PLAYER OF THE WEEK - EBONI GILLIAM, LONGWOOD, F. JR. (RICHMOND, VA.)

Gilliam led Longwood to a pair of conference victories last week, as she averaged 15.5 points and 11 rebounds, headlined by a double-double (15 points, 14 rebounds) in the regular-season finale victory over Gardner-Webb on Saturday. Last Tuesday, she dropped in 16 points and grabbed eight rebounds in Longwood's 84-76 triumph over Coastal Carolina. The forward has now scored 15 points or more on 16 occasions.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - SONORA DENGOKL, UNC ASHEVILLE, G. (SUMTER, S.C.)

Before helping UNC Asheville to its first-ever Big South regular-season championship on Saturday, Dengokl averaged 8.5 points and 5.0 rebounds in a pair of conference wins. Against Charleston Southern on Tuesday, she posted 10 points and five rebounds in a 91-68 triumph. On Saturday, Dengokl provided seven key points with five rebounds to help seal the No. 1 seed in this week's conference tournament.

MARGINAL NOTE

After 110 Big South games, the home teams are 62-48 (=56.3 percent) and have won their 62 games by an average of 13.50 points. Forty-nine of the 100 overall contests have been decided by less than 10 points (5.55 winning average), while the overall margin of victory thus far is 11.97 points.

TOP DOGS

UNC Asheville claimed its first Big South regular-season title in program history on Saturday with its win over High Point. With the regular-season title, the Bulldogs are the No. 1 seed in the Big South Championship Tournament, hosted by UNC Asheville beginning on Thursday. The Bulldogs are also assured a spot in the WNIT should they not win the conference tournament championship, which marks their first post-season appearance since the 2006-07 season.

MOUNTAIN TOP

UNC Asheville leads the Big South with 69.7 points per game, and is looking to lead the Big South in scoring for just the second time. The Bulldogs' lone appearance as the Big South's top scoring team occurred in 1989-90 with a 73.0 average. Meanwhile, Asheville's +11.6 scoring margin leads the conference and ranks 35th nationally as well, and is a category the Bulldogs have never finished as the league leader. The Big South single-season record for scoring margin is +17.2, which was set by Liberty in 2009-10.

WHAT A STEAL!

Winthrop's **ALIYAH KILPATRICK**, who tied the Big South single-game record with 10 steals at College of Charleston on Dec. 22, leads the league and is fourth nationally with 3.54 steals per game. The record is 4.32, set by Campbell's **JULIE SKINNER** in 1987-88. Kilpatrick has had at least five steals 11 times. With four steals on Jan. 12, Kilpatrick became the 37th player in league annals with 200 in a career. Currently with 237 swipes, she needs 30 steals to crack the Top-10 in league history.

"KEY" STAT

High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS** currently leads the Big South in scoring, as she averages 14.9 points per game. Keys looks to become the first Panther to lead the conference in scoring average since **KATIE O'DELL** paced the league in 2005-06. O'Dell was the first HPU player to lead the Big South in program history.

PARKING DECK

Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** became the 16th player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks when she eclipsed the scoring milestone on Dec. 31. In GWU's narrow win over UNC Asheville on Jan. 16, she became just the ninth player with 1,000 points, 800 caroms and 125 blocks in a career. Currently, Parker has scored 1,215 points (T-57th in Big South), grabbed 907 rebounds (12th) and blocked 157 shots (14th).

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Winthrop's **ALIYAH KILPATRICK** became the fifth player this season and 104th member of the Big South's 1,000-point club against Radford on Feb. 23. The Big South now has six active 1,000-point scorers, led by High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS**, who sits in 27th place with 1,431 career points. Campbell's **RAECHAUN EDWARDS** became the 15th player in Big South history with 400 career assists and 200 career steals when she eclipsed the steals milestone Dec. 29 vs. Liberty. Edwards, who became the 19th player in Big South history with 400 career assists in the season opener, became the 10th player in Big South history with 500 career assists on Feb. 1. She currently ranks sixth all-time with 545 helpers. Meanwhile, Liberty's **SADALIA ELLIS** (401) became the 20th player in Big South history with 400 career assists on March 5. She became the fifth Lady Flame on the league's all-time chart – which extended Liberty's Big South record.

