Crumpler batted .438 in four games last week, helping the Keydets to a 3-1 record and their first-ever berth in the Big South Baseball Championship. He recorded a hit in every game, including a 2-3 outing with a double, two walks and two RBI in VMI's 6-0 and tournament-clinching win in the series opener against Radford. He went 3-5 with three RBI and the gamewinning single in the top of the ninth in game two, and then added a double and run scored in the final contest against the Highs, finishing the series with a .500 batting average and five RBI. For the week, Crumpler scored five runs, posted two doubles, six runs batted in and a .563 slugging percentage.

NEW BALANCE PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Kevin Slowey • Junior Winthrop • Pittsburgh, Pa.

Slowey stymied the No. 23-Coastal Carolina Chanticleers with nine strikeouts against zero walks, and scattered five hits in a complete game, 4-2 win. He limited the Chants to a .156 batting average in recording his sixth complete game of the season and improving to 12-2 on the year. Slowey also set the school record for career strikeouts (317) and tied the Winthrop mark for career victories with 27.
