Shuler averaged 21.5 points in two wins last week, leading Winthrop with 18 points at Radford and a career-high 25 points vs. High Point. He went 13-of-25 from the field (=.520) as well as 15-of-16 from the charity stripe (=.938), while adding 4.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 3.5 steals in helping the Eagles clinch the Big South regular-season title and secure the No. 1 seed in next week's Advance Auto Parts Big South Conference Men's Basketball Championship. Against High Point, Shuler posted four assists, five steals and went 9-of-9 from the line and was the Eagles' top scorer in both games.

#### NEW BALANCE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Williams led VMI to its first two Conference wins of the season and snapped an 11-game League losing streak in the process with a 16.7 scoring average in three games. He was VMI's leading scorer in all three contests -- including 25 points in the Keydets' first Big South win of the year Feb. 14, which was his sixth 20-point game of the season. Williams finished the week hitting .400 from the arc (6-of-15) and 1.000 from the charity stripe (8-of-8), while averaging 5.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists.

**WINTHROP CLINCHES REGULAR-SEASON TITLE**

The Winthrop Eagles are the 2004-05 Big South Men's Basketball Regular-Season champion, clinching the top spot following Liberty's loss to VMI last Thursday. Winthrop, which has won a League-record 13-straight Conference games, wrapped up its fourth regular-season League title in seven seasons, all under coach **GREGG MARSHALL's** tenure. The Eagles' previous titles came in 1998-99, 2001-02 and 2002-03. Winthrop also secured the No. 1 seed and home court throughout the 2005 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship.

**THE EAGLES HAVE LANDED**

Winthrop's 13 Conference wins are the most by a League member since UNC Greensboro won 14 Big South contests in 1994-95. Winthrop assistant coach **RANDY PEELE** was an assistant on that UNCG staff as well. The Eagles' 22 wins are the most in the Big South since Liberty won 23 games in 1996-97. With two League games remaining, Winthrop has a chance to tie the Big South record for most Conference wins (15), as well as set the League mark for Conference winning percentage. Meanwhile, Winthrop's 13-game winning streak is tied with Davidson for the fourth-longest active streak in the nation.

**LIBERTY CLINCHES HOME SEED IN 2005 ADVANCE AUTO PARTS CHAMPIONSHIP**

The Liberty Flames have captured a home seed in the 2005 Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship and at least a top four seed for the second-straight season. In addition, the Flames have back-to-back 10-win Conference seasons for the first time in school history, as Liberty has followed up last year's 12-4 mark with a 10-5 record this year with one game remaining.

**VMI ENDS LOSING STREAK; VALIANT EFFORT FALLS SHORT**

The Keydets broke their 11-game Conference losing streak last week and staved off elimination from a berth in the Big South Tournament at the same time, as VMI won 67-54 at Radford and defeated Liberty 73-67. While VMI was still mathematically alive despite its 2-11 record, the run ended Saturday with a loss at Birmingham-Southern -- officially eliminating VMI from the postseason race. However, VMI's eight wins better last season's total (6), and the Keydets can play spoiler this week as they host Winthrop and High Point to conclude the season.

**HOMEWARD BOUND**

Winthrop finished its regular-season home schedule a perfect 13-0, becoming the first Big South squad since Radford in 2000-01 to go undefeated at home in a single-season. The Highlanders did not have the task of playing Conference Tournament games at home that season. Winthrop will look to stretch that mark beginning Tuesday, March 1, with the first round of the Advance Auto Parts Basketball Championship.

**IMPROVING HOME IMPROVEMENT**

With the Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship format of highest seeds hosting Tournament games, the current top four teams in the Big South -- Winthrop, Liberty, UNC Asheville and High Point -- have a combined overall home record of 39-9 (.813). In Conference games, the combined mark is 26-4 (.867). Below is a look at home and road Conference records in current standings order:

Winthrop junior forward **JAMES SHULER** has been a jack-of-all-trades player for the Eagles the last 11 games, as he is averaging 14.4 points, 5.5 rebounds, 3.27 assists and 2.0 steals in that span, while shooting .447 from the floor and .763 from the line. He scored a career-high 25 points in Winthrop's 74-66 win over High Point and has led the Eagles in scoring the last three games. In his 11-game spurt, Shuler has been Winthrop's top scorer four times, top rebounder six times and top assist man four times.