STUFFING HER COFFERS

Campbell's **AMANDA COFFER** leads the Big South with 2.36 blocked shots per game and is looking to become the first Campbell Camel to lead the conference in blocks. Coffey has 159 in her career, good for 14th all-time in Big South history. She needs 24 to enter the Top 10.

MAXIMUM EFFORT

With a pair of blocks against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 16, **MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN** became the 30th player in Big South history with 100 career blocks. Meanwhile, she became the 106th Big South player with 500 career rebounds when she eclipsed the milestone Dec. 29 at Longwood. Maximilien is now the fourth active player with 500 career boards and 100 career blocks.

GOOD WORK YOUNG LADIES

A league-record four women's basketball players are official nominees for the Allstate WBCA Good Works Team®, as Coastal Carolina's **OLIVIA CARLTON**, Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER**, Presbyterian's **JANIE MILES** and UNC Asheville's **PAIGE LOVE** are among the 103 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA. The list will be pared down to a 10-person team featuring five Division I student-athletes in February.

A'S FOR ASHLEY

For the second straight season, Liberty women's basketball redshirt senior post player **ASHLEY RININGER** has been voted to the 2015-16 CoSIDA Academic All-District III team, it was announced Feb. 11. After just three years on campus, Rininger graduated with a bachelor's degree in criminal justice in May 2014, maintaining a 4.0 GPA. She then completed a master's degree in human services counseling with a focus in crisis response and trauma in May 2015 with a 4.0 GPA. Rininger, who aspires to be an FBI agent, is currently working toward a second master's degree, in criminal justice. Again, her GPA stands at 4.0.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Liberty's **ASHLEY RININGER** is the Big South's active-leading rebounder with 924, and cracked the league's all-time Top-10 list. Gardner-Webb's **OLIVIA PARKER** (907) became the 12th player in Big South history with 900 rebounds and needs three rebounds to tie for 11th all-time. Liberty's **KATELYN ADAMS** (832) became the 22nd member of the 800-rebound club, while Gardner-Webb's **CANDACE BROWN** (776) became the 41st member of the 700-rebound club. Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS** (640) and Charleston Southern's **MONIQUE MAXIMILIEN** (605) are among the 72 players with 600 career boards. Liberty's **CATHERINE KEARNEY** (580) became the 107th member of the 500-rebound club on Jan. 24. GARDNER-WEBB, COASTAL CAROLINA SCORE BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG WINS OF 2015-16

Gardner-Webb defeated North Carolina in the season opener, 66-65 in Chapel Hill, while Coastal Carolina knocked off Clemson during the opening weekend. It is the first time since 2006-07 (three wins) that the Big South has collected two victories over the ACC in the same year.

MAGIC WAND-A

Campbell head coach **WANDA WATKINS** needs two wins for 550 in her coaching career, as she is 548-442 in 35 years in Buies Creek, which includes a 229-144 (.614 percent) record in 14 total seasons in the Big South -- good for third in league history, as she surpassed former Coastal Carolina coach **ALAN LeFORCE** (228). Watkins owns the second-most Big South victories with 135, and has recorded double-digit conference wins in her last eight seasons in the Big South -- 2011-to-present, and 1990-94 prior to the Camels' 17-year stay in the TAAC/Atlantic Sun from 1994-2011.

GREEN MACHINE

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** reached the 400-win mark in his coaching career on Feb. 27 against Longwood. He entered the 2015-16 season ranked 13th all-time among active NCAA Division I women's basketball coaches with his 75.0 winning percentage -- ahead of renowned coaches **C. VIVIAN STRINGER**, **SYLVIA HATCHELL** and **BRENDA FRESE**. Green is the Big South's all-time winningest basketball coach -- men's or women's -- with his 401 overall wins, which includes 236 Big South victories.

