He hit three home runs, scored six runs, posted six RBI and slugged 1.231 percent against the Highlanders, helping the Eagles re-claim sole possession of first-place in the Big South standings with a perfect 6-0 record. Roberson went 4-5 with back-to-back home runs in the series opener against RU and followed that performance with a 2-4 effort in game two. He added a home run in the series finale.

Hynick is now 4-1 on the season with a 1.85 ERA in six games.

Hollenbeck pitched the Keydets to a win over their highest-ranked opponent in more than a decade Saturday afternoon, with a 3-2 win over No. 21 CCU. Hollenbeck had 5 SO and permitted just one extra-base hit in helping end the Chants' eight-game winning streak.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers' 17-1 loss to Charleston Southern on Friday was the largest margin of defeat by a **BRIAN SHOOP** coached team in his 16 years ... BSC went 3-2 last week but had its nine-game winning streak snapped against UAB ... The Panthers travel to Troy Tuesday night and VMI this weekend.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU saw its eight-game overall winning streak and 14-game home win streak snapped with a doubleheader loss to Birmingham Southern ... CSU tallied a season-high 22 H in Friday's 17-1 win over the Panthers ... Senior CF **JORDAN HAAR** is hitting .369 this season. He needs 3 H to tie, 4 H to break CSU's career hit record of 234. Haar went 8-18 with 5 RBI last week, while **BRIAN SOLE** continues to lead the club with 6 HR ... Junior LHP **JOSH EVANS** picked up the win over Birmingham-Southern on Friday, allowing 1 R and 5 H in 8 IP. Evans has allowed just 5 ER in his last 22 IP, with 18 SO ... CSU is idle until this weekend's series at Radford.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The third RPI Index by *Boyd's World* was released March 22, and the Chanticleers were ranked 15th. Coastal also was 11th in Warren Nolan's RPI index. The Big South was ranked eighth in the Conference RPI by *Boyd's World*. Future opponent College of Charleston is first on both lists ... Head coach **GARY GILMORE** earned his 600th career victory in 16 years of coaching with a 4-3 win over VMI, March 25. Gilmore, who has 348 wins in 10 years at Coastal, has led his teams to 40-or-more wins nine times, took USC Aiken to one College World Series and two NCAA Tournaments, and Coastal to four NCAA appearances ... Junior **MIKE COSTANZO** still has not allowed an earned run in 21 IP of relief for Coastal. He has struck out 25, while walking only seven, in addition to seven saves this season -- tied for seventh on CCU's all-time single-season saves list ... RHP **RICKY SHEFKA** is 4-0 with a 1.69 ERA, 36 SO, 6 BB in 42.2 IP.

HIGH POINT

High Point pounded rival Elon, 18-0, last Tuesday. It was the third time this season the Panthers had scored 18 runs in a game and was the largest margin of victory for an HPU team since a 28-7 win over Guilford in 1997 ... Freshman RHP **EAMMON PORTICE** continued his dominance on the mound by leading the Panthers to a 7-4 win over Liberty on Friday. Five of HPU's 11 wins this season have come with Portice on the mound ... The Panthers' win over Liberty gave High Point 11 wins in 2005, which matches HPU's win total for the entire 2004 campaign ... High Point will play 12 of its next 17 games on the road, starting with Wednesday's contest at Wofford.

LIBERTY

Catcher **ADAM KEARNEY** continues to lead the Flames in batting average (.338) and doubles (8) after another solid weekend in which he batted .400 (4-10) with a HR, RBI and run scored against HPU ... 1B **AARON GRIJALVA** is batting .325 and is tied for the Flames' RBI lead with 14 in his first season ... **MICHAEL SOLBACH**'s CG on Saturday was his second of the season. A no-hitter through 7.2 IP, Solbach is the first Liberty freshman (redshirt or true) to pitch more than one complete game in a season since 1995, when **TIM HARRELL** pitched three seven-inning complete games ... Liberty travels to James Madison Tuesday before hosting Winthrop this weekend.

RADFORD

Radford dropped a heartbreaker last Tuesday to local rival Virginia Tech, falling 5-3 when the Hokies scored three unearned runs in the top of the ninth ... RU also lost its first three Conference games, losing to preseason favorite Winthrop ... The Highlanders will round out its nine-game homestand with non-Conference tilts this week against VCU and Davidson. RU returns to Big South action this weekend at Charleston Southern.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 2-3 last week, defeating Gardner-Webb before falling in the ninth inning at Western Carolina. In addition to SS **JOSH COYLE**'s performance last week, **ELLIOTT ARRINGTON** was 6-15 (.400) with 2 2B and 4 RBI. **JOHN WHITE** added 7 RBI as the middle of the UNCA order batted .354 (17-48) with 13 RBI ... **CHRIS WHITE** threw the Bulldogs' first complete game of the season in a seven-inning victory over Brown ... UNCA travels to Tennessee and hosts North Carolina A&T and High Point this week.

VMI

VMI's 3-2 win on Saturday over #21 Coastal Carolina marked its first win over a ranked team since Feb. 15, 2004, when VMI defeated #28 Stetson, 19-13. It was also the highest-ranked opponent the Keydets have defeated in at least a decade ... Junior 3B **KELLY SWEPENHISER** accounted for all three runs in VMI's win over Coastal Carolina, hitting his 7th HR of the season, a two-run shot in the first inning, then leading off the sixth inning with his 11th double of the season before scoring ... Sophomore 1B **ROBERT CRUMPLER**'s team-high 15 game hit streak came to an end last weekend at CCU. During that stretch, VMI went 11-4 ... The Keys are 9-3 when scoring first ... The Keydets' next game comes at in-state rival Virginia Wednesday. VMI is currently 3-0 against teams from the state of Virginia ... VMI has won 9 of its last 10 home contests entering this weekend's series against Birmingham-Southern.

WINTHROP

ALAN ROBBINS is currently on an 11-game hitting streak, tying the season-high set by **DANIEL CARTE** earlier this season. The overall record is 23 set by volunteer assistant coach **STAS SWERDEWSKI** in 2001 ... Winthrop travels to No. 10 North Carolina Tuesday before visiting Liberty this weekend. The Eagles are 25-18 all-time against the Flames.
