In both games last week, McCullough was UNCA's leading scorer and averaged 15.5 points in the Bulldogs' two wins. In the 75-72 win over Radford, he scored 15 points and grabbed seven rebounds, including five offensive boards. At Charleston Southern Saturday, McCullough finished with 16 points to lead the Bulldogs to a 66-63 win. For the week, McCullough was 11-of-18 from the floor (=.611), 3-of-4 from three-point range (=.750) and 6-of-8 from the line (=.750), in addition to averaging 4.5 rebounds.

Leasure scored 21 points in leading the Chants to a 69-68 road win at Birmingham-Southern last week to earn his fourth weekly award of the 2004-05 campaign. He went 8-of-13 from the floor (=.615), including 5-of-10 from three-point land (=.500), which was his fourth game this season with at least five treys. Leasure is among the national leaders in three-pointers per game (2.84) and three-point field goal percentage (.439).

BIG SOUTH'S TELEVISION SCHEDULE FEATURES PRESEASON FAVORITE AT "TERRORDOME"

The Big South's television package continues this Monday with Birmingham-Southern travelling to Radford to face the Highlanders for a BSTN game. Birmingham-Southern, the preseason favorite, leads the series, 4-1, and is 1-1 all-time at the Dedmon Center, while Radford is 6-1 at home this year and 233-64 (=.785) all-time at the "Terrordome," which opened Dec. 9, 1981. Among those wins was an 85-83 overtime win against High Point Jan. 22, in which **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** hit a 55-foot buzzer beater to win the game. The shot received national recognition on ESPN's "SportsCenter" last Wednesday as the "top play" of the show's nightly "top ten" highlights.

WINTHROP REMAINS IN SOLE POSSESSION OF FIRST PLACE

After opening the Big South season with a loss, the Winthrop Eagles have won six straight to move ahead of the pack with a 6-1 Conference record. The Eagles' six-game Conference win streak is their longest since winning six-in-a-row in 2002-03, and marks the fourth such win streak during **GREGG MARSHALL's** tenure as head coach. Winthrop is also 9-0 at Winthrop Coliseum this year, and is looking to become the first Big South squad since Radford in 2000-01 to go undefeated at home in a single-season.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Charleston Southern junior guard **TERRELL BROWN** has come into his own this season as a three-point specialist, as 35 of his 43 field goals have been from beyond the arc. His .398 three-point success rate shatters his season average of .282 last year, and places him 6th in the Conference in that category. Brown has converted a three-pointer in 10 straight outings, hitting 32-of-70 (=.457) in that span. In Conference games, Brown is hitting at a .434 rate from three-point land (23-of-53, 2.88 made per game), including 10-of-17 (=.588) the last two games.

WHO'S LINE IS IT ANYWAY?

Radford junior **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** has made 51 of his last 59 free throw attempts for a .864 percentage. The preseason All-Conference selection, who entered the season with a .721 career mark from the line, leads the League in the category at .831, helping the Highs rank 14th nationally in free throw percentage. Holcomb-Faye, whose career average now stands at .742, has recorded seven perfect nights from the line this season. His worst outing was 6-of-10 from the line this past Saturday against Liberty. Radford's single-season free throw percentage record is .879, set by **DON BURGESS** in 1992-93.

MARSHALL PLAN

With the Eagles' 58-45 win over Charleston Southern last Tuesday, Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** became the first Big South coach ever to record seven-straight 15-win seasons. Marshall was tied with former Radford mentor **RON BRADLEY**, who led the Highlanders to at least 15 wins from 1996-02. Marshall, who is third on the League's all-time win chart with 130, is also climbing the Big South's list for Conference wins, trailing UNC Asheville leader **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** by two for third place. However, Marshall does own the highest winning percentage among coaches with 50 Conference games coached.

LIBERTY'S BACKCOURT PRESS

Liberty's backcourt sophomore duo of **LARRY BLAIR** and **DAVID DEES** have combined for 35.9 points in eight Conference games this season, and are producing at almost an identical pace in the Big South campaign. Blair is 48-of-106 FG, while Dees is 44-of-109. Blair has made 16 three-pointers; Dees 17. Blair is .800 from the free throw line, while Dees is at .821. On the boards, Dees is averaging 5.6, compared to Blair's 4.9. Blair has 19 assists, one ahead of Dees' 18. The two also foul alike, as Blair has 17 personal fouls, with Dees being whistled 18 times in the Conference season.