CAMPBELL

The Lady Camels finished 1-1 last week including a big victory at High Point. Campbell rallied from a 19-point third period deficit and **RAECHAUN EDWARDS** hit the game-winning three with four seconds left in Campbell's thrilling 68-65 win over the Panthers. CU suffered a 57-32 setback to Radford in its regular season finale versus Radford. **SUMMER PRICE** continued her strong play to finish the regular season with an average of 16.0 points per game last week.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern closed out the regular season on the road with a loss to UNC Asheville on Tuesday night in Kimmel Arena, 91-68. **ALYSSA MANN** closed out her final regular season game with the Buccaneers with a team-high 12 points in the game. She added six assists and five rebounds from the floor. **GEORGIA ELLIOTT-KING** added nine fourth quarter points for the Bucs, hitting a trio of three-pointers in the final 10 minutes of the game as CSU outscored the Bulldogs 31-18 in the quarter. Mann finished the regular season as the only player to sit among the top five in the Big South in points, assists and steals on the season.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal enters the Big South tournament for the second year in a row – and second time in program history – as the No. 9 seed. The Chants fell to No. 8 Asheville last year in the first round of the tournament. The Chants and Camels have met three times in the tournament, with CU winning all three games. The last time the two played each other in the tournament was 1990-91, with Campbell winning 70-55 in the semifinals. Coastal is 14-29 all-time in Big South tournament games.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb dropped its only contest of the week on Saturday on the road at Longwood, 62-59. With the setback, the Runnin' Bulldogs closed the regular season in a three-way tie for third place and earned the No. 4 seed in this week's Big South Championship. GWU will face No. 5 seed Presbyterian College in the quarterfinals on Friday.

HIGH POINT

Sophomore **KAT HARRIS** tallied 19.5 points per game and upped her career high in both games this week. Freshman **EMMA BOCKRATH** continued her stellar play with 16.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 1.5 steals per game on the week. Junior **KAYLAH KEYS** scored 20 points in the two contests to reach 1,451 points in her career, the most of active Big South players.

LIBERTY

For the second time in three years and the fourth time in program history, Liberty is seeded No. 2 for the Big South Women's Basketball Championship. The Lady Flames have won the title two of the three previous times they have been the No. 2 seed, cutting down the nets in 1997 and 2010. On Saturday, Liberty honored seniors **KATELYN ADAMS**, **SADALIA ELLIS**, **JAYMEE FISHER-DAVIS**, **CATHERINE KEARNEY** and **ASHLEY RININGER**, who have led the Lady Flames to 115 victories over the last five seasons, combining for 4,096 points and 2,710 rebounds. Liberty enters the Big South Women's Basketball Championship coming off of a loss in its regular-season finale for just the third time in **CAREY GREEN**'s 17 seasons as head coach and the first since 2009. The Lady Flames will need to reach the championship game to record their ninth straight 20-win season.

LONGWOOD

Longwood picked up victories in both of its contests this week, beginning with a 84-76 victory over Coastal Carolina on Tuesday, followed by a 62-59 triumph over Gardner-Webb on Saturday. Longwood enters the Big South Championship as the No. 10 seed and faces No. 7 seed Charleston Southern in the opening round on Thursday.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose lead the Big South in turnover margin (+4.38) and assist/turnover ratio (0.9). **TAYLOR PETTY** leads all freshman and sits 12th in the conference in scoring with 11.2 points per game. She also leads the conference in 3-point field goals made with 2.3. **CORTNEY STOREY** leads the conference with a 139 assist/turnover ratio and sits second in the conference with 4.3 assists per game. The Blue Hose take the No. 5 seed into the Big South Conference tournament, their second highest seed in school history.

RADFORD

Radford was one of just three teams to go unbeaten in the Big South's final week of the regular season (UNC Asheville and Longwood). It is the second year in a row RU has earned a Top-3 seed in the tournament, after receiving the No. 2 seed last season. Radford defeated the Blue Hose despite only scoring 12 points in the second half.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs captured their first ever Big South Conference regular-season crown. Saturday's win over High Point coupled with Liberty's loss to Presbyterian gave Asheville first place outright and the No. 1 seed in the Big South Conference tournament. The Bulldogs finished the regular season 23-6 overall and 16-4 in league play. Asheville's 23 victories this season surpasses the number of wins (22) amassed by **COACH MOCK** in the past three seasons combined. The Bulldogs finished the regular season strong, recording multiple team game highs this week. In Tuesday's game against Charleston Southern, Asheville tallied a season-high free throws made (27), second-highest field-goal percentage (55.8%), rebounds (52) and third highest total points scored this season (91). In Saturday's victory over High Point, Asheville turned in a season-high free throw percentage at 90% (18-for-20).

WINTHROP

ALIYAH KILPATRICK moved up Winthrop's career scoring list to 16th with 1,034 points. She has also moved up to 4th on the steals list with 237, and finished the regular season ranked 4th in the nation with 3.53 steals per game, and is 7th overall in steals with 92. The 17 conference losses is the most in the program. The previous most was 16 in 1993-94.
