Tucker helped lead BSC to a 6-0 week with a .529 (9-17) batting average with 4 HR, 10 RBI, 2 2B, 8 R and no strikeouts in 24 total plate appearances. He recorded home runs in three-straight games, posted three multi-hit contests and slugged 1.353 and posted a .583 on-base percentage. He went 3-3 with 3 R, 2 HR and 4 RBI in the Panthers' 7-1 win over Tennessee-Martin, while recording a .400 batting average (4-10) in BSC's three-game sweep of Conference foe Liberty.

## NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

## BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

Birmingham-Southern is on a season long eight-game winning streak ... BSC outscored its opponents 54-19 last week, posting a 6-0 record. The Panthers hit 10 HR and had 10 2B and 52 RBI ... BSC hit 5 HR in a 12-2 win over Butler last Monday. In that game, the Panthers hit back-to-back HR twice in a game for the first time in school history ... Birmingham-Southern hosts Dayton Monday evening, UAB on Wednesday and travels to Charleston Southern this weekend.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern is 11-0 at home this season and has won 12-in-a-row at home dating back to last season ... CSU has won six consecutive games and has 82 hits in those six wins ... Senior LHP **BRAD BISSELL** tossed eight shutout innings, allowing five hits and six strikeouts in the 5-0 win over Fordham ... Junior RHP **RYAN SOWERS** came in relief against No. 18 College of Charleston and went 6.2 IP, allowing 5 H and 2 R as CSU overcame a 5-0 deficit to win, 8-7. The win over the Cougars was the Bucs' second over a top-20 opponent this season ... Charleston Southern completes its series with Fordham on Monday and hosts Birmingham-Southern this weekend.

## COASTAL CAROLINA

The Chants have moved back into the top-25 this week, capturing the 25th spot in *Collegiate Baseball News'* weekly poll ... Coastal Carolina defeated George Mason for the seventh and eighth straight times in a doubleheader sweep of the Patriots, 6-0 and 9-4. Coastal also shut out the Patriots for the first time since Feb. 29, 2004 (South Carolina) ... CCU head coach **GARY GILMORE** is just three wins away from 600 career victories as a head coach. He is in his 16th year with stops at USC-Aiken and Coastal. Gilmore won his 500th game Feb. 21, 2003 against Delaware ... Coastal earned its fourth shutout of the season with a 1-0 win over High Point last Saturday. CCU has four shutouts this season, the most since the 2000 campaign ... Catcher **MIKE FUENTES** is hitting .375 after missing the first month with an injury ... The Chants wrap up their series with High Point Monday, travel to Wake Forest on Tuesday then host Siena Wednesday and VMI this weekend.

## HIGH POINT

**JOSH COTTEN** slugged 3 HR last Tuesday at No. 25 East Carolina to become the first Panther in High Point's short Division I history to hit three homers in a single game ... Freshman RHP **EAMMON PORTICE** had a 16.1 inning scoreless streak snapped when Coastal Carolina pushed across a run in the 8th inning Saturday for a 1-0 win. Portice allowed just 1 R on 2 H in the loss ... HPU finishes its series with Coastal on Monday, hosts rival Elon in a make-up game Tuesday and plays host to Liberty Friday and Saturday.

## LIBERTY

With last Tuesday's win at Old Dominion, the Flames swept the season series with the Monarchs for just the third time ever since the teams began playing in 1982 (1991, 2001) ... Junior LF **PHIL LAURENT** opened Conference play going 6-6 in his first six ABs at Birmingham-Southern. He was 5-5 in Game 1 and opened Game 2 with a base hit. It was his first career 5-5 game and he now owns six multi-hit games this season ... Freshman **P.K. KELLER**'s hitting streak ended this past Saturday at 13 games. The string began Feb. 23 at North Carolina A&T and featured six multi-hit affairs ... Liberty looks to rebound this week with games against Wake Forest Wednesday and at High Point this weekend.

## RADFORD

Radford won its first series of the year, sweeping Marist, the preseason #2 team in the MAAC ... The Highlanders host local rival Virginia Tech Tuesday before opening Conference play Friday at home against Winthrop.

## UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs broke a seven-game losing streak with a 13-9 victory at VMI on Sunday in the final game of the series. It was the Bulldogs' first Big South victory of the season ... **JOSH COYLE** was 3-5 on Sunday with a 2B, HR and 5 RBI ... **ELLIOTT ARRINGTON** was 4-6 against VMI and 6-14 for the week with 2 2B and 4 RBI ... **KEVIN MATTISON** was 6-11 against VMI and **EVAN DAWSON** was 6-12 on the weekend ... UNC Asheville hosts Gardner-Webb Tuesday, visits Western Carolina Wednesday and entertains Brown on Friday and Saturday.

## VMI

VMI scored its first-ever Big South series win this past weekend, taking two-of-three from visiting UNC Asheville. The Keydets scored 40 runs in the series, hitting 6 HR ... Sophomore **ROBERT CRUMPLER** is currently on a 14-game hitting streak, the Keydets' longest of the season ... Junior 3B **KELLY SWEPENHISER** leads the team and is tied for second in the Big South with a .430 batting average and 23 RBI, while also leading the team and ranking second in the League with 6 HR. He is tops with 37 H, 64 TB, 22 R, 9 2B and a .744 SLG ... Senior **DUKE ACORS** became VMI's all-time strikeout leader over the weekend, and now owns 219 career Ks. He is second in innings pitched (281.2) and tied for fourth in wins (12) ... RP **JEFF DeMARA** made his school-record 84th career pitching appearance Sunday vs. UNCA ... VMI travels to Norfolk State Tuesday and hosts Coastal Carolina this weekend.

## WINTHROP

The Eagles wrapped up its West Coast swing with two wins over Hawaii and finished 4-2 ... Winthrop hosts Wright State and Fordham this week before visiting Radford.
