Rollins batted .667 (6-9) in Winthrop's three wins last week, with three doubles, one triple, six runs batted in and five bases on balls. In the Eagles' 13-6 win over The Citadel, Rollins was 1-2 with an RBI, two walks and a stolen base. Against High Point on Saturday, the sophomore went 2-3 at the plate with a double and two RBI, in addition to a sacrifice fly. On Sunday against the Panthers, Rollins did it all in Winthrop's 12-6 win, as he was 3-4 with two doubles and a triple, plus three RBI, two walks and a run scored. On the mound, he allowed just two runs on three hits while striking out nine to earn his ninth win of the season. Rollins finished the week with a 1.222 slugging percentage and a .786 on-base average..
