NOTING THE BIG SOUTH

COASTAL RECEIVES BIG SOUTH'S FIRST-EVER NO. 1 SEED IN NCAA TOURNAMENT

For the fourth time in the last five seasons, the Big South will have two representatives in the NCAA Baseball Championship, as **WINTHROP** won the League's automatic bid and **COASTAL CAROLINA** received an at-large selection. The Eagles have been tabbed a No. 2 seed in the Knoxville Regional, equalling its best seeding (2001). Meanwhile, the Chants are making their fifth-straight NCAA appearance and sixth overall, and received the No. 1 seed in the Tempe Regional, becoming the first Big South squad ever to receive that distinction. Coastal's previous best seeding was No. 2 in 2003.

COSTANZO FIRST BIG SOUTH PLAYER TO EARN MULTIPLE MVP AWARDS

Coastal Carolina junior **MIKE COSTANZO** was voted the 2005 Big South baseball MVP, becoming the first player in Conference history to win multiple MVP awards, as he was the 2004 honoree. He also is the first player to earn First-Team All-Conference honors at two positions (1B and P). Last week, Costanzo was named Second-Team All-America by *USA Today Sports Weekly* as a UTL/DH.

CARTE POWERS WINTHROP TO BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT TITLE

Winthrop junior **DANIEL CARTE** batted .667 (14-21) with 4 HR, 5 RBI and a 1.333 SLG to lead the Eagles to the Big South Baseball Tournament title, Winthrop's first since 1999.

25 BIG SOUTH OPPONENTS AMONG NCAA'S 64-TEAM TOURNAMENT FIELD

Of the 64 teams receiving berths in the 2005 NCAA Baseball Championship, 25 were Big South opponents this season. Not including Big South action, Coastal went 7-4 against NCAA Tournament teams, with wins over East Carolina, Clemson, South Alabama, College of Charleston, Georgia Tech and North Carolina. Winthrop posted a 4-8 record against the Tournament field, defeating Missouri, Clemson, College of Charleston and Georgia Tech.
