Tucker hit .583 (7-12) to lead Birmingham-Southern to a 4-0 week. He went 7-10 (.700) in the Panthers' three-game sweep of High Point, blasting 3 HR and 8 RBI. Tucker went 3-5 with a 2B, grand slam, 2 R and 4 RBI in Friday's 9-2 game one victory, while his grand slam stretched BSC's lead to 8-2. He was 2-2 with a 2B, HR, 2 R and an RBI in Saturday's 3-1 win, and 2-3 with a R, HR and 3 RBI in Sunday's 5-4 victory. Tucker's 3-run homer Sunday tied the game at 4-4. On the week, Tucker totaled 5 BB, a HBP, five extra-base hits (2 2B, 3 HR) and he slugged 1.500 - including 1.800 against High Point.

NEW BALANCE PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Kevin Slowey • Junior Winthrop Pittsburgh, Pa.

Slowey threw his secondstraight one-hitter Saturday in a complete game, 14-strikeout performance against VMI, winning 3-0. He retired the first 17 batters - nine by strikeout -- before allowing a single and a walk. He then retired the final 10 hitters, striking out the side in the 6th inning and finishing with at least two strikeouts in an inning six times. Earlier in the week, Slowey struck out two batters in an inning of relief against The Citadel. He ended the week with a 0.00 ERA in 10 IP, with 2 H, 0 R/ER, 1 BB, 16 SO in two games, holding the two opponents to just a .063 average. Slowey has not permitted a run in his last 18 innings, allowing just two hits and fanning 28 batters in that span.

He broke KIT KADLEC's (1997-00) record of 109 games. Binda also is seventh on Coastal's all-time strikeout list with 257. He struck out 10 batters in 4.1 IP this past week and ranks among the national leaders in K's per nine innings ... Coastal has won nine games in a row, the most since April 21-May 12, 2002. During the streak, the Chants are hitting .334 and slugging .454, while outscoring their opponents 86-47. Junior MIKE COSTANZO is hitting .533 with 4 HR, 12 RBI and 17 BB in that streak ...
