COASTAL CAROLINA BECOMES SECOND BIG SOUTH TEAM WITH TWO WINS IN POSTSEASON

Coastal Carolina has advanced to the Quarterfinals of the Collegeinsider.com Tournament (CIT) following its 65-57 first round win over Mercer on March 15 and 71-62 second round victory over New Hampshire on March 19 -- the program's first-ever postseason victories. The Chanticleers are the second Big South member to play in the CIT Quarterfinals, joining the 2013-14 VMI Keydets that reached the Semifinals that year. The Big South has now advanced in the CIT three consecutive years and has collected seven total wins in its seven all-time appearances.

CLIFF HANGER

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** has reached postseason play in six of his nine years at Coastal, the second-most postseason appearances by a Big South head coach in league annals. Ellis has two NCAA Tournament appearances, two NIT berths and two CIT appearances during his time in Conway.

4x20x3

The Big South Conference has four 20-win teams for the third time in league history, which has actually occurred each of the past three seasons. Two of the squads (WU, HPU) won 20 regular-season games, the fifth such occurrence in conference annals. Winthrop reached 20 wins for the second time in three seasons, and posted 20 regular-season victories for the first time since 2006-07. It is the Eagles' 10th 20-win season as Big South members, extending their league record. High Point's 21 wins marked its second straight and third overall 20-win season since joining the Big South. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville collected its fifth 20-win campaign and first since 2011-12 with its 3-0 run to the Big South Championship. Lastly, Coastal Carolina has now reached the 20-win plateau for the third straight year and fifth time under head coach **CLIFF ELLIS**.

UNC ASHEVILLE PUNCHED TICKET TO NCAA TOURNAMENT

The UNC Asheville Bulldogs appeared in the NCAA Tournament for the third time since 2011 -- the most appearances by a Big South member this decade. Asheville made its fourth overall appearance in the Big Dance, as the Bulldogs also earned berths in 2003, 2011 and 2012 and are now tied for the second-most NCAA Tournament berths by a league program. Asheville is 2-4 all-time in the NCAA Tournament -- the most NCAA wins for a Big South squad.

BIG SOUTH GARNERED NO. 15 SEED IN NCAA's

Big South Champion UNC Asheville was a No. 15 seed in the 2016 NCAA Tournament, the first time the league was off the No. 16 line since 2008 when Winthrop was a No. 13 seed. The Big South has received a No. 15 seed now five times and came close to winning twice with a 2-point loss (2006) and 5-point loss (1996).

UNC ASHEVILLE WINS BIG SOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP AS NO. 4 SEED

Big South Champion UNC Asheville claimed its fifth conference championship on March 6, the second-most titles in Big South history. The Bulldogs won the 2016 Big South Tournament as the No. 4 seed, the fifth time the No. 4 seed has won it all. It was Asheville's third Championship Game appearance as the No. 4 seed and second title in that slot (1989). The No. 4-seeded Bulldogs defeated No. 2 seed Winthrop for the crown, pushing the No. 4 seed to 4-1 against the No. 2 in the all-time meetings.

HIGH FIVE

UNC Asheville and High Point opened the Big South schedule 5-0, the first time the league had two 5-0 teams since 2010-11 (Coastal Carolina and Liberty) and just the fourth time overall. Teams that have started 5-0 in league games have reached the Big South Championship game 18 times -- winning the title 11 times, including UNC Asheville this year.

SKY HIGH

High Point made its fourth consecutive postseason appearance with its NIT berth, as the Panthers fell at South Carolina in the first round. It was HPU's second-ever NIT appearance, and High Point became just the second Big South program in league history to make four straight postseason appearances. Winthrop was the first with four straight postseason berths, accomplishing the feat twice (NCAAs in 1999-00-01-02 and 2005-06-07-08).

BIG SOUTH HAS CO-CHAMPIONS FOR THIRD TIME IN FOUR SEASONS

High Point and Winthrop tied for the regular-season championship, and the Panthers earned the No. 1 seed in the Big South Championship with the Eagles receiving the No. 2 seed, as determined by the league's tiebreaker. High Point captured its fourth consecutive Big South regular-season title, becoming just the third program in league history to accomplish this feat. Winthrop clinched its first regular-season crown since sharing the title in 2007-08. The Eagles have eight outright/shared regular-season championships, most in Big South history.

BIG SOUTH IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

UNC Asheville made its fourth trip to the Big Dance, tied for second-most in Big South history. The Bulldogs are 2-4 all-time in the NCAA Tournament following its first round loss to Villanova.

The Big South Conference first secured an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament in 1992, sending its postseason tournament champion to the Big Dance every year since, with the exception of 1995.

