Miller batted .467 (7-15) in 4 G last week, hitting his first 4 HRs of the season, as well as a notching a double and 8 RBI. He hit 2 solo HR in Saturday's 9-5 win over VMI and two round-trippers - including a fifth inning grand slam - on Sunday in game two of a doubleheader, finishing with 5 RBI and helping the Flames take two of three games from the Keydets. Miller also tallied four runs scored, three multi-hit games, a 1.333 SLG and a .566 OBA last week.

Chris Carrara • Sophomore 2B • Winthrop Charlotte, N.C.

Carrara hit .800 (8-10) from his lead-off spot for the Eagles with 6 R, 5 RBI, 4 BB and an .857 OBA in 3 G last week. He opened the week with hits in his first six at-bats, including his first homer of the season against College of Charleston. Carrara went 4-4 with 3 R, 2 SB and 3 RBI against Troy on Saturday, and finished the weekend with 2 H, 3 R and an RBI against the Trojans on Sunday.

NEW BALANCE PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Britnell threw a complete game five-hit shutout against Radford on Sunday to help the Panthers sweep the three-game series and capture his third win of the season. He sat down 21 of the first 22 batters he faced - the first 11 batters, and following a fourth-inning single, the next 10 hitters - before surrendering three hits over the final two innings. Radford batted just .161 against Britnell, who carried a no-hitter into the fourth inning for the second straight week. Britnell's line: 9 IP, 5 H, 0 R/ER, 0 BB, 4 SO, .161 opponents' average.