**DEES OVERTAKES CONFERENCE GAMES SCORING LEAD**

Liberty sophomore **DAVID DEES** has moved ahead of Coastal Carolina's **PELE PAELAY** on the Conference Games Only scoring chart, as he is averaging 19.4 points in 14 League tilts. In his last 10 appearances, Dees is scoring at a 20.7 per game pace, as well as shooting .484 from the floor (62-of-128), .379 from three-point range (22-of-58) and .754 from the charity stripe (61-of-81). Dees has tallied six of his nine 20-point games in the current span.

**TRIPLE-DECKER**

Coastal Carolina freshman **JACK LEASURE** extended his Conference-leading three-point field goal streak to 18 games, the longest in the League this season. In that span, he has posted five three-pointers in a game four times. Winthrop sophomore **TORRELL MARTIN** improved his streak to 11 straight games, and is one away from tying his season-opening streak of 12 consecutive games with a three-point bucket. In that first streak, Martin went 24-of-63 from the arc ( =.381), compared to his current run, which is detailed below:

**POPOOLA JOINS BIG SOUTH 1,000-POINT SCORERS**

Radford senior **OLUMUYIWA POPOOLA** became the 59th member of the Big South's 1,000-point club -- and fourth this season -- this past Saturday at Liberty. He now owns 1,007 career points, good for 58th place. UNC Asheville's **BRYAN McCULLOUGH** ranks 47th all-time on the Conference's career scoring chart with 1,130 points and needs 41 points for 46th place.

**UNC ASHEVILLE JUMPS IN STANDINGS**

UNC Asheville is 8-3 in its last 11 games, and its eight Conference wins are the most since winning 10 in 2001-02 season. If the Bulldogs can remain in third place in the standings, it would mark the seventh time in coach **EDDIE BIEDENBACH**'s nine seasons that UNCA has finished among the top three. Biedenbach is 74-48 ( =.607) in regular-season Big South games in his nine years.

**MOHN OVER MY HAMMY**

During UNC Asheville's current 8-3 run, junior forward **CHAD MOHN** is averaging 11.3 points, 7.2 rebounds and .488 from the floor -- well above his season averages of 8.7 points, 5.2 rebounds and .437 field goal shooting. During the span, he has scored in double figures six times, including 19 points in two of the last three games.

**WINTHROP MOVES INTO 12TH IN MID-MAJOR POLL**

The Eagles have moved into the 12th spot on *Collegeinsider.com*'s Mid-Major Top 25 poll, their highest place ever. Winthrop was 13th last week, 15th in Week 10 and 14th in Week 9.

**GATHINGS RETURNS FROM SUSPENSION**

Suspended High Point senior **DANNY GATHINGS** returned to the Panthers' lineup this past Saturday at Winthrop, and scored seven points with four rebounds in 17 minutes off the bench. He missed a total of four games.

**MARSHALL 2ND BIG SOUTH COACH WITH FOUR 20-WIN CAMPAIGNS**

Winthrop coach **GREGG MARSHALL** has led his squad to four 20-win seasons during his seven years, equalling former Radford coach **RON BRADLEY**'s Big South record. Bradley led the Highs to 20-win seasons in 1990-91, 1991-92, 1993-94 and 1997-98. Meanwhile, Marshall, who is the only Big South coach ever to record seven-straight 15-win seasons, is third on the League's all-time win chart with 137, and is climbing the Big South's list for Conference wins. He has tied former Coastal Carolina coach **RUSS BERGMAN** for second with 75 victories.