Winthrop garnered the League's highest seed at No. 11 in 2007. Below is a look at the Conference's NCAA Tournament history:

SWEET DOZEN

High Point became the first team in Big South history to win at least 12 conference games in four consecutive seasons, as the Panthers posted 12 in 2012-13 and 2013-14 and 13 in 2014-15 and 2015-16.

MARGINAL NOTE

With the completion of the 99-game conference season, the visiting teams finished 46-53 (=46.5 percent), the third consecutive season at or above 40.0 percent and the highest road winning clip since 2008-09 when the road teams won 46.7 percent of Big South games. Meanwhile, 61 of the 99 contests (=61.6 percent) were decided by less than 10 points (4.28 winning average), and the overall margin of victory was 8.72 points. In fact, 37.4 percent of Big South games (37) were decided by four points-or-less -- tops in the nation.

TAKING FLIGHT

Winthrop will finish the 2015-16 season as the Big South leader in scoring offense at 82.2 points per game, the highest scoring average in the league in two year. The Eagles led the Big South in scoring average just twice previously, with the last time coming in 1992-93 (83.6 average). The first time was in the conference's first year of men's basketball in 1985-86. That season Winthrop was tops with 79.8 points per game.

BIG 10

For the third consecutive year, at least six teams won 10 Big South games in the same season. UNC Asheville was the first team with 10 conference wins -- the Bulldogs' record-tying ninth consecutive campaign with double-digit Big South victories. High Point and Gardner-Webb posted their fourth straight campaign with double-digit conference wins -- tied for the second-longest streak in league annals. Winthrop and Coastal Carolina each reached 10 league contests for the third straight season. It is also the 13th time the Eagles captured 10 Big South wins, extending their league record. Liberty notched 10 Big South wins for the first time since 2011.

FRESHMAN 15

Radford reached 15 wins in a season for the third consecutive year and 20th time as Big South members, extending its league record. Gardner-Webb has won 15 games each of the last four seasons, while High Point reached 15 wins for the fourth straight season and ninth time during its Big South affiliation. UNC Asheville amassed 15 wins for the ninth consecutive year -- the second-longest streak in Big South history. The Bulldogs have won at least 15 games in 18 of their 31 years in the Big South -- tied with Winthrop for the second-most 15-win seasons in conference annals.

BIG SOUTH 2,000-POINT ODYSSEY

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN**, who became the ninth player in Big South history with 2,000 career points when he reached the milestone Jan. 14 in the first half at Winthrop, ends his career as the league's second all-time leading scorer with 2,229 points. HE'S CRAFTY

Gardner-Webb head coach **TIM CRAFT** became the second coach this year and sixth in Big South history to win at least 15 games in each of his first three seasons in the league. He joined UNC Asheville's **NICK McDEVITT** with the accomplishment this year, as well as Liberty's **JEFF MEYER** (1991-94), Radford's **RON BRADLEY** (1991-94), Winthrop's **GREGG MARSHALL** (1998-01) and Birmingham-Southern's **DUANE REBOUL** (2003-06) as the only coaches to achieve this feat.

WHAT A STEAL!

Gardner-Webb freshman **LAQUINCY RIDEAU** finished second in the Big South with 67 steals and 2.03 steals per game. His season total is the second-most by a freshman in league history, as Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** posted a Big South freshman-record 70 swipes in 2004-05.

DOUBLE VISION

Campbell's **CHRIS CLEMONS** will start the 2016-17 campaign as the league's active leader in consecutive double-figure scoring games at 15, as Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON**'s league-leading streak ended at 35 games in the Big South Championship game. High Point's **JOHN BROWN** was second to Johnson at 16 games.

THE BIG 5-0

Head coaches **TIM CRAFT** (Gardner-Webb), **RITCHIE McKAY** (Liberty) and **NICK McDEVITT** (UNC Asheville) became the 10th, 11th and 12th coaches, respectively, in Big South history to reach 50 overall wins in their third season in the league. Craft achieved the benchmark in 92 games, while McKay secured win No. 50 in his 93rd game on Liberty's bench. McDevitt won No. 50 in his 90th game on the sideline. He is one of seven coaches in league history with 50 wins in 90 or less games.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

UNC Asheville and Longwood were the lone Big South programs to have five players average double figures in points, while Coastal Carolina has four players at 10+ points per game. The Bulldogs and Lancers are the first league members to have five players average at least 10.0 points since Charleston Southern in 2013-14.

