With two outs in the ninth inning at Charleston Southern, Fleisher capped a Highlander rally by swatting a three-run homer that gave RU an 8-7 win and a doubleheader sweep of the Bucs - Radford's first two Big South wins of the season. Fleisher batted .444 (4-9) in the three-game series against CSU, with a double, home run and five RBI. He opened the week with a 4-4 performance against Davidson, hitting a double, homer and driving in four runs.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

Birmingham-Southern has a current three game winning streak and has won its last five Big South Conference games ... The Panthers host Alabama A&M Tuesday, and travel to Mississippi State Wednesday and Miami (Ohio) this weekend.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Senior CF **JORDAN HAAR** became the all-time hit leader at CSU on Saturday, eclipsing the school record of 234. Haar is also the school's career HR and RBI leader ... Senior 3B **BRAD WOODS** has moved into fourth-place on the school's all-time hit list with 210 ... Junior LHP **JOSH EVANS** has developed into the ace of this year's staff. Evans is now 5-1 on the season with a team-best 2.21 ERA. Opponents are hitting just .199 against him and he has allowed 4 ER in his last 34 IP ... The Bucs are on the road this week at Furman Wednesday and High Point this weekend.

COASTAL CAROLINA

With Coastal's 5-2 win over Texas-Pan American April 2, the CCU baseball program earned its 1000th win. Coastal now has an all-time record of 1,001-584 and has had only four coaches since 1974. Coastal has been to five NAIA College World Series and five NCAA Tournaments ... Coastal Carolina hit .307 as a team in the two-game series with Clemson, but managed just six runs and one extra-base hit in the two losses, which marked the first time this year CCU dropped consecutive games ... Junior RP **MIKE COSTANZO** has still not allowed an ER in 25.2 IP. Against UTPA this past weekend, Costanzo earned the win Saturday night and picked up his eighth save in the 8-6 win Sunday. He now is tied for third in the country in saves ... The Chants face nationally-ranked College of Charleston Tuesday before hosting Radford this weekend.

HIGH POINT

High Point's baseball team used strong starting pitching and timely hitting to earn a Big South Conference doubleheader sweep of UNC Asheville at Greenwood Field Sunday afternoon. The Panthers won the first game, 5-3 and the nightcap, 4-1 ... The Panthers conclude the series Monday, face UNC Greensboro Tuesday and host Charleston Southern this weekend in Big South action.

LIBERTY

Junior **PHILLIP LAURENT** enters the week with a six-game hitting streak, his second such streak of the season. He has now taken over the team hitting lead with a .350 average ... 2B **MICHAEL JUST** went 4-4 at James Madison Tuesday, and scored each time he got on base. It was Just's fifth multiple hit game of the season, and he is now hitting .342 (13-38) over his last 10 games to raise his average over .300 for the first time this year ... Liberty's win Tuesday at James Madison was its first victory in Harrisonburg since 1999 and only the third time in the series between the two (1989 and 1993) ... With his CG on Saturday against Winthrop, **MICHAEL SOLBACH** became the first freshman to pitch three complete games in a season since **TIM HARRELL** in 1985. That season, Harrell pitched three seven-inning complete games, while Solbach's complete games have all been nine innings ... The Flames host Winthrop Monday afternoon, Virginia Tuesday and UNC Asheville this weekend.

RADFORD

Radford won its first two Conference games of the year with a doubleheader sweep of Charleston Southern on Saturday. After failing to score a run in Friday's loss to the Bucs, RU scored 17 in the two games on Saturday. **MARK FLEISHER** had late-inning heroics in game two of the doubleheader, hitting his fifth home run of the season, pulling him within five of the Radford career record ... The Highs host East Tennessee State and James Madison in mid-week affairs, then travel to Coastal Carolina this weekend.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville defeated Tennessee on Wednesday night, marking the Bulldogs second victory over an SEC school this season ... **ELLIOTT ARRINGTON** has been swinging a hot bat lately, as he was 9-17 (.529) in four games last week and 18-35 (.514) over the last 10 games ... **KEVIN MATTISON** is currently riding a 10-game hitting streak, the longest of the season for the Bulldogs ... UNCA will complete its series against High Point on Monday before playing its annual exhibition game with the Asheville Tourists, the Rockies' Class A team ... The Bulldogs will begin a four-game road trip at Western Carolina on Wednesday before traveling to Liberty over the weekend.

VMI

After dropping this weekend's home series, the Keydets are currently on a season-high five-game losing streak, with three of those losses coming by two runs-or-less ... **B.T. GOOD** was thrown out on the basepaths for the first time this season by Birmingham-Southern, as he is now 11-for-12 on steal attempts ... Freshman 2B **SHANE GEISSLINGER** leads the Keydets in hitting in the Big South Conference, batting .385 from the nine-hole ... VMI now stands 5-8 in 1-run games, as nearly half its games this season have been decided by only one run ... The Keys are also 10-1 when scoring at least six runs and 3-16 when scoring no more than five ... VMI hosts William & Mary and Longwood this week.

WINTHROP

ALAN ROBBINS' 13-game hitting streak was snapped in Saturday's win over Liberty ... RHP **KEVIN SLOWEY** is now 7-0 on the season with a 2.38 ERA. He has walked just two batters in 64.1 IP ... Winthrop faces Liberty Monday, travels to Charlotte Wednesday and takes on nationally-ranked Georgia Tech in a three-game set this weekend.
