## NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

## BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

BSC was swept by Miami (Ohio) last weekend ... CF **SCOTT BILLAK** enters the week with a 7-game hitting streak, SS **MATT BARBER** has a current 5-game hitting streak ... **JONATHAN SANFORD** had a 9-game hitting streak earlier this season which has been the Panthers' longest this year.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern faces nationally-ranked College of Charleston Tuesday and Gardner-Webb Wednesday before hosting VMI this weekend.

## COASTAL CAROLINA

Junior **MIKE COSTANZO** gave up his first earned run of the season in the 7-6 win over Radford. The streak was 30.1 IP before Radford's **DAVID LANDMAN** doubled in **NATE TOTTH** with the game-tying run. Costanzo now has a 0.29 ERA with 38 SO in 31 IP ... Costanzo was selected to the *Baseball America* Mid-Season All-America Second Team as a utility player, the magazine announced April 8. Costanzo leads the Chants with a .364 AVG, 4 HR and 27 RBI. On the mound, the junior has a 0.29 ERA with a 5-1 record, 8 SV and 38 SO in 31 IP. Costanzo is the only player from the Big South on the first or second team ... Freshman **TOMMY BALDRIDGE** laced a double in the ninth inning to plate **KEVIN ENTSMINGER** and give Coastal a 7-6 win April 10. It was Coastal's fourth last at-bat victory of the season and was Baldridge's sixth RBI of the year.

## HIGH POINT

High Point claimed a 4-3 win over Charleston Southern Sunday in the final game of the Big South weekend series. The Buccaneers took the first two games, 8-5 and 14-4. **BRANDON MOORE** (3-0) earned his third win, while **MATT KNIGINYZKY** picked up his fifth save for HPU ... **CHRIS RAMIREZ** (13-35, =.371) and **JOSH DOANE** (12-36, =.333) are tied with the longest hitting streaks of the season at nine games. Ramirez carries his streak into the week.

## LIBERTY

**AARON GRIJALVA** enters the afternoon on a 5-game hitting streak and is hitting .515 over his last 10 games. In that span, he has six multiple hit games with 14 R, 5 2B, 3B, 2 HR and 7 RBI ... After a stint in the bullpen during most of March, RHP **CHRIS ZUVICH** has had a solid return to the Flames' pitching rotation the past two weekends. Making his first start since March 6, Zuvich handcuffed High Point batters for 7 IP, 1 R, 3 H and 4 SO, propelling the Flames to a sweep of their March 29 doubleheader with the Panthers. The then shut down Winthrop over 6.1 IP, allowing only 1 R and 6 H for his second straight victory in a 6-2 win. Over the two starts, Zuvich has held opponents to 2 R and 9 H in 13.1 IP with a 1.35 ERA ... Since taking over the ninth spot in the batting order nine games ago, 3B **CHAD MILLER** is batting .400 with 2 2B, 3 3B and 7 RBI ... Starting on Tuesday, the Flames will play 12 of their next 14 games on the road. The period includes a 10-game road trip, the Flames longest of the season.

## RADFORD

Radford nearly stole two wins at Coastal Carolina. RU tied game three in the ninth inning, then left two runners stranded before giving up a game-winning double in the bottom of the inning ... The Highlanders have performed well in Conference on the road, posting a 3-3 record ... RU has yet to win a home League game, but will try again this weekend against High Point ... With a 3-6 Big South record, RU has already faced two of the top three teams in the Big South (Winthrop, Coastal).

## UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville will complete its weekend series at Liberty on Monday afternoon ... **TONY CAMPANA** has hit in eight-straight games and is 6-16 (= .375) ... **ELLIOTT ARRINGTON** went 3-4 against Western Carolina ... The Bulldogs will host Tennessee at McCormick Field on Wednesday before traveling to Winthrop over the weekend.

## VMI

With Sunday's win, VMI now stands 6-8 in one-run games, 12-6 in games that they hit a home run in, and 14-1 when they score at least six runs ... The Keydets have now hit at least one HR in six of their last seven games ... This weekend's sweep of Longwood is the Keydets' second weekend sweep of the year ... VMI now stands 7-1 in games played against teams from Virginia this season ... The Keydets are currently on a four-game win streak, and have come back after their opponent scored first in each of those games. The four-game run is the team's second longest of the season, trailing only their seven-game win streak from Feb. 23-March 7 ... Over the past four games, both **ROBERT CRUMPLER** and **ELLIOTT ERBE** have gone 9-16 (= .563) with a 2B, 2 HR, 1.000 SLG and .588 OBA. The only statistical differences for the Keydets' fourth and fifth hitters in the lineup are 6 R scored for Erbe, compared to four for Crumpler, and 8 RBI for Crumpler versus seven for Erbe ... Longest hitting streak on the season: Crumpler - 15 games (23-62, =.371) ... Longest current hitting streaks-**THANE SMITH** - 8 games (15-33, =.455) and Crumpler - 7 games (12-26, =.461).

## WINTHROP

**MATT REPEC** had an outstanding series against Georgia Tech. He was 4-9 with 4 RBI and 4 runs scored in the series and a perfect 3-for-3 in Winthrop's 12-9 upset of the Yellow Jackets on Saturday night. In that game, Repec hit a two-out, two-run homer in the fifth inning to give the Eagles a 7-2 lead and knock out Tech starter Jason Neighborgall. In the Tech series, Repec batted .444 and had a slugging percentage of .778.