BIG BROWN

High Point redshirt-senior and Big South Player of the Year **JOHN BROWN** is finished his career second all-time in Big South history with 512 made free throws, just one behind the all-time mark of 513 held by Radford's **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** (2002-06). Brown's 712 career free throw attempts are second-most in league annals as well. Brown, who is the only player in Big South history with 2,000 points (2,229), 800 rebounds (801), 150 blocked shots (167), 150 steals (182) and 150 assists (180), is third in Big South history with 858 career field goals.

C-SQUARED

Campbell freshman guard and Big South Freshman of the Year **CHRIS CLEMONS** is just the fifth Big South freshman in league history to score 500 points in a season (556), as he reached the total Feb. 20 at Charleston Southern. The Big South's leading freshman scorer with 18.5 points per game -- good for 7th among all freshman nationally, Clemons ranks fifth overall in the league in scoring. His 3.07 3FG per game is first in the league, finishing just 0.24 behind the conference's freshman record of 3.31 set by Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** in 2013-14. Meanwhile, Clemons is second in the Big South with an 84.4 free throw percentage.

FRESH PERSPECTIVE

UNC Asheville freshman **DYLAN SMITH** added his name to the Big South's single-season freshman scoring list, as he was the 23rd such frosh to score 400 points in a campaign (460). Fellow freshman **ARMEL POTTER** of Charleston Southern became the 24th freshman to reach the same threshold (414), while Asheville's **DWAYNE SUTTON** (408) surpassed the total during the NCAA Tournament. Coupled with Campbell's **CHRIS CLEMONS**, the quartet tied the Big South record for most freshman to score 400 points in the same year (2013-14).

BIG THINGS COME IN SMALL PACKAGES

Winthrop 5-7 guard **KEON JOHNSON** finished third in the Big South with 18.7 points per game, and was in contention to become just the second Eagle to average 20.0 points since the Big South began sponsoring men's basketball in 1985-86. That year was the last time a Winthrop player averaged 20.0 points, as **FRED McKINNON** averaged a league-best 21.1 points that first season -- also the last time a Winthrop Eagle led the Big South in scoring.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

High Point's **LORENZO CUGINI** became the eighth Big South player this season to surpass the 1,000-point milestone on Feb. 25 (143rd player overall). The Big South had nine active 1,000-point scorers in 2015-16, and below is a look at where all nine rank among the all-time leaders:

BUC-ETS

Charleston Southern is just the second program to lead the Big South in three-pointers per game for four consecutive years, as the Bucs drained a league-high 9.33 threes per contest in 2015-16. Former member VMI led the Big South in 3FGs per game a record six straight seasons from 2006-12.

THREE'S COMPANY

For just the third time in Big South history, a trio of four-year classmates scored 1,000 career points during the same four-year period. High Point's **JOHN BROWN** (2,229), **ADAM WEARY** (1,258) and **LORENZO CUGINI** (1,045) combined for 4,532 points since hitting the court together in 2012. It is the second-highest scoring trifecta and just 80 points behind the all-time high of 4,612 set by UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY**, **J.P. PRIMM** and **CHRIS STEPHENSON** from 2008-12. Meanwhile, Brown and Weary finished as the fourth-highest 1,000-point four-year scoring duo to combine for 3,000 points (3,487), with Brown and Cugini sixth at 3,274.

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

Radford senior guards **RASHUN DAVIS** and **YAYA ANDERSON** became the 20th pair of Big South four-year classmates to score 1,000 points during the same four-year period on Dec. 9 when Anderson eclipsed the milestone. Davis ended his career with 1,304 points, while Anderson concluded his at 1,141. Their combined point total of 2,445 is the 16th-highest scoring combination for a four-year duo with 1,000 points each.

DUBY-DUBY-DO

Winthrop redshirt-sophomore **DUBY OKEKE** led the Big South with 2.48 blocks per game to become the first Winthrop player to lead the league since **JOSH GRANT** in 2002-03 (2.28). Okeke recorded multiple blocks in 21 of his 29 appearances this season, including three games with four, four with five and one with six. Meanwhile, Okeke surpassed 100 career blocks Jan. 30 during the Radford game and was the first Eagle with 100 rejections (118) since **BILLY HOUSTON** eclipsed the mark during the 2004-05 campaign. Sophomore teammate **XAVIER COOKS** surpassed 100 career blocked shots during the Big South Semifinals, and enters 2016-17 with 101 swats. Okeke and Cooks are two of five Eagles residing in the Big South's 100-blocked shot club: Houston (139 from 2002-06), Grant (125 from 2001-04) and **TYRONE WALKER** (105 from 2000-04).

