Costanzo batted .643 (9-14) in Coastal's four wins last week, belting three home runs, knocking in seven runs, slugging 1.429 and recording a .762 on-base percentage. He reached base 13-of-15 plate appearances in the threegame sweep of Birmingham-Southern, in which he had two homers against the Panthers, including the game-winner in the eighth inning of CCU's 6-5 win in game two. He also tallied seven runs scored, seven bases on balls, a triple and two three-hit games. Costanzo also appeared on the mound three times, striking out four batters, notching a save and tossing 3.2 innings of hitless ball..

After allowing a lead-off triple to start the fourth inning, Slowey retired the next 15 batters, six by strikeout to finish with strikeouts in every inning.