BIG SOUTH 1,000-POINT SCORERS

UNC Asheville's **BRYAN McCULLOUGH** became the latest member of the Big South's 1,000-point club when he reached the milestone January 15 against VMI. The Conference now has three active 1,000-point scorers as League members, and four overall when Birmingham-Southern's **JAKOB SIGURDARSON** is added to the mix. Meanwhile, Radford's **OLUMUYIWA POPOOLA** is 67 points away of joining the club. The chart below indicates the active scoring leaders:

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers have suffered six of their nine losses by eight points-or-less, including three by four points-or-fewer ... Birmingham-Southern visits Radford Monday for a BSTN game, then returns to Bill Battle Coliseum to host Liberty Saturday and High Point on Feb. 10.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

In its 66-63 loss to UNC Asheville, Charleston Southern shot .471 from the arc, but missed nine of 16 free throws ... CSU has shot better than 35 percent from three-point range in six of the last seven contests ... The Bucs are in the midst of four-game homestand, which continues Thursday vs. Coastal Carolina and Saturday against Radford.

COASTAL CAROLINA

In his last five games, **PELE PAELAY** is averaging 24.2 points, .539 from the floor (41-of-76), .455 from the arc (10-of-22), .807 from the charity stripe (29-of-36), as well as 5.4 rebounds and 2.4 steals ... Freshman **JACK LEASURE** leads the Big South in three-point field goals made (54) and made per game (2.84). He has nailed a three-point field goal in 11 straight games, as well as in 18 of his 19 appearances this season ... The Chants visit Charleston Southern Thursday before hosting VMI on Saturday.

HIGH POINT

The Panthers' game against Winthrop Saturday was postponed due to inclement weather in the region and a make-up date has yet to be determined ... **ZION WHITE** has nailed a three-pointer in 14 straight games, the longest streak in the Big South this season. In that span, he has made 41 treys for an average of 2.93 per game ... The Panthers are three wins away from tying the school record for home wins in a season (11) since moving to Division I ... High Point travels to Liberty Tuesday, its first appearance at the Vines Center after a 45-point loss to the Flames in last year's Big South Championship game. The Panthers also visit UNC Asheville this week.

LIBERTY

The Flames' five-game winning streak, which ended Saturday at Radford, was the second-longest under LU coach **RANDY DUNTON** and tied for the 10th-longest in school history. Liberty shot .477 from the field during the streak, including two games above .500 ... LU is one win away from reaching the century mark as members of the Big South (99-94) ... Dunton became just the third LU coach to win 50 games when the Flames defeated VMI last week, 91-71 ... Liberty puts its 14-game home winning streak against Conference foes on the line Tuesday when High Point visits. The Flames also face Birmingham-Southern this week on the road.

RADFORD

The Highlanders are looking to record their sixth season ever with just one home loss, the last coming in 1999-00. The other years were 1982-83, 1984-85, 1990-91, 1991-92 and 1999-00 ... Radford hosts Birmingham-Southern in a BSTN game Monday night, then heads to Charleston Southern on Saturday.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs have won two-straight Conference games for the second time this season and are 4-1 in their last five Big South contests. In that five-game span, UNCA is outrebounding its opponents 43.6 to 30.0 (+13.6), including an average of 17 offensive rebounds per night (vs. 11.4) ... **BRYAN McCULLOUGH** needs 16 points to move into 20th place on the Bulldogs' career scoring list. He is ninth all-time in assists with 271 ... UNCA visits Coastal Carolina Monday night before hosting High Point on Saturday.

VMI

The Keydets are in the midst of their longest losing spell since 1999-00, when VMI lost 17 straight ... VMI shot a season-high 51% from the floor against High Point last Wednesday, the first time the Keydets surpassed the .500 mark in a game this year. They also hit .491 last Monday against Liberty ... VMI opens a three-game road trip at Winthrop Monday night, a team it defeated exactly 365 days ago when the Keydets topped the Eagles, 68-61, at Cameron Hall on Jan. 31, 2004. The road swings continues with a visit to Coastal Carolina on Saturday.

WINTHROP

Winthrop moved up to No. 14 in this week's *CollegiateInsider.com* Top 25 Mid-Major poll, their highest spot of the season. The previous best was 19th on Dec. 20 after defeating East Carolina ... This is the second time in school history that Winthrop has opened with 15 wins in its first 20 games. The 1980-81 squad was 18-2 after 20 games ... The Eagles continue to pace the League in overall scoring defense (61.2) and in League tilts (63.0). Winthrop has led the Big South in overall scoring defense six straight seasons -- all during **GREGG MARSHALL**'s tenure as coach ... Winthrop hosts VMI Monday night in its only action of the week, which will be Marshall's 200th game as the Eagles' mentor.