COASTAL'S BOARDWALK

Coastal Carolina is the lone Big South member to have three players with at least 500 career rebounds. **TRISTAN CURTIS** eclipsed the milestone Feb. 13 to become the 81st player in league history with 500 (556), while injured forward **MICHEL ENANGA** reached the benchmark Nov. 21 and stands at 523. **BADOU DIAGNE** became the 31st player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Jan. 23 at Charleston Southern, and is 17th all-time with 782. Meanwhile, Diagne, who became the 50th player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he eclipsed the mark against Grace Bible College on Nov. 18, has an outside chance of joining the league's 1,000-point, 700-rebound and 100-blocked shot club (currently just 13 members), as his career totals include 1,055 points and 97 blocked shots.

HIGH TOPS

Radford senior **RASHUN DAVIS** is the 21st player in conference annals with 1,000 points (1,304) and 400 assists (457), having eclipsed the assist milestone Jan. 20 against Campbell. He ends his career 19th all-time in league history for assists and is also part of a 14-player group with 1,000 points, 400 assists and 150 steals (170). Meanwhile, teammate **BRANDON HOLCOMB** became the 80th Big South player with 500 rebounds Jan. 14 during the Asheville game, and concludes his career as the 24th player in the Big South's 500-rebound (557) and 100-blocked shot club (146). Holcomb is 19th all-time in career blocks.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is the 4th-active winningest coach in Division I with 790 career victories. Ellis, who notched his 700th Division I win Jan. 2 against Winthrop, is 16th all-time in NCAA history for career wins (regardless of affiliation with a minimum 10 head coaching seasons at NCAA schools), and is the 7th-active winningest coach across all NCAA classifications. He became the first head coach in NCAA history with 150 wins at four different Division I programs with the Chanticleers' 68-56 victory over UNC Asheville on Feb. 3, 2015. His Division I school-by-school breakdown is as follows: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 178, in addition to 78 wins leading Cumberland College from 1972-75.

HIGH POINT'S JOHN BROWN MAKES BIG SOUTH HISTORY

For the second time in his career, High Point's **JOHN BROWN** is the Big South Player of the Year. In addition, he is the first player in Big South history to be voted Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year in the same season, and is just the second player to be voted First-Team All-Conference all four years. He is also the sixth two-time Player of the Year honoree in league annals. Brown capped the regular-season with 19.6 points (third in the Big South), a 60.2 field goal percentage (first), 7.1 rebounds (sixth), 1.75 blocked shots (third) and 3.25 offensive rebounds per game (first). He was second in the nation in player efficiency rating and third nationally in offensive efficiency.

DID YOU KNOW...

Campbell hosted the Big South Men's Basketball Championship for the first time. It marked the third time that all rounds of the men's postseason event was held in the state of North Carolina. The previous times were in 1999 and 2000 in Asheville. In all, 41 Big South Tournament games have been contested in the Tar Heel state.

HEAD OF THE CLASS

High Point redshirt-senior **JOHN BROWN** was among the 30 candidates for the national Senior CLASS Award. He is the Big South's first official candidate since former teammate **ALLAN CHANEY** in 2013-14.

GOOD WORK YOUNG MEN

A league-record three men's basketball players were official nominees for the Allstate NABC Good Works Team®, as High Point's **JOHN BROWN**, Longwood's **KANAYO OBI-RAPU** and Presbyterian's **WILL ADAMS** were among the 154 nominees across NCAA Divisions I, II, III and the NAIA.

ANOTHER YEAR OF BIG WINS FOR THE BIG SOUTH

The Big South Conference went 2-2 against BIG EAST this season, with both wins over Georgetown. The last time the Big South had two wins vs. the BIG EAST was in 2012-13. Radford downed the Hoyas in double-overtime in its season opener, followed by UNC Asheville on Dec. 19. In addition, the Highlanders defeated Penn State, 86-74 in State College, Pa., on Nov. 26, 12 days after the Georgetown victory. The win over the Nittany Lions marks the second straight year the Big South has defeated a Big Ten member. The Big South has defeated a BIG EAST member four times in the past five seasons, and the last time the Big South had wins over both the BIG EAST and Big Ten in the same year was 2011-12.

DAILY DOUBLE

Radford's wins over two Power 5 conferences marked the fourth time in the last six seasons that a Big South member achieved this feat. Last season, it was Gardner-Webb (Clemson, Purdue), and prior to that, it was Coastal Carolina (LSU, Clemson in 2011-12) and Presbyterian (Auburn, Wake Forest in 2010-11).

MID-MAJOR MANIA

Radford was ranked No. 25 in the Nov. 16 Collegeinsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 ranking, the second consecutive season a Big South member has appeared in the poll. Five teams have received Top 25 consideration this season -- High Point, Winthrop, Coastal Carolina, Radford and UNC Asheville. Below is a look at where the Big South has stood each week:
