. HPU went 17-41 (41 percent) from beyond the arc this week and have hit at least seven three-pointers in the last seven outings.

LIBERTY

Saturday's victory over Longwood was No. 400 of Carey Green's coaching career. His is now 400-138 in his 17 seasons at Liberty. The Lady Flames have now clinched their 20th consecutive season with a winning record and wrapped up a first-round bye for the Big South Women's Basketball Championship. If Liberty can win both of its games this week, the Lady Flames will claim at least a share of their 16th Big South regular-season title in 19 years.

LONGWOOD

Longwood dropped its only decision on the week, as it fell to Liberty, 67-47, on Saturday in Lynchburg. The Lancer duo of **DEBORAH HEADEN** and **KYNDAL SKERSICK** paced the team with 10 points apiece, while the team totaled 20 bench points for the afternoon.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose lead the Big South in scoring defense (54.1), turnover margin (+4.07), assist to turnover ratio (0.9) and 3-pointers made per game (7.0). PC holds second in scoring margin (+7.7), free throw percentage (.718) and assists per game (12.9). **CORTNEY STOREY** leads the conference in assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.9 and sits second in the conference in assists per game at 4.4. **TAYLOR PETTY** leads the Big South in 3-pointers made per game at 2.4.

RADFORD

Janayla White paced three Radford players in double figures with a career-high-tying 19 points to guide Radford to a 67-38 win over Winthrop, Tuesday night. Radford tied its season-high of eight 3-pointers, connecting on 8-of-16. After being held to just seven points in the opening quarter, the Highlanders outscored Winthrop, 60-28, over the final three stanzas to record their first win inside Winthrop Coliseum since 2009. White pulled down a game-high 16 rebounds, including 11 on the offensive end, to notch her ninth double-double of the season.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs lead the Big South in scoring margin with an average of 68.4 points per game, and field goal percentage at 41.8 percent. Asheville has led the conference in as many as seven categories at once this season. A win on Saturday would be the 22nd season win for **BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK**, as it would also match the number of combined wins from the previous three seasons. The Bulldogs have already matched the combined 14 Big South Conference wins from the past three seasons. The Bulldogs have had different leading scorers in five of their past six games, and had as many as four Bulldogs in double-figures in a single game this season.

WINTHROP

Two lopsided losses to Radford and Presbyterian College and the loss of another scholarship player to a broken foot made a long season even longer for the Winthrop women last week. Sophomore forward Ronata Rogers suffered the broken foot during the Radford game and will likely miss the rest of the season. Without Rogers, the Eagles are dressing eight players, including three walk-ons. Winthrop is still winless away from home this year as they are 0-17. They have one chance to get a road win this Saturday at Coastal Carolina, a team they defeated at home two weeks ago.
